CINCINNATI REDS (75-71) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (54-91)

September 16, 2021 at PNC Park, Pittsburgh, PA -- GAME #146/HOME #76 RHP TYLER MAHLE (11-5, 3.73 ERA) vs. RHP CONNOR OVERTON (0-0, 0.00 ERA)

THE PIRATES... have won four of their last five games and six of their last eight after losing six in a row (three by one run)...Have gone 12-12 in their last 24 games after losing 13-for-14...Collected a season-high 19 hits and 14 runs against the Brewers on 8/14 (game 1)...Have won a season-high three straight games on four occasions (last time before and after the All-Star break from 7/11-17).

SWEEP MUSIC: A victory today would give the Pirates their first sweep of the Reds since August 23-25, 2019 at PNC Park... It would also be their first series sweep of any team since taking two at St. Louis last year on 8/27 (DH sweep)...Pittsburgh's last three-game sweep came over the Brewers at PNC Park last season (August 21-23)...The Pirates are making their 14th attempt at a series sweep this afternoon; they are the only team in MLB without a sweep of a series of any length this season.

HITTIN' THE ROAD: Following the game today the Pirates embark on a 10-game road trip to Miami (three games), Cincinnati (three) and Philadelphia (four)...It will be their final road trip of the season...The Bucs have lost each of their last seven games played on the road and have gone 2-15 in their last 17 (they won two-of-three in St. Louis August 20-22).

<u>SEE YOU IN FOUR DAYS:</u> The Bucs and Reds are scheduled to meet again in a three-game series in Cincinnati beginning Monday night...The two teams, who are scheduled to play each other nine times over the final three weeks (19 games), are also playing the final three games of the regular season at PNC Park...The Bucs have gone 3-9 in the 2021 season series against the Reds...<u>The Pirates have gone 23-8 in the last 30 games played against Cincinnati at PNC Park.</u>

ABOUT TODAY'S STARTER: Connor Overton will became the 15th different starting pitcher used by the Pirates this season, which will be tied for the sixth-most by any team in MLB along with the Twins, Yankees, Mariners and Blue Jays...The only teams in MLB to use more starters this season are the Dodgers (19), Marlins (18), Mets (18), Angels (16) and Diamondbacks (16)...Pittsburgh's club record for starters used in a season is 18, which was established in 1996.

WALKING IT OFF: Last night the Pirates recorded their ninth walkoff win of the season and their first against the Reds since September 6 of last season...The nine walkoffs are the most by the Pirates since recording 10 in 2017.

THE YOSHI SHOW: In his 26 games with the Pirates, **Yoshi Tsutsugo** is hitting .309 (21-for-68) with five doubles, a triple, seven home runs and 19 RBI while producing a 1.121 OPS...Yoshi is also hitting .467 (7-for-15) and has produced 12 RBI while batting with runners in scoring position with the Pirates.

HOME COOKIN': The Bucs are 6-2 on their longest homestand of the season against the Tigers (2-1), Nationals (2-1) and Reds (2-0)...The 11-day, nine-game stay in Pittsburgh concludes with this afternoon's game against Cincinnati...The Pirates have gone 10-5 in their last 15 home games.

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: In their last five series played at PNC Park, the Pirates have gone 4-0-1...Beginning with their series win over the Indians from June 18-20, the Bucs have gone 8-4-2 in the last 14 series played on their home turf.

59 BUCS: With his appearance on Sunday, RHP **Connor Overton** became the 59th different player to appear in at least one game for the Pirates in 2021, a club record for most players used in one season (previous mark was 55 players in 2016)...In addition, there has now been club record 35 different players who have pitched in at least one game in 2021, which eclipses the previous mark of 34, established in 2019.

NEWMAN!: Kevin Newman enters today's action with an eight-game hitting streak (10-for-24, .400) while also hitting safely in 10 of his last 11 games and .317 (20-for-63) in his last 19 games played at PNC Park...Newman leads all Major League shortstops in fielding percentage (.993), having made just three errors in 419 total chances at the position.

<u>STRATTON HIS STUFF:</u> Chris Stratton has made a career-high 61 appearances and ranks tied for second among National League relief pitchers with 72.1 innings pitched this season...<u>His 102.1 innings pitched over the last two seasons are the most among all Major League relievers</u>...Stratton has earned a win and three saves in each of his last four appearances.

COMING THRU IN A PINCH: Wilmer Difo has a Major League-leading 15 pinch-hits this season, the most by a Pirates player in a season since **Delwyn Young** had 16 in 2010...As a team, the Pirates rank seventh in MLB with 51 pinch hits, seventh in pinch-hit RBI (30) and are tied for fifth with eight pinch-hit home runs.

FROM THE TOP SPOT: Ke'Bryan Hayes has led off each of the last nine games and has gone 12-for-38 (.316) with a double, four RBI and seven runs scored while hitting safely in seven of the nine contests...He has gone 5-for-9 in the first inning.

THE LIFE OF BRYAN: Bryan Reynolds ranks seventh among the National League leaders in hits (152) and fifth in OBP (.385)...He has recorded the fourth-most total bases (259) by any outfielder in all of Major League Baseball this season, trailing only Baltimore's Cedric Mullins (285), Cincinnati's Nick Castellanos (270) and Philadelphia's Bryce Harper (263)... His 59 extra-base hits are the third-most among all National League outfielders behind Harper (66) and Castellanos (64).

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

September 16, 1975: The Pirates defeated the Cubs, 22-0, at Wrigley Field in the most one-sided shutout since 1900. Rennie Stennett set a Major League record by going 7-for-7 in the contest that featured 24 hits for the Pirates and just three for the Cubs. Dave Parker knocked in five runs, while Willie Stargell and Frank Taveras had three hits and three RBI apiece.
