HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs and Brewers are meeting for the first time since Aug. 23-25, 2019 in Milwaukee.

- ♦ The D-backs have lost a club-record 16 consecutive road games.
- ♦ **Ketel Marte** is batting .536 (13-for-26) with 3 doubles, 2 home runs and 6 RBI during his 6-game hitting streak.
- ♦ **Josh Reddick** is hitting .425 (17-for-40)/1.027 OPS with 6 doubles and 6 RBI in his last 12 games.

SHOULDN'T THE SEASON BE OVER?: The D-backs' 180 extra-base hits, 796 total bases and 206 walks are more than their 2020 totals (171 EXBH/781 TB/181 BB).

- ♦ **Eduardo Escobar's** 41 RBI in the first 60 games are 1 more than Kole Calhoun's team-leading 40 RBI in 2020, while **Pavin Smith's** 61 hits matched David Peralta's team-high total from last season.

UPON FURTHER REVIEW: An official scoring change has occurred in the ninth inning of the D-backs/Mets game on June 2 @ Chase Field.

- ♦ Francisco Lindor originally reached second on a single and E-8...this has been changed to:
  - ❑ Double for Lindor; no error for Ketel Marte; +1 earned run for Joakim Soria.

D-BACKS ON TOP SINCE MAY 25: **Pavin Smith** leads the Majors with a .475 average since May 25, followed by teammate **Josh Reddick** (.425) and Nick Castellanos/CIN (.415).

- ♦ **Ketel Marte** (.400) is tied for fifth and **Nick Ahmed** (.366) is ninth during that span.
  - ❑ **BEST AVERAGE IN MLB SINCE MAY 25: .475 - Pavin Smith/ARI; .425 - Josh Reddick/ARI; .415 - Nick Castellanos/CIN; .407 - Jonathan India/CIN; .400 - Ketel Marte/ARI** and .407 - Yonathan Daza/COL.

AT A GLANCE: Is in his second season with the D-backs.  
• Acquired from the Marlins on Aug. 31, with RHP Humber-to Mejia and a player to be named (LHP Julio Frias) for OF Starling Marte.

LAST START: Did not factor in the decision on June 1 vs. Mets (2 ER in 5.0 IP)...gave up a 2-run homer to Dominic Smith.  
• Averaged 91.9 mph on his 4-seam fastball compared to 90.6 in his first start on April 3.  
• Threw 14 curveballs, the most in any of his appearances in parts of 2 seasons with Arizona.

VS. BREWERS: Will be making his fourth career start...is 0-3 with a 4.86 ERA (9 ER in 16.2 IP).  
• Has gone 0-2 with a 4.91 ERA (6 ER in 11.0 IP) in 2 starts in Milwaukee.

IN RELIEF: Has gone 2-0 with a 2.70 ERA (9 ER in 30.0 IP) in 18 relief appearances this season.  
• Held righties to a .197 average (.244 vs. lefties).  
• Threw 30+ pitches in 8 of his 18 outings, including 63 on May 14 vs. Nationals (3.0 IP).

THE SLIDING SCALE: Opponents are batting .190 (8-for-42) with 18 strikeouts off his slider in 2021.  
• Has allowed multiple hits off his slider in a game once (June 1 vs. Mets - 2) since Sept. 28, 2019 @ Phillies.

STATS DON'T LIE: His exit velocity (87.6 mph), launch angle (20.4) and barrel pct. (6.9) are all his lowest since 2017 (86.3/18.2/6.9).

2020 RECAP: Combined to go 0-0 with a 2.57 ERA (4 ER in 14.0 IP) in 5 games (4 starts) with the Marlins (1 GS) and D-backs (4 G/3 GS).  
• Opponents hit .125, including a .118 mark by righties.  
• Did not allow a hit with RISP (0-for-13) and opponents were 1-for-19 (.053) with runners on base.

- ♦ **Darnell Coles** (hitting coach) spent 4 seasons as hitting coach with Milwaukee (2015-18)...he also served as the Brewers' Minor League hitting coordinator (2010-11) and manager at Double-A Huntsville.
- ♦ **Eric Hinske** (assistant hitting coach) was born in Menasha, Wis....his 137 Major League home runs are the fourth most by a Wisconsin-born player, trailing Al Simmons (307), Andy Pafko (213) and Ken Keltner (163).
- ♦ **Mike Fetters** (bullpen coach) was named to the Brew-ers' Wall of Honor in 2014 after recording 79 saves in 289 games with Milwaukee from 1992-97.
- ♦ **Joakim Soria** played 26 games with the Brewers in 2018.
- ♦ **Stephen Vogt** hit .254 with 8 home runs and 20 RBI in 45 games with Milwaukee in 2017.
- ♦ **Vaughn Robinson** (Director, Skills Development) gradu-ated from the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point in 2003 and worked as a strength & conditioning coach for the University of Wisconsin from 2003-04.

- ♦ The D-backs dropped both games vs. A's from April 12-13 @ Chase Field.
