ST. LOUIS CARDINALS (5-6) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (4-8)

April 9, 2025 - PNC Park - Pittsburgh, PA - 12:35 EDT - Game #13/Home #6

RHP Erick Fedde (1-1, 7.00 ERA) vs. RHP Mitch Keller (1-1, 7.45 ERA)

THE PIRATES: fell to St. Louis, 5-3, last night and will finish their six-game homestand with today's series finale...Wrapped up a stretch of six consecutive games against American League East opponents with their walkoff win against the Yankees on Sunday and are now in the middle of a six-game stretch against National League Central foes (will also go to Cincinnati for a three-game series with the Reds this weekend)...Went 25-27 within their own division last season.

HITTIN' THE ROAD: Following today's series finale vs. the Cardinals, the Pirates will head to Cincinnati tomorrow to begin a three-game weekend series on Friday at Great American Ball Park vs. the Reds...Pittsburgh will then resume its span of 13 out of 16 games being played at home with a seven-game homestand in which it hosts the Nationals (April 14-17) and Guardians (April 18-20).

K IS FOR KELLER: Mitch Keller enters today five strikeouts shy of 700 for his career...Keller's 695 punchouts rank 22nd in club history (Paul Maholm is 21st with 705)...Pirates broadcaster Bob Walk ranks 24th in team history with 650 punchouts...Per the Elias Sports Bureau, Keller would become the third-fastest pitcher by games (136) in club history to reach 700 career strikeouts with the Pirates if he reached it today, behind Gerrit Cole (123) and Bob Veale (135)...Per Elias, the two fastest pitchers to reach 700 strikeouts with Pittsburgh by innings so far were Veale (740.0) and Cole (753.2)...Keller has pitched only 711.1 innings to this point.

THE 1100 CLUB: With his groundout that scored Alexander Canario in the ninth inning of last night's game against St. Louis, Andrew McCutchen recorded the 1100th RBI of his Major League career...He is one of only five active Major League players with 1100-plus RBI...The only active Major League players with more RBI in their careers than him are the Dodgers' Freddie Freeman (1236), the Yankees' Paul Goldschmidt (1190), the Cardinals' Nolan Arenado (1138) and the Yankees' Giancarlo Stanton (1103).

YOUNG BUBBA: Bubba Chandler, the Pirates' No. 1 prospect according to Baseball America and MLB Pipeline, struck out eight batters while allowing just two walks and one hit over 4.0 scoreless innings in Triple-A Indianapolis' game at Louisville last night...The 22-year-old Chandler, a top-100 prospect in baseball (No. 6 by Baseball America, No. 14 by MLB Pipeline), led all Pirates minor leaguers in 2024 with 10 wins and 148 strikeouts while also ranking among leaders in innings (2nd, 119.2), WHIP (3rd, 1.02), starts (T3rd, 23), opponent batting average (4th, .189) and ERA (5th, 3.08) over 26 outings split between Double-A Altoona and Indianapolis.

LET'S GO REYNOLDS: Bryan Reynolds went deep for the second time in four games with his home run leading off the fourth inning last night...Since the start of 2019, Reynolds ranks sixth among all Major League switch hitters with 124 home runs...The only five with more home runs during that time are Jose Ramírez (172), Anthony Santander (154), Francisco Lindor (151), Josh Bell (131) and Carlos Santana (127).

EXTRA, EXTRA, EXTRA: With a double and home run from Bryan Reynolds, as well as a double from Joey Bart, in Tuesday's game, Pittsburgh extended its streak of games with three-plus extra-base hits to five consecutive games (since Friday vs. New York-AL)...It's the Pirates' longest streak since also doing so in five straight from August 25-30, 2024...The last time Pittsburgh had a streak of more than five games with three-plus extra-base hits was from June 18-25, 2022, when it happened in eight straight contests.

JOEY BARRELS: Joey Bart doubled and drove in a run in Tuesday's game against St. Louis, a night after tripling and homering...Bart is the only Pirates catcher over the last three seasons to record three extra-base hits in a two-game span (he also did it from August 17-18, 2024)...Prior to Bart, the last Pirates catcher to achieve that feat was Michael Pérez, who homered three times on June 30, 2022 vs. Milwaukee.

PUNCH 'EM OUT IN BUNCHES: On Tuesday, Pirates pitchers combined to strike out 10 batters (Skenes 7, Shugart 1, Mayza 2)...Pittsburgh has six games this season with 10-plus strikeouts, tied with New York (NL) and Tampa Bay for the fourth-most 10-strikeout games in all of MLB...The only teams with more games are Houston (eight), Philadelphia (eight) and New York-AL (seven).

LEAN ON THE LEFTIES: Tim Mayza punched out two Cardinals over a perfect ninth inning Tuesday night...Pittsburgh's 43 strikeouts from its southpaws this season are seventh-most in Major League Baseball (the Phillies lead with 54), while the 45.1 innings pitched rank second in MLB (the Cubs lead with 56.1).

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

April 9, 1990: Andy Van Slyke went 3-for-6 with a double and two home runs as the Pirates cruised to a 12-3 Opening Day win against the Mets at Shea Stadium. Jay Bell, Bobby Bonilla and Jose Lind also had three hits apiece in Pittsburgh's 17-hit attack. Van Slyke became the first Pirate to go deep twice on Opening Day since Willie Stargell did it at Wrigley Field in Chicago in 1975.

HOW ACQUIRED: Selected by the Pirates in the 2nd round of the 2014 Draft.

STARTING OFF: The 29-year-old Keller is in his seventh Major League season...He signed a five-year contract extension through the 2028 season on February 23, 2024... He earned Opening Day honors in both 2023 and 2024, which made him the first Pirate to do so since Francisco Liriano started three straight season openers from 2014-16... He was selected by the Pirates in the second round of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Keller allowed seven runs in 3.2 innings (8h, 4bb, 4k, 2hb, 97 pitches) while losing a 9-4 decision in Pittsburgh’s Home Opener on April 4 against the Yankees.

AGAINST THE CARDINALS: Keller is 2-3 with a 3.72 ERA (72.2ip/30ER) and 56 strikeouts in 13 career games (all starts) against St. Louis...He made three starts against the Cardinals in 2024, going 0-2 with a 5.00 ERA (18.0ip/10er) and 12 strikeouts (two walks)...His last start vs. St. Louis came last July 22, when he allowed just one run on six hits and two walks (three strikeouts) over 7.0 innings in a 2-1 win here at PNC Park.

MILESTONE MITCH: Keller comes into today five strikeouts shy of 700 in his career... The first strikeout victim of his career was Cincinnati’s Derek Dietrich on May 27, 2019 (game 2)...He has struck out Nick Castellanos (10 times) more than any other player.

AS A STARTER: Keller’s last start was his 133rd with the Pirates since making his MLB debut in May 2019, breaking a tie with Pink Hawley and Heinie Meine for the 37th-most starts in team history...Murry Dickson ranks 36th on that list with 137 starts.

AND THE WHIFF: In 2023, Keller set the club record by a right-handed pitcher with 210 strikeouts, surpassing the previous mark of 209 held by A.J. Burnett in 2013.

- Since the start of 2023, Keller’s 384 strikeouts are sixth-most among all National League righthanders...The only five National League right-handed pitchers to punch out more batters than Keller during that time are Zack Wheeler (461), Freddy Peralta (432), Aaron Nola (409), Zac Gallen (395) and Logan Webb (387).

KEEPING IT 100: Heading into the 2024 All-Star break, Keller was 10-5 with 105 strikeouts in 114.1 innings pitched...He became the fourth pitcher in club history to have 10-plus wins, 100-plus strikeouts and 100.0-plus innings pitched prior to the All-Star break, along with Gerrit Cole in 2015, Bob Veale in 1966 and Bob Friend in 1960.

AS A PIRATE: The Pirates selected Keller in the second round of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft out of Xavier High School in Cedar Rapids, Iowa...He was rated by Baseball America as Pittsburgh’s No. 1 prospect in each season from 2018-20...He was also recognized by the same publication as a top-100 prospect in the game from 2017-20.

SIGN HERE PLEASE: The Pirates signed Keller to a five-year contract extension through 2028 last year on February 23...He became the third member of the current team to sign a long-term contract extension, along with Ke’Bryan Hayes and Bryan Reynolds.
