DL Hall is making the second start of his Major League career today in his 30th appearance.....his only other start came in his Major League debut on 8/13/22 at Tampa Bay with the Orioles.....he took an 8-2 defeat in that outing (3.2ip, 5h, 5r, 5er, 3bb, 6k).

Brotherly Love

Tylor Megill, the younger brother of Trevor Megill, is scheduled to start for the Mets tomorrow.....the Megill brothers have never pitched in the same game professionally.

Robin the Cradle

Jackson Chourio (20.018) made his Major League debut yesterday as he started in right field and hit leadoff..... Hall of Famer Robin Yount (2x) is the only player in franchise history younger than Chourio to appear in an Opening Day game.....he was 18-years, 201-days old when he made his MLB debut in 1974 and 19-years, 204-days old in 1975.

Yo, Adrian! I Did It!

Jackson Chourio (20.018) yesterday became the youngest player in the majors to start on Opening Day since Hall of Famer Adrián Beltré (19.363) started at third base for the Dodgers on 4/5/99 vs. Arizona.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach.....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the San Diego Padres (42-54), replacing Bud Black in June of that season.....Murphy enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career spent primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009).

CDACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (4th season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach Connor Dawson (3rd season), assistant pitching coach Jim Henderson (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (6th season), third base coach Jason Lane (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator Walker McKinven (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach Ozzie Timmons (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff..... Rickie Weeks (associate manager), Daniel de Mondesert (assistant coach) and Charlie Greene (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

2023 IN REVIEW: The Brewers went 92-70 and qualified for the postseason for the fifth time in the last six seasons.....the team won the NL Central for the third time in the last six seasons, taking the division by 9.0 games over the Cubs.....the Brewers were defeated by Arizona, two games to none, in the NL Wild Card Series in Milwaukee..... in each of the nine seasons in franchise history that the Brewers qualified for the postseason, the team that has eliminated Milwaukee has reached the World Series, a trend continued by the Diamondbacks in 2023 (lost to Texas).

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last six full seasons (does not include 2020).....the Brewers have 574 wins since 2017, which ranks sixth in the majors and third in the National League.....the teams was 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in seven consecutive seasons, missing out by just a single game in both 2017 and 2022.

<u>SPRING TRAINING</u>: The Brewers went 16-15-2 during Spring Training, including 9-2-1 over their last 12 games.

TODAY'S STARTER: #37 - LHP DL HALL (18g, Ogs, 3-0, 3.26era in 2023 with Baltimore)

HALL AT A GLANCE: DL Hall. 25, will be making his Brewers debut,.....Hall was acquired from Baltimore, along with INF Joey Ortiz and a 2024 Competitive Balance Round A selection, in exchange for RHP Corbin Burnes on Feb. 1.....he entered the season as the fifth-best prospect in the organization according to Baseball America.....Hall appeared in 18 games with Baltimore last season, all in relief, and went 3-0 with a 3.26 ERA during two stints (4/29 and 8/26-end of season).....he made his postseason debut in the 2023 American League Division Series against Texas and struck out 6 of the 12 batters he faced over 3.1 scoreless innings during 2 relief appearances.

WHAT'S IN A NAME?: The initials "DL" stand for Dayton Lane.....his first memory of being called "DL" was by his grandfather at age four or five.

CAREER: Is 4-1 with a 4.36 ERA and 1 save in 29 games/1 start (33ip, 16er)....is in his third Major League season with Baltimore (2022-23) and Milwaukee (2024)....his only career start came with the Orioles in his Major League debut on 8/13/22 at Tampa Bay in an 8-2 loss (3.2ip, 5h, 5r, 5er, 3bb, 6k).....Hall was selected by Baltimore in the first round (21st overall) of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of Valdosta (GA) High School.

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER: Is 13-22 with a 3.49 ERA in 96 games/81 starts, all in the Orioles organization (2017-23).....he has held opponents to a .198 batting average with 499 strikeouts in just 353.1 innings pitched.....Hall was selected to the 2019 All-Star Futures Game.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Hall has never pitched in Milwaukee.

CAREER ON THE ROAD: IS 1-1 with a 4.19 ERA in 14 games/1 start [19.1ip, 9er].....went 1-0 with a 3.38 ERA in 9 relief appearances last season [10.2ip, 4er].

CAREER vs. METS: Hall has never faced the Flushing, New York Mets.
