**BIRD WATCHING:** The St. Louis Cardinals conclude a three-game series and homestand with the San Diego Padres this afternoon. The Cardinals won the first two games 3-0 and 3-2 and wrapped up the season series for the first time since 2024, leading 4-2 with one game remaining, giving them the tie-breaker for the post-season. Following today's game, the Cardinals fly to Kansas City to take on their in-state rivals in the Show-Me State Championship concluding their home-and-home "natural rival" series for 2026.

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** St. Louis enters today in 2nd place in the NL Central, 4.5 games back of Milwaukee. The Cardinals reside atop the National League Wild Card standings with Philadelphia and Washington occupying the final two slots. Since June 3, the Cardinals have the best record in baseball at 9-3 (.750).

**LIFE BEGINS AT 40:** Cardinals became the 7th team in Major League Baseball to reach 40 wins last night, edged out by the Phillies by a little over an hour. The last time the Cardinals won 40 games through their first 71 was in 2022 en route to their last N.L. Central title.

**SWEEP-STAKES:** A win today would give the Cardinals their 4th sweep of the season and first against San Diego since May 30-June 1, 2022 at Busch Stadium. The 'Birds have broomed road series at Houston (4/17-19 - 3G), at Pittsburgh (4/27-30 - 4G) and Cincinnati at home (6/5-7 - 3G). The Cardinals have won 6-straight home games.

**NO-HIT ZONE:** Cardinals pitching has held the Padres to just five hits over their first two games, and with four hits or less today, would set their franchise record for fewest hits allowed in a three-games series. Their previous low was 10 against the San Diego Padres Sept. 1-3, 2001 highlighted by Bud Smith's no-hitter. The fewest hits allowed in a three-game series this season is held by the Atlanta Braves hosting the Chicago Cubs with 11 (May 10-12) at Truist Park. The 19 hits over the first six games of the season is the fewest the Padres have been held to in a season series of six or more games. The previous low was held by the 2014 Pittsburgh Pirates limiting San Diego to 30 hits over six games.

**POP THE CLUTCH:** Five of the six Cardinals runs this series have come with two outs as have 7-of-8 total runs between the two squads.

**I'D LIKE A DECISION:** Today's starting pitcher **Kyle Leahy** has not registered a decision in his last four starts, last recording a win vs. Kansas City on May 16. This is the longest streak without a decision by a Cardinals starting pitcher since **Wade LeBlanc** finished his Major League career with five from July 18-Aug. 12, 2021.

**THEY'RE HAVING A BBQ IN THE BULLPEN:** **Dustin May** (9.0) and **Andre Pallante** (7.0) threw consecutive starts of 7.0 innings or more for the first time by Cardinals pitchers since May 6-10, 2025 when the Cardinals ran off four straight starts (**Matthew Liberatore** 7.0 vs. PIT; **Sonny Gray** 7.0 vs. PIT; **Erick Fedde** 9.0 at WSH; **Andre Pallante** 7.1 at WSH)

**BOMBS AWAY BÁEZ!:** Memphis Redbirds outfielder **Joshua Báez** slammed four home runs last night in a 12-5 win over Nashville (Brewers). Báez set the Redbirds single-game franchise record and currently leads the International League with 23 home runs, trailing only **Manuel Pena** (Diamondbacks) for the Minor League lead with 26. Báez is the only player in MLB or MiLB with a 4 HR game this season and the first by a Cardinals farmhand since **Chandler Redmond** for Springfield (AA) at Amarillo on Aug. 10, 2022. The last in professional baseball was Philadelphia's **Kyle Schwarber** vs. Atlanta on Aug. 28, 2025.

#### SAN DIEGO CONNECTIONS

**Fernando Tatis**, father of Padres outfielder, **Fernando Tatis Jr.**, played three seasons with St. Louis (1998-2000)...is famously remembered for hitting two grand slams in one inning (April 23, 1999 at Los Angeles), both off of **Chan Ho Park**.

Cardinals TV broadcaster **Mark Sweeney** played parts of four seasons in San Diego (1997-98, 2002, 2005) and appeared in the 1998 World Series...was a part of the Padres broadcasting team for 12 seasons (2012-23)...resides in San Diego.

**Ramón Urías's** younger brother, **Luis Urías**, played parts of two seasons in San Diego (2018-19), where he made his MLB debut.

**Brant Brown** (June 15, 1996 at Wrigley), **Daniel Descalso** (Sept. 18, 2010 at Busch III), **Dustin May** (Aug. 8, 2019 at Dodger Std.), and **Brad Thompson** (May 8, 2005 at Busch II) made MLB debuts vs. the Padres.

Cardinals President of Baseball Operations **Chaim Bloom** began his baseball career as a Baseball Operations Intern with the San Diego Padres.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played 26 games for San Diego in 2008...traded by St. Louis to San Diego for **David Freese** (Dec. 14, 2007).

Hall of Famer **Ozzie Smith** was selected by San Diego in the 4th round of the 1977 MLB Draft...played four seasons with San Diego (1978-81)...traded by San Diego with Al Olmsted and Steve Mura to St. Louis for Luis DeLeon, Sixto Lezcano and Garry Templeton (Dec. 10, 1981).

**Jon Jay** played the 2016 season with San Diego...traded by St. Louis to the Padres for **Jedd Gyorko** and cash (Dec. 8, 2015).

Padres Asst. Hitting Coach **Mike McCoy** was selected by St. Louis in the 34th round of the 2002

MLB Draft...played six minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization.

Padres Baseball Operations Advisor **Allen Craig** played parts of five seasons (2010-14) with St. Louis, where he was a 2013 NL All-Star and member of 2011 World Series Champion Cardinals.

Padres Coach **Nick Punto** played 63 games for St. Louis in 2011 and was a member of the 2011 World Series Champions.

Padres Coach **Peter Summerville's** brother, **Andrew**, was drafted by St. Louis in the 12th round in 2017...pitched two minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Ray Lankford** played parts of two seasons for San Diego (2001-02)...traded by St. Louis with cash to the Padres for **Woody Williams** (Aug. 2, 2001).

**TODAY'S STARTER:**

- Today marks Kyle's 14th start of the season (15th career) and 112th career Major League appearance; he transitioned to a full-time starter to begin the 2026 season.
- Facing the Padres for the 2nd time this season and 5th time career; He blanked SD over 5.0 IP in his start on 5/10 at Petco Park and took a no-decision in the Cardinals 3-2 extra inning loss on Mother's Day.
- Currently riding 3-game win streak since April 28, but has no-decisions in each of the last four starts with the Cardinals going 1-3 in those four games.
- His five wins this season are a career high and rank 2nd on the team to Andre Pallante (8).
- Three of his five wins this season have come on the road: April 5 at Detroit, April 17 at Houston and April 28 at Pittsburgh.
- Has made four starts in nationally televised games including Easter Sunday on NBC/Peacock Sunday Night Baseball in Detroit, April 11 vs. Boston on FOX, May 23 -Game 2 at Cincinnati on FOX & May 29 vs. the Cubs on FOX.
- His first 97 career appearances were as a relief pitcher beginning with his Major League debut on July 7, 2023; First career start came at Chicago's Wrigley Field on Sept. 28, 2025.
- Kyle's 97 career relief appearances before his 1st career Major League start (Sept. 28, 2025 at CHI) were the most by a Cardinal since **Jordan Hicks** (April 21, 2022 at Miami) who made his 1st career start after having made 114 career relief appearances.

**LAST TIME OUT (Friday, June 12 at Minnesota):** ND, L 9-8; 5.0 IP, 8 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 1 BB, 5 SO, 0 HR - 77 pitches.

- Took a ND for a 4th consecutive start as the Cardinals & Twins exchange late inning leads in a 9-8 MIN that saw the Cardinals let four different leads slip away.
- He departed the game with the Cardinal holding a 3-2 lead after 5.0 IP.

**2026 HIGHLIGHTS:**

**EN GARDE:** Ranks T-3rd among all MLB pitchers with his 20 Opponent's Sword Swings (Max Meyer-MIA, 1st with 29) and his 88.2 competitive swing pct. ranks 8th best among MLB qualifying starters and 2nd on the Cardinals staff to **Andre Pallante** (87.7). A "sword" swing is an expression of the art of forcing a batter to take an uncomfortable, awkward swing.

**FRIDAY NIGHT FLIGHT:** Was in line for the win in his start last Fri. (6/12) at MIN before the two teams went on to score 12 combined runs over the game's final four innings and the Twins pulled out a 9-8 win.

**AIR BENDER:** Ranks 18th among all MLB pitchers with an average swing & miss distance of 6.9 inches, including a season high 19.6 inch swing & miss by the Pirates Brian Reynolds on April 28.

**HIGHS & LOWS:** Struck out a career-high 8 batters in his 5/23 [2] start at CIN, but also allowed a career-high 5 runs - all coming in his 5th and final inning of work

**PARK PLACE:** Each of his first six road games took place at Parks ( Petco Park, Comerica Park, Daikin Park, loanDepot park, PNC Park, Great American Ball Park). His start at Target Field on June 12 ended the string.

**CENTRAL FOCUS:** Earned wins in two of his five starts against NL Central opponents this season (April 28 at PIT & May 4 vs. MIL) to improve to 4-1 in his career against divisional opponents.

**DECISIONS, DECISIONS** Has earned the decision in eight of his 13 starts, but has taken no-decisions in each of his last four starting assignments.

**STRETCHING OUT:** Pitched a career-high 6.0 innings in his 5/16 start vs. KC, and has worked at least 5.0 innings in 10 of his 13 starts on the year.

**OH MOTHER:** Blanked the Padres over his 5.0 IP on just 2 hits on May 10 (Mother's Day), and was in line for the win before the Padres Nick Castellanos tied the game with a 2-out, 2-strike 2-run HR to tie the game at 2-2, and then SD won it in the 10th, 3-2.

**BROOM RIDE:** Gained the win in the middle game of the Cardinals three-game series sweep at HOU in a 9-4 win on 4/17; Struck out a season high 6, but allowed 3 solo HR's.

**ALL EYES ON US:** Drew back-to-back starting assignments in nationally televised games on Easter Sunday on NBC/Peacock Sunday Night Baseball in Detroit and April 11 vs. Boston on FOX. Made the start on 5/23 [2] at Cincinnati on FOX in national telecast Memorial Day weekend.

**EASTER DELIGHT:** Gained his 1st win of the season on April 5, allowing 2 runs over 5.0 IP in the Cardinals 5-3 Easter win over the Tigers. He threw a career-high 97 pitches as he earned the winning decision as a starter for the 1st time - all while helping to prevent a series sweep by Detroit.

**IT'S COLDER IN BOULDER:** Colorado native worked in game time temps of 42° on Easter Sunday in Detroit, his third career MLB appearance in temperatures 45° and below, two shy of matching Cards announcer **Brad Thompson** (5) for T-3rd among Cardinals in the frosty temps.

**CAREER:**

- Graduated from Erie (Colo.) High School. Named Boulder County POY and was selected to play at the High School Futures Game at Coors Field.
- Played college baseball at Colorado Mesa Univ. in Grand Junction, CO, going 22-2 with a 3.13 ERA (204.1 IP), 188 K and six complete games.
- Allowed nine home runs to 852 total batters faced while pitching in high altitude (Grand Junction is 4,583 ft above sea level).
- Posted a 13-0 record with a 1.41 ERA during his sophomore season, earning First Team All-American, First Team Academic All-American, and was the South Central Regional Tournament MVP.
- His father, Tim Leahy, played college basketball at Kansas State University and his uncle, Thomas Leahy, pitched in the Braves organization (1991-93) advancing to Durham (High-A).

**LEAHY VS. SAN DIEGO:**

- Makes his 2nd career start and 5th career appearance vs. the Padres this afternoon.
- Is 0-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER/10.1 IP) and 8 strikeouts in his career meetings against the Padres.
- Blanked the Padres over 5.0 IP on just 2 hits on May 10 (Mother's Day), and was in line for the win before the Padres Nick Castellanos tied the game with a 2-out, 2-strike 2-run HR to tie the game at 2-2, and then SD won it in the 10th, 3-2.
- Pitched 2.2 scoreless innings of relief on 7/26/25 vs. SD that was his longest home relief outing of the season and the longest scoreless relief appearance by a Cardinals pitcher against the Padres since Carlos Martinez.
- Worked 2.2 scoreless innings on 6/30/19 during a 5-3, 11-inning win at Petco Park.
- Today marks his 2nd career start vs. the NL West (both times vs. Padres). Has not allowed a run in eight of his last nine outings vs. NL West opponents since 7/26/25. His 0.97 career WHIP against the NL West is the 4th lowest in franchise history (min. 25.0 IP).
