TODAY'S GAME: San Francisco will try and get the series even this evening against their former prospect in Brewers starter LHP Kyle Harrison after dropping last night's game by a 16-2 margin.

- ▶ The Giants enter today having lost six of their last seven, seven of their last 10 and 13 of their last 18 dating to May 13...since May 13, the Giants 5-13 record is tied for worst in the National League with the Chicago Cubs (who the Giants visit after this series).
- ▶ Overall, the Giants enter today with the second-worst record in the National League, a half a game better than the Colorado Rockies at 23-38.

WELCOME: Earlier today the Giants announced that they have hired longtime Major League coach **Gary Pettis** as their new third base coach...Pettis is slated to join the team tomorrow in Milwaukee.

- ▶ Pettis, who has 22 years of coaching experience in the Majors and 27 years overall, most recently served as the third base coach for the Houston Astros from 2015-2024.
- ▶ The Oakland native has been a coach on six different teams that have reached the World Series (2010 and 2011 with Texas, and 2017, 2019, 2021 and 2022 with Houston)....he won World Series' with Houston in 2017 and 2022.

A MILLI: San Francisco has alternated winning and losing series here in Milwaukee since 2021 (winning the series here in 2021, 2023 and 2025)...overall, the Giants are 9-7 here at American Family Field since 2021.

- ▶ Last night's 14-run defeat at the hands of the Brewers was their largest in their head-to-head matchup with the Giants since the two teams started playing one another in 1998 when Milwaukee joined the National League.
- ▶ The 14-run margin of victory for Milwaukee also matched the largest margin of victory by either team in their head-to-head history...SF beat the Brewers here in Milwaukee 15-1 just over three years ago on May 26, 2023.
- ▶ Lastly, the 16 runs allowed by Giants pitching were the most they've allowed in a single game to Milwaukee in the head-to-head series all-time (previous high was 13 on three different occasions).

T-MAC: RHP Trevor McDonald makes his sixth start of the season for the Giants and the first of his career against the Brewers...the Giants won each of his first three outings this year before dropping each of his last two starts.

- ▶ McDonald had a nice bounce-back outing last Wednesday vs. Arizona albeit in a losing effort...he allowed three runs (two earned) on six hits in 6.1 innings in the Giants' 3-2 loss to the Diamondbacks.
- ▶ Outside of one very rough inning vs. the White Sox on May 22 (he allowed seven runs on three hits with a walk and two hit batters while only getting two outs in the 4th inning), McDonald has given up seven earned runs in his other 28.1 innings pitched (2.22 ERA).

BUCKLE UP: It is slated to be a tough month schedule-wise for the Giants as entering the month their June opponents had a combined .562 winning percentage, giving the Giants the toughest June schedule in the Majors...second on that list was the New York Mets with their June opponents having a .542 win % (NBC Sports Bay Area).

- ▶ In reality it's not much different for San Francisco who to this point have had the third-toughest schedule in the Majors behind the Cubs and Nationals (both with opponent winning percentages of .531)...the Giants' opponents to date have had a .527 win %.

DON'T STOP ME NOW: OF Jung Hoo Lee has hit safely in nine straight games entering play today, going 17-36 (.472) with two doubles, a triple, a homer, five RBI and eight runs...the nine-game streak is two shy of his career-best 11-game hit streak from April 7-20, 2024.

- ▶ Lee hasn't struck out in 10 straight games and his last 43 plate appearances, the longest active such streak in MLB just ahead of PIT's Spencer Horwitz (42 straight PAs)...the third-longest active streak belongs to Lee's teammate, **IF Luis Arraez** (29 PAs).

FARMVILLE: As the calendar flips to June, the Giants minor league organization continues to pace Minor League Baseball with its .630 combined winning percentage entering the month of June...SF's affiliates are 143-84 (.630) with a +290 run differential ahead of the Nationals (135-91, .597, +133 run diff) and Dodgers (128-101, .559, +157 run diff).

T-MAC: Was the Giants' 11th-round pick in 2019 out of George County High School in Lucedale, MS...originally committed to South Alabama for college ball before signing...made his debut with SF during the final game of the 2024 season and has made appearances at the Major League level in each season since.

LAST TIME OUT: Bounced back from a tough start in his previous outing on May 22 vs. Chicago-AL with 6.1 innings against Arizona last Wednesday in SF's homestand finale...he allowed three runs (two earned) on six hits and struck out six but it wasn't enough in SF's 3-2 loss.

VS. MILWAUKEE: Is facing the Brewers for the first time in his young career.

INFLATION: McDonald's 4.34 ERA heading into this outing is largely because of his tough 4th inning against the White Sox on May 22... after opening that game with three perfect innings, he allowed seven runs (all earned) on three hits, a walk and two hit batters before departing...his ERA with the Giants outside of that one inning this year is 2.22 (7er, 28.1ip).

IN ACTUALITY...: Since making his first spot start with SF on May 4 vs. San Diego (and then eventually joining the rotation when **RHP Logan Webb** went down with right knee bursitis), McDonald's 4.34 ERA is actually second-best among Giants starters in that time... only **Adrian Houser** (3.81 ERA in five starts since May 4) has been better...SF's other starters in that time all have ERAs north of five (**Landen Roupp** - 5.92 ERA in five starts, **Robbie Ray** a 7.04 ERA in five starts, Webb a 7.56 ERA in two starts and **Tyler Mahle** a 7.84 ERA in four starts).

IN THE MAJORS: When his number has been called at the Major League level he's been effective except for his rough 4th inning vs. the White Sox two starts ago (0.2ip, 3h, 7r)...he made his MLB debut on the last day of the season in 2024, tossing 3.0 scoreless innings of relief...in three games (two starts) last year he went 1-0 with a 1.80 ERA (3er, 15.0ip) with SF winning both of his starts...in his brief MLB career thus far he owns a 3.26 ERA (17er, 47.0ip) with 42 strikeouts in nine games (seven starts)...the Giants are 5-2 in McDonald's seven career starts.

GROUNDING: In his three starts this year he's logged a 60.7% groundball rate...for comparison's sake, the Angels' Jack Kochanowicz currently leads qualified starters with a 57.4% groundball rate...McDonald's teammate **RHP Landen Roupp** is eighth at 51.2%.

STAND MIXER: McDonald has had some heavy sinker usage in each of his last few outings to account for its 60.1% usage rate for his five starts thus far with the Giants...last time out against the D-Backs, 52 of his 86 total pitches were sinkers (60.5%), which was down from his usage vs. the White Sox when over 71% of his pitches were sinkers (47-of-66)...his slider, which has a usage rate of 26.9% and was his most valuable pitch last season in terms of run value in limited action (+4), is his most used secondary pitch this season with hitters going 3-for-28 off it (.107) with two XBH (both doubles).

ORDER UP...: He's been at his best the first time through the order this year with hitters going a combined 5-for-43 (.116) with a .411 OPS...it goes upward from there with opposing hitters hitting .282 with a .685 OPS the second time through and .296 with a .799 OPS the third time through...in his last outing vs. Arizona, the D-Backs were a combined 1-for-16 the first two times through and 5-for-8 from then on.

IN TRIPLE-A IN 2026: Went 1-1 with a 5.40 ERA (9er, 15.0ip), 12 strikeouts and a 1.53 WHIP in five Triple-A games (four starts) for Sacramento...was much better at home (1-0 with a 2.79 ERA in three games) than on the road (0-1 with a 10.13 ERA in two games).

LOGAN WEBB RHP #62

2026 RECORD: 2-4, 4.82 ERA

- ▶ Will make his second start since returning from the injured list last Friday...missed 20 games with right knee bursitis.
- ▶ Held Rockies batters to just one run on three hits over 4.1 innings in his return last Friday, striking out five.
- ▶ Is a perfect 4-0 with a 2.08 ERA (10er, 43.1ip) in seven career starts vs. the Brewers, limiting them to a .195 average, 0.99 WHIP and 50 strikeouts (10.38K/9ip).
- ▶ Here at American Family Field, Webb is 2-0 with a 2.63 ERA and .184 BAA in four career starts.

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball, Sweeper

Last Game: 5/31 at COL; 1.0ip, 3h, 2r, 2er, bb (26 pitches)

- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento on Sunday (second stint with SF)...has gone 2-1 with a 3.91 ERA (10er, 23.0ip) in 17 relief outings for the River Cats this season.
- ▶ Appeared in 31 games for SF last season, working in a bulk innings role... recorded at least four outs in 18 of the 31 games.
- ▶ Batters were 9x64 (.141) with 18 strikeouts off his sweeper in '25... left-handed batters hit .202 (20x99) with 18 strikeouts off him.

#34 JT BRUBAKER ▶ RHP

(BR00-baker)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Cutter, Changeup

Last Game: 5/31 at COL; 1.2ip, k (17 pitches)

- ▶ Has tossed 8.2 scoreless innings over his last four outings...has a 0.73 ERA (1er, 12.1ip) in his last seven games.
- ▶ Has a 0.61 ERA (1er, 14.2ip) in 11 road games...has a 4.70 ERA (8er, 15.1ip) in nine games at Oracle Park.
- ▶ Issued at least one walk in 11 of 20 contests (4.5 BB/9.0ip).
- ▶ Opponents are hitting .194 (6-for-31) off his slider, .222 (10-for-45) off his sinker and .267 (4-for-15) off his changeup.

#93 MATT GAGE ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Splitter

Last Game: 6/1 at MIL; 1.0ip, 3h, 2r, 2er, 2bb, k (27 pitches)

- ▶ Gage's 29 appearances this year are tied for fourth-most in MLB.
- ▶ Has surrendered eight runs (seven ER) in 24.0ip this year (2.63 ERA)...however, five of the eight runs have come in his last eight outings (6.0ip, 7.50 ERA).
- ▶ Has allowed only nine of his 24 (37.5%) inherited runners to score.
- ▶ Lefties are 4-for-33 (.121) against him this season, and 21-for-116 in his career (.181).
- ▶ His 27.1% hard hit rate ranks in the top 4% of MLB while his 85.6 mph average exit velo is in the top 7%.
- ▶ Opponents are just 2-for-17 (.118) off his changeup and 3-for-22 (.136) off his four-seamer.
- ▶ Seven of the eight runs he's allowed this season have come on the road (16 games) for a 4.50 ERA...has a 0.75 ERA (1er, 12.0ip) in 13 games at Oracle Park.

#31 SAM HENTGES ▶ LHP

(HENT-chiss)

Pitch Arsenal: Curveball, 4-Seam FB, Slider, Sinker

Last Game: 5/30 at COL; 1.1ip, 2h, r, er, 2bb, k (32 pitches)

- ▶ Has made eight appearances with SF, logging 7.2 innings, allowing four hits and eight walks with nine strikeouts.
- ▶ Righties are 0-for-13 off him.
- ▶ Returned from rehab and reinstated from the 15-day IL on May 10.
- ▶ Is pitching in the Majors for the first time since July 2024.
- ▶ Missed the entire 2025 season while recovering from left shoulder surgery, performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache in Los Angeles on September 18, 2024...also developed some right knee soreness during his rehab and underwent arthroscopic surgery in August 2025.
- ▶ Signed one-year deal with SF on December 3, 2025.

#45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

(kill-EE-en)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 5/31 at COL; W, 1.0ip, bb, 2k (15 pitches)

- ▶ Allowed 12 runs (10 earned) in 12.0 innings in May...had allowed one run in 14.0 innings in 13 March/April games.
- ▶ Left-handed batters are 9-for-52 (.173) with no XBH against him while right-handers are 8-for-40 (.200) with five homers.
- ▶ Returned to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite this past offseason...dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of 2025 with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4 Seam FB, Sinker, Changeup

Last Game: 5/29 at COL; 1.0ip, h, k (16 pitches)

- ▶ Has allowed one home run in his last 61.1 innings pitched, dating back to August, 2024.
- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on May 16 after missing 14 games with a low back strain.
- ▶ Has allowed 13 walks in his 16.1ip (7.16 BB/9.0).
- ▶ Right-handers are 5-for-30 (.167) off him while left-handers are 5-for-29 (.172).
- ▶ Holding opponents 0-for-20 off his slider and 5-for-31 (.161) off his sinker.

#71 WILKIN RAMOS ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Sinker, 4-Seam FB, Curveball

Last Game: 6/1 at MIL; 2.0ip, 3h, 2r, 2er, 2bb (40 pitches)

- ▶ Had his contract purchased from Triple-A Sacramento yesterday and made his MLB debut last night...struck out Christian Yelich in the 6th inning for his first career strikeout.
- ▶ Was 3-1 with a 2.00 ERA (6er, 27.0ip), 27 strikeouts and a 1.15 WHIP in 17 games for SAC...had a 1.42 ERA (2er, 12.2ip) in May.
- ▶ Was an NRI with SF this spring after signing an MiLB contract with the Giants in February of this year.
- ▶ This marks his ninth season in professional baseball, pitching for four organizations (OAK, PIT, NYM and SF), 10 different Minor League teams and totaling 205 MiLB games before being promoted to MLB for the first time today.

#67 KEATON WINN ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, 2-Seam FB, Splitter, Slider

Last Game: 5/29 at COL; 1.1ip, 2h, 2r, 2er, hr (18 pitches)

- ▶ Leads SF with 11 holds, which is tied for the fifth-most in MLB.
- ▶ 19 of his 25 appearances this year have been scoreless (2.45 ERA).
- ▶ Opponents are just 15-for-88 (.170) off him this year.
- ▶ Batters are just 6-for-47 (.128) with 17 K's off his splitter.
- ▶ His 85.6 mph average exit velocity ranks in the top 7% of the league while his 26.9% hard-hit rate ranks in the top 3%.

- ▶ Hit his sixth career grand slam and first as a Giant on Sunday.
- ▶ Is 27-for-86 (.314) with 12 XBH (six 2Bs, 3B, five HRs) and 17 RBI in his last 21 games dating to May 10.
- ▶ 26 of his 57 hits this year have been for extra-bases (17 2Bs, a 3B, seven HRs)...his 17 doubles this year are T-4th most in MLB.
- ▶ His walk rate is 4.8% this season, down from 11.7% last year.
