THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game homestand with a record of 5-2 (2-1 vs. Texas and 3-1 vs. Kansas City), the Twins began their nine-game, 10-day roadtrip with a win and a loss to the Astros in Houston...today, Minnesota will continue the trip with the three-game series finale at Minute Maid Park...after today's game, they will travel to New York for an off-day tomorrow, then play the Yankees for three games from Tuesday-Thursday...after New York, the Twins will travel to Pittsburgh to play the Pirates for three games next weekend.
 ☞ Since April 22, the Twins have gone 25-13, the third-best record in baseball since that date, trailing Philadelphia (27-10) and New York-AL (26-12).
 ☞ After a seven-game losing streak from May 14-20, the Twins have gone 8-3 since May 21.
 ☞ The Twins are 3-1 in rubber games this season, their three wins coming April 13 at Detroit, May 12 at Toronto and May 22 at Washington...their one loss coming April 21 vs. Detroit.

JUNE STARTS WITH A BOOM...OR FOUR: The Twins lost to the Astros yesterday at Minute Maid Park by a score of 5-2...Joe Ryan (4-4) was the starter and dealt the loss, allowing five runs on eight hits (4 home runs) in 5.0 innings pitched...the offense recorded just four hits and walked four times, but went 2-for-6 with runners in scoring position...Carlos Correa drove in a run, his 20th RBI of the season and Jose Miranda drove in the other, his 18th RBI.

SPACEBALLS: After going 0-6 against the Astros in 2022, the Twins have gone 5-3 in regular season games vs. Houston since the start of 2023...in that span, they have outscored the 'Stros 37-31...the Twins are 40-45 all-time against the Astros in the regular season, including a record of 29-36 since Houston joined the American League in 2013.

☞ Alex Kirilloff is hitting .391 (9-for-23) with seven walks, a .531 on-base percentage and a .923 OPS in nine career regular season games vs. Houston.

HAPPY FLIGHTS: After starting the season 5-7 in their first 12 games away from Target Field, the Twins have gone 11-6 in their last 17 road games...over the 17-game stretch, the Twins have scored 5.8 runs-per-game (99 runs) and hit 21 home runs.

☞ Willi Castro is hitting .338 (22-for-65) with six doubles, three triples, one home run, a .394 on-base percentage, a .569 slugging percentage and a .964 OPS in his last 17 road games.
 ☞ Max Kepler has reached safely in 13-straight road games, hitting .351 (13-for-37) with nine RBI and a 1.093 OPS in that span.
 ☞ Carlos Santana has seven home runs and 20 RBI in 27 road games this season...his seven home runs are tied for eighth-most in the AL and his 20 RBI are tied for ninth-most.

LEADING MAN: Trevor Larnach is leading off today for the fifth time in the Twins last eight games, all against a right-handed starter (Manny Margot has led-off vs. lefties)...Larnach has posted a 1.026 OPS from the top spot in the lineup...additionally, he has reached safely in each of his last six games overall, slashing .250/.318/.550 (.868 OPS) with two home runs, five RBI and just two strikeouts in that span.

BULLPEN BULLIES: Over the last 11 games, the Twins' bullpen has gone 3-0, 1.46 ERA (37.0 IP, 6 ER) with nine walks, 31 strikeouts, a .155 opponent batting average, 11 holds and six saves in six opportunities...their .155 opponent batting average, .217 slugging percentage, .216 on-base percentage and .200 wOBA all lead baseball in that span.

TWINS TRY MEATLOAF THE 'STROS: The Twins have gone 10-6-2 in series play this season, going 5-4-0 at home and 5-2-2 on the road...a win today would give them their 10th series win in their last 11 tries...2024 series results to the lower right.

☞ Twins are looking for their third consecutive regular season series win against the Astros...they have won three-straight series vs. Houston once: 2000, 2001 and 2006 in Interleague Play.

ROYCE ON REHAB: Royce Lewis is currently on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul...he did not play in last night's game for the Saints...through five rehab games, Lewis is 3-for-19 with one double, seven strikeouts and one stolen base...St. Paul plays at Rochester again this afternoon at 12:05 pm (CT)...Lewis sustained a right quad strain on Opening Day, March 28 at Kansas City, while running the bases.

TWINS MiLB WEEKLYS: High-A Cedar Rapids catcher/outfielder Ricardo Olivar and Low-A Fort Myers right-handed pitcher Iy Langenberg have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

☞ Olivar, 22, played in five games for the Kernels, hitting .364 (8-for-22) with three home runs, five RBI and a 1.136 OPS...the Barquisimeto, Venezuela native was signed by the Twins in June of 2021.

☞ Langenberg, 22, made the start for the Mighty Mussels on Tuesday vs. Bradenton, allowing two runs on four hits in 5.2 innings pitched, with three walks and eight strikeouts...the Urbandale, Iowa native was selected by the Twins in the 11th round of the 2023 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Iowa.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1986, Rod Carew announced his retirement from baseball at the age of 40...Carew retired with a .328 career batting average, compiled over 19 major league seasons...he was inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in 1991...in 2023, former Minnesota pitcher Bartolo Colon officially announced his retirement...Big Sexy made 15 starts for the Twins in 2017, going 5-6, 5.18 ERA (80.0 IP, 46 ER), including a complete game on August 4, 2017 vs. Texas at the age of 44.

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched May 28 vs. Kansas City, opposite Cole Ragans, and earned the win in Minnesota's 4-2 victory...allowed two runs on three hits in 5.0 innings with two walks and four strikeouts...stranded a runner on third base in the third...allowed both runs in the fifth, but stranded a runner on third and preserved Minnesota's 3-2 lead.

- ☞ Induced 10 whiffs on 39 swings (25.6%)...ranks in MLB's ninth percentile this season with an 18.6 percent whiff rate.
- ☞ Allowed just three hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph)...Kansas City went 1-for-3 with a double on those swings...ranks in MLB's 49th percentile with a 38.5 percent hard-hit rate this season.
- ☞ Snapped a streak of six-straight no-decisions.
- ☞ Has allowed three-or-fewer hits in four of eight MLB starts this season...opponents are slashing .235/.284/.315 (.599 OPS) vs. Woods Richardson this season.

TWO STARTS AGO: Started May 22 in Washington, opposite Jake Irvin, and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 3-2 win...threw 4.2 scoreless innings, allowing three hits and one walk with one strikeout...allowed just two runners to reach scoring position and stranded both...was pulled with two outs and nobody on in the fifth, one out shy of qualifying for the win.

- ☞ Induced four whiffs on 34 swings (11.8%).
- ☞ Allowed four hard-hit balls...Washington went 1-for-4 on those swings.

HOMECOMING IN HOUSTON: Has never faced Houston or any of its current hitters at the MLB level...grew up in Sugar Land, TX and attended Kempner High School – less than 30 miles from Minute Maid Park.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Making sixth road start of the season...has gone 1-0 with a 3.00 ERA (24.0 IP, 8 ER), five walks and 12 strikeouts on the road, compared to 1-0 with a 2.25 ERA (16.0 IP, 4 ER), four walks and 18 strikeouts in three home starts...has allowed a .264 (24-for-91) batting average, .282 BABIP (batting average on balls in play) and .687 OPS on the road, compared to .190 (11-for-58) BAA, .268 BABIP and .462 OPS at home.

- ☞ Five of his eight runs allowed on the road – and both home runs – came May 11 in Toronto.

REVERSE SPLITS: On May 28, Kansas City's left-handed hitters went 0-for-2 with a walk and a strikeout vs. Woods Richardson, while its righties went 3-for-16 with a double, a walk and three strikeouts...through eight games vs. Woods Richardson, lefties have hit .172 (10-for-58) with a .462 OPS and 19.7 percent strikeout rate, while righties have hit .275 (25-for-91) with a .687 OPS and 17.5 percent strikeout rate.

- ☞ Average exit velocity vs. Woods Richardson: 86.6 mph by lefties, 90.5 mph by righties.
- ☞ Houston ranks fifth in baseball with a .745 OPS vs. right-handed pitching.

- ☞ On May 28, facing a Royals lineup with seven righties, threw a season-high 43 sliders...Kansas City went 2-for-9 against the pitch with six whiffs on 25 swings (24.0%).
- ☞ Threw season-low three changeups and one curveball vs. Kansas City.
- ☞ Slider has allowed a .222 slugging percentage, sixth lowest in baseball (min. 50 PA)...ranks in baseball's 96th percentile with a breaking ball run value of 6.
- ☞ In five May starts, opponents hit .176 (3-for-17) vs. Woods Richardson's changeup.
