RECENT REDBIRDS: The defending 2019 NL Central Champion Cardinals and division-rival Cincinnati Reds play the finale of a three-game series at Great American Ball Park tonight ... After an off day tomorrow (first since Aug. 14), St. Louis continues its eight-game rivalry road trip Friday with another five-game series against the Chicago Cubs at Wrigley Field ... the Cardinals rank 5th in the NL in run differential (+20) and began the day in 2nd place in the NL Central, 3.0 games back of the 1st place Cubs.

REDBIRD RUNDOWN: After a 16-day layoff from July 30-August 14, (longest mid-season shutdown for a team in MLB history), tonight marks the Cardinals' 23rd game over 19 consecutive days since August 15 without an off day ... St. Louis is in the midst of playing 53 games over the final 44 days of the season, which includes 11 doubleheaders (55 games in 45 days, if necessary).

REDBIRD-ZILLA: A win tonight would give St. Louis its first sweep of the season, its first sweep of the Reds since April 20-22, 2018 at Great American Ball Park, and clinch the season series over Cincinnati for the ninth consecutive season (2012-present).

IT MUST BE THE SKYLINE CHILI: Since August 5, 2017, the Cardinals are 19-6 (.760) in their last 25 games at Great American Ball Park ... St. Louis' season-high 23 hits last night set the Great American Ball Park stadium record by any team, and were the most by the Cardinals since 28 on August 22, 2008 vs. Atlanta ... The last time the Cardinals scored 16 runs vs. the Reds was July 27, 1970 at Riverfront Stadium when the Cardinals won 16-9 behind **Dick Allen's** two homers and **Mike Shannon's** four RBI.

TAKE CARE OF BUSINESS: Twenty-four of the final 31 Cardinals games this season are against the NL Central Division, including this current eight-game rivalry road trip ... St. Louis is 9-7 vs. the NL Central this season after going a MLB-best 46-30 (.605) in 2019 ... Ten of the final 18 games are against Milwaukee.

IT'S MILLER TIME: **Brad Miller's** career-high seven RBI last night were most by a Cardinal player since **Paul Goldschmidt** (7) on Sept. 13, 2019 at Milwaukee, most by a left-handed batter since **Matt Carpenter** (7) on July 20, 2018 at Chicago Cubs, and most by a Cardinals designated hitter in team history, surpassing **Albert Pujols** (6) on June 21, 2009 vs. Kansas City ... Miller's seven at-bats last night were most by a Cardinal in a 9-inning game since **Ray Lankford** (August 5, 1994 at Pittsburgh) and first with three hits and seven at-bats in a 9-inning game since **Garry Templeton** (April 27, 1977 at Chicago Cubs) ... Miller also became the fifth Cardinal over the last 75 years with at 4+ hits, two homers and seven RBI in a game, joining **George Hendrick** (August 25, 1978 at Atlanta), **Mark Whiten** (Sept. 7, 1993 at Cincinnati - G2), **Carlos Beltran** (May 2, 2012 vs. Pittsburgh) and Carpenter (2018). (*Elias*)

GOLD NUGGETS: **Paul Goldschmidt** ranks among MLB leaders in on-base percentage (.495, 1st), batting average (.353, 3rd), OPS (1.037, 9th), OPS+ (185, 3rd), walks (24, 77th), line drive pct. (.347, 5th), PA/walk (.463, 1st), BB/SO (1.71, 2nd) ... Has reached base safely in 26 of 27 games this season, including 23 straight since July 29 (.362/.521/.551, 25-69) tying **Trea Turner** for 2nd-longest in MLB in 2020 behind **Alex Bregman** (24); all three streaks are active ... Is the only MLB player with 20 or more walks and 15 or fewer strikeouts ... Paces MLB with a .583 BA (7-12) when leading off an inning ... Has doubled in four straight games (Aug. 29-present).

FIVE ALIVE: St. Louis (12-0) is MLB's only team to be undefeated when scoring five or more runs in a game this season (STL went 64-10 last season). The Cardinals have scored six or more in their last six wins (Aug. 23-present).

FOREVER DEJONG: Since **Paul DeJong's** MLB debut (May 29, 2017), his 14 career homers vs. the Reds tie **Christian Yelich** for 2nd-most in MLB behind **Kyle Schwarber** (15).

BIRD BYTES: Happy 26th birthday to **Rob Kaminsky** ... Among MLB players with 20+ PA at Great American Ball Park since the beginning of 2019, **Kolten Wong** leads MLB in batting average (.517, 15-29), while **Tommy Edman** (.315, 16-44) ranks 4th and **Paul Goldschmidt** 5th (.344, 11-32) ... St. Louis pitching leads MLB in average against (.198), while its starting rotation paces all of MLB in opponent BA (.186), OBP (.268), SLG (.328), OPS (.597), and WHIP (1.03) ... **Matt Carpenter** is four walks shy of reaching 660 for his career to tie **Rogers Hornsby** (1915-26, '33) for 7th all-time in franchise history ... In bases loaded situations in 2020, the Cardinals lead MLB in batting (.531, 17-32) and OBP (.568), and trail only the Padres (1.219, 1.656) in slugging (.906) and OPS (1.474) ... Five MLB players had 6+ RBI in a game last night: two were former Cardinal **Marcell Ozuna** and former Cardinals minor leaguer **Donovan Solano**.

CINCINNATI CONNECTIONS

Tyler Webb was selected by the Reds in the 48th round of the 2011 MLB Draft, but did not sign.

Mike Shildt made his managerial debut against the Reds (July 15, 2018).

Alex Reyes (August 9, 2016 at Busch Stadium) made his MLB debut vs. Cincinnati.

Mike Maddux was born in Dayton, Ohio...originally selected by the Reds in the 36th round of the 1979 MLB draft, but did not sign to attend the University of Texas at El Paso.

Cardinals broadcaster and Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played 13 games for the Reds in 2010.

David Bell served as a Cardinals Asst. Hitting (2014) and bench coach (2015-17)...played parts of four seasons with St. Louis (1995-98)...traded by Cleveland with **Pepe McNeal** and **Rick Heiser** to St. Louis for **Ken Hill** (July 27, 1995).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Scott Rolen** played his final four seasons in a Reds uniform (2009-12), where he was a 2010 Gold Glove Award winner and two-time All-Star (2010-11).

Reds Executive Advisor to the CEO **Walt Jocketty** served as the Cardinals GM for 13 seasons (1995-2007)...during tenure, the Cardinals compiled seven NL Central Division championships (1996, 2000-02, '04-'06), two NL Championships ('04, '06), and one World Series Championship ('06)...named MLB Executive of the Year (2000, '04, '10).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Vince Coleman** played in 33 games for the Reds in 1996.

Reds first base coach **Delino DeShields** played two seasons with St. Louis (1997-98).

Reds Asst. Hitting Coach **Joe Mather** was selected by the Cardinals in the 3rd round of the 2001 MLB draft...played in 90 games for St. Louis (2008, '10).

Reds broadcaster **Jeff Brantley** pitched in 48 games for St. Louis in 1998.

Reds Special Asst. to the GM **Marty Maier** spent 24 seasons with St. Louis as an area scout, Latin American coordinator, asst. director of scouting, scouting director and special asst. to the GM.

Reds Bullpen Coach **Lee Tunnell** pitched in 32 games for St. Louis in 1987.

Cardinals Principal Owner and Chief Executive Office **William DeWitt Jr.** was a prior Reds owner of the Reds and shareholder of the Cincinnati Bengals...his father, **William O. DeWitt**, was a sole owner of the Reds from 1961-67.

Reds CEO **Robert Castellini**, Chairman **W. Joseph Williams Jr.** and Vice Chairman **Thomas Williams** were Cardinals investors from 1995-2006...Interests were sold as a condition of their acquisition of a controlling ownership stake of the Reds.

- Since his MLB debut in 2017, has recorded the most strikeouts against the Cubs of any opposing pitcher with 62 over 11 appearances.
