**TODAY'S GAME:** The Giants' wrap up the series against Cleveland with today's rubber match...San Francisco is 8-9 in rubber games this season, but have dropped each of it's last six rubber games...the last time SF won a rubber match was July 12 vs. COL.

- ▶ With a win today, the Giants could secure their first road series win since Atlanta from June 16-17...since then, the Giants have dropped seven straight road series.
- ▶ SF defeated the Guardians 1-0 last night, marking their ninth shut out victory of the season and first shut out on the road since July 17 at Seattle (won 7-0).
- ▶ At 52-74 (.413), the Giants are in 4th place in the NL West, just 2.5 games ahead of the last-place Rockies...the Giants' .413 winning percentage is the fourth-lowest in MLB, ahead of the Athletics (.386), Rockies (.394) and Angels (.394).
- ▶ SF enters today having dropped 11 of their last 14 road games and 18 of their last 24...the Giants are 23-41 (.359) on the road this season.

**ON THE MOUND:** RHP Landen Roupp is scheduled to make his 25th start of the year.

- ▶ He is 0-4 with a 6.52 ERA (14er, 19.1ip) and 15 walks over his last four outings...according to *Sports Info Solutions*, the issue has been that the 4-seam and sinker have netted a 57% strike rate...in his three previous starts he went 2-0 with a 1.29 ERA (3er, 21.0ip) with five walks and 14 strikeouts...during that stretch, he was 65% strikes with his sinker.
- ▶ Roupp's curveball and changeup are his best pitches, a trend that has held steady throughout his career...opposing hitters are batting .192 and slugging .265 against these pitches (*SIS*).
- ▶ The Giants have dropped each of his last five starts and 16 of the last 18 games he's been on the mound.

**WILLY WATCH: IF Willy Adames** is sitting on 199 career home runs (19 this season)...his next homer would make him the first Giant to reach the 20-homer mark as a shortstop in multiple seasons since **Brandon Crawford** (24 in 2021 and 21 in 2015), and the first to do it in two straight seasons since **Rich Aurilia** (37 homers in 2001, 20 homers in 2000).

- ▶ His next home run would mark his sixth straight 20-homer season in the Majors overall (2021-present)...only four shortstops in MLB history have recorded six-or-more straight 20-HR seasons: Cal Ripken Jr., BAL, 10 from 1982-1991; Miguel Tejada, OAK-BAL, 8 from 1999-2006; Alex Rodriguez, SEA-TEX, 8 from 1996-2003 and Ernie Banks, CHC, 7 from 1955-1961 (*STATS, LLC*).

**AGAINST CLEVELAND:** The Giants are 5-6 over their past 11 contests against the Guardians, dating back to September 2023.

- ▶ 10 of those last 11 matchups between San Francisco and Cleveland have been decided by two runs or fewer, with seven games being decided by one run...this season the Giants are just 11-21 in one-run contests.

**GOING...GOING...GONE! IF/DH Bryce Eldridge** has three home runs and five RBI in his last seven games...Eldridge has 14 home runs this season, the most by a Giants player at age 21 or younger since **Orlando Cepeda** hit 25 homers in his rookie season of 1958.

**ON DECK:** Following today's game, the Giants will travel to Boston for a three-game series against the Red Sox...dating back to 2007, the Giants are just 3-8 with a -19 run differential over 11 games against the Red Sox at Fenway.

**DOWN ON THE FARM:** *MLB Pipeline* released its updated farm system rankings, with the Giants making the largest jump, climbing from No. 19 to No. 5...San Francisco's 14-spot rise is the organization's highest ranking since 2021, when they ranked No. 8 and is one spot shy of the biggest jump ever...according to *MLB Pipeline*; no organization has made as dramatic a move in so short a time as San Francisco improving from No. 28 in the 2025 preseason to No. 5 now.

- ▶ The Giants have five top 100 prospects per *MLB.com*: **SS/2B Josuar Gonzalez** (No. 17), **SS/3B Luis Hernández** (No. 27), **RHP Jackson Flora** (No. 31), **SS/2B Jhonny Level** (No. 47) and **RHP Ramon Marquez** (No. 100).
- ▶ SF added to its farm system talent by signing draft arms (**RHP Jackson Flora**, **LHP Carson Bolemon** and **RHP Kaden Waechter**) and dealing for **RHP Ramon Márquez**, **LHP Henry Lalane** and **RHP Miguel Mendez** at the deadline.

**ROUPPER:** Roupp is in his third season with the Giants...the 27-year-old was the Giants' 12th round pick in 2021 out of UNC Wilmington.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Received his fourth straight loss after allowing four runs on five hits and three walks while striking out five in 5.2 innings vs. Colorado on August 14...he is 0-4 with a 6.52 ERA (14er, 19.1ip), 15 strikeouts and a 1.66 WHIP in his last four starts.

**VS. CLEVELAND:** Will be making his first career start vs. Cleveland...he has experience against two Guardians on their active roster with Nathaniel Lowe going 1-for-3 and Jo Adell going 0-for-2 with a strikeout.

**HIT-OR-MISS:** The Giants are 7-17 this season in games started by Roupp, with Roupp taking a decision in 19 of the 24 starts (7-12)...when looking at team results, Roupp has a 6.02 ERA (56er, 83.2ip) in his 17 starts when the Giants lose compared to a 1.18 ERA (6er, 45.2ip) in all seven Giants wins (all wins by Roupp as well).

**SO WHAT CHANGED?:** His changeup has been one of his best pitches as of late, with opponents batting .119 (5x42) over his last seven starts...overall, his changeup has a +5 run value, tied with his curveball for his most valuable pitch this year.

**LET THAT SINK IN:** Roupp's sinker has not generated much swing and miss...Roupp's sinker has a whiff rate of 8.7%, which is the fourth-lowest in MLB (min. 200 swings)...he has just one strikeout with his sinker over his last eight games.

**WHAT'S THE COUNT?:** Roupp's 152 plate appearances this year in which the count reached three balls are most in the Majors...his 17.7 pitches per inning is tied for the second-highest mark in MLB among pitchers with at least 120.0 innings pitched this season with CWS' Anthony Kay, and behind only TB's Freddy Peralta (18.3)...Roupp's 4.17 pitches per batter faced is the second-highest in MLB (min. 120.0ip) behind only Toronto's Dylan Cease (4.24).

**NO EAR PLUGS NEEDED:** The righty's 29.9% hard hit rate this season is the lowest in MLB by (min. 350 batted ball events)...the next closest is PHI's Jesús Luzardo (31.8%)...Roupp's 3.3% barrels per plate appearance is also the lowest in MLB...Roupp's 51.8% ground ball rate is sixth-highest in MLB (among qualified pitchers).

**CALLING CARD:** Since entering the Majors in 2024, Roupp's go-to out pitch has been his curveball...this season, Roupp's curveball has a whiff rate of 34.6%, a putaway rate of 24.9% and a run value of +5...Roupp's 53 strikeouts with a curveball this season are seventh-most in MLB.

**DAY MAN:** The righty has a 3.11 ERA (16er, 46.1ip) in eight day game starts this season, which is the 10th-best day game ERA in the National League (min. 8 day game starts).

**WE LOVE TO SEE IT:** Roupp averages 13.8 seconds between pitches with the bases empty, making him one of 25 qualified pitchers in the Majors with a time between pitches of 13.8 or better (MLB average is 16.3 seconds).

**SUCH GREAT HEIGHTS:** Roupp's 129.1 innings, 128 strikeouts, 24 games/starts and 1.30 WHIP are all career bests.
