TODAY'S GAME: The Braves continue their exhibition schedule today against the Baltimore Orioles with their 19th of 32 games this spring... The club will play 16 games at CoolToday Park in North Port, Fla. and 16 games on the road...This afternoon's contest is the fourth of five scheduled exhibition meetings between the clubs...Baltimore has won each of the first three exhibitions..Both teams will field split-squads for their final meeting on March 17...During the regular season, Atlanta will visit Oriole Park at Camden Yards for a three-game set, June 11-13.

- The Braves will host nine different major league teams at CoolToday Park, including three games each against the Baltimore Orioles and Minnesota Twins and two games each against the Boston Red Sox, Pittsburgh Pirates and Tampa Bay Rays...The Detroit Tigers, New York Yankees, Philadelphia Phillies and Toronto Blue Jays will make one visit each to North Port.
- On March 17, Atlanta will travel to Boston's JetBlue Park at Fenway South in Fort Myers, Fla. for the inaugural edition of MLB Spring Breakout...The event is aimed toward showcasing baseball's future: the current stars of Minor League Baseball...Games will be played between teams comprised of each MLB organization's top prospects.

CAMP BREAKDOWN: The Braves currently have 36 players in camp, 17 of whom are pitchers (seven left-handers and 10 right-handers)...Atlanta also has four catchers, eight infielders and seven outfielders in camp... There are seven non-roster invitees (two catchers, three infielders and two outfielders)...The club opened camp with 60 players.

- On Tuesday, the Braves reassigned INF Nacho Alvarez Jr., INF Luke Waddell and OF Luis Liberato to minor league camp.
- On March 5, MLB Pipeline unveiled its prospect rankings for the 2024 season...Atlanta opened camp with seven players that currently rank among the team's top 30 prospects, including top overall prospect, RHP AJ Smith-Shawver...Also included are fellow top 10 prospects RHP Hurston Waldrep (No. 2) and INF Nacho Alvarez Jr. (No. 6).

23 IN '23: The Braves clinched the 23rd division title in franchise history last season, beating Philadelphia, 4-1 on September 13 at Citizens Bank Park to win the National League East...The 23 division titles are the most in major league history, two more than Los Angeles (NL) and three more than New York (AL)...Last season also marked the franchise's 29th postseason berth in the Modern Era (since 1900) and its sixth straight.

- The Braves won a major league-record 14 consecutive division titles from 1991-2005, with the first three coming as NL West champs before moving into the NL East in the strike-shortened 1994 season...They also won the West in 1969 and 1982, and the East in 2013 and every year since 2018.
- The six straight division titles marks the longest streak in baseball...The Astros have won three straight AL West titles dating to 2021, while the Dodgers have won each of the last two NL West crowns.

Probable Pitchers

Bryce Elder • RHP • 6-2 • 220 • 24 yrs • #55

- Makes his fourth start of the spring, last: March 7 at BOS...Owns a 7.04 ERA (6 ER/7.2 IP) with 10 strikeouts and three walks.
- Named to the NL All-Star team last season...In his first major league season, went 12-4 with a 3.81 ERA (74 ER/174.2 IP) in 31 starts... Began the year as Triple-A Gwinnett's Opening Day starter, before being recalled by Atlanta on April 4, 2023.
- Atlanta won 21 of his 31 starts (.677) last season...The only starting pitcher, league-wide, with more team wins in their starts was teammate RHP Spencer Strider (26-6, .813).

Dylan Lee • LHP • 6-3 • 214 • 29 yrs • #52

- Makes his sixth appearance of the spring, last: March 10 at NYY.
- Appeared in 24 games with Atlanta last season, 23 in relief...Posted a 4.18 ERA (11 ER/23.2 IP)...On Atlanta's Injured List, twice, May 19 (retro. May 17) to September 1 (left shoulder inflammation) and September 12 through season's end with the same ailment.
