PERALTA AT A GLANCE: Freddy Peralta, 27, is making his seventh start..... Peralta last started last Tuesday vs. Tampa Bay and earned an $8-2$ win [ $5.1 \mathrm{lip}, 1 \mathrm{~h}, 2 \mathrm{r}$, 2er, Obb $7 \mathrm{k}, 1 \mathrm{hr}$, 2hbp, 66 pitches)......he was ejected for the first time in his career (by Chris Guccione) after allegedly hitting Jose Siri intentionally with a pitch......he was suspended for 5 games by MLB but is appealing.....the team is 6-0 in his starts......he has made 3 quality starts.....opponents are batting . 171 [20-for-117, 4hr].....he is the third pitcher in franchise history born in the Dominican Republic to start on Opening Day, joining Rafael Roque [1999] and Wily Peralta [2016], who is of no relation.....Peralta was acquired from Seattle, along with RHP Carlos Herrera and RHP Daniel Missaki, in exchange for 1B Adam Lind on 12/9/15.....on 2/28/20, he signed a 5 -year contract through the 2024 season with club options for 2025 and 2026.
