NATIONALS NEWS

SERIES BUSINESS

The Washington Nationals wrap up a three-game set with the Athletics today in Sacramento...Today's rubber match will be the Nationals 16th of the season...Washington is 10-5 in rubber games this season.

- **Keibert Ruiz** collected a pair of hits, including his 100th career double last night in his first game after the All-Star break.
- Washington will wrap up its series with the Athletics in Sacramento today before heading to Colorado for a three-game set with the Rockies, Monday-Wednesday.

ROSTER MOVES

The Washington Nationals announced the following roster moves ahead of today's game:

- Signed left-handed pitcher **Matt Krook** and activated him.
- Placed left-handed pitcher **PJ Poulin** on the 15-Day Injured List (retroactive to July 16) with a flexor strain.
- Transferred left-handed pitcher **Richard Lovelady** to the 60-Day Injured List.

ROAD WARRIORS

With a win today, the Nationals would improve to 12-3-1 in road series this season and 30-19 on the road overall, the third most road wins in Major League Baseball behind on the Dodgers and Yankees (31).

- Washington has won back-to-back road series and seven of its last eight series away from home.
- The Nationals have not lost a road series since June 21 against Tampa Bay.
- Washington's three road series losses are all separated by more than a month this season (4/1 at PHI, 5/10 at MIA, 6/21 at TB).

GOING RIGHT AGAINST LEFT

The Nationals lead Major League Baseball in OPS (.794) and batting average (.271) and are second in on-base percentage (.347) against left-handed pitching this season...Washington is 19-12 against left-handed starters this year.

- Washington has scored 181 runs off of left-handed starters this season, the second-highest total in the National League and the third-highest in Major League Baseball.
- The Nationals have 106 extra-base hits off of left-handed starters, also good for second in the NL and third in MLB.
- **James Wood** ranks tied for fourth in the National League with 8 home runs against southpaws this season... **Curtis Mead** ranks tied for sixth in the NL with seven long balls against lefties this year.

HOMERS EVERYWHERE

Washington has hit 142 home runs this season, tied for the most in Major League Baseball with the New York Yankees...The 142 homers are the second-most in team history (2005-pres.) through 99 games behind only the 2017 Nationals (145 HR).

- The Nationals have clubbed 105 home runs since May 6, the most in Major League Baseball, 15 more than the Pirates (90)...Washington entered play on May 6 with 41 home runs, 12th-most in Major League Baseball.
- The Nationals are one of three clubs in Major League Baseball to have four players with at least 15 home runs this season along with the Los Angeles Dodgers and Chicago Cubs.

POP FROM THE TOP

James Wood is 21-for-55 (.382) with a .534 on-base percentage (18 BB, 16 SO) and a .909 slugging percentage (.32B, .3B, 8 HR) in his last 15 games...He's reached safely in 35 of his last 59 plate appearances (19 H, 16 BB, 11 SO).

- He clubbed his Major League leading 10th leadoff home run on July 12 vs. New York (AL)...His 10 leadoff homers are the most in a season in franchise history (MON/WSH).
- Wood has 13 career leadoff homers, one shy of matching **Trea Turner's** Nationals record (2005-pres.) 14 and two shy of tying **Brad Wilkerson's** franchise record (MON/WSH) 15.

NOT ON THE LIST? SORRY.

A few exclusive lists containing several Washington players include:

- **CJ Abrams** and **James Wood** are two of only three players in baseball with at least 20 home runs and at least 15 stolen bases this season...Wood is the only player in the 25 HR/15 SB club.
- There are 10 players in Major League Baseball with at least 20 home runs and at least 60 RBI...**James Wood**, **CJ Abrams** and **Luis García Jr.** are three of the 10...No other team has more than one player on the list.

LUIS! LUIS!

Luis García Jr. is in the midst of a career year, already hitting a career-high 20 home runs and closing in on his career-high of 70 RBI in 2024...He ranks in the National League in RBI (T2nd, 68), slugging percentage (4th, .547) and home runs (T10th, 20).

- García Jr. has been arguably the best hitter in Major League Baseball since May 24, leading the league in home runs (17), RBI (46), slugging percentage (.711) and ranking third in OPS (1.060).
- His 11 home runs in his last 22 games are second-most in MLB since June 19.
- He is 21-for-59 (.356) with four doubles, seven homers, 19 RBI, four walks and 11 runs in his last 15 games.

OPPONENT

ATHLETICS

The Nationals and Athletics will face off three times this season (3 in Sacramento)...Nationals Pitching Strategist **Sean Doolittle** was drafted by the A's in the first round of the 2007 draft (41st overall)...He pitched six seasons (2012-17) with the Athletics and was named an All-Star in 2014...**Drew Millas** was acquired from the Athletics - along with others - at the 2021 Trade Deadline in exchange for **Yan Gomes** and **Josh Harrison**...2019 World Series champion, **Javy Guerra** is the Athletics Bullpen Coach.

LAST START

Griffin tossed 7.0 innings of one-run ball on five hits with nine strikeouts...He earned his 10th win of the season in the 8-2 victory over the Houston Astros on July 8.

- He has not allowed more than one earned run in any of his last seven starts.

vs. ATHLETICS

Griffin is set to make his first career appearance against the Athletics.

1 IS THE LONLIEST NUMBER...UNLESS YOU'RE FOSTER GRIFFIN

Griffin has allowed one earned run or fewer in seven consecutive starts, the longest active streak among starters (excluding openers) in Major League Baseball and the second-longest streak in MLB this season behind Milwaukee's **Jacob Misiorowski** (8 GS, May 1 to June 12)...The seven-game streak is tied for the longest in Nationals history (2005-pres.) with **Stephen Strasburg** (7 G, May 11-June 21, 2013) and **Jordan Zimmermann** (7 G, June 27-July 28, 2012).

- Over his last seven starts, Griffin is 4-0 with a 1.25 ERA (6 ER/43.1 IP) with 44 strikeouts and just five walks...Left-handed batters are 4-for-42 (.098) with 16 strikeouts and zero walks.

RANKINGS

Griffin ranks among National League pitchers in WHIP (3rd, 1.02), opponents' on-base percentage (4th, .268), winning percentage (T5th, .833), opponents' average (6th, .210), walks allowed per nine innings (6th, 2.12), strikeouts-to-walk ratio (7th, 4.19), innings pitched (T8th, 110.1) and ERA (8th, 2.77).

TECHNICALLY, HE'S A ROOKIE

Although he spent three seasons in Japan, Griffin still qualifies as a rookie...Because of that, he leads qualified National League rookie pitchers in ERA (2.77), WHIP (1.02), wins (10), starts (19), innings pitched, (110.1) and ranks second in strikeouts (109) and opponents' average (.210).

- Griffin earned his 10th win of the season on July 8 against the Houston Astros, the most wins in a single-season by a Nationals rookie pitcher.

LEFT ON LEFT CRIME

Griffin has held opposing left-handed batters to a .149 batting average (17-for-114) with 37 strikeouts and just six walks...His four-seam fastball (.053), sweep (.114), cutter (.148) and sinker (.176) have been particularly tough on left-handed hitters this year...In three starts from April 26 to May 8, lefties went 1-for-20 (.050) with six strikeouts and three walks against him.

KEPT IT 100

Griffin tossed at least 100 pitches in four consecutive starts from June 10 to June 27, the longest active streak in Major League Baseball at the time and the second-longest streak this season behind **Paul Skenes**.
