The 2023 Baltimore Orioles Media Guide, as well as the latest game notes, rosters, press releases, and other team information, can be found at oriolespressbox.com.

YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles were shut out by the Guardians yesterday, 5-0, in the opener of the three-game set at Oriole Park...Have dropped three straight series openers and four of their last five after beginning the year 13-0 in such games...Were shut out for the fourth time this season and first since May 14 vs. Pittsburgh; all shutouts have come since May 3...Have dropped four of their last five games at Oriole Park after beginning the year 15-7 at home.

WELLS, WELLS, WELLS: Tyler Wells has struck out at least seven batters in each of his last four starts, tied for the third-longest streak by an Orioles pitcher since the franchise moved to Baltimore in 1954, behind an eight-game streak by Connie Johnson in 1957 and a five-game streak by Erik Bedard in 2007; Wells is the first O's hurler to strike out at least seven batters in four straight starts since Dylan Bundy did so in 2017...Wells' streak is the third-longest active streak in MLB this season behind Atlanta's Spencer Strider (11 G) and Pittsburgh's Mitch Keller (6 G).

⚾ Leads MLB in WHIP (0.83) and opponent on-base percentage (.220); also ranks among qualified pitchers in H/9 (2nd, 5.71), opponent batting average (2nd, .176), and BB/9 (7th, 1.71).

⚾ Has tossed at least 5.0 innings in each of his 11 appearances (10 starts) this season; entered 2023 with 12 such games (all in 2022).

CLOSE ENCOUNTERS: Of Baltimore's 54 games this season, 48 have been decided by four or fewer runs, tied with Los Angeles-AL for the most in MLB...The O's have gone 31-17 in those games, the most wins and best winning percentage (.646) in MLB...The O's have gone 22-13 in games decided by three or fewer runs, tied for the most wins in MLB with Cleveland (22-19).

THE SKIPPER: Manager **Brandon Hyde** managed his 600th career game with the Orioles yesterday, becoming the sixth skipper to manage 600 games for the Orioles, along with Earl Weaver (2,541), Buck Showalter (1,353), Paul Richards (1,063), Hank Bauer (726), and Mike Hargrove (649)...Managed his 600th overall game on Sunday; served one game as Miami's interim manager on June 19, 2011 against Tampa Bay, following the resignation of manager Edwin Rodriguez...Hyde is currently in his fifth season as manager of the Orioles after being named the 20th manager in club history on December 14, 2018...In 2022, he led the O's to an 83-79 record, his first winning season as manager and the club's first winning campaign since 2016...He was named the *Baseball America* MLB Manager of the Year and was voted the *Sporting News* American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers...He finished second in voting for the Baseball Writers' Association of America (BBWAA) American League Manager of the Year award.

FEELS GOOD TO BE HOME: The O's are in the middle of a six-game homestand, which began this past weekend with three games against the Rangers (1-2)...The Orioles are hosting the Guardians for a three-game set which began yesterday (0-1)...The Birds are 16-11 (.593) in Baltimore and own the fourth-best home winning percentage in the AL and tied for fifth-best in MLB.

AGAINST THE GUARDIANS: The O's are facing the Guardians for the second of seven games this season...The Birds will travel to Cleveland for four games at Progressive Field from September 21-24...Baltimore went 3-3 against Cleveland in 2022, 1-2 at Oriole Park and 2-1 at Progressive Field...The O's have not won a season series against the Guardians since 2016 (5-1).

WHAT'S TRENDING: The O's have won 25 of their last 38 games, 28 of 42, and 30 of 45...The 34-20 overall record ranks third in MLB to start the season (see box at right)...Entering today, the Rays (39-17), Rangers (34-19), Dodgers (33-22), Yankees (33-23), Braves (32-22), Astros (31-22), and Diamondbacks (31-23) are the only other teams with 30 wins this season, while the Rays and Rangers are the only other teams with 20 or fewer losses.

MOUNT UP: Ryan Mountcastle ranks fifth in MLB with 28 Barrels, per *Statcast*, trailing only New York-AL's Aaron Judge (32), Toronto's Matt Chapman (31), Atlanta's Matt Olson (30), and New York-NL's Pete Alonso (29)...He ranks tied for ninth in MLB with 80 Hard-Hit Balls...His 38 RBI rank tied for seventh in the AL and tied for 11th in MLB; they are tied with Los Angeles-NL's Max Muncy for third among primary first basemen, trailing only New York-NL's Pete Alonso (46) and Atlanta's Matt Olson (42).

SOLID CONTACT: The Orioles rank tied with the Cardinals and Dodgers for sixth in MLB with an 89.8 mph average exit velocity, per *Statcast*, trailing the Braves (91.2 mph), Rays (90.3 mph), Angels (90.0 mph), and Rangers and Yankees (89.9 mph)...Baltimore's 15.1 degree average launch angle on batted balls is the second-highest in the majors, trailing only the Dodgers (15.5)...Baltimore's 576 Hard-Hit Balls rank sixth in the AL and ninth in MLB.

WHAT A RELIEF: The Baltimore bullpen owns a 3.11 ERA (70 ER/202.2 IP), the third-best in MLB behind the Yankees (2.95) and Guardians (3.09)...O's relievers have 16 wins this season, tied with the Yankees for the most in the majors...The O's are second in MLB with 235 strikeouts from the 'pen, trailing the Royals (249).

ROSTER MOVES: The Orioles today signed outfielder **Aaron Hicks** to a Major League contract...He will wear No. 34 and be active for tonight's game...In a corresponding move, outfielder **Cedric Mullins** was placed on the 10-day Injured List with a right groin strain.

ON THIS DATE IN 1982: Though it is unknown at the time, **Cal Ripken, Jr.** begins his amazing consecutive games streak in a home loss to the Blue Jays, batting eighth and playing third base...It will be more than 16 seasons before Ripken does not start a game for the Orioles, after 2,632 consecutive games.

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his 12th start of the season, fifth at home, and 22nd career appearance (21st start) against the Guardians tonight...Became the first O's pitcher in club history (since 1954) to start and win each of his three first appearances with the team...Started a season 4-0 for the second time in his career, joining a 6-0 start with Texas in 2021; became the fifth Oriole starting pitcher since 2004 to begin a year 4-0, joining **John Means** (4-0 in 2021), Bud Norris (4-0 in 2013), Wei-Yin Chen (4-0 in 2012), and Erik Bedard (4-0 in 2006)...In 278 career appearances (272 starts), Gibson owns a 95-94 record with a 4.49 ERA (783 ER/1570.0 IP)...The O's signed Gibson to a one-year contract on December 5, 2022...He has also spent time with the Twins, Phillies, and Rangers across 10 Major League seasons.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his second straight win in his last start on May 25 at New York-AL...Worked a season-high-tying 7.0 scoreless innings on two hits with a season-high four walks and three strikeouts...Marked his team-leading sixth quality start of the season...Also marked his sixth win of the season; last season, he earned his sixth victory in his 20th start on July 27 vs. Atlanta with Philadelphia...Became the oldest O's pitcher (35-214) to toss 7.0-or-more shutout innings in a start since Freddy Garcia (36-236) also tossed 7.0 scoreless frames on May 30, 2013 vs. Washington...Marked his fewest hits surrendered in a start since also allowing two on April 22 vs. Detroit...Also marked his first shutout start of 7.0-or-more innings since also tossing 7.0 scoreless frames on August 27, 2022 vs. Pittsburgh with Philadelphia...Tossed 7.0 innings-or-more in back-to-back starts for the first time since working 15.0 innings across two outings from April 13-18, 2021 with Texas...Threw 96 pitches, 56 strikes.

CAREER AGAINST THE GUARDIANS: Making his 22nd career appearance (21st start) against the Guardians...Charged with a blown save in his last start against Cleveland with Minnesota on September 15, 2019 at Progressive Field...Allowed two runs (1 ER) on two hits (1 HR) and one walk in 1.0 inning...Threw 31 pitches, 16 strikes...Owns a 3-10 record with a 5.59 ERA (64 ER/103.0 IP) through his first 21 appearances (20 starts) against the Guardians.

CAREER AGAINST THE AL CENTRAL: Making his 96th career appearance (92nd start) against the AL Central tonight...Has made four starts against the division in 2023, going 1-1 with a 5.56 ERA (14 ER/22.2 IP) in those games...Dealt the loss in his last start against the AL Central on May 3 at Kansas City after allowing six runs on 10 hits (1 HR), both season highs, in 6.2 innings of work...Did not record a walk or a strikeout in a start for the first time in his career...Threw 74 pitches, 49 strikes...Made his MLB debut on June 29, 2013 against the Royals with Minnesota; earned the win after allowing two runs on eight hits with five strikeouts and a hit batter in 6.0 innings at Target Field...Threw 91 pitches, 64 strikes...With the Rangers, he tossed a career-low 0.1 inning on April 1, 2021, at Kansas City...Owns a 33-32 record with a 4.54 ERA (267 ER/529.1 IP) through his first 95 games (91 starts) against the AL Central.

HOME COOKING: Making his fifth home start of the 2023 campaign tonight...Owns a 2-2 record with a 3.04 ERA (8 ER/23.2 IP) through his first four starts at Oriole Park this season...Dealt the loss in his last home start on May 14 vs. Pittsburgh after allowing four runs on seven hits with a then-season-high-tying three walks and five strikeouts in 5.0 innings...Threw 95 pitches, 57 strikes...Has lost each of his last two starts at Oriole Park since May 8 after winning two straight to begin the season.

GIBBY THE GIVER: On May 11, Gibson teamed up with "All Kids Bike", a nonprofit organization in Baltimore that aims to teach every child in America how to ride a bike...Gibson is a two-time nominee for the distinguished Roberto Clemente Award (2022 & 2019)...While with the Phillies, he donated to Philabundance, a nonprofit food bank in Philadelphia, and Cradles for Crayons...He also created a Philly Fantasy Football League in support of Help One Now, an organization that supports families in developing countries strike out extreme poverty...Gibson is the Vice President of the Big League Impact, a nonprofit founded in 2013 by Roberto Clemente Award winner Adam Wainwright (2020) to help people meet basic human needs, including food, clean water, medical care, shelter, and education...He was the recipient of the 2017 Carl R. Pohlad Community Service Award selected by the Twins Community Fund Board of Directors.

2022 HIGHLIGHTS: Went 10-8 with a 5.05 ERA (94 ER/167.2 IP) in 31 starts with the Phillies, the fifth time in his career making at least 30 starts in a season...Made his Phillies debut on April 9 vs. Oakland (W, 7.0 IP, 2 H, 10 K)...Made his 250th career start on July 27 vs. Atlanta...Retired the first 18 batters he faced on August 5 vs. Washington over 8.0 innings, the longest perfect game bid of his career...Struck out 11 batters on August 16 at Cincinnati, his second double-digit strikeout game of the season, the most in his career...Gibson's final nine starts averaged 10.37 K/9...Had a career-best 3.00 K/BB ratio (144 K/48 BB).

POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE: Appeared on his fifth career Postseason roster in 2022 with the Phillies and made his World Series debut in Game 3 at Citizens Bank Park, working 1.0 scoreless inning out of the bullpen with one hit and one strikeout in Philadelphia's 7-0 loss to the Houston Astros...In two relief appearances during the 2022 Postseason, he worked 2.1 scoreless innings, allowing two hits with one walk and two strikeouts.


