**GIMME FIVE:** The Orioles secured their fifth straight series victory yesterday, beating the Red Sox, 6-2, at Oriole Park to complete a 5-1 homestand...**Ramón Urias** set a career high with four hits and matched a career best with three runs scored after going 4-for-4 with three runs scored and an RBI...**Cedric Mullins** reached base three times, going 2-for-3 with a run scored, an RBI, a walk, and a stolen base...**Tyler Wells** surrendered two runs over 5.2 innings to earn his first win of the season.  
 ⚾ Urias registered the fifth game of at least four hits by an Oriole this season, joining **Austin Hays** (2x) and **Adley Rutschman** (2x); those five such games are tied with Chicago-NL for the most in MLB this season.

**WHAT'S TRENDING:** The O's have won eight of their last nine games, 10 of their last 12, and 12 of their last 15...The 16-8 record is tied for the third-best start to begin a season in team history (since 1954) and is the best opening to a campaign since the 2017 club also started the year 16-8...Only the 1997 and 2005 Orioles, who were both 17-7, had a better record through 24 games played than the 2023 Birds.

⚾ Entering today's games, Baltimore owns the second-best record in the AL, trailing only Tampa Bay (20-5); the O's .667 winning percentage is the fourth-best in MLB behind Tampa Bay (.800) and Atlanta and Pittsburgh (.680).

⚾ Baltimore has played 15 consecutive games against teams that do not have a winning record while going 12-3...That trend continues through the Kansas City series next week, though Boston is currently at .500 entering play today.

**GIB AND TAKE:** Kyle Gibson makes his sixth start of the season tonight, looking to improve to 5-0...No Oriole starting pitcher has started a season 5-0 since Jimmy Key went 8-0 in his first nine starts in 1997...Gibson had a career-high-tying 11 strikeouts in his last start against Detroit on April 22 at Oriole Park after entering the start with 13 total strikeouts in his first four starts of the year.

⚾ Opponents are batting just .125 (4-for-32) with two home runs against his sweeper; the pitch has a 43.1 percent whiff rate, per *Statcast*.

**AGAINST THE TIGERS:** Baltimore and Detroit wrap up the season series with four games beginning tonight through Sunday at Comerica Park...The Orioles swept a three-game set by a combined score of 9-3 at Oriole Park from April 21-23, the team's first sweep of the Tigers in any series since September 24-26, 2004 (3G)...The Birds went 1-5 against Detroit last season, including being swept in three games in Motown from May 13-15 and going 1-2 in Baltimore from September 19-21.

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN:** The Orioles begin their longest road trip of the season with these four games in Detroit through Sunday...The team has an off day on May 1 before three games at Kansas City from May 2-4 and three games at Atlanta from May 5-7.

**ON THE ATTACK:** Baltimore is batting .253/.336/.419 (200-for-790) with 43 doubles, two triples, 28 home runs, 125 runs scored, 121 RBI, and 97 walks to start the season...The O's rank fifth in the AL and ninth in MLB in runs scored after finishing 10<sup>th</sup> in the AL and 20<sup>th</sup> in MLB with 674 runs scored in 2022...The Birds rank among AL teams in walks (T-1<sup>st</sup>, 97), batting average (4<sup>th</sup>, .249), on-base percentage (4<sup>th</sup>, .333), OPS (4<sup>th</sup>, .753), and slugging percentage (5<sup>th</sup>, .420).

⚾ The Orioles lead the AL and rank third in MLB with 4.04 pitches per plate appearance this season; the O's have five players in the top 22 in the AL in pitches per plate appearance: **Adley Rutschman** (4<sup>th</sup>, 4.33), **Adam Frazier** (8<sup>th</sup>, 4.24), **Anthony Santander** (T-13<sup>th</sup>, 4.20), Gunnar Henderson (15<sup>th</sup>, 4.19), and Cedric Mullins (22<sup>nd</sup>, 4.13).

**WHAT A RELIEF:** The Baltimore bullpen has a 1.21 ERA (6 ER/44.2 IP) in the last 12 games since April 13...For the season, O's relievers own a 2.78 ERA (29 ER/94.0 IP), the third-best mark in MLB...The Orioles' pen has pitched to a 2.95 ERA (14 ER/42.2 IP) on the road this season after working to a 3.72 (120 ER/290.2 IP) away from Oriole Park in 2022.

**CEDRIC THE ENTERTAINER:** Cedric Mullins is batting .381/.509/.571 (16-for-42) with three doubles, one triple, one homer, five runs scored, 12 RBI, 11 walks, and five stolen bases in the last 13 games since April 12...During that time, he leads MLB in on-base percentage and ranks among MLB leaders in walks (T-4<sup>th</sup>), batting average (5<sup>th</sup>), and OPS (8<sup>th</sup>)...He entered this stretch slashing .163/.250/.326 (7-for-43) with one double, two home runs, seven runs scored, eight RBI, five walks, and five stolen bases in the first 11 games of the season.

**THE CANO SHOW:** Yennier Cano set down the first four batters he faced yesterday to tie the team record (since 1954) with 24 consecutive batters retired to start a season, joining Fred Holdsworth who set the record from July 17-24, 1976...The stretch ended on a Justin Turner hit-by-pitch with two outs in the eighth inning...Cano's 25 hitless at-bats to begin a season are also tied for the most to begin a season in O's history with Todd Frohwirth in 1991 and Steve Barber in 1967...The last MLB pitchers with 25-or-more hitless at-bats to open a season were Tampa Bay's Jason Adam and San Diego's Sean Manaea (both 28) in 2022...Milwaukee's Josh Hader did not allow a hit in his first 35 at-bats to begin the 2020 season.

**NEED FOR SPEED:** The O's have 26 stolen bases, third in MLB behind the Pirates (34) and Guardians (31 SB)...**Cedric Mullins** swiped the team's first base in six games yesterday...The O's have only been caught stealing four times for an 86.7 percent success rate...Mullins is tied with three others for second in MLB with 10 stolen bases, behind only Atlanta's Ronald Acuña Jr. (13 SB)...Mullins is the only one of the five MLB players with 10+ steals without a caught stealing...**Jorge Mateo** is tied for third in the AL and tied for seventh in MLB with eight steals...The duo's 18 combined stolen bases are more than 16 MLB teams.

⚾ Mullins' 10 successful stolen bases are the most to begin a season by an Oriole since Brian Roberts and Corey Patterson, who each swiped their first 13 attempts, an O's record to start a campaign, to begin 2006.

**ROSTER MOVES:** The Orioles recalled **Joey Ortiz** from Triple-A Norfolk today...He will wear No. 65 and his first appearance will be his MLB debut...Ortiz was slashing .359/.389/.500 (23-for-64) with five doubles, two triples, six runs scored, five walks, and one stolen base in 16 games with the Tides this season...In a corresponding move, **Terrin Vavra** was optioned to Norfolk after yesterday's game.

**THE SKIPPER:** Manager **Brandon Hyde** returns for his fifth season...In 2022, he led the O's to an 83-79 record, his first winning season as manager and the club's first winning campaign since 2016...He was named the *Baseball America* MLB Manager of the Year and was voted the *Sporting News* American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers...He finished second in voting for the Baseball Writers' Association of America (BBWAA) American League Manager of the Year award...Hyde was named the 20<sup>th</sup> manager in Orioles history on December 14, 2018.

**QUICK HITS:** Scheduled to make his sixth start of season, fourth on the road, and second against the Tigers tonight...Became the first O's pitcher in club history (since 1954) to start and win each of his three first appearances with the team... In 272 career appearances (266 GS), Gibson owns a 93-91 record with a 4.50 ERA (767 ER/1534.0 IP)...The O's signed Gibson to a one-year contract on December 5, 2022...He has also spent time with the Twins, Phillies, and Rangers across 10 Major League seasons.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Earned his fourth win of the season in his last start on April 22 vs. Detroit...Allowed one run on two hits (1 HR) with three walks and a career-high-tying 11 strikeouts (3x, last: 8/16/22 at CIN w/ PHI) in 6.1 innings...Has started a season 4-0 for the second time in his career, joining a 6-0 start with Texas in 2021... Is the fifth Oriole starting pitcher since 2004 to begin a year 4-0, joining John Means (4-0 in 2021), Bud Norris (4-0 in 2013), Wei-Yin Chen (4-0 in 2012), and Erik Bedard (4-0 in 2006)... Extended the scoreless innings streak by O's starting pitchers to 29.2 before a one-out home run in the seventh inning... Threw 96 pitches, 59 strikes.

**CAREER AGAINST THE TIGERS:** Making his 27<sup>th</sup> career appearance (26<sup>th</sup> start) and second start this season against the Tigers...Earned the win in his last start against the Tigers on April 22 at Oriole Park...Owns an 11-11 record with a 5.64 ERA (89 ER/142.0 IP) in his first 26 career appearances against Detroit...His 11 career quality starts against the Tigers are tied for his second-most against any opponent, trailing only Chicago-AL (12).

**CAREER AGAINST THE AL CENTRAL:** Making his 94<sup>th</sup> career appearance (90<sup>th</sup> start) against the AL Central...Owns a 33-31 record with a 4.48 ERA (258 ER/518.1 IP) and 40 quality starts through his first 93 appearances...Made his MLB debut on June 29, 2013 against the Royals with Minnesota; earned the win after allowing two runs on eight hits with five strikeouts and a hit batter in 6.0 innings at Target Field...Threw 91 pitches, 64 strikes...With the Rangers, he tossed a career-low 0.1 inning on April 1, 2021, at Kansas City.

**ROAD WARRIOR:** Making his fourth road start of the 2023 campaign...Owns a 2-0 record with a 5.19 ERA (10 ER/17.1 IP) through his first three outings away from Oriole Park...Made his Orioles debut and second career Opening Day start on March 30 vs. Boston; earned the win after allowing four runs on six hits with one walk, one hit batter, and three strikeouts in 5.0 innings...Sports a 45-43 record with a 4.52 ERA (386 ER/769.0 IP) with 62 quality starts and three complete games in 137 career road appearances (133 GS).

**GIBBY THE GIVER:** Gibson is a two-time nominee for the distinguished Roberto Clemente Award (2022 & 2019)...While with the Phillies, he donated to Philabundance, a nonprofit food bank in Philadelphia, and Cradles for Crayons... He also created a Philly Fantasy Football League in support of Help One Now, an organization that supports families in developing countries strike out extreme poverty...Gibson is the Vice President of the Big League Impact, a nonprofit founded in 2013 by Roberto Clemente Award winner Adam Wainwright (2020) to help people meet basic human needs, including food, clean water, medical care, shelter, and education...He was the recipient of the 2017 Carl R. Pohlad Community Service Award selected by the Twins Community Fund Board of Directors.

**2022 HIGHLIGHTS:** Went 10-8 with a 5.05 ERA (94 ER/167.2 IP) in 31 starts with the Phillies, the fifth time in his career making at least 30 starts in a season... Made his Phillies debut on April 9 vs. Oakland (W, 7.0 IP, 2 H, 10 K)...Made his 250<sup>th</sup> career start on July 27 vs. Atlanta...Retired the first 18 batters he faced on August 5 vs. Washington over 8.0 innings, the longest perfect game bid of his career...Struck out 11 batters on August 16 at Cincinnati, his second double-digit strikeout game of the season, the most in his career...Gibson's final nine starts averaged 10.37 K/9... Had a career-best 3.00 K/BB ratio (144 K/48 BB).

**POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE:** Appeared on his fifth career Postseason roster in 2022 with the Phillies and made his World Series debut in Game 3 at Citizens Bank Park, working 1.0 scoreless inning out of the bullpen with one hit and one strikeout in Philadelphia's 7-0 loss to the Houston Astros...In two relief appearances during the 2022 Postseason, he worked 2.1 scoreless innings, allowing two hits with one walk and two strikeouts.
