Freddy Peralta has held opponents to a .199 batting average over his MLB career (since 2018)....of pitchers with at least 600.0 innings pitched during that span, only Jacob deGrom (.187) and Justin Verlander (.195) have lower opponent batting averages.

# They're Out of Our League

The Brewers are 51-29 (.638) during Interleague Play since 2022, trailing only the Dodgers (49-23, .681)....the team is 8-6 in Interleague Play this season.....the Brewers start a 3-game series in Kansas City tomorrow.

TODAY'S GAME: Is the third game (1-1) of a 6-game road trip to Chicago-NL (1-1) and Kansas City (3g).....following this trip, the team returns to American Family Field for a 7-game homestand against St. Louis (4g) and Pittsburgh (3g).

AT HOME: The Brewers are 7-7 at home, going 2-2-1 in series play.

<u>ON THE ROAD</u>: The Brewers are 13-5 on the road, going 4-0-1 in series play.....their 13-5 record ties the best road start in franchise history (also 2014).

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach.....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the San Diego Padres (42-54), replacing Bud Black in June of that season.....Murphy enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career spent primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009).

COACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (4th season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach Connor Dawson (3rd season), assistant pitching coach Jim Henderson (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (6th season), third base coach Jason Lane (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator Walker McKinven (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach Dzzie Timmons (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff..... Rickie Weeks (associate manager), Daniel de Mondesert (assistant coach) and Charlie Greene (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

**LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE**: The Brewers have made six replay challenges this season, going 5-1.....their last challenge came on 4/24 at Pittsburgh as a safe call at first base involving Edward Olivares in the ninth inning stood.

# TODAY'S STARTER: #51 - RHP FREDDY PERALTA (6gs, 3-0, 3.21)

PERALTA AT A GLANCE: Freddy Peralta, 27, is making his seventh start.....Peralta last started last Tuesday vs. Tampa Bay and earned an 8-2 win (5.1ip, 1h, 2r, 2er, 0bb, 7k, 1hr, 2hbp, 66 pitches)....he was ejected for the first time in his career (by Chris Guccione) after allegedly hitting Jose Siri intentionally with a pitch.....he was suspended for 5 games by MLB but is appealing.....the team is 6-0 in his starts.....he has made 3 quality starts.....opponents are batting .171 (20-for-117, 4hr).....he is the third pitcher in franchise history born in the Dominican Republic to start on Opening Day, joining Rafael Roque (1999) and Wily Peralta (2016), who is of no relation.....Peralta was acquired from Seattle, along with RHP Carlos Herrera and RHP Daniel Missaki, in exchange for 1B Adam Lind on 12/9/15.....on 2/28/20, he signed a 5-year contract through the 2024 season with club options for 2025 and 2026.

LAST SEASON: Peralta went 12-10 with a 3.86 ERA in a career-high 30 starts last season.....the team went 17-13 in his starts.....he made 16 quality starts.....opponents batted .212 (131-for-617, 26hr).....Peralta ranked among the 2023 National League leaders in K/9IP (3rd, 11.41), WHIP (5th, 1.12), H/9IP (5th, 7.12), strikeouts (T5th, 210) and K/BB [7th, 3.89]....he became the eighth pitcher (14x) in franchise history to produce 200+ strikeouts in a season.

CAREER: Is 45-27 with a 3.79 ERA and 1 save in 152 games/103 starts (614.1ip. 259er)....is in his seventh Major League season, all with the Brewers (2018-24)....has gone 37-25 with a 3.78 ERA as a starter (530.1ip, 223er) and 8-2 with a 3.86 ERA in relief (84ip, 36er)....was an All-Star in 2021.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 26-14 with a 3.39 ERA in 80 games/52 starts (323.2ip, 122er).....is 1-0 with a 4.09 ERA in 2 starts this season (11ip, 5er).

**CAREER ON THE ROAD:** Is 19-13 with a 4.24 ERA in 72 games/51 starts (290.2ip, 137er)....is 2-0 with a 2.78 ERA in 4 starts this season (22.2ip, 7er).

CAREER vs. CUBS: Is 5-1 with a 3.34 ERA in 15 games/10 starts (59.1ip, 37h, 22r, 22er, 31bb, 85k, 6hr).....his only start against the Cubs last season came on 7/6 in Milwaukee as he had no decision in a 6-5 win (5.1ip, 4h, 3r, 3er, 3bb, 10k, 1hr).....is 3-1 with a 4.50 ERA in 8 career games/6 starts at Wrigley Field (30ip, 24h, 15r, 15er, 19bb, 43k, 2hr).
