tonight with the opener of a three-game weekend Interleague series against the Chicago White Sox at Busch Stadium ... The New York Mets visit St. Louis for three games on Monday ... The Cardinals recently split its recent six-game road trip through the New York Mets (2-1) and Detroit (1-2).

RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals kick off a six-game homestand

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis opens today in 4th place in the National League Central, 5.5 games behind first place Milwaukee (19-11) and 2.0 games back of Cincinnati (16-15) for 3rd place.

LEAHY RECALLED: Prior to tonight's homestand opener, the Cardinals placed LHP Steven Matz on the 15-Day Injured List with a lower back strain (retroactive to May 1) and recalled RHP Kyle Leahy from Memphis (AAA) ... Leahy, who made his MLB debut at the Chicago White Sox on July 7, 2023, pitched 1.1 innings in Game 2 of last Tuesday's doubleheader at Detroit.

FRENEMIES: St. Louis welcomes the White Sox to Busch Stadium for the first time since May 1-2, 2018 (six years ago yesterday) ... The Cardinals and the ChiSox have since played their last 11 games over four series at Guaranteed Rate Park (2018, 2020, 2021, 2023), representing the Cardinals most

consecutive road games against an opponent since 12 straight versus the Pirates at PNC Park from May 12, 2009-May 9, 2010. - Elias

HELLS BELLS: Closer Ryan Helsley was voted National League Reliever of the Month for March/April today, becoming the 3rd Cardinals reliever to take home the honor, along with Delivery Man of the Month Award winners Jason Isringhausen (May 2006) and Ryan Franklin (August 2009).

- Helsley posted a 1.69 ERA (3 ER/16.0 IP), converting 10 of 11 save opportunities across 16 appearances, with 19 strikeouts, 0.94 WHIP, .220 opponents average, and 10.69 SO/9 IP.
- The 29-year-old led MLB in games finished (15) in March/April, and shared the league lead in saves (10) and appearances (16).
- Helsley became the 9th Cardinals closer to record 10 saves (career monthly high) in a single month and the first since Giovanny Gallegos (11 saves in September 2021).

HOMEWORK ASSIGNMENT: Beginning tonight, St. Louis is home for 15 of its next 22 games (May 3-26) ... The Cardinals, Nationals, Guardians, Twins, and Pirates have all played 12 home games, fewest in MLB ... So far this season, the Cardinals have played more games in the Pacific Time Zone (13) than in the Central Time Zone (12).

THE MERRY MERRY MONTH OF MAY: Since moving into Busch Stadium III in 2006, the Cardinals have compiled a .500 or better record in the month of May in 13 of 17 full seasons ... Their best May in that time span was a 20-7 mark (.741 win pct.) in 2013, and their worst was a 9-18 (.333) spiral in 2019 on the heels of a strong 19-10 (.655) March/April start ... The 2023 Cardinals started 0-5 in May, but finished the month going 15-8 for a final 15-13 record.

JUNIOR CIRCUIT JUGGERNAUTS: St. Louis is 245-240 all-time in Interleague play (1997-present), with a .505 win pct. that trails only Los Angeles (.540) and Atlanta (.509) among National League clubs ... Over that timespan, Cardinals designated hitters have produced a combined .788 OPS, 4th-highest coming from the designated hitter position behind Boston (.868), Cleveland (.810), and Philadelphia (.794) ... The White Sox (..784) rank 6th.

BROKEN WINGS: Two Cardinals have recently begun injury rehabilitation assignments with Cardinals minor league affiliates:

- OF Dylan Carlson is batting .333 (2-6) with a home run and a pair of walks in three games with Memphis (AAA), appearing in two games at designated hitter and 6.0 innings in center field ... Carlson has missed the first 31 games with a left shoulder AC sprain after colliding with **Jordan Walker** on a fly ball against the Cubs in a Cactus League Spring Training Game on March 25 in Mesa, Ariz.
- 1B/DH Matt Carpenter, who has missed 26 games with a right oblique strain, joined the Springfield Cardinals (AA) at Tulsa (AA-Dodgers) yesterday, but their game was postponed due to rain and rescheduled as a doubleheader today.

THE NEW GUYS: Since April 9, free agent acquisitions Sonny Gray, Lance Lynn, and Kyle Gibson have combined to go 5-2 with a 1.92 ERA (15 ER/70.1 IP) and seven quality starts in their 12 starting assignments.

CLOSE CALLS: Twenty-three of the Cardinals 31 games this season have been decided by three or fewer runs, 2nd-most in Major League Baseball to the Yankees (24) ... St. Louis is 12-11 in those games.

CHICAGO CONNECTIONS

Cardinals broadcaster **John Rooney** spent 18 years (1998-2005) with the White Sox - one in TV followed by 17 seasons in radio...Rooney worked with the World Champion team in back-to-back seasons, following the White Sox win in 2005.

Lance Lynn pitched parts of three seasons with the White Sox (2021-23)...was an AL All-Star and finished 3rd in the Cy Young Award voting in 2021.

Paul DeJong was selected by St. Louis in the 4th round of the 2015 MLB Draft...played parts of his first seven seasons with the Cardinals (2017-23)...finished 2nd in the 2017 NL Rookie of the Year voting and was a 2019 NL All-Star.

Rafael Ortega played two minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization (2014-15).

Keynan Middleton pitched in 39 games for the White Sox in 2023.

Dominic Leone pitched parts of two seasons (2017-18) with the Cardinals.

John Brebbia pitched parts of three seasons (2017-19) for St. Louis after being selected from Arizona in the AAA phase of the 2015 Rule 5 Draft.

Dylan Carlson (Aug. 15, 2020-1 at Guaranteed Bylan Carison (Aug. 19, 2020) at Guaranteed Rate Field), Riley O'Brien (Sept. 21, 2021 at Guaranteed Rate Field), Ryle Leahy (July 7, 2023 at Guaranteed Rate Field) and Turner Ward (Sept. 21, 2021). 10, 1990 at Cleveland Stadium) made MLB debuts vs. the White Sox.

Tommy Pham was selected by the Cardinals in the 16th round of the 2006 MLB Draft...played parts of his first five seasons in St. Louis (2014-18).

Hall of Fame Manager **Tony La Russa** managed both the Cardinals (1996-2011) and White Sox (1979-86, 2021-22)

Dan O'Connor Assistant Video Coordinator was born in Chicago and was an usher at the stadium in Section 136/137 by the White Sox dugout during the 2006 season..Dan is the son of longtime Chi cago Tribune investigative reporter Matt O'Connor

Cardinals broadcaster **Ricky Horton** pitched in 52 games for the White Sox in 1988...originally traded by the Cardinals with outfielder Lance Johnson and cash to Chicago for pitcher Jose DeLeon.

Cardinals VP/General Manager Michael Girsch is a Chicago native...graduated from the University of Notre Dame and the University of Chicago.

White Sox Head Groundskeeper Roger Bossard designed and built new playing fields at Busch Stadium II and Busch Stadium III, as well as Roger Dean Stadium in Jupiter, Fla.
