HAPPY OPENING DAY: The Orioles begin their 73rd season this afternoon against the Minnesota Twins at Camden Yards...

- March 26 will be the earliest the O's have ever played a game in team history.
- The Birds are 47-25 on Opening Day since the franchise moved to Baltimore prior to the 1954 campaign...That .653 winning percentage since moving to Charm City is the best in the majors during that time.
- The Orioles are 48-24 (.667) in Home Openers, including 33-13 (.717) when the Home Opener is also Opening Day...The O's have won four consecutive Home Openers since 2022 and seven.
- Baltimore faces Minnesota on Opening Day for the 10th time in team history and for the fifth time since the club moved to the Twin Cities in 1961...The Orioles are 7-3 in those games, including 4-1 against the Twins since 1961...The last time the teams met on Opening Day was on March 29, 2018 at Oriole Park when Orioles Hall of Famer Adam Jones hit an 11-inning walk-off solo home run for a 3-2 O's victory.
- Tyler O'Neill has homered in a major league record six consecutive Opening Days dating back to 2020, surpassing the previous record of four shared by Todd Hundley (1994-97), Gary Carter (1977-80), and Yogi Berra (1955-58)...Those three all did so with the same team, while O'Neill has accomplished the feat with three different clubs.

ROGERS THAT: Trevor Rogers is scheduled to take the ball for his first career Opening Day start...He'll be the first Orioles lefty to start on Opening Day since John Means did so in 2021 at Boston and 2022 at Tampa Bay and the first O's left-hander to do so at home since Jimmy Key in 1997.

- Rogers earned Most Valuable Oriole last year after going 9-3 with a 1.81 ERA (22 ER/109.2 IP) in 18 starts...His ERA was the lowest mark by an Oriole starter (min. 100.0 IP) in franchise history and marked the third-lowest ERA by an Oriole through his first 18 starts of a season, behind Milt Pappas (1.77 ERA, 1965) and Jim Palmer (1.78 ERA, 1975).

OPENING DAY RUTSCH: Adley Rutschman is 10-for-14 with three home runs, seven runs scored, nine RBI, and two walks in his first three career Opening Days...Rutschman joins former Oriole Don Baylor as the only players in major league history with 10 hits in their first three career Opening Day games with Rutschman being the only player in MLB history to reach base at least 12 times.

WELCOME TO BIRDLAND: Eight players on the Opening Day roster will be making their O's debut: Blaze Alexander, Pete Alonso, Chris Bassitt, Shane Baz, Ryan Helsley, Anthony Nunez, Leody Taveras, and Taylor Ward...Nunez will be making his major league debut with his first appearance.

- Alonso, Bassitt, Helsley, and Taveras signed as free agents, Alexander (AZ), Baz (TB), and Ward (LAA) were acquired via trade during the offseason, while Nunez (NYM) was acquired via trade at last year's trade deadline.
- Ward has played on Opening Day at Camden Yards before when he was with the Angels in 2024...He went 0-for-4 on March 28 while batting fourth for Los Angeles in an 11-3 Orioles win.

GRAPEFRUIT LEAGUE RECAP: The Orioles finished the Grapefruit League schedule 11-13-3 with two canceled games and went 2-0 in two exhibition games against the Washington Nationals...Tyler O'Neill (1.145), Samuel Basallo (1.114), and Coby Mayo (1.027) all finished with an OPS above 1.000, while Pete Alonso led Grapefruit League clubs with 61 plate appearances during the exhibition schedule...On the mound, Chris Bassitt led the club with 16.1 innings and Trevor Rogers paced the team with 16 strikeouts.

FOR THE BOYS: Craig Albernaz was hired to be the 22nd manager in Orioles history and 19th full-time manager on October 27, 2025...“Alby” joins Baltimore from the Cleveland Guardians where he served as bench coach (2024) and associate manager (2025) under Stephen Vogt, who won American League Manager of the Year both seasons...Albernaz also worked under Gabe Kapler with the San Francisco Giants as bullpen coach from 2020-23 after spending his first five seasons as a minor league coach in various roles in the Tampa Bay Rays organization.

- New to the coaching staff is Jason Bourgeois (First Base Coach), Miguel Cairo (Infield Coach), Hank Conger (Bullpen Coach), Donnie Ecker (Bench Coach), Dustin Lind (Hitting Coach), Brady North (Assistant Hitting Coach), and Joe Singley (Field Coordinator/Catching Coach).
- Buck Britton (Third Base Coach), Drew French (Pitching Coach), Ryan Klimek (Pitching Strategy Coach), and Mitch Plassmeyer (Assistant Pitching Coach) all return to the staff.

2025 RECAP: Baltimore finished 75-87 (.463) last season, ending under .500 for the first time since 2021...From 2022-24, the Orioles were 275-211 (.566), tied for the fourth-best record in the majors with the New York Yankees, trailing the Los Angeles Dodgers (.636, 309-177), Atlanta Braves (.605, 294-192), and Houston Astros (.586, 284-201).

- The O's used 70 different players in 2025, tied for the second-most players in a season by a team in major league history with the 2024 Marlins, trailing the 2025 Braves (71)...The previous O's high was 62 players in 2021.
- The Orioles used 41 different pitchers (including position players), one shy of tying the AL record shared by the 2021 Orioles and 2019 Seattle Mariners.
- Baltimore had 34 different position players appear in a game, the most by a major league team since 2022 (37, SF; 34, LAA, OAK, PIT) and tied for the most in a season in franchise history with 1955.
- Seven different players appeared at catcher, setting the franchise record.

SEEING DOUBLE: The Orioles and Twins meet for the first three of six games against each other this season this weekend at Oriole Park...The clubs will meet at Target Field from August 10-12...Last year, Baltimore was swept in the season series (0-6) by Minnesota for the fourth time since the Twins moved to the Twin Cities in 1961, joining 2019 (0-6), 2015 (0-7), and 2007 (0-7)...The O's went 13-6 (.684) against Minnesota from 2022-24.

- Ryan Mountcastle has hit in 17 straight games against the Twins, the longest hitting streak against Minnesota in team history...Mountcastle's stretch began May 4, 2022, and he's slashing .400/.406/.677 (26-for-65) with nine doubles and three homers during that period.

OPENING DAY: Rogers is scheduled to make his first career Opening Day start, while becoming the 45th Opening Day starter in Orioles history (since 1954)...RHP Zach Eflin took the ball for Baltimore last season in the O's 12-2 season-opening victory over the Blue Jays at Rogers Centre.

NEW TEAM, WHO DIS?: Rogers is set to face the Twins for the first time in his career, one of three clubs he has yet to square off against, along with the Royals and White Sox
 ⚡ In three career starts opposite AL foes, he is 1-1 with a 3.77 ERA (6 ER/14.1 IP)...His last outing against the division came in his Orioles debut on 8/1/24 at Cleveland (L, 4.1 IP, 6 H, 5 ER, 3 BB, 1 HR, 3 K).

FOUR-SEAM FOCUS: Last season, Rogers featured his four-seam fastball 40.8 percent of the time and limited the opposition to a .158 (22-for-139) clip on the offering...The .158 opponent average was the second lowest among all MLB starters (min. 100 AB ending in pitch), trailing SEA's Bryan Woo (.153, 42-for-274).

MAKING HISTORY: During the 2025 campaign, his 1.81 ERA (22 ER/109.2 IP) was the lowest mark by an Oriole starter (min. 100.0 IP) in franchise history (since 1954), ahead of Dave McNally (1.95 ERA, 1968) and Jim Palmer (2.07 ERA, 1972)...His .180 opponent average (70-for-388), .263 opponent slugging percentage, and .503 opponent OPS were the lowest marks by an Oriole starter (min. 100.0 IP) in franchise history (since 1954), while his .240 opponent on-base percentage ranked second behind McNally (.232 OBP, 1968)

⚡ From 7/6-8/30/25, made 10 straight starts of 6.0+ innings and allowing two or fewer runs, setting the franchise record.

⚡ Named 2025 American League Pitcher of the Month for August, going 4-1 with a 1.29 ERA (6 ER/42.0 IP) across six starts...Became the first Oriole to earn the honor since Corbin Burnes (September 2024) and the first Oriole left-hander since Erik Bedard (July 2007)...Became the first Oriole in franchise history (since 1954) to make at least five starts and allow one or zero runs in each of the outings in a single month.

MVO: Rogers was voted as the winner of the 2025 Most Valuable Oriole Award by members of the local media, joining Randy Myers (1997), Mike Cuellar (1974), and Dave McNally (1968) as the only left-handed pitchers in franchise history to be named Most Valuable Oriole...He was the first pitcher to earn the honor since Rodrigo Lopez (2002).

HOME IS WHERE THE HEART IS: In seven starts at Camden Yards in 2025, Rogers went 4-1 with a 0.96 ERA (5 ER/47.0 IP).

⚡ The 0.96 ERA was the third-lowest home ERA by an Orioles hurler (min. 45.0 IP) in franchise history (since 1954), trailing Gregg Olson (1989 - 0.77 ERA, 4 ER/46.2 IP) and George Zverink (1955 - 0.85 ERA, 5 ER/52.2 IP)

2025 IN REVIEW: Went 9-3 in 2025 with a 1.81 ERA (22 ER/109.2 IP) on 70 hits (6 HR), 29 walks, and two hit batters with 103 strikeouts across 18 starts...Led the Orioles with a career-high 5.5 *Baseball Reference* Wins Above Replacement, the third-highest mark by an Oriole southpaw in franchise history (since 1954).

⚡ His ERA was second lowest in MLB behind TEX's Nathan Eovaldi (1.73), while his opponent average, opponent slugging percentage, and opponent OPS each led all pitchers (min. 100.0 IP)

⚡ On 8/1 at CHC, threw his first career complete game (L, 8.0 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 8 K), becoming the first Oriole starter to throw a complete game since Dean Kremer (9/23/22 vs. HOU, 9.0 IP)...Became the first Oriole to suffer a loss in a complete game since Chris Tillman (9/14/13 at TOR, 8.0 IP, 6 H, 4 R, 1 HR, 2 BB, 4 K)

⚡ Began the season on the 15-day Injured List after being placed on the IL on 3/27 (retroactive to 3/24) with right knee subluxation...Reinstated on 5/11 and optioned to Triple-A Norfolk that day

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the win last Sunday vs. Washington in his final Grapefruit League start, tossing 5.1 scoreless innings of four-hit ball with three walks and three strikeouts.

vs. MINNESOTA: Set to make his third career start against the Twins, going 0-1 with a 4.50 ERA (5 ER/10.0 IP) through his two prior outings...His last start vs. Minnesota came at Camden Yards on July 1, 2023, when he suffered the loss despite recording a quality start (6.0 IP, 1 R, 7 H, 1 HR, 1 BB, 7 K)...Over six career starts (3 QS) against the AL Central, he is 3-1 with a 2.41 ERA (9 ER/33.2 IP), 1.19 WHIP, and .212 (25-for-118) opponent average.

- From 3/29-4/24, opened the season with nine straight scoreless appearances, which tied the third-longest single-season streak of his career behind runs of 17 games (4/14-5/17/23) and 11 games (8/3-26/23)
