THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
APRIL 7
1979 - **Ken Forsch** fires a no-hitter in the Astrodome, blanking Atlanta, 6-0...Forsch needs just 106 pitches, striking out three and walking two... with Ken accomplishing the feat, he and his brother **Bob Forsch** became the first brothers to pitch no-hitters in MLB history.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Astros continue their 10-game road trip with the second game of a three-game series against the Colorado Rockies at Coors Field in Denver, CO...**RHP Mike Burrows** will be on the mound for the Astros opposite **LHP Kyle Freeland** and the Rockies.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: **RHP Mike Burrows** is set to make his third start of the season...in his last start on April 1 vs. BOS, he allowed two runs on five hits and three walks with six strikeouts in five innings to earn his first win as an Astro...was acquired from the Pirates this offseason as part of a three-team, six-player trade in which the Astros sent **OF Jacob Melton** and minor leaguer **RHP Anderson Brito** to the Rays, while the Rays sent **IF Brandon Lowe**, **OF Jake Mangum** and **LHP Mason Montgomery** to the Pirates...Burrows impressed this Spring, making five starts and posting a 1.50 ERA (3ER/18IP) while allowing a .200 opponent batting average with 17 strikeouts.

SUSTAINED SUCCESS: Dating back to the 2015 season, the Astros have made nine postseason appearances in 12 seasons, winning seven division titles, four AL pennants (2017, 2019, 2021, 2022) and two WS titles (2017, 2022)...in that span, the Astros became the only team in history to advance to seven consecutive ALCS (2017-23) and posted the second-most wins in the Majors (982), trailing only the Dodgers (1,044).

NEW FACES: The Astros focused their offseason efforts on acquiring pitching, landing **RHP Mike Burrows** and **RHP Kai-Wei Teng** in trades and **RHP Tatsuya Imai** and **RHP Ryan Weiss** off the international free agent market.

AT THE HELM: Manager **Joe Espada** is in his third season as the Astros skipper...in 2025, for the second consecutive season, Espada and his staff were forced to deal with an extremely high number of injuries...despite an ever-changing roster that often was missing key players, to his credit, Espada managed to navigate his club to an 87-75 record, finishing in a tie for the final AL Wild Card berth (lost tiebreaker to DET).

ROAD TRIP: Tonight is the fifth game of a 10-game road trip for the Astros...after this three-game set at COL, the Astros will travel to Seattle for a four-game series at T-Mobile Park (Fri-Mon)...the Astros are 1-3 so far on this trip...Houston went 41-40 on the road last season.

LAST NIGHT'S GAME: The Houston Astros fell to the Colorado Rockies, 7-9, at Coors Field in Denver, CO...**RHP Cody Bolton** (4.1 IP, 3 H, 2 ER, 2 BB, 5 K) made his first career start...**SS Jeremy Peña** (2x5, 2B), **2B Jose Altuve** (3x5, 2 2B, RBI), **1B Christian Walker** (2x5, RBI), **RF Cam Smith** (2x4, HR) and **CF Jake Meyers** (2x4, 2B) each recorded a multi-hit game...**RHP Enyel De Los Santos** (1.0 IP, 1H) tossed a scoreless inning in his season debut.

WALKER AT COORS: **1B Christian Walker** has batted .348 (65x187) with 12 doubles, 14 HR, 39 RBI and a 1.045 OPS in 48 career games at Coors Field...his 1.045 OPS at Coors Field is the highest among active players, directly ahead of **PHI IF Bryce Harper** (1.036 OPS).

AGAINST THE ROCKIES: The Astros and Rockies face each other tonight for the second of six scheduled matchups in 2026...the Astros went 4-2 against the Rockies in the in 2025, including a 2-1 record at Coors Field...the Astros own a 110-88 all-time record against the Rockies...the Rockies will travel to Daikin Park for a three-game series from April 14-16.

BROWN INJURY UPDATE: **RHP Hunter Brown** has been diagnosed with a Grade 2 Right Shoulder Strain...he will refrain from throwing for a few weeks.

LEAGUE LEADERS: The Astros lead the Majors in runs (77), doubles (34) total bases (190), hits (111), walks (64) and OBP (.394)...individually, **LF Yordan Alvarez** leads the Majors in OBP (.540) and walks (13)...**2B Jose Altuve** leads the Majors in runs (12) and **1B Christian Walker** leads the Majors in doubles (6).

HOT START: The Astros have scored 77 runs this season, which is the most in the Majors...the 77 runs are also the most in the first 11 games to begin a season in franchise history, directly ahead of the 2004 season, where the Astros scored 70 runs in the first 11 games of the season.

ON-BASE MACHINE: **2B Jose Altuve** has started the season with a 11-game on-base streak, which is tied for the longest active on-base streak in the Majors.

AL PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Yesterday, **LF Yordan Alvarez** was named the American League Player of the Week for the week of March 30-April 5...Alvarez batted .471 (8x17) with two doubles, three home runs, eight RBI, seven walks and a 1.733 OPS for the week...marked the fourth time that Alvarez has been named the AL Player of the Week.

FUTURE HALL OF FAMER: **2B Jose Altuve** recorded his 2,400th career hit last night at COL on a double in the first inning...became the second active player to record at least 2,400 hits, joining **LAD IF Freddie Freeman**...also joins **IF Craig Biggio** as the only two players in franchise history with at least 2,400 hits.

THE AIRCRAFT CARRIER: **RF Cam Smith** went 2x4 with a home run, double and two runs scored last night vs. COL...the home run was launched 462 feet, making it the longest home run by any player in the Majors this season...the second longest home run this season was 460 feet by **PHI OF Kyle Schwarber**.

YORDAN'S UPCOMING MILESTONES: **LF Yordan Alvarez** recorded his 174th career home run on Sunday at ATH...the home run tied him with franchise icon **OF George Springer** for seventh on the Astros all-time list...next up on the Astros all-time list is **3B Alex Bregman** (191 HR).

LAST START, APRIL 1 VS. BOS: picked up his first win of the season last Wednesday vs. the Red Sox after tossing 5.0 innings and allowing 2 runs on 5 hits in the Astros 6-4 win...tossed 84 pitches, including 55 for strikes...marked just his 4th Major League win and his 2nd as a starter (also, June 4, 2025 vs. HOU).

ABOUT BURROWS: right-handed starter is in his first full Major League season...was acquired by the Astros via trade this offseason and performed so well in Spring Training that he began the year as the Astros No. 2 starter.

SEASON DEBUT: made his Astros and season debut in the Astros 2nd game of the season on March 27 vs. LAA (5ER/5.2IP)...tossed a career-high 94 pitches in the start, surpassing his previous high of 91 pitches from July 30, 2025 vs. SF as a member of the Pirates.

SPRING TRAINING: had a phenomenal Spring, posting a 1.50 ERA (3ER/18IP), a .200 opponent batting average, 1.06 WHIP and 17 strikeouts in 5 starts.

VS. THE ROCKIES: has faced the Rockies once in his career, on Aug. 23, 2025 vs. COL (0ER/4IP)...struck out 5 and allowed 2 singles and a walk in the Pirates 5-1 win.

THE TRADE: after spending eight seasons (2018-25) in the Pirates organization, the Astros acquired Burrows this offseason in a 3-team, 6-player trade...as part of the deal, the Astros traded **OF Jacob Melton** and minor leaguer **RHP Anderson Brito** to the Rays...meanwhile, the Rays traded **IF Brandon Lowe**, **OF Jake Mangum** and **LHP Mason Montgomery** to the Pirates, and Burrows got dealt to the Astros.

2025 RECAP: pitched most of the season with the Pirates, making 23 appearances (19 starts) and going 2-4 with a 3.94 ERA (42ER/96IP)...struck out 97 hitters in 96.0 IP...had two Major League stints on the year, from April 24-25 and from May 21 thru the end of the year...recorded a strong second half with the Pirates, posting a 3.27 ERA (20ER/55IP) in 13 games (10 starts)...in that span, allowed 1-or-fewer runs in 7 of his last 8 appearances, posting a 2.22 ERA (7ER/28.1IP) in those games, which spanned from Aug. 16 thru the end of the year...did not allow a homer over a 26.1-inning span from Aug. 16-Sept. 21...finished tied for third in the NL in strikeouts by a rookie (97).

THE JOURNEY: a native of Waterford, CT, Burrows was committed to the University of Connecticut out of high school...the Pirates selected him in the 11th round of the June 2018 draft and signed him to an over-slot bonus to sign and forgo his commitment to UConn...spent 6 seasons (2018-23) in the Pirates minor league system before finally debuting in 2024 with a single appearance...pitched the majority of the 2025 season at the Major League level and flashed potential before the Pirates flipped him to Houston this offseason.

CONNECTICUT CONNECTION: Burrows is in a small fraternity of Major Leaguers from Connecticut...only four other Connecticuter's have played for the Astros in their franchise history: **C Brad Ausmus** (1259g), **OF George Springer** (795g), **RHP Bill Dawley** (157g) and **RHP Josh Zeid** (48g).

CAREER: has appeared in the Majors with Houston in each of the last seven seasons (2019-25)...owns a 16-13 record with 17 saves, a 2.82 ERA (104ER/332.1IP) and 454 strikeouts in 332.1 Major League innings...among relievers in club history, ranks 4th in strikeouts (454), 7th in appearances (321) and 12th in innings (332.1).

LAST APPEARANCE: surrendered 4 runs on 5 hits with 1 strikeout and 2 walks Sunday at ATH (44 pitches-26 strikes)...prior to Sunday's outing, he'd posted a 0.37 ERA (1ER/24.1IP), 0.66 WHIP and .100 opponent batting average (8x80) over his last 11 MLB appearances dating back to last season (since Aug. 31, 2025)...leads Astros relievers with 3 appearances of 2.0 or more IP this season.

OPENING DAY: made his 1st career Opening Day roster this season...pitched on Opening Day vs. LAA, tossing 2.1 innings of 1-run ball, allowing his only run on a solo homer by Mike Trout...dazzled hitters with an uptick in velocity, including throwing a 98.8 mph 4-seam fastball on a strikeout of **IF Yoán Moncada**...marked the hardest pitch thrown in his career.

2025 SEASON: went 3-1 with a 1.69 ERA (6ER/32IP), a 0.88 WHIP, .152 opponent average and 9.84 SO/9IP through 11 Major League appearances (three starts)...also made 22 total appearances (19 starts) with Triple A Sugar Land this season, going 5-8 with a 5.27 ERA (58ER/99IP)...recorded a 21.0-inning scoreless streak from Aug. 23 through the end of the 2025 season.

ABOUT BLUBAUGH: entered the 2026 season as the Astros No. 4 prospect and as having the "Best Slider" according to *Baseball America*.
