YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles defeated the Marlins, 7-6, in 10 innings to snap a three-game skid and avoid the series sweep...The 0's scored their 500<sup>th</sup> run of the season yesterday in their 102<sup>nd</sup> game of the season; the last time Baltimore scored 500 runs in fewer games played in a season was in 2004 (99 games)...**Corbin Burnes** spun a season-high 7.1 innings after allowing season was in 2004 (99 games)...**Corbin Burnes** spun a season-nigh 7.1 innings after allowing three runs on six hits (1 HR) and one walk with five strikeouts...**Ryan Mountcastle** connected on a go-ahead, game-winning RBI single in the 10th inning...**Anthony Santander** rocketed his 28th home run of the season in the first inning, tying Gunnar Henderson for the team lead...**Colton Cowser** blasted a three-run shot in the third inning, tallying three-or-more RBI in consecutive games for the first time in his career and the fourth time an Oriole has done so this season... **Connor Norby** homered for the second time this season in his first game since being recalled from Triple-A Norfolk vestorday. from Triple-A Norfolk yesterday.

**WHAT'S TRENDING:** The Orioles have lost eight of their last 12 since July 9...At 61-41 (.598), the Birds are tied for the second-best record in MLB with the Guardians (.598, 61-41) and behind only the Phillies (.627, 64-38)...Since the start of 2023, Baltimore is 162-102 (.614), the best winning percentage and tied for the most wins in the majors with the Dodgers during that time...The O's are 245-181 (.575) since the start of 2022, the second-best record in the AL and fourth-best in MLB behind the Astros (.585, 249-177), Braves (.609, 259-166), and Dodgers (.638, 273-155).

**HOMER HAPPY:** The Orioles lead MLB with 160 home runs, 11 more than the second-place Yankees (149) and 19 more than the Dodgers (141), who rank third...The Birds homered in 22 consecutive games from June 1-23, setting a franchise record.

- 8 Baltimore has an MLB-best eight players with at least 10 home runs, the most in MLB: Gunnar Henderson and Anthony Santander (28), Adley Rutschman (17), Jordan Westburg (16), Colton Cowser (14), Ryan Mountcastle and Ryan O'Hearn (12), and Cedric Mullins (10); the Birds had eight players hit 10+ homers before the 100-game mark for the third time in team history, joining the 2000 and 1987 seasons.
- Henderson and Santander are one of two duos with at least 25 home runs, along with New York-AL's Aaron Judge (35) and Juan Soto (26); this marks the third time an 0's team has had multiple players with 25+ homers through the first 100 games of a season, joining **Brady Anderson** (31) and **Rafael Palmeiro** (25) in 1996, and **Boog Powell** (27) and **Frank Robinson** (25) in 1969.
- The Orioles lead MLB with nine leadoff homers this year; **Gunnar Henderson** has eight of those, tied with Philadelphia's Kyle Schwarber for the most in MLB and tied for the second-most in a single season in Orioles history with **Cedric Mullins** (2021), trailing only Brady Anderson (12, 1996)
- The O's hit 60 home runs in June, the most homers in a month in franchise history; they are the third team with at least 60 in a month in MLB history, joining the 2023 Braves, who hit 61 in June, and the 2019 Yankees, who hit 74 in August; Baltimore has hit 21 in July, tied for  $16^{th}$  in MLB this month, with six coming from **Anthony Santander**.

TOP GUNN: Gunnar Henderson ranks third in MLB with 81 runs scored behind Kansas City's Bobby Witt Jr. and New York-AL's Juan Soto (83)...It's tied for the most runs scored through the first 100 Witt Jr. and New York-AL's Juan Soto (83)...It's tied for the most runs scored through the first 100 team games to begin a season in Orioles history with **Frank Robinson** (1969)...He scored three runs on July 19 at Texas for the eighth time this year, two more than the next closest player... Henderson's 15 such games since the start of 2023 are five more than any other player in that time...He's on pace to score 129 times...Only one player in team history has scored 130 runs in a season: **Roberto Alomar**, who set the team record with 132 runs in 1996.

①s Three players in team history have led the AL in runs scored: **Frank Robinson** in 1966 (122), **Cal Ripken, Jr.** in 1983 (121), and **Don Buford** in 1971(99).

MASHED TATERS: Anthony Santander is slashing .280/.325/.632 (51-for-182) with five doubles, one triple, 19 home runs, 28 runs scored, 38 RBI, 12 walks, one hit-by-pitch, and one stolen base in

46 games since the beginning of June...His 19 homers lead the majors during that span.

(b) He's hit safely in 11 straight games since July 10 while batting .333/.375/.733 (15-for-45) during that time; this marks his fifth career hitting streak of at least 10 games and his

longest since a career-long 16-gamer from July 16 to August 6, 2022. Santander is the ninth player in 0's history to hit 25+ homers in at least three straight seasons, matching **Frank Robinson** (1969-71), **Lee May** (1976-78), and **Manny Machado** (2015-17), and trailing **Eddie Murray** (1982-85) and **Rafael Palmeiro** (1995-98), who did so in four consecutive years, **Chris Davis** (2012-17) and **Cal Ripken, Jr.** (1982-87), who had

six, and **Adam Jones** (2011-17), who hit 25 or more homers in seven straight years. He has 15 multi-homer games, eighth-most in franchise history behind **Frank Robinson** (16), **Brady Anderson** (17), **Chris Davis** and **Manny Machado** (19), **Eddie Murray** and **Boog** 

**Powell** (20), and **Cal Ripken, Jr.** (21). Drove in his 400<sup>th</sup> career run on Thursday in his 688<sup>th</sup> game, becoming the fifth switch hitter in franchise history to record 400 or more RBI; the only hitter to do so in fewer games with the Orioles is Eddie Murray (643).

FEELS GOOD TO BE HOME: The Orioles open a seven-game homestand tonight with the opener against the Padres...The Birds welcome the Blue Jays for a four-game slate next week through Wedneday, including a doubleheader Monday...Baltimore is coming off their first losing homestand (1-5) since September 11-17, 2023 (3-4)...Since the start of 2023, the Birds have gone 79-54 (.594) at Oriole Park, tied for the best home record in the AL and the fifth-best home record in MLB behind the Brewers (.614, 78-49), Braves (.621, 82-50), Phillies (.642, 86-48), and Dodgers (.644, 87-48).

**AGAINST THE FRIARS:** The Orioles and Padres are meeting for their first series in Baltimore since 2019...The 0's lost two of three games in San Diego last season from August 14-16...In the last series at Camden Yards, the Friars swept a two-game set from June 25-26...The Birds have dropped six of the last seven games between the teams at Oriole Park after winning the first two games between the clubs in 2002.

Baltimore is 13-16 (.448) against the NL this season; of the nine series losses in 2024, five have come against NL opponents; the Orioles are an MLB-best 48-25 (.658) against

MONTHLY DUES: The 0's have nine consecutive winning months (min. 10 games played) since the start of 2023, the longest streak by the 0's since May 1982 through September 1983 (11), per the Elias Sports Bureau...At 8-10 this month, the Birds will need to go 5-2 in their final seven games in July to extend the streak...The current stretch is the longest active streak in the majors.

ROSTER MOVES: The Orioles acquired right-handed pitcher Seranthony Domínguez and outfielder Cristian Pache from the Philadelphia Phillies in exchange for outfielder Austin Hays today... To make room on the 40-man roster, right-handed pitcher Levi Stoudt was designated for assignment...The O's also acquired right-handed pitcher Zach Eflin and cash considerations from the Tampa Bay Rays in exchange for minor league right-hander **Jackson Baumeister**, minor league infielder/outfielder **Mac Horvath**, and minor league outfielder **Matthew Etzel**...To make room on the 40-man and active rosters, right-handed pitcher Vinny Nittoli was designated for assignment...Domínguez and Pache have both reported while Eflin has yet to report.

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his 19<sup>th</sup> start of the season tonight against the Padres...Is the first Oriole to win at least 12 of their first 18 outings to begin a season since Sidney Ponson in 2003 (also 12); the last Oriole to win 13 of his first 19 appearances was Ponson in the same year...Reinstated from the 15-day Injured List prior to the game on May 18 vs. Seattle (right shoulder inflammation); placed on the IL on May 1, retroactive to April 30...His 12 wins are one behind the MLB lead, which is held by Atlanta's Chris Sale...With 76 total runs of support this season, his 6.47 RSA/9 ranks first in MLB...His 249 strikeouts are the most in an 0's pitcher first 41 games with the team in club history...Posted a 7-4 record and 4.35 ERA(59 ER/122.0 IP) across 23 starts in his rookie campaign last year... Began last season with Triple-A Norfolk before being promoted and making his MLB debut on April 5 at Texas...Optioned to Norfolk on May 27...Recalled on July 17 for the remainder of the season...Originally selected by the Orioles in the first round (No. 11 overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Secured his 12<sup>th</sup> win of the year on July 20 at Texas after allowing two runs on three hits and two walks with eight strikeouts in 6.0 innings...His 12 wins on the year are tied with Kansas City's Seth Lugo for first in the AL and tied for second in MLB...Marked his team-leading sixth game with 8+ strikeouts... Threw 103 pitches, 70 strikes; marked his fourth 100-pitch game of the year and second in his last four starts.

AGAINST THE PADRES: Slated to make his second career start against San Diego...Earned the win in his sole outing against the Padres on August 14, 2023 at Petco Park; allowed one run on three hits (1 HR) and one walk in 7.0 innings.

**AGAINST THE NL WEST:** Making his third career start against the NL West and first of the season...0wns a 1-0 record with a 3.75 ERA (5 ER/12.0 IP) across his two prior starts against the division...NL West opponents are slashing .233/.283/.349 (10-for-43) off him in his career.

CITY CONNECT KID: Rodriguez is set to make his first City Connect start of the 2024 season...He went 0-1 with 7.45 ERA (8 ER/9.2 IP) in his two City Connect outings last season...Did not factor in the decision of his last Friday start at home on July 28, 2023 vs. New York-AL after tossing 6.1 scoreless innings, allowing three hits and two walks with four strikeouts.

**REVERSE SPLITS:** Lefty hitters are slashing .202/.272/.318 (40-for-198) off him this season while righties are hitting .272/.332/.471(56-for-206).

**GAME OF ADJUSTMENTS:** In Rodriguez's 10 starts in his initial stint with the club in 2023, he notched a 7.35 ERA (37 ER/45.1 IP)...After being optioned to Norfolk, he returned to Baltimore on July 17 and has gone 16-6 with a 3.32 ERA (65 ER/176.1 IP) across 30 starts since...Has posted 17 quality starts in his last 289outings, dating back to July 28, 2023...Did not register a quality start in his first 12 outings to begin his career.

**GAS 'EM UP:** Punched out 129 batters for the 0's last season, the most for an Orioles rookie since 2012 (Wei-Yin Chen, 154)...His mark ranks sixth among rookies in team history (since 1954)...He became the 20<sup>th</sup> rookie pitcher in Orioles history to strike out at least 100 batters.

**2023 HIGHLIGHTS:** Rodriguez opened last season with the Norfolk Tides, earning the nod as their Opening Day starter...Recalled by the Orioles on April 5, making his MLB debut in a start at Texas...Marked the first of six Orioles to make their big-league debut last year...Earned his first career win on April 29 (G2) at Detroit, throwing 5.0 shutout innings and striking out nine...Tossed a careerhigh 8.0 scoreless innings on September 16 vs. Tampa Bay, tied for the longest outing by an Oriole in 2023; at 23 years old, 304 days old, became the youngest O's starter to work 8.0 scoreless frames since Zack Britton (23-141) tossed a shutout on May 12, 2011 vs. Seattle, and the youngest rookie right-hander to do since Brad Bergesen (23-257) worked 8.0 scoreless on June 9, 2009 vs. Seattle.

**POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE:** Made his Postseason debut last season, taking the loss in Game 2 of the ALDS against the Rangers on October 8...Allowed five runs on six hits and four walks across 1.2 innings...Marked the most runs that Rodriguez had surrendered since May 26 when he allowed eight, also against the Rangers.
