 ⚡ Allowed a home run in back-to-back outings for the first time in his career as a reliever from 7/3-4, both at SEA
 ⚡ Did not allow a hit in five straight appearances (9.0 IP) from 6/14-24

 ⚡ Recalled from Triple-A Norfolk prior to yesterday's game; was optioned on 7/24; marks his second stint with the O's this season (also recalled 6/11)
 ⚡ Tossed 1.0 perfect inning with a strikeout on 7/23 at MIA; has not allowed a baserunner in his last two appearances (2.2 IP)
 ⚡ Has thrown a season-high 2.0 innings twice (7/9 vs. CHC & 6/25 vs. CLE)
 ⚡ Suffered his first loss of the year after allowing three runs on one hit and two walks with two strikeouts on 7/4 at SEA; all three runs scored after he exited the game
 ⚡ Earned his first win of the season on 6/20 at NYY

 ⚡ Has not been charged with a run in seven games (6.0 IP) since 6/29; has surrendered three hits and two walks with seven strikeouts in that time
 ⚡ Leads the AL with 24 holds, his last coming on 7/14 vs. NYY
 ⚡ His 118 appearances since the start of 2023 are tied for fourth in MLB
 ⚡ Ranks in the 100th percentile in Groundball Rate (68.3), according to Statcast
 ⚡ Set the O's rookie record with 72 games last year; opened the year in Triple-A
 ⚡ Appeared in his first All-Star Game in 2023

 ⚡ Posted a 0.96 ERA (2 ER/18.2 IP) in 19 games from 5/15-7/12 but has allowed a 13.50 ERA (5 ER/3.1 IP) in his last three appearances since 7/14
 ⚡ Recorded his lone save of the year in the 11th inning on 6/14 at BAL
 ⚡ Ranks in the top-five percent of MLB with a 97.6 mph average fastball velocity, per Statcast

 ⚡ Allowed four runs on seven hits (1 HR) with one strikeout in 4.0 IP on 7/11 vs. CHC; is the second pitcher in club history to allow 4+ runs in three consecutive relief appearances (11.1 IP, 14 total R; since 5/22), joining Bob McCrory in 2009 (1.1 IP, 13 total R; 9/13-21)
 ⚡ Last pitched as a starter on 6/30 vs. TEX; suffered the loss after being charged with five runs on five hits (1 HR), two walks, and two hit batters with two strikeouts in 3.2 innings; left with two runners on, who were stranded
 ⚡ Posted a 0.65 ERA (2 ER/27.2 IP) with 16 hits (1 HR), three walks, and one hit batter with 17 strikeouts in five games (4 GS) from 4/21-5/19
 ⚡ Has a 6.92 ERA (30 ER/39.0 IP) with 57 hits (18-2B, 2-3B, 8 HR), 36 total runs, nine walks, and three hit batters with 25 strikeouts in nine games (6GS) since 6/1
 ⚡ Threw a career-high 22.2 scoreless innings from 4/21-5/10

 ⚡ Suffered his sixth blown save of the season on 7/25 at MIA; allowed three runs (1 ER) on two hits and two walks in 0.2 inning; has blown consecutive save opportunities for the second time this season, joining 4/28 and 4/28 vs. OAK; has allowed nine base runners in his last three appearances (2.2 IP) after allowing 14 base runners in his previous 22 outings (21.0 IP)
 ⚡ Suffered a blown save but earned his sixth win on 7/14 vs. NYY; walked the first two batters before allowing a go-ahead three-run home run to Ben Rice; marked his third homer surrendered this year, joining 5/8 at WSH and 4/28 vs. OAK, and only the second extra-base hit allowed since 5/10 (2B, 6/19 at NYY); posted a 0.43 ERA (1 ER/21.0 IP) while holding opponents to .088/.184/.103 (6-for-68) slash line with five walks, three hit batters, and 31 strikeouts in 22 games from 5/10-7/7 before the appearance
 ⚡ Secured his 23rd save of the year with a scoreless inning on 7/7 at OAK; has not earned 24 saves in a season since 2021 (w/CHC & CWS) and has not recorded more than 24 since registering 42 in 2018 (w/BOS)
 ⚡ Has at least six wins for the third straight year after not earning more than five victories in his first 12 MLB seasons
 ⚡ His 440 career saves are the most among active pitchers and fourth all-time
 ⚡ His 1,247 career strikeouts are third-most all-time by a reliever
 ⚡ Now has 12 seasons of 20+ saves, tied for fourth-most all-time
 ⚡ Became the ninth pitcher in MLB history to reach 10+ career Postseason saves and the third member of the 400-save club with 10+ Postseason saves in 2023

 ⚡ Recorded his second save of the season on 7/25 at MIA, tossing a perfect 10th inning with two strikeouts; threw a wild pitch with the automatic runner on second base and two outs
 ⚡ Leads the O's with 165 appearances since the start of 2022, 40 more than the next closest player (125, Baker)
 ⚡ Has not allowed a home run in 75 games, the longest active streak in MLB; it is the fourth-longest homerless streak by an Orioles pitcher in team history and six behind B.J. Ryan (2003-04) for third; it's the longest such streak since Zack Britton did so in a club-record 88 consecutive games (4/15/16-8/10/17); his 63.2-inning homerless streak is also the longest active streak in MLB and the longest by an Oriole since Britton did so in that same stretch (85.1 IP)
 ⚡ Reinstated from the 15-day Injured List on 4/29; was placed on the IL with a right oblique strain on 3/31
 ⚡ Started a rehab assignment with Triple-A Norfolk on 4/24; appeared in two games with the Tides during his rehab; threw 1.1 scoreless innings on 4/27
 ⚡ Failed to record an out on 3/30 vs. LAA before leaving the game with lower back discomfort; allowed two runs on two hits, one of which scored after exiting

 ⚡ Threw 1.2 innings on one hit with a season-high-tying three strikeouts on 7/23 at MIA; surrendered a leadoff single to Josh Bell in the fifth inning, the first baserunner he's allowed since joining the O's
 ⚡ Has thrown four consecutive scoreless outings (4.1 IP) with the Orioles; made his O's debut on 7/12 vs. NYY
 ⚡ Had his contract selected from Triple-A Norfolk on 7/11, marking his second stint in the majors this season; spent the first part of the season with MIA before being designated for assignment on 6/14 and released on 6/20; traded from TB on 3/27; signed a minor league contract with the Orioles on 6/27
 ⚡ Went 2-0 with a 4.25 ERA (14 ER/29.2 IP), allowing 39 hits (1 HR) and nine walks with 23 strikeouts in 25 appearances with MIA this season
 ⚡ Did not surrender a run in his two appearances for the Tides (2.0 IP), allowing one hit with two strikeouts

 ⚡ Pitched 0.2 inning, surrendering one hit with two strikeouts on 7/25 at MIA; allowed an inherited runner to score on an RBI double by Josh Bell
 ⚡ Holding opposing left-handers to a .113/.236/.129 (7-for-62) slash line; the SLG is tied with CLE's Emmanuel Clase for the best in MLB and the OPS (.365) is the third best by a righty against LHH this season (min. 15 G); the lone extra-base hit was a double to Luis García Jr. in the 12th inning on 5/8 at WSH
 ⚡ Allowed a solo homer to Adolis García on 6/29 vs. TEX, his second allowed this season, joining 4/24 at LAA (27 G, 25.0 IP)
 ⚡ His 49 appearances are tied for third in the AL
 ⚡ Leads MLB with 74 appearances since being activated on 8/9/23 after being claimed off waivers from the Angels
 ⚡ Five of his 17 runs allowed this season have been in extra innings
 ⚡ Had a nine-game (11.0 IP) scoreless streak from 5/23-6/13; the stretch was snapped on 6/14 after two runners scored in the 11th inning
 ⚡ Surrendered a career-high four runs without recording an out on 6/21 at HOU; has a 1.83 ERA (9 ER/44.1 IP) in his other 47 appearances
 ⚡ Earned his first win with Baltimore on 6/1 vs. TB; threw a career-high-tying 2.1 innings, his most as an Oriole; entered with the bases loaded and two outs and stranded all three inherited runners
 ⚡ Recorded his first save of the season and the fifth of his career on 4/30 vs. NYY; also earned a save in the 12th inning on 5/8 at WSH
