RAY REPORT—The Rays continue a 10-day, three-city road trip through Atlanta (0-2, 1 to play), Minnesota (3 to play) and Pittsburgh (3 to play) tonight at Truist Park...have lost two straight, three of four, seven of nine, and nine of their last 14 games...are 8-10 in their last 18 contests on the heels of a season-high six-game losing streak from May 19-25...their 8-16 record since May 19 is third worst in the AL, ahead of the Athletics (7-17/.292) and White Sox (5-21/.192)...this, after posting an 11-4 mark in their previous 15 contests from May 3-18...are 2-7 so far during a stretch of 19 games in 20 days from June 7-26.

- ★ The Rays scored first for the second straight game and third time in their last four, but were defeated, 9-2, yesterday in Atlanta...Tampa Bay's 19 blown lead losses are fourth most in the AL behind the White Sox (26), Astros and Rangers (both 20).
- ★ Tampa Bay is a season-high five games below .500 for the first time since entering play on June 23, 2018 (35-40)...it was last six games under on June 22, 2018 (34-40).
- ★ The Rays have now split their last six series and are 3-5-0 in their last eight...today, they look to avoid being swept for the fourth time, which would join April 26-28 at CWS, May 20-22 vs. BOS and June 7-10 vs. BAL.
- ★ The Rays have been swept by the Braves four times, most recently in a two-game set from July 29-30, 2021 at Truist Park...the only other instance of Tampa Bay being swept in Atlanta came from June 7-9, 1999 at Turner Field.
- ★ Over their last five games, 12 of the Rays 16 runs have come in the 7th inning or later...they did not score from the 7th on in any of their previous six games.
- ★ Since May 1, the Rays are 17-5 when scoring 4+ runs and 2-16 with three or fewer...they have won seven of their last eight games when scoring 4+ times, but have tallied three runs or fewer in eight of their last nine contests.
- ★ Tampa Bay will be opposed by a rookie starting pitcher for the 10th time, going 4-5 in the previous matchups...rookie starters have posted a 2.45 ERA (47.2IP, 13ER) against the Rays, second lowest in the AL, ahead of the Mariners (1.71).

HAPPY FATHER'S DAY!—The Rays are 12-13 all-time on Father's Day, going 4-7 at home and 8-6 on the road...this marks their fourth straight season with a road game on Father's Day, losing each of the last three contests...last year, Tampa Bay suffered a 5-4 defeat at San Diego despite out-hitting the Padres, 12-7...today marks the Rays first Father's Day matchup with the Braves...they are seeking their first win on the holiday since June 16, 2019 vs. LAA (6-5) and their first on the road since June 15, 2014 at HOU (4-3).

PRETTY EFLIN GOOD—Zach Eflin has not issued a walk over his last 36.2 innings and 153 batters faced...according to Elias, both streaks are franchise records, surpassing marks held by David Price (35.1IP, 2013) and Corey Kluber (35.1IP/150BF, 2022)...his last free pass came on April 26 at CWS, when he issued consecutive one-out walks to Robbie Grossman and Eloy Jiménez in the 3rd inning.

Per Elias, only three pitchers have recorded longer single-season walk-less inning streaks since 2018: CLE Corey Kluber (46.1IP, May 8-June 15, 2018), SF Ross Stripling (42.0IP, July 2-Aug. 16, 2023) and NYY Gerrit Cole (40.1IP, April 12-May 17, 2021).

Over the last six seasons since 2019, the only pitcher to face more than 153 consecutive batters without a walk within a single season is Stripling (169BF, July 2-Aug. 16, 2023).

ROAD TRIPPIN'—The Rays are 7-5 over their last 12 road contests following a 7-10 start...their .583 road winning pct. in that span (since May 15) is tied with the Giants (7-5) for third best in MLB behind the Yankees (13-4/.765) and Orioles (10-5/.667)...the Rays have played only 29 road games, tied with the Mets for the fewest in the majors...this series marks the beginning of a stretch in which 15 of their 21 games will take place on the road.

José Caballero is batting .321 (27-for-84) on the road, second in the AL behind HOU Yordan Alvarez (.328)...he owns a .200 (24-for-120) average at home.

Isaac Paredes is batting .318 (34-for-107) as a visitor, fifth best in the AL...he is slashing .365/.412/.540 (.23-for-63) during a career-long 16-game road on-base streak, the third-longest active streak in the AL behind KC Salvador Perez (.31C) and HOU Yordan Alvarez (.17G)...the last Ray with a longer single-season streak was Yandy Diaz (.19G) from July 27-Sept. 13 (G1), 2022.

Paredes also has a career-long nine-game road hitting streak. Amed Rosario is 17-for-38 (.447) with 5 XBH during a 10-game road hitting streak.

CARDIAC KIDS—The Rays 19 comeback wins are tied for fourth most in the majors behind the Nationals, Orioles and Yankees (all 20)...Tampa Bay has come from behind in eight of its last nine wins, including four multi-run comebacks in its last five victories...10 of the 19 wins came after trailing by multiple runs...they have faced a multi-run deficit at some point in seven straight, 12 of 14, and 20 of their last 25 games...57.6 pct. of their victories have been comeback wins, the highest percentage in the AL.

The Rays 16 wins after conceding the first run are tied for second most in MLB behind the Yankees (18)...they have lost three straight games when scoring first and have won three in a row when their opponent strikes first.

Tampa Bay has held a lead entering the 7th inning just three times in its last 25 games since May 18 (June 4-5 at MIA, June 12 vs. CHC) but has managed a 9-16 record over that span...the Rays rank among MLB leaders in wins when trailing after six (1st, 9), seven (1st, 7) and eight (T2nd, 4) frames.

DOWN TO THE WIRE—The Rays own the best record in the majors in both one-run games (13-5/.722) and games decided by two runs or fewer (23-10/.697)...they are 14-4 in their last 18 games decided by two runs or fewer and have won seven of eight and nine of their last 11 one-run contests.

THE CHAMP IS HERE—Yandy Diaz is riding a season-high 18-game on-base streak, batting .278/.354/.333 (20-for-72) with 2 2B, 1 3B, 5 RBI, 9 BB and 12 SO...it marks the third-longest active streak in the AL and fourth longest in MLB...it signals his longest streak since a career-high-tying 22-game run from April 27-May 28, 2023 and ties Isaac Paredes (18G, April 28-May 19) for the longest on-base streak by a Ray this season.

TWO-OUT TROUBLES—Over the last five games, Rays pitching has been tagged for a .414/.474/.700 (29-for-70) slash line with 6 HR with two outs compared to .157/.209/.275 (16-for-102) with 3 HR with one or zero outs...they held opposing hitters to a .241 (53-for-220) two-out average over their previous 19 games from May 19-June 10...on the season, Tampa Bay's .263 two-out opp. average is second highest in MLB behind Colorado (.277).

HOMER (UN)HAPPY—The Rays have allowed an MLB-leading 97 HR and have hit 54 HR, tied with the Marlins for the fewest in the majors...they are 14-3 when holding the opposition homerless compared to 19-35 when yielding 1+ HR...the club is 26-15 when out-homering the opponent or homers are even and 7-23 when being out-homered...the Rays have not out-homered an opponent in any of their 13 games during June, posting a -16 (24-8) home run margin this month.

IN THE ATL—The Rays and Braves conclude their lone series of 2024 today...Tampa Bay is 6-8 against Atlanta since 2020 and 16-28 (.363) all-time against the Braves...it marks the Rays second-worst winning pct. against a single opponent, ahead of a 7-14 (.333) record against the Reds...the 44 all-time meetings are their second most against any NL opponent behind Miami (137)...Yandy Diaz is 14-for-38 (.368) in 10 career games vs. ATL.

- ★ Braves RHP Charlie Morton pitched two seasons for the Rays, making one of his two All-Star appearances in 2019 before helping the club to a World Series appearance in 2020.
- ★ C Alex Jackson was traded to the Braves in 2016 and made his MLB debut with them in 2019 after progressing through their farm system...he appeared in 19 games with Atlanta over three seasons before being dealt to the Marlins for OF Adam Duvall at the 2021 trade deadline.
- ★ RHP Taj Bradley grew up in Stone Mountain, GA rooting for the Braves...he is friends with Braves OF Michael Harris II, who also hails from DeKalb County...OF Josh Lowe was also a Braves fan while growing up in Marietta, GA.
- ★ RHP Matt McWilliams, uncle of LHP Garrett Cleavinger, played for Short-A Eugene in the Braves system in 1995.
- ★ Rays LHP Colin Poche and Braves OF Brian Anderson were teammates at the University of Arkansas from 2013-14.
- ★ Rays INF Brandon Lowe hit his first career home against the Braves on Aug. 28, 2018 (Julio Teheran).
- ★ Braves RHP Hurston Waldrep pitched at the University of Florida in 2023.
- ★ Braves RHP Jimmy Herget, who is currently on the 15-day IL, hails from Tampa and is a University of South Florida product.
- ★ Atlanta C Travis d'Arnaud appeared in 92 games for the Rays in 2019.
- ★ Braves C Sean Murphy attended Wright State (OH) University, the same school as Bally Sports Sun announcer Brian Anderson...Wright State has produced eight major leaguers in its history, including former Ray Carlos Peña.
- ★ Tampa Bay and Atlanta faced off in the first game at Tropicana Field on March 27, 1998, an exhibition that saw the Devil Rays claim a 5-0 win...Hall of Famer Tom Glavine started for the Braves.

TODAY'S START—Eflin will take the mound for his 13th start of the season, including his eighth on the road...marks his third start since his May 20-June 5 stint on the 15-day IL (lower back inflammation)...is seeking his first road victory since May 13 at Boston and his second quality start away from home, joining his April 20 start at New York-AL (ND, 6.0IP, 3H, OR, OBB, 6SO)...is 12 strikeouts shy of 800 for his career.

LAST TIME OUT—Did not factor into the decision on June 11 vs. Chicago-NL...tossed 5.2 innings of two-run ball, conceding seven hits with zero walks and three strikeouts.

- Was scoreless through 3.0 innings...allowed a solo homer to **Christopher Morel** to open the 4th frame.
- Departed in the 6th inning with runners on 1st and 2nd base and was charged with his second ER following a PH RBI-single by **David Bote**.

FAMILIAR FOE—Eflin has made 17 career appearances (14GS) against Atlanta, going 7-3 with a 3.14 ERA (86.0IP, 30ER)...in his last 11 appearances (8GS) dating to Sept. 18, 2019, he is 5-0 with a 2.35 ERA (53.2IP, 14ER).

- His seven career wins vs. Atlanta are sixth most among all active pitchers behind PHI **Aaron Nola** (15), TEX **Max Scherzer** (13), PHI **Zack Wheeler** (12), TEX **Jacob deGrom** (10) and BOS **Nick Pivetta** (8).
- The seven victories are his most against any opponent, while the 17 appearances and 86.0 IP are second most behind Miami (19 & 103.0IP).
- Eflin is 4-1 with a 4.37 ERA (35.0IP, 17ER) in six starts at Atlanta, compared to 3-2 with a 2.29 ERA (51.0IP, 13ER) in 11 appearances (8GS) when facing the Braves at home.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING—Eflin has walked two batters or fewer in 46 straight starts dating to June 14, 2022, tied with SEA **George Kirby** for the longest active streak in the majors...since 2010, only two starters have strung together longer streaks: **Phil Hughes** (64GS) and **Clayton Kershaw** (47GS).

- Of the 46 starts, 43 have come with the Rays...in his last start on June 11 vs. CHC, Eflin surpassed **Andy Sonnanstine** (42GS, Aug. 5, 2007-Sept. 21, 2008) for the most consecutive starts with two walks or fewer in franchise history.
- He has not issued a walk to his last 153 BF or issued a free pass in his last 36.1 IP, both of which are the longest streaks in franchise history.

QUALITY CONTROL—Min. 50.0 IP. Eflin paces the majors in walk rate (1.4%), walks per 9.0 IP (0.52) and SO/BB ratio (12.50)...he has produced the lowest walk rate in the majors since 2020 (min. 1.750BF) at 3.7 pct., ahead of **Zack Greinke** (4.4%)...his 68.80 pct. strike rate since the beginning of last season ranks second in the majors (min. 200.0IP) behind SEA **George Kirby** (70.46%)...Eflin has walked one or zero batters in 36 of his 43 starts since the beginning of last season—only Kirby (40) has more such starts during that span.

IT'S A MARATHON—In innings 1-5, Eflin has posted a 2.90 ERA (59.0IP, 19ER) with a .232 (53-for-228) average...from the 6th inning on, he owns an 11.17 ERA (9.2IP, 12ER), .431 (22-for-51) opp. average and 1.257 opp. OPS.

- When his pitch count resides between 1-60, opponents are 47-for-200 (.235) against him...once he surpasses the 60-pitch mark, opposing hitters are 28-for-79 (.354).
- Opponents are batting a combined .215 (45-for-209) against Eflin the first two times through the order, including .178 (18-for-101) the second time through...opposing hitters have produced a 30-for-70 (.429) clip the third time through and beyond.

SEARCHING FOR STRIKEOUTS—Eflin has 3 SO or fewer in five straight starts, tied for the longest streak of his career (also July 20-Sept. 1, 2019).

- His season-high strikeout total is six (2x, last: May 1 at MIL)...he had 7+ SO in 14 of his 31 starts last season.
