THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
SEPT. 16
1995 - 2B Craig Biggio ties a club record by stealing four bases in an Astros 7-4 win over the Expos in Montreal...since this date, no Astros player has recorded four steals in a 9.0-inning game.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The first-place Astros will continue their final homestand of the season tonight as they host the Royals for the middle game of their three-game series in Houston, TX...the resurgent **RHP Cristian Javier** (2-5) will try to pitch the Astros to back-to-back wins tonight as he starts opposite **LHP Daniel Lynch IV** (5-5) and the Royals.

MR. CRISTIAN: **RHP Cristian Javier** is making his 11th start and 16th appearance of the season tonight...he's pitched well in his last two starts, holding the D-backs and Phillies to a combined two runs on four hits in 11.0 innings for a 1.64 ERA...he had 13 strikeouts over those last two starts and has fanned 30 hitters in 23.1 IP over his last five outings.

ASTROS-ROYALS: The Astros and Royals have a memorable history, with the two clubs meeting each other in the 2015 ALDS, won by the Royals in five games...11 years later, **2B Jose Altuve** and **C Salvador Perez** remain on their respective team's active rosters, while **SS Carlos Correa**, currently on the IL, also played in the series...more recently, the Astros are 10-4 in their last 14 games against the Royals, including a 3-1 record this season.

HADER NAMED CLEMENTE NOMINEE: For the second straight season, **LHP Josh Hader** has been named the Astros nominee for the **Roberto Clemente Award**, baseball's most prestigious individual honor for MLB players...the Roberto Clemente Award, presented by Capital One, is the annual recognition of an MLB player who best represents the game of baseball through extraordinary character, community involvement, philanthropy and positive contributions, both on and off the field.

LOS ASTROS: Space City Home Network will televise tonight's game in English and Spanish with the Spanish broadcast being televised on SCHN2...**Enrique Vasquez** and **Danny Gonzales** will be on the call on the Spanish telecast tonight.

MEDIA PARKING UPDATE: Media parking will be exclusively available in Lot C for the entirety of the Royals series...Lot B will reopen to media for the weekend series vs. the Braves.

POSTSEASON CREDENTIALS: Media may now apply for credentials for potential Astros postseason home games in the Wild Card Series and ALDS on MLB's credentialing system...the deadline to apply for Wild Card Series credentials is Sunday, Sept. 27...ALCS and World Series credential applications are also live on MLB's credentialing system.

LAST NIGHT'S WIN: The Astros picked up a 4-2 win last night behind a huge game by **SS Jeremy Peña** (3x4, 2RBI), who homered twice, including a leadoff shot...he was joined by **DH Yordan Alvarez** (1x2, 2RBI), who connected for a two-run homer in the 5th...**RHP Hunter Brown** (1ER/5IP) earned the victory, fanning 10 hitters, which ties his career high.

BROTHER BROWN: Astros ace **RHP Hunter Brown** has posted a 5-2 record and a 3.00 ERA (19ER/57IP) in his last nine starts (since July 25), pitching through the 5th inning in all nine outings...Brown, who finished third in the AL Cy Young Award voting last season, has been limited this season, missing over two months due to a lengthy stint on the IL (April 1-June 15) with a right shoulder strain.

ON THE MEND: The Astros have five players on the Major League Injured List...updates on four:

- RHP Mike Burrows** (rt. shoulder inflammation) threw 20 pitches off a mound on Sunday at the Astros Florida complex...he will continue his throwing progression in Houston this week.
- IF Carlos Correa** (lt. ankle tendon injury) will not return to the active roster in 2026...Correa spent last week rehabbing at the Astros Florida complex and during the ramp-up process he experienced soreness in his surgically repaired ankle...he will return to Houston this week to be medically re-evaluated.
- LHP Steven Okert** (rt. hamstring strain) spent last week at the Astros Florida complex, where he began a throwing progression...he will continue his throwing progression in Houston this week.
- OF Brice Matthews** (lt. knee sprain) began a minor league rehab assignment last week with Triple A Sugar Land...he's played in four games so far, appearing defensively in CF, 2B, 3B and LF.

TRIPLE THREAT: **DH Yordan Alvarez**, who is a solid candidate for the AL MVP Award, currently ranks first or second in the AL in all three **Triple Crown** categories...he enters today leading the AL in batting avg. (.310), while ranking second in HR (39) and RBI (98)...Alvarez also leads the Majors in OPS (1.023), SLG (.594) and OBP (.429)...since **Carl Yastrzemski** won the AL Triple Crown in 1967, there has been just one Triple Crown winner in the Majors, **Miguel Cabrera** in 2012 (AL)...AL leaders below:

TRIPLE DIGITS: **DH Yordan Alvarez** reached 98 RBI last night and is looking to post the 29th 100-RBI season in Astros history...Alvarez's career high in RBI is 104, which he reached in 2021.

LEADING MAN: **SS Jeremy Peña** hit his fifth leadoff home run of the season last night, and the 10th of his career, a total that ranks fifth in Astros history...he now immediately trails **OF Terry Puhl** (13 leadoff HR) for fourth on that all-time list.

STALKING 200: **1B Christian Walker** is currently sitting on 199 career home runs and needs just one homer to become the 35th active Major League player to reach 200 career long balls...Walker has hit 25 homers this year for his fifth consecutive 25-plus homer season (2022-26).

THE FIREMAN: **LHP Josh Hader** converted his 26th consecutive save opportunity to open his season last night, which sets the Astros franchise record...the previous record of converting 25 consecutive saves opportunities to begin a season was set last season by Hader as well...should Hader finish the season without a blown save, he would become just the seventh pitcher in MLB history to post 26-plus saves without a blown save and the first to do so since **RHP Ken Giles** in 2018 (26 SV).

CHAMPS!: The Class A Fayetteville Woodpeckers won the Carolina League Championship Series last night with a 7-4 win over Charleston in Game 2 of the three-game championship series...this gives the Astros two minor league champions this season, which includes the FCL Astros, who took home their respective title.

LAST START, SEPT. 10 at PHI: Notched his 2nd quality start of the season, allowing 1 run on 3 hits through 6.0 innings with 1 walk and 5 strikeouts in the Astros' 2-1 win over the Phillies last Thursday at Citizens Bank Park...matched his season high in innings (also, Aug. 3 vs. TOR)...marked his 1st start in which he tossed 6.0+ innings and allowed 3-or-fewer hits since Aug. 29, 2025 vs. LAA (6.0 IP, 0 H)...was also his 100th career start.

EL REPTIL: The Dominican hurler, who's in his 7th MLB season with the Astros...the 2026 season is his first full season since missing parts of the 2024-25 seasons after undergoing Tommy John surgery...has pitched as both a starter (10g) and reliever (5g) this year, while pitching around a midseason, 3-month IL stint.

REPTIL ON A RUN: Over his last 4 starts (since Aug. 18 vs. LAA), he's posted a 3.32 ERA (7ER/19IP) with 26 strikeouts, a .191 opponent batting average (13x68) and a 1.05 WHIP.

ON THE CHASE: Has induced a 34.6-percent chase rate this season, which would set his single-season career high and ranks in the 86th percentile among MLB pitchers...would surpass a 29.0-percent chase rate from 2023...has logged a 42.7-percent chase rate with his changeup, which would also set a career high, surpassing a 41.2-percent rate from 2025.

SINCE HIS RETURN: Is making his 9th start since being reinstated from the 60-day IL on July 3...has posted a 4.08 ERA (21ER/46.1IP) with 51 strikeouts (14 walks) in his 12 total appearances since returning from the IL.

AS A STARTER: Began the season as the Astros' No. 3 starter and made 3 turns in the rotation before being placed on the IL with his right shoulder strain...has worked predominantly as a starter since the 2022 season, making 81 of his 91 total appearances in that span as a starter...has gone 35-25 with a 3.95 ERA (224ER/510.1IP), a .211 opponent batting average, and a 1.17 WHIP in his 100 career regular-season starts.

KEEP IT 100!: Became the 34th pitcher in franchise history to make 100 career starts with the club...also became just the 11th pitcher to do so for the franchise since 2000, the first year of Daikin Park.

VS. KC: Will be facing the Royals for the 1st time since a start on April 9, 2024, at Kauffman Stadium (2ER/5.1IP)...owns a career 5.60 ERA (11ER/17.2IP) in 5 career apps. (3 starts) vs. KC.

A CUT ABOVE: Has begun to mix a cutter into his repertoire, tossing it at a single-game career-high 17.4-percent rate in his start on Aug. 9 at SD...had not thrown a tracked cutter in his MLB career prior to his appearance on July 27 at LAA...has held opponents to a .235 batting average (4x17) with his cutter this season.

IN RELIEF: Has posted a 2.70 ERA (4ER/13.1IP) with 17 strikeouts, a 1.20 WHIP and a .245 opponent batting average through 5 relief appearances this season...his relief appearance on July 4 vs. TB was his 1st regular-season relief outing since Aug. 26, 2022 vs. BAL.

WELCOME BACK: Was reinstated from the 60-day IL on July 3 after missing 76 games (April 9-July 1) due to a right shoulder strain...has battled a multitude of injuries the past few seasons, also missing most of the 2024 and '25 seasons due to Tommy John surgery (underwent the procedure in June 2024)...returned from Tommy John surgery on Aug. 11, 2025, going 2-4 with a 4.62 ERA (19ER/37IP) in eight starts to close out the season.

LAST APPEARANCE (9/15 vs. KC): Tossed a perfect 8th inning with 1 strikeout in last night's win vs. KC to pick up his 15th hold of the season...needed just 7 pitches (5 strikes) to navigate the scoreless frame.

TURNING THE PAGE: Since May 3, he has gone 6-2-7 with a 2.16 ERA (12ER/50IP)...also has recorded 61 strikeouts, a 1.08 WHIP and a .172 opponent average during the stretch...prior to May 3, Abreu had a 12.54 ERA in his first 11 apps. of the season...among AL relievers since May 3 (min. 50 IP), he ranks 4th in opponent batting average and 5th in SO/9 (10.98).

ASTROS RANKINGS: Enters tonight with 525 career strikeouts and is 4 strikeouts from matching RHP Dave Smith (529) for the 3rd-most by a reliever in Astros history.

VS. KC: In 14 career appearances vs. the Royals, he's recorded a 3.00 ERA (4ER/12IP) with 11 strikeouts.

SAVANT SAYS: Ranks in the 97th percentile in whiff perc. (34.7%), 93rd percentile in K rate (30.3%) and 93rd percentile in xBA (.197) per Baseball Savant.

A CUT ABOVE: Began throwing a cutter this season in his outing on June 2 vs. PIT and has tossed the pitch at a 10.7 percent rate on the season...has held opponents to a .158 batting average (3x19) vs. his cutter this year.
