BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles defeated the White Sox, 4-2, securing their fourth series win of the year, first since May 9-11 at Los Angeles-AL (2-1), and first at home since April 28-30 vs. New York-AL (2-1)...Have gone 17-5 (.773) against the White Sox since 2022, their highest winning percentage against any single opponent during that time...Secured back-to-back home wins for the first time since April 30-May 2...The O's continue with the finale of a three-game set this afternoon against the White Sox at Camden Yards before heading out west to face the Mariners (6/3-5) and the Athletics (6/6-8).

- 👉 **Dean Kremer** earned his second straight win after allowing one run on six hits and two walks with seven strikeouts in 6.0 innings...Completed 6.0 innings for the first time since tossing 7.0 scoreless frames on May 2 vs. Kansas City...His 2.25 ERA (6 ER/24.0 IP) is his lowest mark through his first four home starts in his career and the lowest by an Oriole through his first four starts at Oriole Park since **Albert Suárez** in 2024 (also 2.25).
- 👉 **Ryan O'Hearn** extended his hitting and on-base streaks to 10 and 17 games, respectively, both career highs...Hitting .475 (19-for-40) during the 10-game run...Is the fourth Oriole with a 10+ game hitting streak this season, joining **Ryan Mountcastle** (12 G, 5/4-18), **Ramón Uriás** (11 G 5/17-28), and **Jackson Holliday** (10 G, 5/14-24).
- 👉 **Jackson Holliday** launched his first career leadoff home run, marking the fourth by an Oriole this season (last: 4/19 vs. CIN, Mullins)...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, at 21 years, 178 days old, Holliday became the second-youngest player in team history (since 1954) to hit a leadoff homer...**Paul Blair** did so at 21 years, 75 days (4/17/65 at BOS) and at 21 years, 100 days (5/12/65 vs. CLE).
- 👉 **Jorge Mateo** lined a two-run homer in the fifth inning, his first long ball and multi-RBI effort since hitting a two-run home run on June 21, 2024 at Houston...Drew two walks, recording a season-high three times on base...Has stolen a base in a career-best five straight games with a plate appearance, the fifth Oriole to do so, joining **Corey Patterson** (9 G, 5/27-6/5/06), **Luis Matos** (6 G, 10/1-5 [G2]/01), **Luis Aparicio** (5 G, 5/30-6/3/64), and **Brian Roberts** (5 G, 6/30-7/5/03).
- 👉 The Orioles have earned at least one walk in 135 straight games since July 2, 2024, the longest active stretch in the majors ahead of the Braves (79 G) and Blue Jays (68 G)...It's the second-longest such streak in franchise history behind a 155-game stretch from June 23, 1955-June 24 (G1), 1956.

GUNNING FOR MORE: **Gunnar Henderson** on Friday tallied his 400th career hit with a double in the sixth inning, becoming the sixth Oriole to do so before the age of 24, joining **Manny Machado**, **Eddie Murray**, **Boog Powell**, **Brooks Robinson**, and **Cal Ripken, Jr.**

👉 Henderson is one of three Orioles to reach at least 400 hits, 250 runs scored, and 75 home runs at age 23 or younger, joining **Machado** and **Murray**...Of the three, he is the only one to do so in less than 400 games played (392 G; **Murray**, 480 G; **Machado**, 530 G).

FOLLOW THE LEADER: **Ryan O'Hearn** has reached safely in 30 of his last 31 games since April 24 while slashing .360/.450/.568 (40-for-111) with five doubles, six homers, 17 runs scored, 15 RBI, and 16 walks...Over that period, he ranks among AL leaders in batting average (4th), on-base percentage (4th), OPS (4th, 1.017), and slugging percentage (8th).

👉 O'Hearn has 19 hits since May 21, the most in a 10-game span in his career...He's tallied at least three hits in four of those games...He is the first Oriole with 19+ hits in a 10-game stretch since 2020-21 (Mullins, 19 H, 9/27/20-4/11/21).

👉 Overall, he ranks among AL leaders with a .420 on-base percentage (2nd), .962 OPS (3rd), .333 batting average (4th), and .542 slugging percentage (4th)...His batting average is the best by an Oriole through the first 57 team games since 2020 (Iglesias, .373), while his OPS is the best in that span by an Oriole since 2018 (Machado, 1.024).

👉 O'Hearn is slashing .418/.473/.761 (28-for-67) in 18 games he's played when the O's win...The 1.234 OPS is the third-highest such mark in the AL and sixth in MLB (min. 50 PA) behind **Judge** (1.351), **Devers** (1.285), **LAD's Freddie Freeman** (1.270), **WSH's James Wood** (1.250), and **MIA's Agustin Ramirez** (1.248).

RISPY BUISNESS: The O's have registered at least 13 at-bats with runners in scoring position five times in the last 10 games...The Birds are batting .155/.215/.328 (9-for-58) with runners in scoring position over the last six games...For the season, the Orioles are hitting .208 (93-for-447) with runners in scoring position, second lowest in MLB ahead of the White Sox (.206)...That number falls to .176 (37-for-210) with RISP and two outs, the lowest in the majors.

👉 Baltimore has registered 208 at-bats with runners in scoring position over their last 22 games since May 8, going 47-for-208 (.226)...The 208 at-bats are the most in the majors during that period, while the .226 average ranks 21st.

NOT SO PITCH PERFECT: The Birds have permitted 87 home runs, the second highest mark in the majors behind the Athletics (90 HR)...The 87 long balls are the second most through the first 57 games of a season in team history (since 1954), ahead of the 2019 Orioles (118).

HOMEWARD BOUND: The Orioles have dropped 10 of the last 13 home games since May 3, including eight straight from May 3-18, tied for the fourth-longest home losing streak in Oriole Park history (since 1992)...At 11-17 (.393), the O's have the third-lowest home winning percentage in MLB ahead of the Rockies (.214, 6-22) and Athletics (.321, 9-19)...Baltimore's worst home record in franchise history (since 1954) came in 2019 (.309, 25-56).

👉 From 2023-24, the Orioles were 93-69 at home, the fourth-best record in the AL during that time behind the Rays (95-67), and Mariners and Rangers (both 94-68).

👉 Baltimore has a 5.83 ERA at home, third highest in the majors behind the Athletics (5.95 ERA) and Rockies (5.93 ERA)...The O's have never had an ERA at home above 6.00 since the team moved to Charm City in 1954.

BIRDS AND THE SOUTH SIDE: The Orioles and White Sox conclude their first of two series this season today...The Orioles swept a four-game set in Chicago last year from May 23-26 and took two of three at home from September 2-4...Since 2022, the Birds own a 17-5 record against the White Sox, going 8-3 at Oriole Park and 9-2 in Chicago.

👉 Since the start of 2022, the Orioles' .773 winning percentage against the White Sox is their best versus any single opponent during that span, ahead of the Angels (17-6, .739) and Rangers (14-5, .737).

👉 The O's are 6-14 (.300) against the AL Central this season, their lowest against any AL division and second lowest behind the NL East (1-5, .167)...The .300 winning percentage against the AL Central division is the second lowest in the AL ahead of only the White Sox (2-14, .125).

QUICK HITS: Morton is set to make his eighth start (14th appearance) of the season and the sixth start of his career against Chicago-AL...Has made six relief appearances this season after having one career regular season outing and one Postseason game in relief in his career entering 2025...He's one of six MLB pitchers with at least 40.0 innings and an ERA over 7.00, along with MIA's Sandy Alcantara (8.47 ERA), BOS' Tanner Houck (8.04 ERA), COL's Antonio Senzatela (7.14 ERA), COL's German Marquez (7.13 ERA), and ARI's Eduardo Rodriguez (7.05 ERA)...Is the only pitcher in the AL with seven losses...At 41 years, 142 days old in his home debut, became the oldest Orioles pitcher to record 10 strikeouts in a game in franchise history (since 1954), per [@SlangsOnSports](#)...Signed a one-year contract with the Orioles on January 3, 2025...Made 30 starts with the Braves in 2024, going 8-10 with a 4.19 ERA (77 ER/165.1 IP) on 154 hits (23 HR), 85 total runs, 65 walks, and 18 hit batters with 167 strikeouts...Was on Atlanta's NLWC roster, but did not appear in a game...Closed out Houston's World Series Championship with 4.0 scoreless relief innings in Game 7 on November 1, 2017 at Los Angeles-NL.

LAST START: Morton last pitched on May 26 vs. St. Louis, allowing two runs on four hits (1 HR), two walks, and a hit batter with five strikeouts in 6.0 innings to earn his first win of the season...Marked his first start since May 7 at Minnesota...Surrendered a home run for his sixth consecutive start (7 total HR), setting a career high...Snapped a career-worst stretch of eight straight starts without a quality start since September 15, 2024...Had lost nine games in a row since September 20, 2024, the longest losing skid of his career...Threw 86 pitches, 58 strikes.

DEEP DISH: Morton has won all five career starts against the White Sox while posting a 2.08 ERA (7 ER/30.1 IP) with 18 hits allowed (1 HR), nine walks, and 28 strikeouts in those outings...He has thrown 13.2 consecutive scoreless innings against Chicago-AL dating back to the fifth inning on April 9, 2019.

☯ The White Sox are one of two teams he has never lost to in his career...The other is Pittsburgh (2 GS), who spent parts of seven seasons with.

SALES PITCH: Morton has limited opponents to a .178 (8-for-45) clip on his four-seam fastball, but six of the seven hits have gone for extra-bases (2B, 5 HR).

WALK THIS WAY: He has issued at least one walk in 20 straight starts since July 20, 2024 (G1)...The 20-game streak is the longest stretch for Morton since a career-high 58-gamer from June 28, 2022-June 2, 2024 (148 total BB)...Among pitchers with at least 40.0 innings, his 4.98 walks per nine innings is the third highest in the majors behind CLE's Gavin Williams (5.47 BB/9) and MIA's Sandy Alcantara (5.12 BB/9), and his 11.9 percent walk rate is the sixth highest in MLB.

BEHIND THE CURVE: Opponents are batting .257 (18-for-70) with a .500 slugging percentage with two doubles, one triple, and three home runs off Morton's curveball this season...In his last eight appearances (2 GS) since April 26, opposing teams are hitting .178 (8-for-45) with a .333 slugging.

☯ In 2024, Morton limited opponents to a .200 (55-for-275) average on the offering while producing a 34.2 percent whiff rate...Of his 167 strikeouts last season, 102 came on the curveball (61.1%).

LIKE FINE WINE: In his Orioles debut, at 41 years, 136 days old, Morton became the oldest pitcher in franchise history to start a game for the Orioles, surpassing Orlando Peña (39y, 177d) on May 13, 1973 (G1) at New York-AL...The oldest pitcher to ever appear in a game in club history is Jesse Orosco (42y, 160d) on September 28, 1999 at New York-AL.

UPS AND DOWNS: His 3.97 run support average in 2024 was the sixth lowest in MLB (min. 120.0 IP) behind PIT's Luis Ortiz (3.32), PIT's Jared Jones (3.48), WSH's Patrick Corbin (3.50), CIN's Hunter Greene (3.89), and STL's Andre Pallante (3.93).

☯ Since 2023, Morton is 20-5 with a 3.32 ERA (71 ER/192.1 IP) when receiving three runs or more of support as a starter, compared to 3-24 with a 5.35 ERA (102 ER/167.0 P) when receiving two runs or fewer.
