SNAKEBITES

1 MORE GAME THEN 84 DAYS UNTIL WINTER.... Bill Veeck said “There are only two seasons – winter and baseball.”

AND 179 DAYS UNTIL NEXT YEAR’S BASEBALL SEASON: After today’s game, the D-backs have 179 days until 2026 Opening Day on March 26 @ Dodgers.

SNAKE BITES: Brandon Pfaadt, who is making his career-best 33rd start (32 GS in 2024), has 2 starts vs. Padres this season and is 2-0 with a 2.63 ERA (4 ER in 13.2 IP), an opponent .180 AVG (9-for-50)/.546 OPS, 3 walks and 8 strikeouts.

- Geraldo Perdomo has set a career high with his 16-game on-base streak, passing his 15-gamers from this season: April 3-19 and July 29-Aug. 14, hitting .373 (22-for-59)/1.154 OPS with 6 doubles, 1 triple, 3 homers, 8 RBI, 11 walks (9 K) and 3 hit by pitches.
- Gabriel Moreno has reached base safely in 15 of his last 16 games, batting .333 (20-for-60)/.897 OPS, including 6 straight road games (.458, 11-for-24, 1.244 OPS).

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 5-1 @ Padres.

- Eduardo Rodriguez worked 6.0 innings (5 R, 6 H, 1 BB, 6 K) for the fifth time in his final 6 starts.
- Geraldo Perdomo hit his 20th home run, a solo blast in the fifth inning to reach the 20-homer mark for the first time.
- Gabriel Moreno had 2 singles and 1 walk.
- Andrew Hoffman and Taylor Rashi each tossed 1.0 scoreless inning.

THE RESURGENCE: Since August 1, the D-backs’ 29-23 (.558) record is tied for third in the NL and ninth in the Majors.

- The D-backs’ 17-12 mark in August was fourth in the Majors to the Brewers (21-9), Phillies (18-11) and Red Sox (17-11).

STIFF COMPETITION: The D-backs’ last 28 games (16-12), since Aug. 27, included all 3 NL division winners (@ Brewers, @ Dodgers, vs. Phillies, vs. Dodgers), 2 Wild Card qualifiers (vs. Red Sox, @ Padres) and 2 teams in the Wild Card Race at the time (vs. Rangers, @ Giants, vs. Giants).

NL WILD CARD RACE: The D-backs trailed by 10.0 games in the NL Wild Card race on August 1 but were one of baseball’s best teams the last 2 months, playing nearly .600 baseball, to pull into a tie for fourth place and 1.0 game behind entering Thursday’s game...overall, went 29-22 in 51 games from Aug. 1-Sept. 25 to enter Friday’s game fifth in the race and 2.0 games behind before being eliminated from postseason consideration.

VETERAN LEADERSHIP: James McCann has hit safely in 7 of his last 9 games (.313 AVG, 10-for-32, .896 OPS, 2 2B, 2 HR, 8 RBI, 1 HBP).

- Ildemaro Vargas has hit safely in 9 of his last 10 road games (.333 AVG, 11-for-33, .777 OPS, 1 HR, 7 RBI, 1 BB).

YOUNG BUCKS: Adrian Del Castillo has reached base safely in 7 of his last 10 games, batting .278 (5-for-18)/1.058 OPS with 1 double, 2 homers, 5 RBI and 4 walks.

- Jake McCarthy has hit safely in 6 of his last 7 road games at a .333 clip (7-for-21)/1.078 OPS with 1 double, 2 triples, 1 homer and 5 RBI.
- Brandyn Garcia has held opponents scoreless in 6 of his last 7 games, allowing 1 unearned run in 6.2 frames (6 H, 0 BB, 9 K).
- Taylor Rashi has held opponents scoreless in 4 of his last 5 games (2 ER in 7.2 IP, 6 H, 4 BB, 12 K).

1-2-3-WHEEEEEEE: Over the last 11 games, since Sept. 15, Geraldo Perdomo, Ketel Marte and Corbin Carroll are hitting a combined .331 (43-for-130)/.979 OPS with 14 doubles, 2 triples, 4 homers, 18 RBI, 17 walks (24 K), 3 hit by pitches and 5 stolen bases.

H/T TO THE BULLPEN: Andrew Saalfrank has held opponents scoreless in 13 of his last 14 games for a 0.63 ERA (1 ER in 14.1 IP) with an opponent .152 AVG (7-for-46)/.444 OPS, 5 walks and 10 strikeouts.

- Ryan Thompson has held opponents scoreless in 10 of his last 12 road games, allowing 2 runs (1 earned) in 9.1 innings with 10 hits, 1 walk and 9 strikeouts.
- Jalen Beeks has held opponents scoreless in 10 of his last 11 relief appearances, allowing 1 run in 7.2 innings with 3 hits, 2 walks and 4 strikeouts (does not include 2 openers).
 - Has held opponents scoreless in 24 of 28 road games, for a 1.01 ERA (4 R-3 ER in 26.2 IP), an opponent .160 AVG (15-for-94)/.450 OPS, 6 walks and 23 strikeouts.
 - Ranks among D-backs relievers on the road all-time (min. 25 G, min. 20 GR, max 5 GS) with the lowest ERA (1.01) ahead of Andrew Chafin (2018, 38 G, 1.52 ERA) and Yoshi Hirano (2018, 37 G, 1.83 ERA) and lowest opponent OPS (.450) ahead of Fernando Rodney (2017, 30 G, .496) and Yoshi Hirano (2018, 37, .553) while ranking second with an opponent .160 AVG to Fernando Rodney (2017, 30 G, .135) and ahead of Kevin Glnkel (2023, 28 G, .187).

START ME UP: The D-backs starting rotation is among the best in the Majors since Aug. 27 ranking second with 17 quality starts, tied for fourth with 12 starter wins, fifth with a 3.24 ERA and 158.1 innings, and seventh with 62 runs allowed and an opponent .671 OPS.

ROUNDTRIPPERS: The D-backs’ 213 homers are fourth most in a season in team history behind 2017 (220), 2019 (220) and 1999 (216) and ahead of 2024 (211) and 2001 (208).

- The D-backs have 4 seasons of 200+ homers since 2017 (2017, ‘19, ‘24, ‘25) after having 2 such seasons from 1998-2016 (1999, 2001).
- The D-backs are 1 of 4 teams with 200+ homers in each of the last 2 seasons (424 HR: 211 in 2024, 213 in 2025) with the Yankees (509 HR: 237 in 2024, 272 in 2025), Dodgers (474 HR: 233 in 2024, 241 in 2025), and Mets (431 HR: 207 in 2024, 224 in 2025).

- 1 OF 1: Corbin Carroll (.884 OPS, 107 R, 146 H, 32 2B, 17 3B, 31 HR, 84 RBI, 67 BB, 32 SB) is the only player in Major League history with a season with an .850+ OPS, 100+ runs scored, 140+ hits, 30+ doubles, 15+ triples, 30+ home runs, 80+ RBI, 60+ walks and 30+ stolen bases.
- Lowering the qualifiers to 10+ triples, Carroll is 1 of 2 players all-time to reach those marks with Ken Williams/St. Louis Browns (1922).

- 1 OF 3: Geraldo Perdomo (172 H, 94 BB, 98 R, 99 RBI) is the third D-back (7 times) with at least 160 hits, 90 walks, 90 runs and 90 RBI in a season with Luis Gonzalez (2001, ‘03) and Paul Goldschmidt (2013, ‘15, ‘16, ‘17).
- Since Perdomo’s first full season in 2022, is 1 of 7 players in the Majors (10 times) to reach a minimum 160 hits, 90 walks, 90 runs and 90 RBI with Mookie Betts (2023), Alex Bregman (2023), Aaron Judge (2022, ‘24, ‘25), Shohei Ohtani (2025), Matt Olson (2023, ‘25) and Juan Soto (2024).

YEAR OF THE SNAKE: Geraldo Perdomo’s 6.9 bWAR (Baseball-Reference.com) leads NL position players and is fourth in the Majors to Aaron Judge/NYY (9.5), Cal Raleigh/SEA (7.2) and Bobby Witt Jr./KC (7.0) and ahead of Julio Rodríguez/SEA (6.8) and Shohei Ohtani/LAD (6.4).

- Perdomo’s 6.9 bWAR is the fourth-best by a D-backs position player in a season all-time behind Paul Goldschmidt (8.3 in 2015), Luis Gonzalez (7.9 in 2001) and Ketel Marte (6.9 in 2019).
- Perdomo’s 7.1 fWAR (FanGraphs.com) is second in the NL to Shohei Ohtani/LAD (7.2) and ahead of Trea Turner/PHI (6.7) and Corbin Carroll/AZ (6.5).

SNAKEBITES

AT A GLANCE: Third season with the D-backs...debuted in May 2023 and made 5 starts in the Postseason (1 Wild Card, 1 NLDS, 2 NLCS, 1 World Series).

- Named the D-backs' 2022 Minor League Pitcher of the Year after leading the organization's farmhands in wins (11), ERA (3.83) and strikeouts (218).
- D-backs' fifth-round pick in the 2020 draft (Bellarmine University).

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW: His career-high 13 wins are tied for seventh among NL starters with Zac Gallen/AZ, Adrian Morejon/SD, Nick Pivetta/SD, Quinn Priester/MIL and Cristopher Sánchez/PHI, behind Freddy Peralta/MIL (17), Jesús Luzardo/PHI (15), Matthew Boyd/CHC (14), Sonny Gray/STL (14), Brady Singer/CIN (14) and Logan Webb/SF (14).

- Making his career-high 33rd start, passing his 32 starts in 2024.
- His 3.16 ERA (4 GS; 9 ER in 25.2 IP) in September is currently a career third-best in any month, behind his 2.31 ERA in July 2024 (4 GS) and 2.78 ERA in April/March in 2025 (6 GS).
- In his last 6 starts (4 quality), is 3-0 with a 2.56 ERA (11 ER in 38.2 IP), opponent .221 AVG (32-for-145), 7 walks and 29 strikeouts.
- 10 of his 13 wins have come when the D-backs scored 6+ runs.
- Tossed a career-high 9.0 innings on Sept. 17 vs. Giants

LAST START: Had his second straight quality start on Sept. 23 vs. Dodgers, allowing 3 runs on 4 hits and 2 walks with 4 strikeouts over 6.0 innings...the D-backs won 5-4 vs. Dodgers, coming back from a 5-0 deficit with a 3-run seventh inning then winning it on Geraldo Perdomo’s walk-off single with 2 outs in the ninth inning.

VS. PADRES: Making his ninth career start, fifth @ Petco Park.

- Has won his last 3 starts, going 3-0 with a 2.37 ERA (6 R-5 ER in 19.0 IP), opponent .174 AVG (12-for-69), 0.84 WHIP, 4 walks and 17 strikeouts.
- Tossed 8.0 innings his last road start on July 9 @ Petco Park with 2 earned runs allowed on 4 hits with no walks and 4 strikeouts.
- In 4 career starts @ Petco Park, is 1-1 with a 2.92 ERA (8 ER in 24.2 IP), 4 walks and 20 strikeouts.
- In 8 career starts vs. Padres, is 3-2 (team is 5-3) with a 3.23 ERA (20 R-17 ER in 47.1 IP), 10 walks and 45 strikeouts.

VS. NL WEST: Has 2 quality starts in his last 5 on the road, going 2-2 with a 5.22 ERA (17 ER in 29.1 IP), 5 walks and 20 strikeouts.

- Has 3 straight no-decisions (0-0, 3.26 ERA).
- Over 12 starts this season, is 5-4 with a 4.16 ERA (33 ER in 71.1 IP), 19 walks and 54 strikeouts.

30+ STARTS: Is the 12th D-backs starting pitcher all-time with 2+ consecutive 30+-start seasons.

- Brandon Webb holds the franchise record with 5 straight seasons (2004-08) followed by Randy Johnson’s 4 straight (1999-2002), Ian Kennedy’s 3 straight (2010-12) then 2 straight seasons by Brandon Pfaadt (2024-25), Merrill Kelly (2022-23), Zac Gallen (2022-23), Zack Greinke (2017-18), Patrick Corbin (2017-18), Wade Miley (2013-14), Dan Haren (2008-09), Curt Schilling (2001-02) and Andy Benes (1998-99).

ON THE ROAD: Owns a 2.03 walk rate...has walked 1 or fewer batters in 11 of his 15 starts, including 3 starts with 0 walks.

- Has tossed 5.0+ innings in 8 of his 13 starts, including a career-high 8.0 innings on July 9 @ Padres.

NO WALK PFAADT: Among NL starting pitchers (min. 25 GS), his 37 walks are tied for third lowest with Miles Mikolas/STL, behind Shota Imanaga/CHC (26) and Nick Lodolo/CIN (29).

- His 1.93 walks per 9.0 innings ratio is tied for fifth-lowest in the Majors with Jacob deGrom/TEX, behind Tarik Skubal/DET (1.52), Zack Littell/CIN (1.54), Bryan Woo/SEA (1.74) and Sonny Gray/STL (1.89).
- Since the start of the 2024 season, his 17 starts with no walks are tied for third in the NL with Ryne Nelson/AZ, behind Miles Mikolas/STL (22) and Shota Imanaga/CHC (18).
- Has held opponents to 1 or fewer walks in 22 of his 32 starts.

BY INNING: In 9 of his last 10 starts, in innings 5-6, has limited opponents to 1 or fewer runs, including 5 starts with 0 runs allowed.

- In innings 1-2 in his last 11 road starts, since May 17, has held opponents to 7 runs in 22.0 innings (20 H – 1 HR, 2 BB, 18 K).

WINNING WAYS: Secured his 10th victory in 7-3 win vs. Cardinals on July 18 to become the second-youngest D-back starter (26-165), behind Patrick Corbin (23-261, 8 wins in 2013), and sixth overall to collect 7+ wins in their first 10 starts of a season.

APRIL WAS NO JOKE: Had a career-high 5-game win streak from April 4-April 27.
