**THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY**  
**JUNE 3**  
**2015** - RHP **Lance McCullers Jr.** fires the first complete game of his career and strikes out 11, leading the Astros to a 3-1 win over the Orioles in Houston...McCullers becomes the first Astros rookie to strike out 11 in a complete game effort since RHP **Roy Oswalt** in 2001.

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Astros will continue their nine-game homestand tonight as they play the middle game of the homestand and of the series against their former divisional opponent, the Pirates...it's a stellar pitching matchup tonight between the reigning AL Pitcher of the Month for May in RHP **Spencer Arrighetti** matching up with the reigning NL Cy Young winner in RHP **Paul Skenes**.

**HOT SPAGHETTI:** Tonight's Astros starter RHP **Spencer Arrighetti** made his season debut on April 15 and has since gone 7-1 with a 1.34 ERA (7ER/47IP) and a .167 opponent average while allowing one-or-fewer earned runs in seven of his eight starts...among AL pitchers with 45+ innings pitched, he's posted the lowest ERA and opponent average, while ranking tied for third in wins.

**PITCHER OF THE MONTH:** RHP **Spencer Arrighetti** has been named the AL Pitcher of the Month for May after going 4-1 with a 0.93 ERA (3ER/29IP) and a .165 opponent average (16x97) in five starts in the month...in May, he posted the lowest ERA and opponent average among AL starters, while ranking tied for first in wins.

**VS. THE PIRATES:** The Astros are hosting the Pirates in Houston for their first series in the city since July of 2024...since the Astros moved to the AL in 2013, the Astros have gone 9-10 against the Pirates...historically, these teams have played each other 719 times, with the Astros going 348-371.

**WELCOME BACK MURPHI:** This series, the Astros are welcoming back Pirates pitching coach **Bill Murphy**, who previously worked for the Astros for the last 10 seasons (2016-25)...during his time with the Astros, Murphy had a variety of roles within the organization, serving as a minor league coach and minor league pitching coordinator before joining the Major League staff as the assistant pitching coach in 2021...Murphy was elevated to the pitching coach role in 2022, helping the club to a World Series championship that season.

**PRIDE NIGHT:** Tonight at the ballpark, the Astros are hosting **Pride Night** presented by Coca-Cola...as part of the celebration, 10,000 fans will receive a Pride Fan, also presented by Coca-Cola...also, a special limited-edition Astros Pride Night Basketball Jersey is available as an add-on for \$44.

**ON THE DIAL:** The Astros English radio broadcast this series will feature **Robert Ford** and **Josh Reddick**, who's subbing for **Steve Sparks**...Reddick, who played parts of 13 seasons in the Majors and was a 2017 World Series champion, will make select appearances on Astros radio this season.

**LOS ASTROS:** Space City Home Network will televise this series in English and Spanish with the Spanish broadcast being televised on SCHN2...**Danny Gonzalez** and **Enrique Vasquez** will be on the call on the Spanish telecast this series.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Astros scored in four different innings but were unable to keep up with the Pirates in a 10-6 loss at Daikin Park...DH **Yordan Alvarez** (2x4) smacked his AL-leading 21st homer and drove in three in the defeat...SS **Jeremy Peña** also had a big game, going 2x5 with two runs scored and two RBI.

**VOTING COMMENCES:** Major League Baseball launched the 2026 Konami eBaseball MLB All-Star Ballot earlier today...the 2026 MLB All-Star Game presented by Mastercard will be held on Tuesday, July 14 at Citizens Bank Park, the home of the Phillies...the Astros on the ballot: **1B Christian Walker**, **2B Jose Altuve**, **3B Isaac Paredes**, **SS Jeremy Peña**, **C Yainer Diaz**, **DH Yordan Alvarez**, **OF Brice Matthews**, **OF Jake Meyers** and **OF Cam Smith**.

**YOR-GONE!:** DH **Yordan Alvarez** has hit 191 career regular season home runs, which ties him for sixth in Astros history along with **3B Alex Bregman**.

**ON THE LEADER BOARD:** DH **Yordan Alvarez** leads the Majors in OPS (1.064) and total bases (142) and leads the AL lead in homers (21)...also in the AL, he ranks tied for first in extra-base hits (33), second in SLG (.645), second in OBP (.419), tied for fourth in hits (67), fifth in batting avg. (.305), tied for fifth in RBI (42), and tied for sixth in walks (40).

**WALKER, TEXAS HAMMER:** **1B Christian Walker** has five HR and 13 RBI in his last nine games...on the season, he ranks tied for first in the AL in RBI (44), tied for fifth in XBH (26), sixth in HR (16), tied for sixth in total bases (114), and 10th in SLG (.504)...Walker also has not committed an error in 61 games.

**FIRE STARTER:** **SS Jeremy Peña** is batting .296 (16x54) with three home runs, 10 RBI and an .802 OPS in 14 games since being activated from the IL on May 18...the Astros are 8-6 since his return.

**HIT PAREDES:** **3B Isaac Paredes** recorded his 500th career hit on Sunday vs. MIL, becoming just the 10th Mexican-born player in MLB history to reach the milestone...looking ahead, Paredes is just two home runs away from 100 career home runs and three doubles away from 100 career doubles.

**THERE IS A SANTA!:** RHP **Alimber Santa** (pronounced saun-tuh) has retired 15 consecutive batters through three appearances to open his MLB career...per Elias, this is a franchise record and Santa is the first pitcher to do so since RHP **Bryce Miller** of the Mariners retired his first 16 batters faced in his MLB debut on May 2, 2023 at OAK.

**ON ASSIGNMENT:** OF **Joey Loperfido** went 1x4 with an RBI double, a run scored and a walk in a start in right field last night at Triple A Sugar Land in what was the sixth game of his current minor league rehab assignment...Loperfido has been sidelined since April 18 with a right quad strain.

**MINOR LEAGUE HONORS:** The Astros player development department has named RHP **Kellan Oakes** and C **Jason Schiavone** the Astros Minor League Pitcher and Player of the Month for May...Oakes went 2-1 with a 1.50 ERA (3ER/18IP) in four relief appearances in May with Class A Fayetteville...Schiavone hit .297 (27x91) with 10 homers, 23 RBI, and a 1.165 OPS in 26 games between High A Asheville and Double A Corpus Christi in May.

**LAST START, MAY 28 AT TEX:** Added another quality start under his belt, spinning 6.0 innings of 1 run ball, allowing 3 hits and a walk with 3 strikeouts...leads the Astros in quality starts (4)...tossed 94 pitches (55 strikes)...has worked at least 5.0 innings in each of his 8 starts this year, marking the longest such streak by an Astro this season.

**PITCHER OF THE MONTH:** Named American League Pitcher of the Month for May...marked the first Pitcher of the Month Award and second monthly award overall for Arrighetti...was also named AL Rookie of the Month for August of 2024...was outstanding in the month of May, posting a 4-1 record in his five starts with an 0.93 ERA (3ER/29IP) and a .165 opponents batting average...led the AL in ERA and opponents batting average and was tied for first in wins...allowed just three earned runs in his five May starts, allowing one or no earned runs in all five starts...is the first Astros hurler to earn Pitcher of the Month honors since **RHP Hunter Brown** won the award for June of 2025...is also the Astros second monthly award winner in 2026 as **Yordan Alvarez** was named AL Player of the Month for March/April of this season.

**IN GOOD COMPANY:** Is the 11th instance in Astros history a starter has posted an ERA of 1.50 or lower through their first 8 starts of the year and is the 1st to do so since **RHP Hunter Brown** (1.48 ERA) in 2025...prior to Brown, the last to do so was **RHP Justin Verlander** (1.22 ERA) in 2022.

**SPAGHETTI DAY:** The 3rd-year starter has dominated in his Major League action this season, going 7-1 in 8 starts with a 1.34 ERA (7ER/47IP), while fanning 43 in 47.0 innings and allowing a .167 (27x162) opponent batting average...leads the Astros with 7 wins on the season...all this came after he began the season at Triple A Sugar Land (recalled on April 15).

**VS. PIT:** Is set to make his 1st career start vs. PIT...has faced a few Pirates hitters in the past, including **Spencer Horwitz** (1x3, HR), **Brandon Lowe** (2x3, 2B, K), **Ryan O'Hearn** (0x3), and **Marcell Ozuna** (0x2, K)

**START FOR THE BOOKS:** Pitched the best start of his career on May 15 vs. TEX at Daikin Park, where he allowed 1 hit and 4 walks with 5 strikeouts in 7.1 scoreless innings...also carried a no-hit bid through 7.1 innings prior to allowing a single...was the longest no-hit bid by an Astros pitcher since a no-hit bid of 8.2 innings by **LHP Framer Valdez** on Aug. 6, 2024 at TEX...was Arrighetti's longest career no-hit bid and his longest since tossing 7.0 no-hit innings on Aug. 28, 2024 at PHI.

**SINCE HIS RECALL:** Since making his season debut on April 15, Arrighetti ranks 1st among MLB pitchers in wins (7)...in the AL over that span, he also ranks 1st in opponent batting average (.167) and 1st in ERA (1.34).

**ABOUT ARRIGHETTI:** Grew up in Albuquerque, N.M., but moved to the Houston suburb of Katy for high school and attended Cinco Ranch High School...was selected by the Astros in the 6th round of the 2021 MLB First-Year Player Draft from UL-Lafayette...was named the Astros 2023 Minor League Pitcher of the Year.

**LAST APPEARANCE (6/2 vs. PIT):** Surrendered 3 runs on 2 hits with 1 walk and 2 strikeouts last night...all 3 runs came on a 3-run homer from **IF Brandon Lowe** that hit off the right-field foul pole.

**TURN THE PAGE:** Has allowed 4 runs through 1.1 innings over his last 2 appearances (Fri. vs. MIL and last night vs. PIT)...prior to this current stretch, he had logged 9 consecutive scoreless outings (8.2 IP) from May 3-28, striking out 7 while holding opponents to a .148 average (4x27) over that span...his streak of 9 consecutive scoreless appearances is the longest by an Astro this season.

**ALL-TIME ASTRO RANKINGS:** Ranks 7th all-time in appearances (339) among relievers in Astros history, and is closing in on **RHP Ryan Pressly** (342) for 6th on that all-time list...also ranks 4th all-time among Astros relievers in strikeouts (473)...with his outing on April 24 vs. NYY, he reached 338.0 career innings, passing **RHP Octavio Dotel** for the 10th-most innings by a reliever in Astros history.

**DAIKIN PARK RANKINGS:** Is just 1 strikeout away from matching **RHP Octavio Dotel** (247) for the 2nd-most by a reliever in Daikin Park history...also has 181.0 IP in his career at Daikin Park, trailing **Dotel** (190.1) for the 3rd-most innings pitched by a reliever in the venue's history...reached 179.2 career innings pitched at Daikin Park with his outing on May 16 vs. TEX, surpassing **RHP Ryan Pressly** (179.1) for No. 4 on that list.

**VS. PIT:** Prior to last night, had been scoreless through 5 career appearances against the Pirates (5.1 IP), with 8 strikeouts, a 0.94 WHIP and a .167 opponent batting average in that span.

**CAREER:** In 339 career games with the Astros, he's recorded a 2.94 ERA (114ER/349IP) with 473 strikeouts, a 1.22 WHIP, a 12.20 K/9 and a 0.77 HR/9...since 2019, he ranks 1st in strikeouts and 2nd in appearances among active AL relievers.
