Offense

Since the start of July the Braves have scored 82 runs, the most in Major League Baseball.

They've reached a double-digit run total in three games this month, tied for the most in the majors.

In just 13 July games, Atlanta has already surpassed its run total from the entire month of June. The team scored 77 runs in 23 games last month.

The Braves have hit 21 home runs this month, also exceeding their June total in that regard (19).

TODAY'S GAME: In a matchup of two first-place teams, the Atlanta Braves and Texas Rangers duel for three games to commence baseball's second half...This is the only scheduled meeting between these two clubs this season.

A The Braves beat the Rangers last night in the series opener, 15-1, and secured their third double-digit run total of the month...Every Atlanta starter recorded a hit by the completion of the fourth inning.

A The Rangers swept the Braves across three games in Arlington last July...Atlanta won its previous home series against Texas in 2024, and needs one more win this weekend to secure another set.

A Prior to this series, Atlanta and Texas had met for just 11 series and 33 total games...The Braves swept the first two series in 2002 and '03, before the Rangers won six straight sets from 2005-22... The Braves have played to a 16-18 record (.471) against Texas all-time.

A LH MacKenzie Gore has made nine previous starts against the Atlanta, eight times as a Washington National and once as a San Diego Padre...All-time, he's 3-3 with a 3.56 ERA (17 ER/43.0 IP) against the club...The 6-foot-2, 193-pound southpaw from Wilmington, NC, has surrendered more than two earned runs in two of his nine turns against the Braves...His club has lost each of his last four starts against Atlanta.

OWEN MURPHY: Is set to make his first career start and his third appearance...The 22-year-old right-hander from Chicago, IL, has pitched to a 2.25 ERA (1 ER/4.0 IP) across two relief outings.

A Albeit over a small sample, Murphy's four-seam fastball has garnered an induced vertical break of 18.9 and a run value of three, per Statcast...Per 100 pitches, Murphy's fastball would amass a run value of 6.4, the second-best in MLB (without qualification).

A Three players, 23 years-old-or-younger, have pitched for the Braves this season, tied for the most on a team in MLB (PIT, MIA).

WIN: The Braves beat the Rangers last night, 15-1, in Game 1 of this series...Atlanta won a game by at least 14 runs for the second time this season (also April 2 at Arizona)...The Chicago Cubs are the only other team with multiple wins by such a margin.

A RHP Víctor Mederos logged his first career hit and RBI in the first plate appearance of his professional career...Per MLB's Sarah Langs, he became the first pitcher to log multiple RBI in a game since Logan Webb did so for San Francisco on October 3, 2021...Maderos became just the second pitcher, MLB-wide, to record a hit since the universal designated hitter went into effect in 2022.

A Mederos became the first Atlanta pitcher to record a hit since Max Fried did so on September 12, 2021...Fried and Charlie Morton each collected two hits that month.

DRAKE BALDWIN: Coming off his first career All-Star selection, Baldwin last night went 3-for-4 out of the leadoff spot and recorded two runs, a home run, five RBI and a walk.

A Baldwin became just the second Brave with a five-RBI performance this season, joining Jonah Heim on May 3...Since Baldwin's debut last season, his three, five-RBI games are the most on Atlanta's club.

A Since the start of last season, only three other primary catchers have logged at least three, five-RBI games: Cal Raleigh (SEA, 4), Carson Kelly (CHC, 3) and Kyle Higashioka (TEX, 3).

A Baldwin has gone 24 plate appearances without striking out, the fourth-longest active streak in MLB behind Javier Sanoja (MIA, 52 PA), Adley Rutschman (BAL, 34 PA) and Chandler Simpson (TB, 31 PA).

MATT OLSON: Belted a fourth-inning home run last night to extend Atlanta's lead...It marked his 26th homer and 50th extra-base hit of the season...He ranks top-10 in MLB in extra-base hits (2nd, 50), doubles (T3rd, 24), total bases (T4th, 203), runs (T4th, 66), home runs (7th, 26) and slugging percentage (10th, .543).

A Olson reached 50 extra-base hits in 96 games-or-less for the third time since joining the Braves in 2022...In that span, only two other players have done so multiple times: Aaron Judge (NYY) and Shohei Ohtani (LAD).

A Olson's 3.4 bWAR are the most among National League first basemen and are ninth most by any NL batter...He ranks in the 93rd percentile or higher in expected slugging percentage (.520), average exit velocity (92.9 mph), hard-hit percentage (51.6) and batting run value (23).

STRIKE ZONE: Six of Atlanta's 19 hits last night occurred on pitches outside of the strike zone, tied for the club's second most in a single game this season...Ozzie Albies accounted for two of those hits.

A The Braves have collected an even 200 hits on true balls this season, easily the most in the National League and second most in baseball...Tampa Bay (209) has logged the most in MLB, while Philadelphia (178) is the runner-up in the NL.

A Individually, Albies (31) and Michael Harris II (30) have amassed the fifth- and seventh-most hits on balls this season...They've batted .230 and .234 on balls, respectively, higher than the MLB average of .159.

AUSTIN RILEY: Went 2-for-5 with his 10th home run of the season last night, his 86th career extra-base hit in the month of July...That total is the second-highest among active hitters since his debut in 2019...Rafael Devers is the only player to amass more (90).

A Riley is batting .440 (22-for-50) with the count in his favor this season, the 14th-best mark among qualified batters...With the count against him, he's hitting just .130 (25-for-193), the fourth-worst average in MLB.
