Left-handed Pitching

The Braves are set to face left-hander Richard Lovelady tonight as he opens for RHP Miles Mikolas...The team enters play 15-4 (.789) against opposing left-handed starters this season...That is the most wins and third-best winning percentage in such games in the majors this year.

Dating even further to 2019, no team in baseball has been better against lefties...The Braves have gone 181-103 (.637) versus left-handers in that span.

Since the start of May, Atlanta has faced nine left-handed starting pitchers...The club has played to an 8-1 record in those games.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Nationals tonight open a three-game weekend series with the fifth of 13 scheduled games between the two teams this season...Atlanta and Washington are set to see each other next from July 30-August 2 at Truist Park for a four-game series.

A The Braves accumulated 13 hits to beat the Marlins last night, 9-3, to stack their 14th series win of the season...RHP Spencer Strider pitched 6.1 innings, allowed three runs and whiffed nine batters, his highest total since striking out 11 Athletics on July 10, 2025.

A Atlanta took three-of-four from Washington at Nationals Park earlier this season, April 20-23... The club went 9-4 against Washington last year, and has won the season set versus the Nationals in seven of the last eight seasons dating to 2018...The Braves are 80-49 (.620) in 129 total games against the Nationals in that span.

A LHP Richard Lovelady is set to make just his third career start, his 138th appearance, as he opens for RHP Miles Mikolas...All of Lovelady's career starts have occurred since May 9...He briefly pitched in Atlanta's organization, making four appearances for Triple-A Gwinnett from April 2-11, 2023.

A Mikolas has pitched in nine games (eight starts) against the Braves, and owns a 3-4 record with a 3.33 ERA (19 ER/51.1 IP) against the club...He has cleared 6.0 innings in each of his last six nods facing Atlanta, dating to May 24, 2019...That's tied for the longest active streak by an opposing pitcher against the Braves, in lockstep with Arizona's Merrill Kelly, who has completed at least 6.0 IP in each of his six games versus Atlanta.

BRYCE ELDER: Gets the nod for Atlanta tonight to make his 11th start of the season...His 2.01 ERA (14 ER/62.2 IP) ranks fifth in the NL and eighth in MLB.

A The 6-foot-2, 27-year-old Texan also ranks among NL leaders in innings pitched (62.2), opponent batting average (.187) and WHIP (0.99).

A In his last turn, May 16 versus Boston, Elder completed 8.0 innings for the third time in his career and allowed three earned runs...Struck out just three batters...Became the first Brave to complete at least 8.0 innings and log three-or-fewer strikeouts since Matt Wisler did so on May 10, 2016 versus Philadelphia.

A Dating to August 24 of last season, a span of Elder's last 17 turns, his 2.35 ERA (28 ER/107.1 IP) ranks fifth in baseball among qualified pitchers behind just Cam Schlichter (NYY, 1.93), Paul Skenes (PIT, 2.03), Cristopher Sánchez (PHI, 2.14) and Chris Sale (ATL, 2.20)...Elder's 107.1 total innings in that span trail just Sandy Alcántara (110.1) and Cristopher Sánchez (109.1).

A In 2026, Elder ranks in the 100th percentile in fastball run value, in the 99th percentile in overall pitching run value, and in the 90th percentile with a barrel percentage of 3.5.

SERIES PLAY: Atlanta's win last night against the Marlins secured the team's 14th series victory of the season, moving to 14-1-1...The only two non-wins came at the hands of the Arizona Diamondbacks (series split, 2-2) and the Seattle Mariners (series loss, 2-1).

A The only other team in MLB with fewer than five series losses is Milwaukee (4).

A Since 1999, only one other team has played at least 51 games in a season and suffered one-or-fewer series losses...The Los Angeles Dodgers dropped a single series during the shortened, 60-game 2020 regular season.

A The 2026 Braves are the 20th team in the modern era (since 1900) play at least 51 games and suffer one-or-fewer series losses...**Of the previous 19 teams to do so, 15 of them (79%) have played in the World Series, and eight of them (42%) have hoisted the Commissioner's Trophy.**

SCORING: The Braves plated nine runs last night to beat the Marlins, 9-3...With 276 runs scored this season, Atlanta only trails this Washington club (280 runs) for the most in baseball this season.

A Atlanta scored in six different innings for the first time since September 19, 2024 at Cincinnati...The only innings wherein it didn't score were the third, fourth and seventh frames.

A After getting blanked by the Marlins on Monday, 12-0, the Braves have responded by scoring at least eight runs in three consecutive games...Only two teams in MLB have posted longer streaks this season: the Los Angeles Dodgers (4 games) and Houston Astros (4 games).

A The Braves also scored eight-plus in three straight games from May 1-3 at Colorado, making them the only team in baseball this season multiple such three-game streaks.

HOT MIKES: Last night, LF Mike Yastrzemski and CF Michael Harris II combined to go 5-for-8 with three home runs, five RBI, four extra-base hits and 15 total bases.

A Dating to May 12, Atlanta has three players that rank top-10 in MLB in home runs, all with the given name "Michael"...Michael Harris II is tied for second since that date with four home runs, while Michael Andrew Yastrzemski and Michael Austin Riley are each tied for seventh with three homers apiece.

A Atlanta's 2.1 fWAR by Mikes and Michaels (not counting Riley) are the most in baseball, ahead of the Los Angeles Angels (1.8 fWAR) and Chicago Cubs (1.6 fWAR).

A In his last 13 games dating to May 18, Harris II is slashing .302/.315/.547 (16-for-53) with nine runs scored and four homers...In Yastrzemski's last nine games, he's slashing .409/.500/.955 (9-for-22) with three doubles, three homers, eight RBI and four walks...He has a 1.455 OPS in that time.

Today's Game

Makes his 11th start of the season today in the opener of a three-game weekend series against the Nationals at Truist Park...Will be facing Washington for the first time since beating the club on April 20 at Nationals Park.

Owns a 3-2 record and a 3.18 ERA (16 ER/45.1 IP) over seven career starts against Washington, with four quality starts and 33 strikeouts against seven walks.

Tossed a complete-game shutout against the Nationals on September 26, 2022 at Nationals Park, allowing six hits and walking one while striking out six in an 8-0 win...It is the lone complete game and shutout of his career, and his most innings pitched in a game at 9.0.

Carries a 2.01 ERA (14 ER/62.2 IP) across 10 starts entering play, the fifth-lowest mark among qualified National League starters...The 6-foot-2, 220-pound Texas native has posted a 56-to-20 strikeout-to-walk ratio over the span...Atlanta is 6-4 in his 10 turns.

Dating to August 24 of last season, a 17-start span, Elder has tallied a major-league-most 13 quality starts and posted a 2.35 ERA (28 ER/107.1 IP)...His 2.35 ERA ranks fifth in baseball over the span, behind New York's (AL) Cam Schlichter (1.93), Pittsburgh's Paul Skenes (2.03), Philadelphia's Cristopher Sánchez (2.14) and teammate Chris Sale (2.20).

Has worked at least 5.0 innings while allowing three earned runs or fewer in each of his last 13 starts dating to September 19 of last season...He is the first Atlanta pitcher to do so since Reynaldo López strung together 17 such turns in 2024.

Left-handed batters are 20-for-141 (.142) against him this season, the second-lowest mark among qualified major league starters behind only Milwaukee's Jacob Misiorowski (.113)...Right-handers are 22-for-71 (.262).

Is one of just five pitchers in Atlanta history to make at least six starts in March/April and compile an ERA under 2.00, joining Tom Glavine (1997, 2000, 2002), Greg Maddux (1994), Tim Hudson (2007) and Julio Teheran (2014)...Finished March/April with a 1.88 ERA (9 ER/43.0 IP) over seven starts, marking the first such mark by an Atlanta starter since Teheran in 2014.

His four-seam fastball is averaging 92.1 mph this season, a career-high mark that edges his 91.8 average from 2025 and is up 1.4 mph from his 90.7 mph average across his first four major league seasons from 2022-25.

Has incorporated a cutter into his arsenal this season after not registering the pitch across his first four major league seasons from 2022-25...Has thrown the offering almost exclusively to left-handed batters, going to it against a right-hander just once all season, on May 16 against Boston.

Since the start of the 2023 season, the Braves are 44-36 in Elder's starts...His 78 starts for Atlanta over the span lead the Braves staff.

2026

His 2.01 ERA (14 ER/62.2 IP) over his first 10 starts of the season matches his 2023 mark (2.01, 13 ER/58.1 IP) for the lowest ERA through his first 10 starts of a season in his career...Per Baseball Reference, his other season-opening 10-start spans produced a 4.08 ERA (2025) and a 6.52 ERA (2024).

Has worked more innings (62.2 to 58.1), allowed fewer hits (42 to 52) and recorded more strikeouts (56 to 51) across the 2026 span than he did over his first 10 starts in 2023...His 0.99 WHIP through 10 starts is a career low for the span, down from 1.17 in 2023.

Took the loss in his last outing on May 16 against Boston despite working 8.0 innings of three-run ball on seven hits with no walks and three strikeouts on 103 pitches in a 3-2 defeat at Truist Park...It marked his longest outing since June 7, 2025 at San Francisco, and the second-longest start of his career.

Earned his fourth win on May 10 at Dodger Stadium, allowing one hit over 5.2 scoreless innings with four walks and a season-high-tying eight strikeouts on 83 pitches in the 7-2 victory at Los Angeles (NL)...Marked his second career win against the Dodgers.

Worked 7.0 innings on April 25 against Philadelphia, surrendering a pair of triples in the outing to become the first Brave to do so since Spencer Schwellenbach on September 18, 2024.

Took the loss on April 4 at Arizona despite tossing 7.0 innings without allowing an earned run (4 H, 2 R, 0 ER, 1 BB, 8 K, 89 pitches)...Committed his first career fielding error, a throwing miscue in the second inning that resulted in two unearned runs...Atlanta managed just one run of support in the 2-1 defeat.

Earned the win in his season debut on March 30, tossing 6.0 scoreless innings against the Athletics (5 H, 1 BB, 5 K, 83 pitches)...Recorded his first career pickoff, catching Lawrence Butler at first base in the second inning.

Career

Awards: 2023 National League All-Star.

Completed his first full major league season in 2023, going 12-4 with a 3.81 ERA (74 ER/174.2 IP) in 31 games, all starts.

Named to the 2023 National League All-Star Team, his first selection.

Joined Hall-of-Famer John Smoltz and Michael Soroka as the only starters in Atlanta-franchise history to make the All-Star team in their second year playing.

Career Cont.

Atlanta won 21 games started by Elder in his first full season with the Braves, the second most team victories on the season...Trailed only teammate Spencer Strider's 26 team wins that year.

Made six starts in his career of at least 6.0 innings without allowing a run, the most such games in Braves franchise history (since 1900) in a player's first 25 starts...Irv Young (1905), Clif Curtis (1909-'10) and Ian Anderson ('20-'21) each had five such starts.

Was originally drafted by Atlanta in the fifth round of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Texas...Was the fifth member of the 2020 draft class to debut, and the lowest-selected pick to do so.

Of the first five members to play in the majors from the 2020 draft class, three were selected with the first 11 picks in the draft - Detroit's Spencer Torkelson (No. 1 overall), the Angels' Reid Detmers (No. 10) and the White Sox's Garrett Crochet (No. 11).

The other two were both selected by Atlanta, and chosen with the 126th (Spencer Strider) and 156th (Elder) overall selections.
