THE TWINS: Completed their six-game roadtrip with a record of 2-4, going 1-2 at Colorado last weekend and 1-2 at Los Angeles-NL from Monday-Wednesday...tonight, they will begin a six-game homestand with the first of three against the Nationals over the weekend...following this series, they will host the Red Sox for three games from Monday-Wednesday.

UNHAPPY HOLLYWOOD ENDING: The Twins lost to the Dodgers on Wednesday afternoon in Los Angeles by a score of 4-3, suffering a walk-off defeat...Freddie Freeman, down to his final strike, drove in the game-tying and game-winning runs on a bases loaded single off Griffin Jax...it marked just the third loss for the Twins this season when leading entering the ninth inning (42-3)...Chris Paddack was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on four hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and eight strikeouts...the offense recorded five hits, two from Royce Lewis, who doubled and homered.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins today placed left-handed pitcher Anthony Misiewicz on the 15-day Injured List (retroactive to July 23) with left shoulder impingement...to replace Misiewicz on the 26-man roster, the Twins recalled left-handed pitcher Kody Funderburk from Triple-A St. Paul...this is Fundy's fourth stint with Minnesota this year, going 1-0 with a 6.92 ERA (13.0 IP, 10 ER), five walks and nine strikeouts in 10 combined appearances in his prior stints.

MONUMENT MEETS MINNEAPOLIS: The Twins and Nationals are playing each other for the 25th, 26th and 27th times in their history this weekend...the Twins are 12-12 all-time against the Montreal/Washington franchise...Twins are 2-4 at Target Field (2019 & '23), 3-6 at Nationals Park (2013, '16 & '24), 4-2 at the Metrodome (2007 & '08) and 3-0 in Montreal (2004).

◆ These two last met for three games at Nats Park from May 20-22, 2024 as the Twins lost the first game but took games two and three.

◆ The last time the Twins hosted Washington was for three games from April 21-23, 2023 as the Twins lost games one and two but won game three.

◆ Byron Buxton has a .920 OPS in eight career games against the Nationals, including two doubles and three home runs...he has hit safely in each of his last seven against Washington, dating back to April 24, 2016...one of Buck's 15 career multi-homer games was at Nationals Park last year in game two, homering twice off Patrick Corbin.

HISTORY LESSONS. For 60 years the Washington Senators played baseball in our nation's

HISTORY LESSONS: For 60 years, the Washington Senators played baseball in our nation's capital, winning one World Championship (1924) and three AL pennants (1925, '33)...in 1961, owner Calvin Griffith moved the Senators from Washington, D.C. to Bloomington, Minnesota... the Senators played from 1901-1960, compiling a record of 4223-4864...the Senators beat the New York Giants in the 1924 World Series in seven games, marking the only World Series victory for the franchise during its first 60-year tenure in Washington.

The Twins enter tonight's game with an all-time club record (since 1961) of 5085-5143-8 and an all-time franchise record (Senators and Twins) of 9309-10006.

THE OTHER GUYS: Twins have gone 15-21 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-3 at St. Louis (March 27-30), 2-1 vs. New York-NL (April 14-16), 0-3 at Atlanta (April 18-20), 3-0 vs. San Francisco (May 9-11), 2-1 at Milwaukee (May 16-18), 1-2 at Cincinnati (June 17-19), 0-3 vs. Milwaukee (June 20-22), 1-2 at Miami (July 1-3), 2-1 vs. Chicago (July 8-10), 2-1 vs. Pittsburgh (July 11-13), 1-2 at Colorado (July 18-20) and 1-2 at Los Angeles-NL (July 21-23).

DAYS GONE BYRON: Over his last 34 games, Buxton is hitting .331 (43-for-130) with eight doubles, one triple, 13 home runs, 20 RBI, 31 runs scored, 12 walks, a .396 on-base percentage, a .708 slugging percentage and a 1.104 OPS.

The has a 13.57 at-bat-per-home run ratio, third-best in the AL and sixth-best in baseball, trailing Cal Raleigh (9.51), Aaron Judge (10.11), Eugenio Suárez (10.25), Shohei Ohtani (10.68) and Kyle Schwarber (11.06).

Since June 17, Buck has 12 home runs (29 games), tied with Nick Kurtx, Shohei Ohtani Stowers for third-most in baseball, trailing Eugenio Suárez (15) and Cal Raleigh (13).

C4, IGNITING: In five games over the roadtrip, Carlos Correa reached safely 12 times (5 hits, 7 walks) in 23 plate appearances, for an on-base percentage of .522...over his last 26 games, Correa is hitting .330 (31-for-94) with six doubles, two home runs, 10 RBI, 11 walks, a .400 on-base percentage, a .457 slugging percentage and an .857 OPS.

FEELING MINNESOTA: The Twins have gone 28-20 at home this season, compared to 21-32 on the road...during their last homestand, they went 6-3, winning three-consecutive series' vs. Tampa Bay (July 4-6), Chicago-NL (July 8-10) and Pittsburgh (July 11-13).

They are 8-3 in their last 11 in Minnesota, dating back to June 25.

Byron Buxton has a 1.047 OPS in 40 home games this season, fourth-highest in baseball (minimum of 100 plate appearances).

THE LEFTORIUM: Today marks the 19th time the Twins have faced a left-handed starter this season...Minnesota is 6-12 against lefty starters...they lost their last game started by a lefty on July 18 at Colorado (Kyle Freeland)...their last win over a left-handed starter came on July 8 vs. Chicago-NL (Shota Imanaga).

Buxton is hitting .339 (20-for-59) with four doubles, one triple, six home runs and a 1.158 OPS against left-handed pitching this season...over his last four games vs. lefties, he has five hits in eight at-bats, including two home runs.

Over his last 27 games vs. lefties, Willi Castro is hitting .340 (16-for-47) with a 1.096 OPS.

Carlos Correa is hitting .300 (21-for-70) with a .923 OPS vs. lefties on the season.

BAILEY DOSE: Right-handed pitcher Bailey Ober (left hip impingement) will make his second rehab start for Triple-A St. Paul tonight at CHS Field against Worcester with first pitch at 7:07 pm (CT)...his last rehab start was on July 18 at Louisville, pitching 4.0 shutout innings, with four hits allowed, no walks and three strikeouts.

◆ Infielder Luke Keaschall (right forearm fracture) is also rehabbing with the Saints, going 5-for-22 (.227) with one RBI in 6 games.

ROCKY RETURN: Last pitched on July 19 at Colorado in his first major league game since being placed on the IL on June 8, opposite Antonio Senzatela, and was dealt the loss in Minnesota's 6-10 defeat...allowed a season-high five runs on a season-high eight hits (1 HR), with one walk and six strikeouts in 4.0 innings...permitted an RBI double to Ryan Ritter in the second and a two-run homer to Ryan McMahon in the third...gave up two singles in the fifth and was replaced by Brock Stewart who subsequently allowed a three-run homer to Ezequiel Tovar, and two of the three runs were retroactively charged to Matthews.

Procured a career-high 17 whiffs on 40 total swings, a rate of 42.5 percent.

TWO STARTS AGO (TRIPLE-A): Pitched on July 13 on a rehab assignment with the Triple-A St. Paul Saints vs. the lowa Cubs, opposite Ben Brown, but did not factor into the decision of St. Paul's 2-8 defeat...allowed just one hit with no walks and nine strikeouts in 4.0 scoreless innings...nine strikeouts tied his professional career high, done five times previously, including twice this season on April 8 with St. Paul against Omaha and on May 24 with the Twins against Kansas City...the lone hit he gave up was a two-out double to the league's hitting leader, Jonathan Long, in the first inning.

₱ Retired his final 10 batters faced in the first through fourth innings, and struck out the side

MOW 'EM DOWN MATTHEWS: Matthews has totaled 74 strikeouts through his first 14 career major league games, the fifth most in Twins history (1961-)...here are some of his numbers compared to other Twins pitchers through their first 14 games:

NATIONALS GUARD: Matthews is facing the Washington Nationals for the first time today...they become his 13th new opponent faced in 15 career games...he is 0-3, 6,35 ERA (17.0 IP, 12 ER) with six walks. 19 strikeouts and a .292 (21-for-72) opponent batting average in four career Interleague starts.

WELCOME HOME: Zebby has gone 1-2 with an 8.87 ERA (22.1 IP, 22 ER), six walks, 36 strikeouts and a .350 (36-for-103) opponent batting average in six career major league starts at home; compared to 1-4, 5.17 ERA (38.1 IP, 22 ER) with 14 walks, 38 strikeouts and a .277 (43-for-155) opponent batting average in eight career major league starts on the road.

 ♣ În his sole major league start at home this season on May 24 vs. Kansas City, Matthews did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 5-4 walkoff victory...allowed two runs off five hits, with one walk and a career-high nine strikeouts in 4.0 innings.

PLATOON SPLITS: Through his first five major league starts this season, left-handed hitters have slashed .286/.348/.429 in 42 at-bats vs. Matthews, while righties have slashed .308/.368/.404 in 52 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 84.1 mph and a whiff rate of 36.8 compared to righties' 91.8 mph and 24.1 percent.

THE ARSENAL: Matthews uses a five-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer 44% of the time...primarily uses his fastball and curveball against right-handed batters, while favoring is changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his 2025 pitch breakdown:
