TODAY'S GAME: SF seeks a series win with a victory this afternoon after evening the series with yesterday's 5-1 win over the Reds.

- ▶ SF is 4-8 in its last 12 games dating to April 30...the only teams with fewer wins since April 30 are the Blue Jays (3-6), Cardinals (2-9) and Reds (1-9).
- ▶ The Giants are 10-7 in day games...in home day games, the Giants are 6-2 with the only losses coming April 21 vs. ARI and April 24 vs. NYM.

ENOUGH ALREADY: OF Michael Conforto became the sixth Giant position player to go down with an injury in the last eight days, leaving yesterday's game with right hamstring strain.

- ▶ The others were **C Patrick Bailey** (May 4, concussion), **C Tom Murphy** (May 5, left knee sprain), **OF Jorge Soler** (May 8, right shoulder strain), **IF Nick Ahmed** (May 10, left wrist sprain) and **OF Austin Slater** (May 11, concussion).
- ▶ Of the five on the IL, only Bailey has been activated, missing the minimum seven games on the concussion IL.

HEY THERE YOUNG KIDS, WHAT'S HIP?: With the recent IL placements, the Giants have called up some of the younger players on their 40-man roster to fill the spots.

- ▶ The Giants have promoted the likes of **OF Heliot Ramos** (24 years, 248 days), **IF/OF Brett Wisely** (25 years, 4 days), **IF Casey Schmitt** (25 years, 72 days) and **C Blake Sabol** (26 years, 126 days).
- ▶ According to *Baseball Reference*, the Giants have an average batter's age (weighted by AB plus games played) of 29.8 years, third-oldest in the Majors...only the Mets (30.2) and Dodgers (30.4) are older.
- ▶ Looking at it differently, the Giants have had 2,731 games of MLB experience hit the IL between Ahmed, Murphy, Slater and Soler.
- ▶ Ramos, Sabol, Schmitt & Wisely have combined to play in 297 career MLB games.

SNELLZILLA...RECHARGING: LHP Blake Snell, who himself has been on the 15-day IL since April 24 with a left adductor strain, is scheduled to make a rehab start for Single-A San Jose today down the road at Excite Ballpark against Stockton.

- ▶ Snell has made three starts for SF after signing near the end of Spring Training...he's given up 15 runs on 18 hits in 11.2 innings over those three starts.

A RUNNING TAB: The Giants are slashing .226/.291/.342 over their last 16 games dating to April 24...they are averaging 3.00 runs/game in that span, scoring 48 runs in 16 games.

- ▶ SF's 3.00 runs/game in that time is thirteenth-worst in the Majors ahead of only the Reds (2.88 runs/game) and Pirates (2.75).
- ▶ Yesterday, however, the Giants were able to plate five runs in their 5-1 win...when the Giants have scored at least five this year they are a perfect 11-0.

HEADS UP, 7-UP: SF's bullpen worked 4.2 scoreless innings in yesterday's win...over their last seven games dating to May 5 the bullpen owns a 2.55 ERA (7er, 24.2ip) with 34 strikeouts to just eight walks.

YER A WIZARD, HARRY: LHP Kyle Harrison takes the bump this afternoon for his ninth start of the campaign and is facing the Reds for a second time in his career.

- ▶ Harrison's home debut on August 28 of last year came against the Reds...the young lefty was electric, striking out 11 batters over 6.1 shutout innings en route to his first Major League win with the Giants 4-1 victory.
- ▶ More recently, the Giants have won each of the 22-year-old's last five starts dating to April 15 with Harrison going 2-0 with a 2.25 ERA (7er, 28.0ip) in that time...of the Giants' three wins on their last 3-7 road trip, two of them came in Harrison starts.
- ▶ Furthermore, today marks Harrison's first start this year where he'll be pitching following a Giants win...SF had lost the game before each of his first eight starts this year.
- ▶ Here at Oracle Park in his brief MLB career (seven home starts), he's logged a 2.97 ERA (12er, 36.1ip).

STUNT ON 'EM, WALK: With another scoreless inning yesterday, **RHP Ryan Walker** lowered his ERA to 2.14.

- ▶ Over Walker's last 11 outings he's worked 11.0 scoreless innings, struck out 19, walked just one and allowed five hits.
- ▶ Walker owns a 34.9% strikeout %, seventh-best among ML relievers with at least 15.0ip innings pitched this year.

PATIENTLY WADE-ING: IF/OF LaMonte Wade Jr. has reached base in 12 consecutive games entering play today and has a .500 OBP with five RBI in that span...he's slashing .341/.475/.429 with five doubles, one homer and 12 RBI in 39 games so far this season.

- ▶ Wade's .475 on-base percentage and 19.5% walk rate are both tops in MLB (min. 100 PA), while his .341 average is eighth-best.
- ▶ Wade also carries an eight-game hitting streak into today's game...he's 10-for-25 (.400) with two runs scored, one double, four RBI and eight walks during that streak.

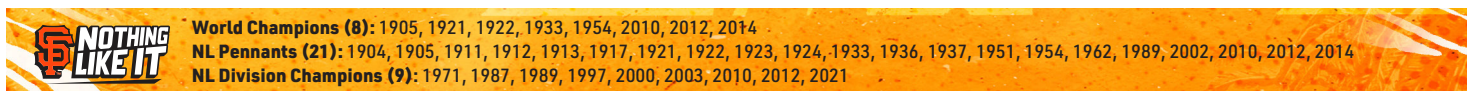
THOSE GUYS: The Los Angeles Dodgers make their first of two visits to Oracle Park starting tomorrow when the two teams open a three-game series.

- ▶ It's been a tough go versus LA at home since 2018 with the Giants going 17-29 in 46 games against the Dodgers here at Oracle Park...SF has a -101 run differential in that time.
- ▶ SF did not win a home series against the Dodgers last year, going 2-4...since August 1, 2022, the Giants are 2-11 in their last 13 games here against the Dodgers.

Austin Warren continues to throw bullpens twice a week in Arizona, mixing in all his pitches.

TODAY'S START: Harrison is scheduled to make his ninth start of the season today in the final game of this three-game series against the Reds...Harrison is 3-1 with a 3.20 ERA (16er, 45.0ip) in his eight starts this season...the Giants are 6-2 in his starts this season, having won each of his last five.

ABOUT KYLE: Entered the season as the No. 1 ranked player in the SF system and the top left-handed pitching prospect entering the 2024 season, according to *MLB.com* and *Baseball America*...Harrison was selected in the third round of the 2020 draft out of local De La Salle High School in Concord, CA.

LAST TIME OUT: Tossed a career-high 7.0 shutout innings on May 7 at Colorado, becoming the sixth Giants pitcher to throw at least 7.0 shutout innings at Coors Field...Harrison joined **Barry Zito** (April 9, 2012; 9.0ip), **Tim Lincecum** (June 11, 2008; 7.0ip), **Matt Cain** (April 17, 2007; 7.0ip), **Jason Schmidt** (July 17, 2004; 8.0ip) and **Russ Ortiz** (August 28, 2002; 8.0ip).

MORE BREAKING STUFF: According to *Sports Info Solutions*, Harrison in his last three starts (since April 26), has thrown 57 breaking balls and got 10 outs without allowing a hit...he's throwing the breaking ball more than twice as often as he was in his starts prior to that (21% now, 10% then).

FROM SIS: According to *Sports Info Solutions*, Harrison is in a similar place to where he was last year with his pitches in that he gets outs with his four-seam, but the other stuff causes some issues...opposing hitters are 19-for-66 (.288) with three homers in at-bats that end with something other than his four-seam fastball...they're 24-for-105 (.229) in at-bats ending with the four-seam...last year, opponents hit .182 against the four-seam, .278 against everything else he threw.

FIRST PITCH STRIKES: He's throwing first-pitch strikes 60% of the time...in the 88 times he's gotten up 0-1, opponents have a .239 OBP with 31 strikeouts and three walks...in the 73 times he's been down 1-0, opponents have a .411 OBP with eight strikeouts and nine walks (S/S).

GIVE ME 5: Harrison has pitched 5.0+ innings in seven of his eight starts this season.

THE FASTBALL: Harrison has relied heavily on his four-seam fastball this season, throwing it 64.3% of the time, second-highest among starting pitchers to throw at least 200 pitches (CHC's Justin Steele, 67.9%).

VS. CINCINNATI: Faces the Reds for the second time in his career...last faced them August 28, 2023 in what was his second career big league start and shut them out for 6.1 innings while allowing three hits with a career-high 11 strikeouts...in the process he earned the first big league win of his career.

NO FREE PASSES: Has limited the walks through his first eight starts, allowing 12 free passes in 45.0 innings...last season he gave up 48 walks in 67.2 minor league innings.

MORE FROM SIS: According to *Sports Info Solutions*, one career stat for Harrison that stands out is that his first time through the order, he has 40 strikeouts vs. 135 batters faced...other times through the order, he has just 35 strikeouts out of 198 batters faced.

2023 SEASON: Started the year at Triple-A Sacramento and made 20 starts for the River Cats before having his contract selected...went 1-3 with a 4.66 ERA (34er, 65.2ip) and struck out 105 of the 295 (35.6%) batters he faced in all Triple-A...Harrison's 14.50 K/9ip in the minors last year ranked as the second-highest figure in all MiLB (min. 65.0ip).

WELCOME TO THE SHOW: Had his contract selected on August 22, 2023 and made his MLB debut that night at Philadelphia...tossed 3.1 innings and held opponents to two runs on five hits with five strikeouts in the outing...at 22 years and 10 days old, the southpaw became the youngest Giant to make his first career start since **Madison Bumgarner** in 2009 (20 years, 38 days).

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Cutter, Sinker

Last Game: 5/8 at COL; 1.0ip, h, 2r, 2er, hr, 2bb (20 pitches)

- ▶ Has worked in just three of SF's last 12 games.
- ▶ Is 2-0 with a 3.95 ERA and 6-for-6 in save chances in 14 games.
- ▶ Has struck out 17 batters over 13.2 innings of work (11.2 SO/9.0).
- ▶ 13 of his 17 strikeouts this year have come with his slider.
- ▶ Righties are just 3-for-24 (.125) off him, while lefties are 7-for-26.
- ▶ Has gone 6-for-6 in save chances this year and owns a 1.50 ERA (1er, 6.0ip) with four hits allowed, one walk and eight strikeouts.
- ▶ In eight non-save situations in '24, Doval has a 5.87 ERA (5er, 7.2ip) with six hits allowed (two homers), nine walks and nine strikeouts.

#64 SEAN HJELLE ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

Last Game: 5/11 vs. CIN; 1.0ip, h, k (16 pitches)

- ▶ Over his last five games, Hjelle has a 1.29 ERA (1er, 7.0ip) with six hits allowed, no walks allowed and 12 strikeouts.
- ▶ Worked 4.0 scoreless innings and struck out 10 over two appearances in SF's last weekend in Philadelphia...the last time a Giants reliever had 10+ strikeouts in any series (since 1969) was **RHP Tom Griffin** from Aug. 14-17, 1980 vs. ATL.
- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on April 19...missed SF's first 21 games with a right elbow strain he suffered early in spring.
- ▶ Five of his seven outings with SF have been scoreless.
- ▶ The 6'11" right-hander is tied for the tallest pitcher in MLB history with RHP Jon Rauch.

#77 LUKE JACKSON ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 5/9 at COL; 1.0ip, k (13 pitches)

- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on April 22...he suffered a low back strain on Opening Day against the Padres back on March 28.
- ▶ Has made seven appearances since being reinstated (7.1ip, 7h, 0r, 2bb, 5k).
- ▶ Batters are 9-for-29 (.310) with three walks and five strikeouts off him, however, they are just 3-for-their-last-15 (.200).
- ▶ Allowed all four of his inherited runners to score so far in 2024.

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

Last Game: 5/11 vs. CIN; 1.0ip, bb (20 pitches)

- ▶ Has held opponents scoreless in 11 of his last 14 outings, while striking out 17 batters and posting a 0.91 WHIP...has a 2.51 ERA in that time (since April 10).
