TODAY'S GAME: After yesterday's off day, the Giants continue their six-game road trip across the southern half of the United States today with the first of three against the Texas Rangers.

- ▶ SF won Wednesday's series finale in Arizona 9-3, with three home runs and 10 walks to power the offense and end its season-long six-game losing streak.
- ▶ The win also snapped SF's seven-game losing streak at Chase Field, the franchise's second-longest at Arizona all-time.

RANGER DANGER: The Giants are 25-16 (.610) all-time vs. the Rangers with a 189-174 (+15) run differential...SF is one of two teams (also LAD) to hold an all-time winning percentage greater than .600 vs. the Rangers according to *Stats, LLC*.

- ▶ This marks SF's second series at Globe Life Field, with the Giants splitting the two-game series June 8-9, 2021 with a 12-8 run differential.
- ▶ Today also kicks off SF's second series vs. **Bruce Bochy** since he returned to managing...Bochy guided the Giants to three World Series titles in 2010, 2012 and 2014.
- ▶ SF lost two of three vs. the Rangers in Bochy's return to Oracle Park last season (August 11-13), with the lone win coming in the finale on a **C Patrick Bailey** walk-off home run.
- ▶ The Giants' championship in 2010, with Bochy at the helm, was their first in San Francisco history (since 1958) and their first overall since the New York Giants won in 1954...overall, Bochy posted 1,052 wins with San Francisco, the second-most managerial wins by a Giants manager behind Hall of Famer **John McGraw**.

SPIDER WEBB: RHP Logan Webb will make his fourth career start against Texas...he is 1-0 with a 1.47 ERA (3er, 18.1ip), 20 strikeouts, 1.09 WHIP and a .194 opposing batting average.

- ▶ The Giants have lost each of Webb's last three starts, and six of his last seven, despite Webb posting a 3.54 ERA (16er, 40.2ip) over the seven-game span.
- ▶ Webb's seven starts of at least 7.0 innings this season are most in the Majors.

HE GETS ON BASE: OF **Heliot Ramos** had a historical finale in Arizona, reaching base in all six plate appearances with four walks...he has reached base in 24 of his 26 games this season.

- ▶ At 24 years and 272 days old on Wednesday, Ramos was the youngest Giant with four walks in a game since **OF Darren Lewis** (24 years, 19 days) on September 16, 1991 vs. Atlanta.
- ▶ He is the youngest in franchise history to log two hits and four walks in the same game, and just the eighth Giant all-time to achieve that feat...Ramos is just the third Giant in franchise history to have two hits, two RBI and four walks in a game (**OF Barry Bonds** on September 11, 2000 and **OF Darryl Hamilton** on June 6, 1998).
- ▶ Also with two walks in Tuesday's game, Ramos became the first Giant with six walks in a two-game span since **OF Ángel Pagán** May 17-18, 2012.
- ▶ Ramos has five multi-hit games in his last nine games, and three home runs in his last four games.
- ▶ This marks just the eighth game in the SF era, and second instance this season, in which the Giants' No. 2 hitter reached base safely six times in a game (also **IF/OF LaMonte Wade Jr.** on May 22 this season).

LOS FLORES: IF Wilmer Flores hit his sixth career grand slam on Wednesday, and the fourth by a Giants hitter this season...SF's four grand slams are tied with Cincinnati and Pittsburgh for most in MLB this season.

- ▶ Wednesday marked the fourth instance in which a Giant recorded five RBI in a game, which is tied with Arizona and Kansas City for most such player games this season.

CHAPSTICK: IF Matt Chapman extended his on-base streak to 23 games with a three-walk game on Wednesday...his 23-game on-base streak is tied with STL's Paul Goldschmidt for the longest active streak in the National League, and tied for fourth-longest active in MLB.

- ▶ Chapman has a slash line of .295/.404/.545 with 21 runs, 10 doubles, four home runs and 14 RBI over the streak.

7TH HEAVEN: The Giants remain one of MLB's best late-scoring offenses as shown in the chart below.

HELP THE PEN: Outside of **RHP Logan Webb**, who ranks ninth in MLB with 79.1 innings this season, SF has just two games in which its starter pitched at least 7.0 frames (**LHP Kyle Harrison**, May 7 at COL and **RHP Jordan Hicks**, April 5 vs. SD).

- ▶ While SF starting pitchers have totaled 302.2 innings, which is 29th in MLB ahead of only Milwaukee's 290.0ip, the SF bullpen has 253.0 innings pitched, which trails only the Brewers' 259.1 innings.
- ▶ SF's 23 games in which starters pitched at least 6.0 innings are ranked tied for 22nd in MLB.

NO MORE THAN 4: SF has done well winning close, low-scoring games this season...SF is 21-1 (.955) when allowing three or fewer runs, which is the fewest number of losses, and best winning percentage in the Majors (*Stats, LLC*).

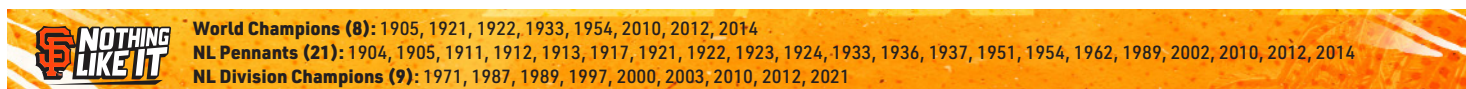
This Date in Giants History

WEBB GEMS: SF's Opening Day starter is in his sixth season with the Giants and made his fifth Opening Day roster in 2024...SF's ace signed a contract extension in April 2023 that keeps him in a Giants uniform through the 2028 season.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered the loss last Saturday night at Oracle Park against a red-hot Yankee offense in SF's 7-3 defeat...he allowed a two-run homer to Aaron Judge in the 1st inning and two more runs in the 4th but held the line there, giving SF a chance to climb back into the game...he finished 7.0 innings on a season-high 108 pitches and left with the Giants only trailing by a run at 4-3...the Yankees opened up the game in the 8th to seal the win.

DADDY LONG LEGS: Webb has finished at least 7.0 innings on seven different occasions so far this season...only two other Giants starters this year have finished 7.0 innings (**Jordan Hicks** did so on April 5 vs. San Diego and **Kyle Harrison** did so on May 7 at Colorado)...no other pitcher in the Majors has completed at least 7.0 innings more than Webb has this year (see chart below)...his 79.1 innings are 9th-most in the Majors entering play today...Boston's Tanner Houck leads at 85.0 innings

MESS WITH TEXAS: Tonight's start will be Webb's first against the Rangers on the road as each of his three previous starts vs. Texas have come at Oracle Park...Webb is 1-0 with a 1.47 ERA (3er, 18.1ip) in those three starts while SF has gone 3-0 in those games...last year on August 13 Webb nearly had his second shutout of the season as he took the ball for the 9th inning with SF up 1-0 on the Rangers...he got the first two outs of the inning before allowing a double to J.P. Martínez...Webb was taken out after throwing 107 pitches and Texas tied the game off closer **Camilo Doval** with Martínez scoring from second on an infield single...SF eventually won it with a walk-off homer from **C Patrick Bailey** in the 10th.

THE SPLITS: Below is a look at Webb's numbers within the confines of Oracle Park this year versus what he's done on the road...the Giants have won only one of Webb's seven road starts this year (April 13 at Tampa Bay)...it's worth noting Webb was much better in his three road starts in May (3.18 ERA) than he was in April (6.28 ERA).

EL CAMBIO: According to *Statcast*, Webb's changeup in 2023 was the second-most valuable pitch in the Majors in terms of run value at +28...only the Yankees Gerrit Cole had a more valuable pitch (+29 with his four-seam fastball)...this season, Webb's changeup is up to a +5 run value...last start, Yankee hitters were 2-for-11 off his changeup with one of the two hits being Aaron Judge's homer...in his last three starts, hitters are 5-for-30 (.167) in at-bats that end with the pitch with one extra-base hit (the Judge homer).

WE'RE STAYING IN: Webb has allowed only three homers in 79.1 innings so far in 2024 after giving up 20 homers in 216.0 innings a season ago...his 0.34 HR/9ip would be a career-best after he posted a 0.55 HR/9ip ratio in 2021 and a 0.51 rate in 2022...from 2020-2022, Webb allowed 24 homers in 395.0 innings for a 0.55 HR/9ip rate, lowest among qualified starters.

CHECK 'EM: Opposing teams have had success running on Webb so far in 2024, stealing 11 bases when he's been on the hill but it's gotten better recently...after allowing 10 steals through his first nine starts opponents have only swiped one base in his last four starts.

BAND TOGETHER: The Giants as a team are 59-45 (.567) in Webb's 104 regular season starts since 2021...SF is 5-8 in his 12 starts in 2024...he's received three or fewer runs of support in 10 of the 13 starts.

BEHIND THE DISH: Webb has strong career numbers with both **C Patrick Bailey** and **C Curt Casali** as his catcher.

BOOTS ON THE GROUND: Through 13 starts this year Webb owns a 56.3% ground ball rate, fourth-best in the Majors...only PHI's Christopher Sánchez (62.7%), ATL's Max Fried (61.4%) and LAA's José Soriano (60.3%) have been better...below is a chart of Webb's groundball breakdown by start so far in 2024.

- ▶ Matched his career-high with four runs allowed on Sunday and allowed a career-high four hits...marked his second blown save of the season and his second in his last three chances.
- ▶ Issued 17 walks in 23.1ip...his 15.6% walk rate is in the bottom 4% of the league.
- ▶ Has struck out 30 batters over 23.1 innings of work (11.57 SO/9.0).
- ▶ 16 of his 30 strikeouts this year have come with his slider.
- ▶ Lefties are hitting .304 (14-for-46) off him.
- ▶ In 13 non-save situations, he is 2-0 with a 3.46 ERA (5er, 13.0ip), eight hits allowed (two homers), 11 walks and 16 strikeouts.
