PITTSBURGH PIRATES (13-19) vs. CHICAGO CUBS (17-16)

May 9, 2021 at Wrigley Field, Chicago, IL -- GAME #33/ROAD #21

LHP TYLER ANDERSON (2-3, 3.24 ERA) vs. RHP KYLE HENDRICKS (2-3, 6.07 ERA)

THE PIRATES... have lost three straight games after beating the Padres in San Diego Tuesday night...Have gone 1-8 in their last nine games after winning a season-high three games in a row to go above .500 (12-11) on 4/27...Have gone 12-13 in their last 25 games after losing a season-high six in a row from 4/3-8...Were 10-22 after 32 games in 2020 (10-23 after 33).

ON THE BUMP: Tyler Anderson has posted a 2.35 ERA (23.0ip/6er) in his last four starts while winning two of his last three decisions...His .156 (12-for-77) batting average against in that time (since 4/14) is the third-lowest among all National League pitchers with at least 21.0 innings pitched and the fifth-lowest in MLB...Anderson has surrendered three runs or less in each of his first six starts and two or less in each of his last four.

THE KA'AI OF THE TIGER: Yesterday afternoon Ka'ai Tom connected off Trevor Williams for his first Major League home run...Tom has reached base safely in seven of his eight games with the Pirates, producing a .393 OBP and five RBI.

HEADIN' HOME: Following the game today the Pirates travel to Pittsburgh, where they are scheduled to begin a seven-game homestand Monday night with the first of three games against Cincinnati...The homestand concludes with four games against San Francisco, beginning Thursday night...The Bucs have lost four straight games at PNC Park after winning five-of-seven...Overall the Pirates have posted a 5-7 record on their home turf this season.

WANNA BE STARTING SOMETHING: Over the last five games, the Bucco starting pitchers have posted a 2.54 ERA (28.1ip/8er)...Dating back to April 23, the starters have produced a 3.65 ERA (69.0ip/28er) - the fifth-best ERA among National League starting staffs in that time.

4 IS THE MAGIC NUMBER: The Pirates have posted a 10-3 record this season when scoring four runs or more...They have, however, gone six straight games without plating four runs.

BULLISH PEN: Dating back to April 8, Pittsburgh's bullpen has posted the second-lowest ERA among Major League teams (2.53), trailing only the Miami Marlins (2.50).

THE UN-FRIENDLY CONFINES: The Bucs dropped two-of-three at Wrigley Field to start the season and have gone 2-17 in their last 19 games played here, dating back to 9/26/18...They had lost 10 games in a row prior to beating the Cubs on Opening Day.

MOUNDSMEN: In their last nine road games, the Bucco pitching staff has produced a 2.14 ERA (76.0ip/18er) while giving up two earned runs or less in seven of the nine games...In the eight games against the Cubs this season, the pitchers have posted a 3.04 ERA (68.0ip/23er)...Over the course of the last 14 games this season, the staff has posted a 3.35 ERA (121.0ip/45er).

PERFECTO: Richard Rodríguez has retired each of the last 28 batters he has faced since giving up a single to Eric Hosmer at PNC Park on 4/12...He has allowed just two baserunners overall while posting a 0.16 WHIP in his 12 appearances...His WHIP is the third-lowest by any Major League pitcher thru his first 12 games since 1900.

ON THE ROAD: The Pirates have gone 7-7 in their last 14 games played on the road while posting a 2.87 ERA (116.0ip/37er)...The starting pitchers have produced a 3.62 ERA (74.2ip/30er) while the bullpen has turned in a 1.52 ERA (41.1ip/7er).

HISTORY IN THE MAKING: Richard Rodríguez has made eight straight hitless outings (9.0ip) and has surrendered just one hit overall in his first 12 appearances (12.1ip)...Rodríguez is the first pitcher in Pirates history to allow no more than one hit over his first 12 appearances of a season.

HOT ROD: Dating back to June 1, 2019, Richard Rodríguez has produced a 2.06 ERA (78.2ip/18er) in his 82 games - that is the lowest ERA in the Majors among all relief pitchers with at least 75 appearances...Rodríguez has allowed just two baserunners (one hit and one walk) in his first nine outings this season (38 at bats) and has made 23 consecutive scoreless appearances (23.0ip) dating back to August 30 of last season.

PEN PALS: David Bednar has been scored upon once in his last 11 appearances (9.2ip/1er)...Kyle Crick has made eight straight hitless outings (7.2ip) and has allowed just one hit in his first 11 games (31 at bats) overall...Sam Howard has stranded all 10 of his inherited runners and Clay Holmes has been charged with one earned run in his last 10 games (12.2ip).

SHELTY'S CREW: Manager Derek Shelton and his entire 2020 coaching staff have returned for a second season in 2021...Christian Marrero has joined the staff as Assistant Hitting Coach...Returning coaches include Tarrick Brock (First Base), Joey Cora (Third Base), Rick Eckstein (Hitting), Don Kelly (Bench), Oscar Marin (Pitching), Justin Meccage (Bullpen), Mike Rabelo (Field Coordinator) and Glenn Sherlock...Catching coaches Herbie Andrade and Jordan Comadena have returned.

May 9, 1950: Bucco Hall-of-Famer Ralph Kiner homered twice, including his second grand slam in three days and eighth of his career, as the Pirates doubled up Brooklyn, 10-5, at Forbes Field. Kiner finished the day with a total of seven RBI, tied for the second-most in a single game in his career.

MITCH KELLER: The 25-year-old righthander will be making his seventh start of the season when he takes the mound against the Reds at PNC Park tomorrow...His last start was a win in San Diego Tuesday (5.2ip/2h/0r/2bb/5so)...Picked up his first win on 4/10 over the Cubs at PNC Park (5.0ip/1er)...His first start was a 4-3 loss to Zach Davies in Chicago on 4/4 (3.0ip/3er)...Posted a 1-1 record and a 2.91 ERA (21.2ip/7er) in five starts during the 2020 season...Finished the season pitching 11.0 consecutive no-hit innings over his last two starts.
VS. CINCINNATI: 0-1 with a 6.92 ERA in three starts (13.0ip/10er)...Had a no-decision in his one start in 2020; gave up three runs in 3.0ip on 9/14 at GABP (game two)...Made his Major League debut on 5/27/19 at Great American Ball Park and surrendered seven hits and six runs in the first inning en route to an 8-1 loss to Sonny Gray...Also allowed one run in 6.0-plus innings in Pittsburgh's 3-2 walkoff win on 8/23/19.
