#STLFLY: The St. Louis Cardinals continue on their final regular season road trip, a seven-day, eight-game excursion to Milwaukee (Sept. 20-23) and Chicago (Sept. 24-26). Today, the Cardinals continue on their road trip to Chicago where they will play a split doubleheader against their longtime rivals, the Cubs at Wrigley Field with two seven-innings games. The Cardinals are coming off a four-game sweep of Milwaukee and have won seven straight road games and 12 games overall. Entering play today, the Cardinals are 7.5 games behind first place Milwaukee in the N.L. Central and 4.5 games up on Philadelphia for the second Wild Card slot. Their magic number to clinch a postseason bid is six.

THE DIRTY DOZEN: The Cardinals extended their winning streak to 12 games yesterday afternoon with their largest comeback win of the season, erasing a 5-0 deficit to win 8-5. The current win streak started on Sept. 11, with a four-run comeback against Cincinnati. The last time the Cardinals won 13 straight was July 2-18, 1935 when they set the franchise record with 14 straight wins. Over their 130-year history, the Cardinals have 13 double-digit win streaks.

A WINNING TRADITION: With their 82nd win Wednesday night, the Cardinals have a winning record for 14 consecutive season, all under President of Baseball Operations, **John Mozeliak**, since he was hired to his post on October 31, 2007. The Cardinals franchise record for consecutive winning seasons is 15 (1939-53), while the New York Yankees hold the all-time mark at 29.

A SEPTEMBER TO REMEMBER: The 12-game win streak by the Cardinals beginning on Sept. 11, is the longest win streak after Sept. 1 by the franchise and the longest since the Cleveland Indians won 15 straight in 2017. *Elias*

SEPTEMBER SURGE: The Cardinals have moved their record in September to 16-6 (.727), tied for the best record in Major League Baseball with the Toronto Blue Jays. The best Septmeber in Cardinals history was 21-4 in both 1930 and 1942, with the current mark (.727) ranking T-8th best September and best since 2002 (21-6, .778). Since the start of the century, the Cardinals' .568 (338-257) winning percentage in September ranks first among National League teams and second in MLB (New York Yankees, .587).

DOWN THE STRETCH THEY COME: The Cardinals continue their final 20-game stretch to close out the regular season, starting 10-0 vs. New York (3-0), San Diego (3-0) and Milwaukee (4-0) ... St. Louis' best 20-game finishes to a season include a 17-3 mark (1942), 16-4 finishes (2002, 1930) and 15-5 surges (2013, 2011, 2001).

ROOKIE RIPPER: Cardinals rookie outfielder **Dylan Carlson** has 59 RBI and needs one more to set the Cardinals franchise rookie record for RBI by a switch-hitter passing the mark established by **Ripper Collins** set in 1931.

FINALE FEDERALE: Since the start of September, Cardinals relief pitcher **Giovanny Gallegos** has nailed down 9-of-10 save opportunities. He currently ranks T-14th among National league relievers with 12 saves and has the most saves in MLB during the month of September. The nine saves are the most in September by a Cardinal since **Juan Acevedo** set the franchise record going 10-for-10 in 1998.

TERRIFYING TRIFECTA: **Paul Goldschmidt** clubed a pair of home runs yesterday (20th career multi-HR game), bringing him to 29 on the season, tied with **Tyler O'Neill** for 2nd on the Cardinals behind **Nolan Arenado** (33). They are seeking to become just the second trio of Cardinals to each hit 30+ HR in the same season since the 2004 MVP3 of **Albert Pujols** (46), **Jim Edmonds** (42), and **Scott Rolen** (32).

THE THREE AMIGOS: The Cardinals bullpen includes three of the Top 7 relievers in the National League in terms of appearances with **Giovanny Gallegos** T-3rd with 69 and **Alex Reyes** and **Génesis Cabrera** T-7th at 67. Both Reyes and Cabrera are one appearance shy of 100 for their careers.

PONCHÉ: With **Giovanny Gallegos'** two strikeouts yesterday, the Cardinals have two relief pitchers (**Alex Reyes**) with 90 or more strikeouts for the first time in franchise history. The New York Yankees set the bar with four relievers posting 90+ stirkeouts season in 2018 (**Dellin Betances**, **Chad Green**, **Aroldis Chapman** & **David Robertson**), while the Houston Astros set the National League mark in 2003 (**Octavio Dotel**, **Brad Lidge** & **Billy Wagner**).

CHICAGO CONNECTIONS

Jon Lester pitched five seasons with the Cubs (2015-19) posting a 74-41 record and helped the team to their first World Championship in 2016.

Matt Carpenter (June 11, 2011 at Busch), **Tyler O'Neill** (April 19, 2018 at Wrigley), **Andrew Knizner** (June 2, 2019 at Busch), **Tommy Edman** (June 8, 2019 at Wrigley), and **Johan Oviedo** (Aug. 19, 2020-2 at Wrigley) made MLB debuts against the Cubs.

Paul DeJong graduated from Antioch (Ill.) Comm. High School...played college baseball at Illinois State University (2013-15) while majoring in bio-chemistry and pre-medicine.

Tommy Edman (junior) and **Nico Hoerner** (freshman) were teammates at Stanford Univ. in 2016.

Mike Maddux's younger brother, **Greg Maddux**, was a Hall of Fame pitcher for Chicago for parts of 10 seasons (1986-92, '04-06).

Jason Heyward played 2015 with St. Louis...traded by Atlanta with **Jordan Walden** to St. Louis for **Tyrell Jenkins** and **Shelby Miller** (Nov. 17, 2014).

As back-to-back compensation picks for the departures of **John Lackey** and **Jason Heyward** signing with Chicago in 2016, **Dylan Carlson** (No. 33) and **Dakota Hudson** (No. 34) were selected by St. Louis in Compensation Round A of the first round of the 2016 MLB draft.

TODAY'S GAME

- Making his 29th start of the season and 327th career start (353rd app.).
- Making his 10th start as a member of the Cardinals, his 8th Major League organization joining the Phillies (2007-10), Astros (2010-12), Blue Jays (2012-14, '16-18), Mariners (2015), Pirates (2015), Yankees (2018-20), and Twins (2021).
- Is 4-2, 4.33 ERA (43.2 IP/21 ER) in his nine starts with St. Louis.
- Seeking the ninth 10+ win season in his career which would rank T-6th among active pitchers and T-2nd among active lefties (Lester-11 is 1st).
- Went a perfect 3-0 in August and was 2nd on the team in ERA (2.22), trailing only Adam Wainwright (5-1, 1.43). All three wins came in road games. Ranked 11th among NL pitchers with his 2.22 ERA (min. 25.0 IP) in August.
- Is 4-1, 3.75 ERA in seven starts vs. NL Central clubs this season with a .200 Opp. BA.
- Has yielded 29 home runs in 142.0 innings pitched this season. His 1.84 homers/9 IP ratio is the 3rd highest of his career and ranks 3rd-highest among MLB starters.
- 18 of 29 homers have been solo (T7th most in MLB), including seven of the last nine.
- Ranks 10th among active pitchers with 326 starts trailing teammates Jon Lester (449, 3rd) & Adam Wainwright (356, 8th).
- Ranks 4th among active left-handed pitchers with 132 career wins (Jon Lester 200, Clayton Kershaw 185, David Price 154).
- Prior to his Cardinals debut on Aug. 4, previously had pitched in the N.L. in 2015 when he went 7-2 in part of a season with Pittsburgh.
- Became the 10th different left-hander to pitch for St. Louis this season, tying the 1993 Cardinals for most in single-season franchise history.

- Activated from the Injured List today and makes 15th start of the season (90th career).
- Missed 60 games (June 1-Aug. 12) with a left oblique strain in May and 28 additional games (Aug. 25-Sept. 23) after suffering a right shoulder strain in August.
