# Atlanta Braves (76-70) at San Francisco Giants (97-52)

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Giants face the Braves for the final game of this series and the season series this afternoon at Oracle Park...the Giants are 4-2 in the homestand after splitting the four-game series against San Diego and winning the first two in this set... SF has won 13 of its last 16 games overall entering play today.

**NATIONAL LEAD:** The Giants' 97-52 current record puts them in contention for the best record by an NL team in the divisional era...their 97 wins through their first 149 games are tied for fifthmost in the NL since 1969...the 1975 Reds and 1986 Mets each finished the year with 108 wins, which is the best mark for any NL team since 1969.

**BEST IN THE BIGS:** The Giants (97-52, .651) enter today with the best record in the Majors, two games ahead of the Dodgers (95-54, .638)..the .651 winning percentage through 149 games is the club's best in the SF-era and the best by a Giants team since 1913, when they went 98-51 (.658) through their first 149 decisions.

**THE BROOM CLOSET:** SF has swept 11 series this year and has an opportunity to sweep the Braves this afternoon with a win...the last time the Giants swept a series from the Braves came May 4-6, 2018 when the Giants took a three-game series in Atlanta...the last time SF swept a series from the Braves here in San Francisco came May 25-27, 2009.

**SUNDAYS IN THE PARK:** Despite losing their last day game on Thursday to San Diego, the Giants still own the Majors' best winning percentage in day games this season...SF is 38-17 (.691) this year and has won seven of its last eight day game contests...in their last 19 day games, the Giants are 16-3.

**BRYANT THE GIANT: IF/OF Kris Bryant** has reached base safely in each of his last 17 games entering play today, his longest streak since a 23-game on-base streak from June 2-26, 2019 with the Cubs...in 39 games since joining the Giants, Bryant is hitting .285 with 11 doubles, seven homers, 16 RBI and an .875 OPS...SF is 27-12 in games when Bryant plays.

**WE MUST PROTECT THIS HOUSE!:** Last night's win gave the Giants 49 victories at Oracle Park this season (49-25, .662)...the last time the Giants won at least 50 games at home was 2009 when that club went 52-29...since Oracle Park opened in 2000, the most victories a Giants team has accumulated at home during the regular season is 57 by the 2003 Giants.

**DANCING IN SEPTEMBER:** The Giants are averaging 6.24 runs per game this month, on pace to be one of the team's highest-scoring Septembers in the modern era...SF has outscored their opponents 106-63 this month (*Stats, LLC*). **Giants, Most Runs Per Game in September - Since 1901 Year**1924 **Runs/Game**1924

**MOON SHOTS:** The Giants have reached 227 home runs this season, surpassing the 2000 club (226) for second-most all time by a Giants team in a single season...the team needs just eight more homers to match a franchise-best 235 home runs done by the 2001 club.

**O CAPTAIN! MY CAPTAIN!: IF Brandon Belt** went 0x3 last night to end his 10-game hitting streak but is still hitting .329 (27x82) with five doubles, nine homers, 17 RBI and a 1.134 OPS in his last 20 contests...since the All-Star break, he has averaged a home run every 8.67 at-bats, a rate matched only by Barry Bonds in Giants history (see chart on the right courtesy Stats, LLC).

## TODAY'S STARTING PITCHING MATCHUP

**LHP Max Fried** starts for Atlanta and is facing the Giants for a second time this season and for a fifth time in his career (fourth time as a starter)...Fried limited the Giants to four runs (three earned) on five hits in 6.0 innings back at Truist Park on August 27 in the Braves 6-5 win...he's 2-0 with a 2.79 ERA lifetime vs. SF.

**RHP Anthony DeSclafani** gets the ball for the Giants this afternoon to face the Braves for a second time this season...DeSclafani started the final game of the three-game series in Atlanta in August and pitched well through the first 3.0 innings before giving up three runs in the 4th inning...in three starts this month, DeSclafani is 1-0 with a 2.12 ERA and the Giants have won all three of those outings.

The Giants enter today with 227 homers, second-most in the Majors behind Toronto (236)...SF has scored 50.8% of their runs off home runs (374 of 736 total runs), most in the Majors...only two Giants teams since 1950 have led MLB in home runs (including ties for the lead) and only one since the team moved West in 1958: 1954 NY Giants (186 HR tied with Brooklyn) & 1972 SF Giants (150 HR)...the 227 homers are second-most in team history behind the 2001 club, who hit a franchise-best 235 homers.

**TODAY'S OUTING:** 31-year-old right-hander will make his 29th start in the last game of this three-game series against the Braves... the Giants are 19-9 in his outings, going 9-3 here at home.

**LAST START:** Was credited with his 12th win of the season last Tuesday vs. San Diego in SF's 6-1 victory...pitched 6.2 innings, allowing three hits and one earned run with one walk and three strikeouts.

**VS. BRAVES:** Is set to face the Braves for the second time this season and seventh time in his career...he's 1-3 with a 4.85 ERA (16er, 29.2ip) in six starts...will be seeking his first win over Atlanta since 2016.

**ON THE HOME FRONT:** Owns a 3.36 ERA (23er, 61.2ip) in 12 starts at Oracle Park this season...he's been excellent over his last four starts here as he's fashioned a 1.42 ERA (3er, 19.0ip) and a BAA of.167 (11x66).

**FOR HIS CAREER:** His 12 wins this season are a career high and his 3.24 ERA would be the lowest of his career over a full season.

**GETTING TO A DOZEN:** Only five Giants pitchers since 1990 have won at least 12 games in their first season with San Francisco...the last Giants pitchers to do it were **Johnny Cueto** and **Jeff Samardzija** both did so in 2016 (*Stats, LLC*).

**ON THE LEADERBOARD:** Among NL leaders, he's tied for fourth in complete games (two), tied for 9th in wins (12) and 13th in ERA (3.24).

**THE RIGHT STUFF:** DeSclafani has held right-handed batters to a .319 slugging percentage this season, the 14th-lowest mark in the NL among qualified starters...overall, DeSclafani is holding right-handed batters to a .207 batting average against, while lefties are hitting .237 against him.

# DICK TIDROW 1947-2021

Senior Advisor to the President of Baseball Operations Dick Tidrow passed away unexpectedly on July 10 in Lee's Summit, M0. He was 74 years old.

A former American League Rookie Pitcher of the Year and 13-year Major League veteran, Dick Tidrow spent 28 seasons in the Giants front office. He came to the organization prior to the 1994 campaign, serving as the club's Major League scout for the American League. Throughout his tenure with the Giants, he held the titles of Special Assistant to the General Manager, Director of Player Personnel, Assistant General Manager for Player Personnel and Senior Vice President and Senior Advisor to the General Manager.

Prior to joining the Giants organization, Tidrow served as a special assignment scout with the New York Yankees from 1985 through 1993. The former right-handed pitcher, nicknamed "Dirt," enjoyed parts of 13 years in the Majors from 1972-84. He was honored as The Sporting News A.L. Rookie Pitcher of the Year as a starter with the Cleveland Indians in 1972, while also capturing pennant and World Series rings as a reliever with the Yankees in 1977 and 1978, respectively. He later pitched for the Cubs, White Sox and Mets. His lifetime numbers show a 100-94 record with 55 saves and a 3.68 ERA.

The San Francisco native graduated from Mt. Eden High School in 1965 and Chabot Junior College in 1967, both located in Hayward. Tidrow also served in the U.S. Marine Corps from 1968-71. He is survived by his wife, Mari Jo, three children— Andy, Matt and Richelle, his grandchild, Trista, and many relatives and loved ones on the West Coast and in the Midwest.
