**Counting to Ten**  
The Brewers look to go 10 games over .500 for the first time this season....the team has been 9 games over .500 seven times: 17-8, 20-11, 24-15, 26-17, 27-18, 30-21 and 31-22.

**Home Improvement**  
The Brewers are 8-2 in their last 10 home games after a 5-7 start....the team has won 3 in a row at home.

**Rebel Yell**  
Christian Yelich enters tonight's game needing 2 HR for 200 career and 2 doubles for 300 career.

**Swinging All the Way**  
Willy Adames belted a 3-run homer off Hayden Wesneski on a 3-0 pitch in the eighth inning yesterday....it marked the 10th time in his career that Adames swung at a 3-0 pitch (124th 3-0 count pitch) and first time he homered....it was his third career hit on a 3-0 count with the others on 8/19/20 at NYY (RBI-single) and 10/5/22 vs. ARI (single)....the last home run on a 3-0 count from a Brewers player prior to yesterday was by Christian Yelich on 5/23/21 at CIN.

**Everyday People**  
Willy Adames and William Contreras have both started each of the team's first 53 games....this is the longest streak to start a season by Brewers teammates since Ryan Braun and Prince Fielder in 2011 (56 games).

**Iron Man**  
William Contreras has played in 90 straight games - all starts - dating back to last season....his last game missed came on 8/20/23 at Texas.

**MVP**  
William Contreras, who has started every game for the Brewers this season (43g at C, 10g at DH), currently ranks among the National League top five in the following categories:

**AT HOME:** The Brewers are 13-9 at home, going 4-2-1 in series play....the team has gone 8-2 in their last 10 home games after a 5-7 start.

**ON THE ROAD:** The Brewers are 18-13 on the road, going 5-4-1 in series play....the team took 2 of 3 games at Boston on its last trip to snap a streak of four straight road series losses....the Brewers went 4-0-1 in their first five road series this season.

**MANAGER:** Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the San Diego Padres (42-54), replacing Bud Black in June of that season....Murphy enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career spent primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009).

**COACHES:** First base coach Quintin Berry (4th season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach Connor Dawson (3rd season), assistant pitching coach Jim Henderson (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (6th season), third base coach Jason Lane (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator Walker McKinven (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach Ozzie Timmons (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff....Rickie Weeks (associate manager), Daniel de Mondesert (assistant coach) and Charlie Greene (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

**LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE:** The Brewers have made 11 replay challenges this season, going 7-4....their last challenge came on 5/25 at Boston as a call originally ruled no fan interference on a hit by Willy Adames was overturned (double).

**TONIGHTS STARTER: #51 - RHP FREDDY PERALTA (10gs, 3-3, 3.81)**

**PERALTA AT A GLANCE:** Freddy Peralta, 27, is making his 11th start of the season and second against the Cubs....Peralta last started last Wednesday at Miami and took a 1-0 (7ip, 4h, 1r, 1er, 1bb, 7k, 1hr, 98 pitches)....the team is 7-3 in his starts....he has 5 quality starts....opponents are batting .211 (43-for-204, 7hr)....he is the third pitcher in franchise history born in the Dominican Republic to start on Opening Day, joining **Rafael Roque** (1999) and **Wily Peralta** (2016), who is of no relation....Peralta was acquired from Seattle, along with RHP Carlos Herrera and RHP Daniel Missaki, in exchange for 1B Adam Lind on 12/9/15....on 2/28/20, he signed a 5-year contract through the 2024 season with club options for 2025 and 2026.

**LAST SEASON:** Peralta went 12-10 with a 3.86 ERA in a career-high 30 starts last season....the team went 17-13 in his starts....he made 16 quality starts....opponents batted .212 (131-for-617, 26hr)....Peralta ranked among the 2023 National League leaders in K/9IP (3rd, 11.41), WHIP (5th, 1.12), H/9IP (5th, 7.12), strikeouts (T5th, 210) and K/BB (7th, 3.89)....he became the eighth pitcher (14x) in franchise history to produce 200+ strikeouts in a season.

**CAREER:** Is 45-30 with a 3.83 ERA and 1 save in 156 games/107 starts (637.1ip, 271er)....is in his seventh Major League season, all with the Brewers (2018-24)....has gone 37-28 with a 3.82 ERA as a starter (553.1ip, 235er) and 8-2 with a 3.86 ERA in relief (84ip, 36er)....was an All-Star in 2021.

**CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD:** Is 26-14 with a 3.41 ERA in 81 games/53 starts (329.2ip, 125er)....is 1-0 with a 4.24 ERA in 3 starts this season (17ip, 8er).

**CAREER ON THE ROAD:** Is 19-16 with a 4.27 ERA in 75 games/54 starts (307.2ip, 146er)....is 2-3 with a 3.63 ERA in 7 starts this season (39.2ip, 16er).

**CAREER vs. CUBS:** Is 5-2 with a 3.50 ERA in 16 games/11 starts vs. Chicago (64.1ip, 40h, 25r, 25er, 37bb, 90k, 6hr), including a 5-0 loss this season on 5/5 at Wrigley Field (5ip, 3h, 3r, 3er, 6bb, 5k, 1hbp, 1wp).
