**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The St. Louis Cardinals are coming to the end of a 10-day road trip through Chicago-AL (1-2), Arizona (3-1) and Los Angeles (0-1). Tonight, the Cardinals play the second of three games against their longtime rival, the Los Angeles Dodgers and the 2,064th regular season matchup. The Cardinals enter today in second place in the National League Central, one-half game behind the Chicago Cubs. St. Louis had not begun a day out of first place since May 2nd.

OHHHHHHHH, CANADA!: Tyler O'Neill returned from the Injured List on May 27 and has homered in four of his five games since returning, including home runs in his first three games in Arizona. O'Neill is currently on a career-high eight game hitting streak. Seven of his eight hits have been for extra bases and leging daried inting streak. Sever in this layer has have been for extra bases and he slugged 1,045 over the last five games. Despite his time on the Injured List, O'Neill finished the month of May tied for 5th in the National League in home runs (7), tied for 10th in RBI (18), 3rd in slugging (.691), 5th in OPS (1.020) and 4th in HR/AB (9.71). Analytically, O'Neill leads all National League batters in Barrel Percentage (23.1%) trailing only **Mike Zunino** (SEA, 28.1%); with an expected Slugging Percentage of .674, 3rd in MLB (**Byron Buxton** .695, **Fernando Tatis** .**Ir** .692) do Tatis, Jr., .692).

ROOKIE ROCKSTAR: Cardinals rookie outfielder, Dylan Carlson, has homered in consecutive games for the second time this season (April 6-7 at Miami) after taking a 45-day haitus without a longball. The Golden State native leads, or is tied for the lead, National League rookies in home runs (5), RBI (24), on-base percentage (.357), runs (29), walks (23), while ranking 2nd in hits (49), doubles (8) and triples (2).

J-WILLIE STYLE: Last night, Justin Williams got the Cardinals on the board jacking a home run high off the right field foul pole in the 6th inning off **Trevor Bauer**. At that time, the home run was the hardest hit ball of the day in Major League Baseball, departing the bat with an exit speed of 115.0 MPH, which was also the hardest hit of the season for the Cardinals. Williams bookended the month of May homering on May 1 at Pittsburgh and again on May 31 at Los

MILLER REHAB CONTINUES: Andrew Miller is scheduled to make another rehabilitation apppearance for Memphis (AAA) tonight, when the Redbirds host the Toledo Mudhens on "Nacho Average Tuesday" at Autozone Park. Miller has been on the Injured List since April 29 with a right foot toe blister. The 36-year old, 16-year Major League veteran, has made three appearances for Memphis during his rehab assignment including one start and is 0-0 with a 3.00 ERA appearance for 10 injurio in sech, while striking out five total. appearing for 1.0 inning in each, while striking out five total.

WALK IN THE PARK: The Cardinals issued their MLB-leading 15th bases loaded walk of the season last night. Since 1974, the Cardinals season high for bases loaded walks in a season is 17 in 2008. The 1999 Seattle Mariners hold the record over that period with 28. Overall, the Cardinals lead MLB with 240 walks, with 65 of those walks scoring. The Angels rank T-2nd with 222 walks and 2nd with 62 walks scoring. (Elias Sports Bureau)

LOADED WEAPON: Cardinals pitchers have issued 15 bases loaded walks, but have the lowest opponent batting average with the bases loaded at .192 (14-73). Unfortunately, the Cardinals have also allowed the most bases loaded RBI at 59 (Cincinnati, 2nd, 53), and yet are one of 10 teams who have not allowed

THERE GO THOSE MEN: Nolan Arenado and Paul Goldschmidt made a career of success against the Los Angeles Dodgers. Goldschmidt (32 HR, 99 RBI) and Arenado (28 HR, 86 RBI) are the current active leaders in home runs and RBI against the Dodgers. The duo is attempting to continue where Cardinals Hall of Famer **Stan "The Man" Musial** left off, the all-time MLB leader against the Dodgers in runs (299), hits (522) RBI (270) and 3rd in home runs (74).

THE G.O.A.T. CATCHES KENDALL: With a start tonight, Yadier Molina will pass **Jason Kendall** for 5th-place all-time in games caught at 2,026. Molina has a chance to catch **Gary Carter** (2,056) for 4th place later this season.

LIBBY LEADS THE RED, WHITE & BLUE: Cardinals pitching prospect Matthew

Liberatore made the start for Team USA's Olympic qualifying squad against
Nicaragua at Port St. Lucie, Fla., last night. The southpaw earned the win tossing 5.0 innings allowing one run on five hits, walking one
and fanning four in an 87-pitch effort. Liberatore, 21, acquired from the Tampa Bay Rays in a 2020 trade, is the Cardinals No. 1 pitching
prospect, and was pitching with Memphis (AAA) when he was selected to pitch for the "original home team". Liberatore joins several former
Cardinals on the USA squad (RHP Brandon Dickson, RHP Edwin Jackson, OF Jon Jay & LHP Marc Rzepczynski).

## LOS ANGELES CONNECTIONS

Jack Flaherty was born in Burbank Calif...graduated from Harvard-Westlake High School, where he went 23-0 with an 0.63 ERA over his final two seasons and 35-3 overall throughout his high school career...led Harvard-Westlake to the 2013 state title, pitching a complete-game shutout and driving in the lone run in a 1-0 win in the CIF Championship at Dodger Stadium...resides in Sherman Oaks...grew up a Dodgers fan.

Paul Goldschmidt was originally selected by the Dodgers in the 49th round of the 2006 MLB Draft but did not sign....was teammate of **A.J. Pollock** in Arizona for parts of seven seasons (2012-18).

Nolan Arenado graduated from El Toro High School in nearby Lake Forest, Calif. and resides in San Clemente, Calif...grew up a Dodgers fan...one of his favorite players growing up was outfielder Shawn Green...singled off Josh Wall for his first MLB hit (April 29, 2013 at Dodger Stadium).

Mike Maddux pitched parts of the 1990 (11 games) and 1999 (49 games) seasons with the Dodgers...his younger brother, Hall of Famer Greg Maddux, pitched parts of the 2006 and 2008 seasons with the Dodgers.

Ron "Pop" Warner was born in Alhambra, Ca

Joe Kelly pitched parts of three seasons with St. Louis (2012-14), including 11 games (four starts) in the Postseason...originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2009 MLB draft...later traded by the Cardinals with Allen Craig to Boston for Corey Littrell, John Lackey and cash. lif...graduated from Redlands High School.

Albert Pujols played 11 seasons with St. Louis (2001-11), hitting combined 328/420/617 with 445 home runs and 1,329 RBI, with 10 straight seasons of 300-30 HR-100 RBI (2001-2010)... won three NL MVP awards (2005, '08-09)...

named NL Rookie of the Year (2001)...member of two World Series Champion squads (2006, '11) and three NL pennant-winning teams (2004, '06, '11)...selected nine NL All-Star squads (2001, '03-04, '08-10) and two Gold Gloves (2006, '10)...originally selected by St. Louis in the 13th round of the 1999 MLB draft, by then Scouting Director John Mozeliak...resides in St. Louis County, Mo.

Daniel Ponce de Leon graduated from La Mirada (Calif.) High School in 2010, where he was named the school's All-Athlete of the Year as a senior... Played sophomore season at nearby Cypress (Calif.) College in 2012.

Jobel Jiménez was minor league outfielder in the Dodgers system for two seasons (1993-94)... spent five seasons as an outfield instructor and VSL scout for the Dodgers (1994-98).

#### **TONIGHT'S GAME**

- Making his 10th start of the season and 38th career (144th career appearance).
- Making only his 2nd career start against the Dodgers and his first appearance at Dodger Stadium as a member of the Cardinals. Pitched here in 2016 as an Atlanta Brave.
- Has not allowed a HR to his last 156 batters faced (last HR allowed: Bryce Harper, 1st inning, 4/18/21 at PHI) over 34.2 IP covering 6+ games. The 34.2 IP are tied for 4th longest streak in majors.
- His 1.81 ERA would rank as 5th best in the majors, but he is 9.1 IP shy of qualifying.
- Has allowed more than three runs just once over his last 19 starts dating back to Aug. 8, 2018, when he allowed six runs in a start vs. LAD (9/15/18).
- Has the majors 4th largest difference in expected ERA at -3.14 (1.81 vs. 4.95), earning the monicker "Frogger" from manager Mike Shildt for ability to get around base traffic.
- Ranks 1st in MLB with five sacrifice bunts on the season, tied with Nicky Lopez (KC) and Zach Davies (CHI).
- In the batters box, has hit two home runs since 8/14/18, T-3rd most among Major League pitchers trailing only Zack Greinke & Steven Matz (3).
- Made 81 straight relief appearances between his 2018 and 2021 starts (11-4, 3.43 ERA, 3 SV, 23 Holds).

 For a 2nd-straight start, helped the Cardinals snap a 3-game losing skid, this time with a 4-0 win over the White Sox May 26 on Chicago's South Side.

- Has MLB best .000 opp. BA (0-8) with bases loaded. Is 11th in NL with .171 mark (13-76) with runners on base & 3rd at .116 (5-43) with runners in scoring position.

- Held opposing batters to an .088 BA (3-34) with no XBH on two-strike counts.
- Did not allow a run in seven road appearances (7.2 IP) with two hits, one walk and 12 strikeouts.

#### CAREER

- His .611 winning pct. (22-14) as a member of the Cardinals is tops among teammates with 100 or more appearances during that span (2017-21).
- Made 81 straight relief appearances between his 9/26/18 and 4/6/21 starts.
- Has a career record of 10-13 with 3.45 ERA in 37 career starts and a 13-5 record with a 3.60 ERA and three saves in 106 career relief appearances.
- Missed pitching in the postseason each of the last two years, most recently on the injured list in 2020 and was not added to the postseason roster in 2019.
- Ranked T-3rd among MLB relief pitchers with 11 wins from 2019-20.
