THE TWINS: Have gone 2-3 through five games on their six-game homestand, going 1-2 vs. the Blue Jays over the weekend, followed by a split of the first two games against the Rangers... today, Minnesota will complete the homestand with the three-game series finale against Texas... after today's game, they will travel to Houston to begin a six-game, seven-day roadtrip with three games against the Astros this weekend, an off-day in Cincinnati on Monday, then a three-game series against the Reds from Tuesday-Thursday.
✦ Twins are 29-16 in their last 45 games since April 22, second most wins in baseball since that date, and trailing only Detroit (30-16).

BUCK BLASTS ARE BIGGER VS. TEXAS: The Twins beat the Rangers last night by a score of 6-2... David Festa was the starter and winner, allowing two runs on three hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with two walks and four strikeouts... the offense recorded 10 hits and were led by Byron Buxton, who went 3-for-3 with a walk and a three-run jimmy jack in the third inning... Willi Castro went 2-for-3 with a walk and two RBI and Brooks Lee went 2-for-4.
✦ Twins have gone 18-6 in their last 24 home games, since April 15... they are 14-5 in their last 19 home games, since April 25.

TWINS TRADE ALCALA: The Twins have acquired minor league infielder Andy Lugo from the Red Sox in exchange for right-handed pitcher Jorge Alcala... Lugo, 21, has played in 44 games for High-A Greenville this season, hitting .265 (40-for-151) with 11 doubles, one triple, four home runs, 20 RBI, 16 runs scored, 14 walks, four stolen bases and a .757 OPS... the San Cristóbal, DR native was signed by the Red Sox in July of 2021 and has played in 208 games across parts of three seasons in Boston's minor league system.
✦ Alcala, 29, appeared in 22 games for the Twins this season, going 0-2, 8.88 ERA (24.1 IP, 24 ER), five home runs, 15 walks, 28 strikeouts and a .302 opponent batting average... he spent his entire major league career with Minnesota (since 2019) and has gone 9-13, 4.32 ERA (187.2 IP, 90 ER), one save, 29 holds, 69 walks and 193 strikeouts in 166 games.
✦ To replace Alcala on the 26-man roster, the Twins have activated left-handed pitcher Joey Wentz, who was claimed off waivers yesterday afternoon from the Pirates.

LONE STAR STATS: The Twins have gone 6-3 against the Rangers since the start of last season... the Twins are 11-5 against the Rangers since the start of 2023, that includes a home record of 6-3.
✦ The next series between these two will be a three-game series at Globe Life Field from September 23-25, the penultimate series of the 2025 season and part of the final roadtrip for Minnesota.
✦ Since the start of 2021, 23 of 30 games between these two have been decided by three runs-or-fewer, while 14 games have been decided by one run.

SUMMER WARM-UP: Twins offense has scored 5.4 runs-per-game in 10 games this month... they scored 3.9 runs-per-game in 31 March/April games and 4.3 runs-per-game in 26 May games... below are the offensive monthly totals:

FOUR POINT BUCK: Byron Buxton has a team-leading 11 home runs this season... last night's home run was the 144th of his career, passing Joe Mauer and moving into sole possession of 13th on the Twins all-time list (since 1961); next is Max Kepler with 161... it was measured at 479 feet, marking the fifth-longest in Target Field's history (below)... also the second-longest in baseball this season, trailing Mike Trout's 484-foot shot on April 19.

ADDITIONALLY: Buck's homer last night was the 10th hit into the centerfield Delta Sky360° suite (all by Twins), joining ByungHo Park (2016), Miguel Sanó (2017), Jake Cave (2018), Tyler Austin (2018), Nelson Cruz (2019), Josh Donaldson (2020), Trevor Larnach (2021), Jorge Polanco (2022) and Max Kepler (2023).

SERIES STUFF: Twins are looking to win their 12th series of the season today... Minnesota is 11-9-1 in series play, going 6-3-1 at home and 5-6-0 on the road... they began the season 1-4-0 in series play but have gone 10-5-1 in their last 16.
✦ Twins have gone 4-0-0 in series play vs. Texas dating back to August of 2022.

LEFT TURNS: Today marks the 10th time the Twins have faced a left-handed starter this season... Minnesota is 5-4 against lefty starters, their four losses against Martín Pérez (3/31 at CWS), Cole Ragans (4/8 at KC), Chris Sale (4/19 at ATL) and Kris Bubic (5/25 vs. KC)... their five wins coming against Yusei Kikuchi (4/26 vs. LAA), Garrett Crochet (May 4 at BOS), Cade Povich (5/6 vs. BAL), Logan Allen (5/19 vs. CLE) and Noah Cameron (5/23 vs. KC).
✦ In their last 36 games, Twins are slashing .261/.342/.403 (.746 OPS) against lefties... prior to that stretch, they were .157/.222/.289 (.511 OPS) in their first 20 vs. lefties.
✦ Notable individuals in that 36-game stretch (since April 19) vs. LHP: Willi Castro is hitting .367 (11-for-30)... Byron Buxton is hitting .435 (10-for-23)... Ryan Jeffers is hitting .294 (10-for-34)... Carlos Correa is hitting .323 (10-for-31)... Jonah Bride is hitting .296 (8-for-27).
✦ In 2025, Correa is hitting .316 (12-for-38) with three doubles, four home runs, a .711 slugging percentage and a 1.061 OPS vs. lefties.

TY ONE ON: Ty France has reached base safely in a career-high 22-straight games... it marks the longest for a Twin this season and longest since Edouard Julien reached in 23-straight from September 6, 2023-March 30, 2024... the last in a *single season* was Byron Buxton with 24, from April 25-May 24, 2023... France's streak is the fourth-longest active streak in baseball.
✦ During the streak, France is hitting .325 (27-for-83) with three doubles, one home run, 15 RBI, seven HBP and a .391 on-base percentage.

DON'T STOP BE-LEE-VIN': Brooks Lee has hit safely in 11-straight games with an at-bat, extending his career-high... the streak is the longest by a Twin this season and tied with Vinnie Pasquantino and José Ramírez for the longest active streak in baseball... Minnesota's last streak as long was by Kyle Farmer, who hit in 13-straight, from September 3-22, 2024.
✦ During the current streak, Lee is hitting .333 (15-for-45) with two doubles, one home run and six RBI.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2017, the Twins selected Royce Lewis with the first overall pick in the MLB Draft out of JSerra High School... in the following days, in the 12th round, the Twins drafted Bailey Ober out of College of Charleston.
