EARLIER TODAY: The Brewers defeated the Athletics, 7-4, in Phoenix....1B Rhys Hoskins went 2-for-3 with a double, grand slam and 5 RBI....CF Garrett Mitchell went 2-for-4 with a run....LHP DL Hall made the start (2ip, 5h, 2r, 2er, 1bb, 3k)....LHP Robert Gasser tossed 3.0 scoreless innings (2h, 1bb, 3k).

THE ROSTER: The team opened Cactus League play with 58 players in Major League camp: 31 pitchers, 6 catchers, 13 infielders and 8 outfielders....there were 18 non-roster invitees: 11 pitchers, 2 catchers, 4 infielders and 1 outfielder....there are currently 53 players in Major League camp: 28 pitchers, 5 catchers, 12 infielders and 8 outfielders....there are 13 non-roster invitees remaining: 8 pitchers, 1 catcher, 3 infielders and 1 outfielder.

2023 IN REVIEW: The Brewers went 92-70 and qualified for the postseason for the fifth time in the last six seasons....the team won the NL Central for the third time in the last six seasons, taking the division by 9.0 games over the Cubs....the Brewers were defeated by Arizona, two games to none, in the NL Wild Card Series in Milwaukee.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last six full seasons (does not include 2020)....the Brewers have 573 wins since 2017, which ranks sixth in the majors and third in the National League....the teams was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in seven consecutive seasons, missing out by just a game in both 2017 and 2022.

TODAY'S STARTER: #87 - RHP CARLOS RODRÍGUEZ

RHP Carlos Rodríguez, 22, has won Brewers Minor League Pitcher of the Year honors in each of his first two seasons in the organization.....he was the co-winner last season with LHP Robert Gasser.....Rodríguez was also named 2023 Southern League Pitcher of the Year after going 9-6 with a league-best 2.77 ERA in 25 starts at Double-A Biloxi.....he has held opponents to a .192 batting average in his Minor League career with 287 strikeouts in just 236.0 innings.....he was selected in the sixth round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft from Florida SouthWestern State College.

ALSO SCHEDULED TO PITCH...

RHP Janson Junk, 28, spent most of last season at Triple-A Nashville, where he went 7-10 with a 4.18 ERA in 27 games (25 starts).....he also had two stints with Milwaukee (4/11-4/12 and 10/1-end of season).....Junk was acquired from Los Angeles-AL as part of the deal for OF Hunter Renfroe on 11/22/22.....he was originally selected by the Yankees in the 22nd round of the First-Year Player Draft and was traded to the Angels on 7/30/21.

LHP Bryan Hudson, 26, was acquired from Los Angeles-NL in exchange for LHP Justin Chambers and a player to be named or cash on Jan. 3.....he made his Major League debut last season with the Dodgers, making 6 relief appearances.....Hudson was selected by the Cubs in the third round of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft.

RHP Sam Carlson, 25, signed with Milwaukee on Nov. 30 and is a non-roster invitee.....he was selected by Seattle in the second round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft and spent his career (2017-23) in the Mariners farm system prior to joining the Brewers.
