YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles defeated the Yankees, 7-2, to secure the four-game series win... Have gone 12-0-4 in their last 16 series against the AL East since late April 2023... **Jorge Mateo**, **Ryan McKenna**, and **Ryan Mountcastle** each homered in the win; Baltimore's 10 games with at least three home runs lead MLB... **Kyle Bradish** was reinstated from the Injured List prior to the game to make his first start of the season and struck out five in 4.2 innings.

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles lead MLB with 48 home runs, tied for the second-most homers through the first 31 games in O's history with 1996 and trailing only 2012 (50); the most long balls through Baltimore's first 32 games of a season is 50 by the 2012 team.

♫ The Orioles are the only MLB team with five players who have hit at least five home runs: **Gunnar Henderson** (10), **Colton Cowser** and **Cedric Mullins** (6), and **Ryan Mountcastle** and **Jordan Westburg** (5); the Brewers, Dodgers, Phillies, and Yankees are tied for second with four players each.

AL PLAYER OF THE MONTH: Major League Baseball today announced that **Gunnar Henderson** was voted the American League Player of the Month for March/April... Marks Henderson's second career monthly honor after winning AL Rookie of the Month in June 2023... He is the first Orioles Player of the Month winner since **Manny Machado** in August 2017... Overall, he is the 14th Oriole (21st occurrence) to claim the award.

♫ Henderson slashed .291/.356/.624 (34-for-117) with three doubles, three triples, 10 home runs, 25 runs scored, 24 RBI, eight walks, and six stolen bases in 29 March/April games.

♫ For the month, he led the AL in slugging, total bases (73), and FWAR (2.2), and ranked tied for the MLB lead in home runs.

♫ He also ranked among AL leaders in March/April in extra-base hits (T-2nd, 16), triples (T-2nd), runs (T-2nd), OPS (4th, .980), RBI (T-4th), hits (T-8th), and stolen bases (T-8th).

♫ Henderson became the first 22-year-old in MLB history to reach double-digit home runs before May 1; Trevor Story, at 23 years, 167 days old, held the previous mark with 10 home runs through April 30, 2016 with Colorado.

♫ Henderson's nine homers in April are tied with **Chris Davis** (2013) and **Machado** (2018) for third in club history, trailing **Frank Robinson** (10 in 1969) and **Brady Anderson** (11 in 1996).

♫ Homered in three straight games for the second time in his career from April 15-17.

AL ROOKIE OF THE MONTH: Major League Baseball today announced that **Colton Cowser** was voted the American League Rookie of the Month for March/April... Marks Cowser's first career monthly honor and the first Orioles winner since **Gunnar Henderson** in June 2023... Overall, he is the seventh Oriole to claim the award; in addition to Henderson, Cowser joins **Rodrigo Lopez** (July 2002), **Nick Markakis** (August 2006), **Nolan Reimold** (June 2009), **Brian Matusz** (August 2010), and **Ryan Mountcastle** (June 2021) as Orioles winners.

♫ Cowser slashed .303/.372/.632 (23-for-76) with seven doubles, six home runs, 12 runs scored, 18 RBI, nine walks, and three stolen bases in 28 March/April games.

♫ For the month, he led MLB rookies in slugging, OPS (1.004), extra-base hits (13), total bases (48), and RBI, while ranking tied for the lead in home runs.

♫ Hit his first two Major League home runs on April 11 at Boston; according to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, Cowser became the seventh player since the team moved to Baltimore in 1954 to hit his first two career home runs in the same game, and first since **Ryan Mountcastle** on August 30, 2020 at Toronto's Sahlen Field.

♫ Homered four times in four games from April 11-14, the first Orioles rookie to do so since Mountcastle from June 16-19, 2021.

♫ Homered in back-to-back games twice: April 11-12 and April 21-22.

♫ Recorded 10 RBI in the three-game set in Boston from April 9-11, becoming the first O's player to drive in 10 runs in a series at Fenway Park; according to MLB.com's Sarah Langs (@SlangOnSports), he became the seventh player since RBI became an official statistic in 1920 to drive in at least 10 runs in a three-game series (or shorter) as a visitor at Fenway.

♫ Named the AL Player of the Week for the week of April 8-14, his first career weekly award.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: **Gunnar Henderson** and **Colton Cowser** have been voted American League Player and Rookie of the Month, respectively, for March/April... It marks the first time in team history that the O's have claimed both awards in the same month... The last MLB team to do so was the Dodgers in August 2023: Mookie Betts (Player) and James Outman (Rookie)... The last occurrence among AL teammates was the Guardians in April 2022: José Ramirez (Player) and Steven Kwan (Rookie).

MINOR LEAGUE PLAYERS AND PITCHERS OF THE MONTH: Minor League Baseball today announced the Player and Pitcher of the Month Award winners for April in each of the 11 full-season leagues in Major League Baseball's player development system... The Orioles, along with the Mariners, led with three selections.

♫ **Heston Kjerstad** (Norfolk) has been named the International League Player of the Month after leading the league in home runs (10), RBI (26), and slugging percentage (.770).

♫ **Cade Povich** (Norfolk) has been named the International League Pitcher of the Month after going 2-1 with a 1.03 ERA (3 ER/26.1IP) in five starts with a league-best 40 strikeouts.

♫ **Creed Willems** (Aberdeen) has been named the South Atlantic League Player of the Month after leading the league in total bases (43), RBI (21), and slugging percentage (.642), and ranking tied for the lead in home runs (6).

THE PLACES YOU'LL GO: The Orioles wrapped up a seven-game homestand yesterday, going 4-3 overall against the A's (1-2) and Yankees (3-1)... The Birds are now on a five-game road trip in Cincinnati (3 G) and Washington (2 G)... The club has scheduled off days on May 6 and May 9... The O's are 8-4 on the road to begin year.

AGAINST THE REDS: The Orioles and Reds open their only series of the season tonight with the first of three games at Great American Ballpark... The O's dropped two out of three against the Redlegs last year from June 26-28 at Oriole Park... Marks the first trip to Cincy for the Birds since they dropped two out of three from July 29-31, 2022... Baltimore and Cincinnati have only squared off in the regular season 18 times in team history (since 1954), with the O's holding a 10-8 advantage in those matchups; the 18 regular-season games against the Reds are tied for Baltimore's fewest against a single active opponent with the Cardinals and Dodgers, who the Birds will travel to for three games each later this season... The Orioles and Reds first met in the regular season in 2005, but faced off in the 1970 World Series, with the Orioles defeating the Big Red Machine, 4-1, to win their second World Series title.

SWEEPLESS IN BALTIMORE: The Orioles have gone 101 consecutive regular-season series of at least two decisions (no ties) without being swept... According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, that is the fourth-longest regular-season streak in MLB history, trailing the 1942-44 St. Louis Cardinals (124), 1906-09 Chicago Cubs (115), and 1903-05 New York Giants (105)... Baltimore's current streak is the longest in O's history, ahead of 46 such series from 1971-72... The Birds have not been swept in a regular-season series of at least two games since May 13-15, 2022 at Detroit (0-3), and not at home in a series of at least two games since August 27-29, 2021 vs. Tampa Bay (0-3)... The Orioles were swept by the Rangers in three games in the 2023 ALDS.

ORIOLES HALL OF FAME: The Orioles today announced that former right fielder **Nick Markakis** and former hitting coach and first baseman/designated hitter **Terry Crowley** have been elected to the Orioles Hall of Fame... Additionally, longtime former Orioles scout **Dick Bowie** will be inducted as this year's Herb Armstrong Award winner for non-uniformed Orioles personnel... The three honorees will be recognized on Friday, August 23, at a luncheon at Oriole Park hosted by the Oriole Advocates, founders of the Orioles Hall of Fame... The on-field induction ceremony will be held on Saturday, August 24, prior to the 4:05 p.m. ET game against the Houston Astros... Information on purchasing tickets for the Oriole Advocates Hall of Fame Luncheon will be announced soon... To purchase tickets for the induction ceremony and game, visit Orioles.com/Tickets.

THE SKIPPER: Manager **Brandon Hyde** is in his sixth season in Baltimore... The 2023 BBWAA AL Manager of the Year has 335 career wins, fifth all-time among Orioles managers.

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his sixth start of the season this evening against Cincinnati...Made his fifth Opening Day roster...Began the 2023 campaign in the starting rotation with the big-league club; had four stints with the Orioles after being optioned to Triple-A Norfolk on April 14, May 21, and September 13; recalled from the Tides on May 16, June 10, and October 1...Owned a 1-4 record with a 4.81 ERA (31 ER/58.0 IP) in 12 starts and pitched to a 3.26 ERA (7 ER/19.1 IP) in 12 relief appearances with the O's...Did not appear on the ALDS roster...Acquired by the Orioles along with RHP Kyle Virbitsky from the Oakland Athletics in exchange for INF Darell Hernaiz on January 26, 2023.

LAST TIME OUT: Picked up the win on April 27 vs. Oakland, allowing four hits and one hit batter with five strikeouts across 7.0 shutout innings against his former team...Marked his longest start as an Oriole...Extended his scoreless streak to 14.1 innings, the longest scoreless-inning streak of his career, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*...Threw 89 pitches, 63 strikes.

AGAINST THE REDS: Making his second career start and fourth appearance against the Reds...Owns a lifetime 1.69 ERA (1 ER/5.1 IP) in his three prior outings against Cincinnati...Did not factor into the decision of his only prior start on June 26, 2023 at Oriole Park after allowing one run on three hits with three strikeouts across 3.0 innings.

AGAINST THE NL CENTRAL: Owns a lifetime 0-2 record and 5.50 ERA (11 ER/18.0 IP) in seven career appearances (3 GS) against the NL Central...Opponents are slashing .278/.333/.542 (20-for-72).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Slated to make his third road start of the season...Has pitched to a 1-0 record with a 3.86 ERA (5 ER/11.2 IP) in his two prior road starts this year.

NIGHT OWL: Scheduled to make his fourth night start of the season; he's gone 0-1 with a 6.75 ERA (11 ER/14.2 IP) in his first three night outings this year.

MAYDAY: Owns a 3-6 record and a 4.59 ERA (34 ER/66.2 IP) across 12 career appearances (11 GS) in May; marks his second highest ERA of any month behind a 5.81 (48 ER/74.1 IP) mark in September...Opponents are slashing .260/.300/.405 (68-for-262).

2023 HIGHLIGHTS: Tossed a career-high 4.0 innings of relief on July 18 vs. Los Angeles-NL...Did not allow more than one earned run in five straight starts from June 26-August 19, the longest such streak of his career...Pitched for Norfolk in Game Two of the International League Championship Series on September 27 vs. Durham; tossed 3.0 scoreless innings with two hits and five strikeouts.

Scheduled to make his season debut with Baltimore after beginning the season on the 15-day Injured List with a left forearm strain...Made six rehab starts with Norfolk, pitching to an 8.68 ERA (18 ER/18.2 IP) with 22 strikeouts and seven walks...Threw 7.0 shutout innings in his final rehab appearance with the Tides on April 28 vs. Gwinnett; allowed one hit, one walk, and one hit batter with eight strikeouts...Began the 2023 season on the 60-day Injured List following left elbow UCL surgery...Went 1-2 with a 2.66 ERA (7 ER/23.2 IP) and 10 strikeouts across four starts last year...Will be making his first career start against Cincinnati.
