PITTSBURGH PIRATES (1-3) AT TAMPA BAY RAYS (2-1)

March 31, 2025 - George M. Steinbrenner Field - Tampa, FL - 7:05 EDT - Game #5/Road #5
RHP Carmen Mlodzinski (5-5, 3.38 ERA in 2024) vs. RHP Drew Rasmussen (0-2, 2.83 ERA in 2024)

THE PIRATES: were walked off for the third time in four games Sunday afternoon against the Marlins...Earned their first win of 2025 with a 4-3 victory Friday night...Opened the season on the road for the ninth straight year and the 10th time in 11 years...Finished the 2024 season with a 76-86 record (fifth place in the N.L. Central)...Won 15 games in their last at-bat last season (most since having 16 in 2021)...Played in 51 one-run games in 2024, their most since 2018 (also 51).

TAMPA BAY TIMES: Pittsburgh's season-opening, seven-game road trip concludes with this three-game series against Tampa Bay...It will mark the fifth time that the Bucs play the Rays on the road during interleague play (also 2003, 2014, 2022 and 2023).

I'VE BEEN EVERYWHERE: Tonight, the Pirates will play in a regular-season game at George M. Steinbrenner Field for the first time...When Andrew McCutchen appears in a game here, it will be the 37th stadium he's played at least one game in since making his MLB debut in 2009, per the Elias Sports Bureau...Out of 30 active stadiums, the only ones he hasn't played at besides Steinbrenner are Globe Life Field (Rangers) and Sutter Health Park (Athletics)...He's also played in games at eight stadiums not currently in use by a Major League team (Globe Life Park, Hubert H. Humphrey Metrodome, Oakland Coliseum, Sahlen Field, Sun Life Stadium, TD Ballpark, Tropicana Field and Turner Field)...McCutchen appeared in one game at Historic Bowman Field in Williamsport, PA, when Pittsburgh was in the 2017 Little League Classic.

CUTCH: Andrew McCutchen collected the 800th extra-base hit of his Major League career with his home run leading off the second inning Sunday at Miami...His 611 extra-base hits with Pittsburgh rank fifth in Pirates history, while his 800 Major League extra-base hits are third-most among all active players...McCutchen is also just three RBI shy of 1100 for his Major League career, and he ranks fifth among active players on that list (LAD's Freddie Freeman leads with 1236, while NYY's Giancarlo Stanton is six RBI ahead of McCutchen with 1103)...McCutchen is now also tied with Arky Vaughan for 10th on the Pirates' all-time runs list (936)...Tommy Leach is ninth (1009).

LET'S GET IT STARTED: Andrew Heaney allowed one run in 5.0 innings while making his Pirate debut Sunday afternoon in Miami...Pittsburgh's starters have produced a 2.42 ERA (22.1ip/6er) through its first four games of the 2025 season...That's the ninth-best in MLB and the third-lowest in the National League...The only two starting rotations in the National League that have produced a lower earned run average so far in 2025 are the Nationals (1.04) and Rockies (1.17).

TAKE A WALK: The Pirates have walked a Major-League leading 25 times in their first four games of the 2025 season...Individually, Oneil Cruz ranks second in Major League Baseball with six walks (four of which came on Saturday at Miami)...Atlanta's Marcell Ozuna leads the way with seven.

BUCS ON THE BASES: With a steal from Jack Suwinski in Sunday's game at Miami, Pittsburgh has now swiped 15 bases through its first four games of the season...The 15 steals through four games are Pittsburgh's most through four games in a season since at least 1900, per the Elias Sports Bureau, surpassing the previous mark of 10 steals, set in 1907...The 15 steals are also tied for second-most by any Major League team through four games since at least 1900, per Elias, trailing only the 1903 New York Giants (16 steals)...Seven different Pirates have stolen at least one base, including five players with multiple steals (Cruz 4, Kiner-Falefa 3, Hayes 2, Pham 2, Suwinski 2).

SPEED DEMONS: Jack Suwinski's steal Sunday at Miami was Pittsburgh's 15th in a row without being caught to start 2025 (streak snapped when Endy Rodríguez was caught stealing in the ninth inning)...Per the Elias Sports Bureau, that was the longest streak by a Pirates team since caught stealings were first tracked in the National League in 1951, surpassing the streak of 14 straight successful steals to begin the season by the 1981 team...It also marked the longest streak by any Major League team to begin a season since the 2015 Cincinnati Reds were successful on each of their first 17 stolen base attempts.

GUIDING THE SHIP: On Friday, sixth-year manager Derek Shelton earned his 295th win with Pittsburgh, tying him with Gene Lamont for 12th on the Pirates' all-time managerial wins list...Billy Meyer ranks 11th with 317 victories...Shelton spent seven seasons (2010-16) as Tampa Bay's hitting coach, working under Joe Maddon and current manager Kevin Cash.

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

March 31, 2014: Neil Walker hit a walkoff, solo home run off Carlos Villanueva to lift the Pirates to a 1-0, 10-inning win over the Cubs on Opening Day at PNC Park. It was the first walkoff hit of Walker's career and Pittsburgh's first walkoff homer on Opening Day since Bob Bailey broke a scoreless tie in the 10th inning with a solo homer off San Francisco's Juan Marichal on April 12, 1965.

HOW ACQUIRED: Selected in Comp. Balance A round (No. 31) of the 2020 Draft.

STARTING OFF: Last name is pronounced ma-JINSK-ee...This marked Mlodzinski's first season as a member of the team's Opening Day roster...The 26-year-old righthander is in his third season with the Pirates...Mlodzinski was drafted as the team's Competitive Balance Round A selection (31st overall pick) in the 2020 First-Year Player Draft.

VS. TAMPA BAY: Mlodzinski will be making the second appearance (both starts) of his career against the Rays...On June 21 of last season at PNC Park in Pittsburgh, he made one of his four "spot" starts of 2024, allowing a run on four hits across 1.2 innings.

SPRING TRAINING RECAP: Mlodzinski made a total of four appearances (two starts) during spring training...He last pitched in a game on March 15 against the Orioles at LECOM Park, striking out three and allowing just one run in 3.0 innings on 64 pitches.

AS A STARTER: Tonight will be Mlodzinski's sixth career Major League start...He opened a total of four times during the 2024 season, where he went 0-1 with a 1.42 ERA (6.1ip/1er)...Mlodzinski's last game as a starter came on September 10 against the Marlins at PNC Park, when he tossed 2.0 scoreless innings in Pittsburgh's 6-4 win... Of Mlodzinski's five Major League starts, none have been for more than 2.0 innings.

- Carmen spent his first two professional seasons as a starter from 2021-22, making 36 starts in that time between High-A Greensboro and Double-A Altoona...Also started 14 of 26 games in college at South Carolina (2018-20).

FINISHING 2024 STRONG: Mlodzinski posted a 1.98 ERA (13.2ip/3er) over his final 12 appearances of the 2024 season...He went 3-0 with a .167 batting average against (8-for-48) during those 12 outings, all of which came in the month of September.

SAVE IT: Mlodzinski has one save in his big-league career, which came on September 23, 2023 at Cincinnati...The Pirates rallied from being down 9-0 after three innings, staging their largest come-from-behind win in 137 seasons of National League play.

2023 IN REVIEW: Mlodzinski reached the big leagues for the first time in 2023, making his Major League debut on June 16 at Milwaukee...In total, he appeared in 35 games (one start), posting a 3-3 record with 11 holds, one save, 2.25 ERA (36.0ip/9er), 34 strikeouts and 18 walks...He held opponents scoreless in 24 of his 35 outings.

AS A PROSPECT: Mlodzinski entered the 2022 season rated by Baseball America as the No. 10 prospect in Pittsburgh's minor-league system...He began the 2021 season ranked by MLB Pipeline as Pittsburgh's 10th-best prospect...At the end of the 2020 season, he had the "best changeup" in Pittsburgh's system, according to MLB Pipeline.

BEFORE THE BUCS: Mlodzinski grew up playing shortstop before beginning to pitch as a junior in high school...Is a 2017 graduate of Hilton Head (SC) High School, where he was a Rawlings-Perfect Game Atlantic All-Region first-team selection in 2017.

- Also pitched at the University of South Carolina, where he made three starts in 2019 as the No. 1 starter before suffering a broken left foot that ended his season on March 1...Was one of 55 players named to the 2020 pre-season Golden Spikes Award (nation's top amateur player) watch list.
