TWINS TRADE ALCALA: The Twins have acquired minor league infielder Andy Lugo from the Red Sox in exchange for right-handed pitcher Jorge Alcala...Lugo, 21, has played in 44 games for High-A Greenville this season, hitting .265 (40-for-151) with 11 doubles, one triple, four home runs. 20 RBI, 16 runs scored, 14 walks, four stolen bases and a .757 OPS...the San Cristóbal, DR native was signed by the Red Sox in July of 2021 and has played in 208 games across parts of three seasons in Boston's minor league system.

♣ Alcala, 29, appeared in 22 games for the Twins this season, going 0-2, 8.88 ERA (24.1 IP, 24 ER), five home runs, 15 walks, 28 strikeouts and a .302 opponent batting average... he spent his entire major league career with Minnesota (since 2019) and has gone 9-13, 4.32 ERA (187.2 IP, 90 ER), one save, 29 holds, 69 walks and 193 strikeouts in 166 games.

♣ To replace Alcala on the 26-man roster, the Twins have activated left-handed pitcher Joey Wentz, who was claimed off waivers yesterday afternoon from the Pirates.

LONE STAR STATS: The Twins have gone 6-3 against the Rangers since the start of last season...the Twins are 11-5 against the Rangers since the start of 2023, that includes a home record of 6-3.

◆ The next series between these two will be a three-game series at Globe Life Field from September 23-25, the penultimate series of the 2025 season and part of the final roadtrip for Minnesota.

◆ Since the start of 2021, 23 of 30 games between these two have been decided by three runs-or-fewer, while 14 games have been decided by one run.

**SUMMER WARM-UP:** Twins offense has scored 5.4 runs-per-game in 10 games this month... they scored 3.9 runs-per-game in 31 March/April games and 4.3 runs-per-game in 26 May games...below are the offensive monthly totals:

**FOUR POINT BUCK:** Byron Buxton has a team-leading 11 home runs this season...last night's home run was the 144th of his career, passing Joe Mauer and moving into sole possession of 13th on the Twins all-time list (since 1961); next is Max Kepler with 161...it was measured at 479 feet, marking the fifth-longest in Target Field's history (below)...also the second-longest in baseball this season, trailing Mike Trout's 484-foot shot on April 19.

SERIES STUFF: Twins are looking to win their 12th series of the season today...Minnesota is 11-9-1 in series play, going 6-3-1 at home and 5-6-0 on the road...they began the season 1-4-0 in series play but have gone 10-5-1 in their last 16.

◆ Twins have gone 4-0-0 in series play vs. Texas dating back to August of 2022.

LEFT TURNS: Today marks the 10th time the Twins have faced a left-handed starter this season...Minnesota is 5-4 against lefty starters, their four losses against Martín Pérez (3/31 at CWS), Cole Ragans (4/8 at KC), Chris Sale (4/19 at ATL) and Kris Bubic (5/25 vs. KC)... their five wins coming against Yusei Kikuchi (4/26 vs. LAA), Garrett Crochet (May 4 at BOS), Cade Povich (5/6 vs. BAL), Logan Allen (5/19 vs. CLE) and Noah Cameron (5/23 vs. KC). ♣ In their last 36 games, Twins are slashing .261/.342/.403 (.746 OPS) against lefties. ♣ Notable individuals in that 36-game stretch (since April 19) vs. LHP: Willi Castro is hitting .367 (11-for-30)... Byron Buxton is hitting .435 (10-for-23)...Ryan Jeffers is hitting .294 (10-for-34)...Carlos Correa is hitting .323 (10-for-31)...Jonah Bride is hitting .296 (8-for-27). ♣ In 2025, Correa is hitting .316 (12-for-38) with three doubles, four home runs, a .711 slugging percentage and a 1.061 OPS vs. lefties.

**TY ONE ON:** Ty France has reached base safely in a career-high 22-straight games...it marks the longest for a Twin this season and longest since Edouard Julien reached in 23-straight from September 6, 2023-March 30, 2024...the last in a *single season* was Byron Buxton with 24, from April 25-May 24, 2023...France's streak is the fourth-longest active streak in baseball. **\*\*During the streak, France is hitting .325 (27-for-83) with three doubles, one home run, 15 RBI, seven HBP and a .391 on-base percentage.** 

**DON'T STOP BE-LEE-VIN':** Brooks Lee has hit safely in 11-straight games with an at-bat, extending his career-high...the streak is the longest by a Twin this season and tied with Vinnie Pasquantino and José Ramírez for the longest active streak in baseball...Minnesota's last streak as long was from Kyle Farmer, who hit in 13-straight, from September 3-22, 2024. **◆**During the current streak, Lee is hitting .333 (15-for-45) with two doubles, one home run and six RBI.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 2017, the Twins selected Royce Lewis with the first overall pick in the MLB Draft out of JSerra High School...in the following days, in the 12th round, the Twins drafted Bailey Ober out of College of Charleston.

IT AIN'T OBER TIL IT'S OBER: Last pitched on June 6 against the Blue Jays, opposite Paxton Schultz, taking the loss in Minnesodra's 4-6 defeat, his first loss at home this season...allowed five runs on five hits (2 HR), with one walk and four strikeouts in 7.0 innings...retired nine of his first 10 batters before plunking Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (his third hit batter of the season), then allowing a two-run shot to Addison Barger in the fourth...in the fifth, allowed a two-run RBI single to Bo Bichette, and finally a solo homer to George Springer in the sixth...marked his first 6.0-plus inning non-quality start of the season, and fourth of his career.

4 Retired the first six batters of the game in order on 15 pitches; needed 21 pitches to get through the first inning in his previous outing on May 31 in Seattle.

4 Caught Bo Bichette attempting to steal second base in the seventh inning, Ober's first pitcher caught stealing of the season and the third of his career.

4 Ober is tied with Tyler Mahle and Carlos Rodón for the seventh-best winning percentage (.667)

- ◆ Ober is tied with Tyler Mahle and Carlos Rodón for the seventh-best winning percentage (.667) in the American League among qualified pitchers.

TWO STARTS AGO: Pitched on May 31 against the Mariners in his 100th career start, opposite Bryce Miller, and did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 4-5 defeat...allowed two runs on six hits, with one walk and four strikeouts in 4.0 innings...his two runs allowed came off a home run from Cal Raleigh in the third, scoring Ben Williamson...was his longest streak of no decision games in

or this career (five straight).

◆ Became the 27th pitcher to start 100 games as a Twin...among those 27, he ranks second in WHIP (1.101), second in HR/9 (1.4), third in K/9 (9.0), fourth in H/9 (7.9) and ninth in ERA (3.73).

THIS AIN'T TEXAS: Ober is 1-0 in three career starts against Texas, posting a 5.40 ERA (15.0 IP, 9 ER) with seven walks and 12 strikeouts...faced the Rangers twice in 2024, posting a 3.27 ERA (11.0 IP, 4 ER) with six walks, eight strikeouts and a .256 (11-for-43) opponent batting average, his second highest BAA among American League opponents last season, behind the Kansas City Royals (.322).

This career 5.40 ERA is his highest among teams he has faced at least three times, behind the Cardinals (12.15) and Reds (6.19).

The his last start against the Rangers on August 15, 2024 at Globe Life Field, Ober did not face.

- ♣ In his last start against the Rangers on August 15, 2024 at Globe Life Field, Ober did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 3-2 victory...allowed two runs on seven hits, with three walks and three strikeouts.

**JUNE GLOOM:** Ober owns his lowest career win percentage in June...he is 3-6 (.333) in 17 career starts during June, posting a 4.21 ERA, his second highest behind only August (4.36 ERA)...has a .242 (85-for-351) opponent batting average, a 1.128 WHIP...has allowed 45 runs (44 ER), 16 home runs, 21 walks and 93 strikeouts.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Since 2021, Ober has gone 16-10 with a 3.82 ERA (270.2 IP, 115 ER), 9.11 W9, 2.13 BB/9 and 1.56 HR/9 in 52 games (51 starts) at home compared to 13-14 with a 3.84 ERA (274.0 IP, 117 ER), 8.80 W/9, 1.77 BB/9 and 1.28 HR/9 in 51 road starts.

◆ Ober is 2-1 in seven starts at home so far this season, posting a 3.08 ERA (38.0 IP, 13 ER) with six walks, five home runs, 32 strikeouts and a .264 (39-for-148) opponent batting average.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: Through 13 starts in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .271/.306/.414 in 140 at-bats vs. Ober, while righties have slashed .270/.320/.467 in 137 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 86.8 mph and a whiff rate of 22.4 compared to righties' 91.9 mph and 27.7 percent.

◆ His hard hit percentage against left-handed batters is 29.1 percent, while his hard hit percentage against right-handed batters is at an all-time high 52.8 percent.

**THE ARSENAL:** Ober uses a six-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer 37.9% of the time, the lowest of his career...primarily uses his slider, sweeper and sinker against right-handed batters, while favoring his curveball and changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at

PITCH (AVG. MPH)
4-Seam Fastball (90.4) Changeup (83.4) Slider (83.5)...... Sweeper (79.0)... Curveball (75.6).

**EXTENSION # 6-9:** Standing six feet, nine inches tall, Ober is tied with Aaron Slegers (2017-18) and Alex Meyer (2015-16) as the second-tallest players to pitch for the Twins in franchise history (since 1901), trailing only Jon Rauch (6-11, 2009-10)...on average this season, Ober has released his pitches 7.4 feet off the mound, the sixth-longest extension in baseball, which puts him in the 99th percentile according to Baseball Savant...teammate Chris Paddack also has one of the longest extensions in baseball (7.0 feet), ranking in the 93rd percentile.

**THRILL OF THE CHASE**: Per Baseball Savant, Bailey owns a 35.3 chase percentage this season, ranking in baseball's 95th percentile; ranks second on the Twins pitching staff, behind Griffin Jax (40.4) who ranks second in all of baseball.

**UNDER PRESSURE:** This season, with runners in scoring position vs. Ober, opponents are hitting .235 (12-for-51) with three home runs, three walks and 16 strikeouts; with runners in scoring position *and* two outs, opponents are hitting .120 (3-for-25) with one home run, two walks and eight strikeouts.
