AROUND THE HORN

KELLY’S FIRST BOBBLEHEAD TONIGHT: Tonight, the team will celebrate a starting rotation mainstay with the Merrill Kelly Bobble courtesy of Casino Arizona & Talking Stick Resort for the first 20,000 fans in attendance.

KPOP DEMON HUNTERS TOMORROW: Tomorrow, fans will want to act fast to ensure they get the exclusive D-backs x KPop Demon Hunters Tee as club’s popular Special Event Ticket Pack series embraces the worldwide phenomenon.

HERE’S THE STORY: The D-backs are a season-high-tying 10 games above .500 (also: 78-68 on Sept. 8).

- The D-backs have won 5 of their last 6 games and 6 of their last 8.
- D-backs starters’ combined 2.16 ERA (6 ER in 25.0 IP) in their last 6 games since Sept. 5 ranks second in the Majors to the Rays (1.83).
- The D-backs have won or split 5 of their last 6 series (4 wins, 1 split).
- The D-backs are 10-5 in their last 15 Interleague games.
- **Ketel Marte** has a 9-game hitting streak since re- turning from the 10-day Injured List on Aug. 31, batting .286 (10-for-35)/.838 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 homer, 6 RBI, 5 walks, 1 hit by pitch and 1 sac fly... has reached base 2+ times in 6 games.
- **Brandon Pfaadt**, in his last 13 starts, is 7-1 (Team 11-2) with a 2.38 ERA (21 ER in 79.1 IP), opponent .222 AVG, 0.98 WHIP, 12 walks and 46 strikeouts.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 9-1 vs. Rangers on Fri- day...on 9/11, the D-backs recorded exactly 9 runs on 11 hits, the first team to do so since the Mets on Sept. 11, 2019 vs. D-backs.

- **Merrill Kelly** went decisionless after tossing 4.1 in- nings with 1 run allowed on 2 hits and 3 walks with 3 strikeouts.
- **Justin Martinez** recorded the fifth immaculate in- ning in franchise history (83rd in MLB since 1998) in the sixth inning and second of the season for the D-backs (also: Michael Soroka on March 30 vs. Tigers, fourth in club history and 80th in MLB since 1998).
- **Ildemaro Vargas** (2-for-5, 2B, RBI) and **Ketel Marte** (2-for-4, 2 2B, 3 RBI) got the D-backs on the board with back-to-back doubles in the fifth inning to take a 3-1 lead.
- **Gabriel Moreno** went 2-for-5 with 2 RBI.
- **Corbin Carroll** (20) and **Nolan Arenado** (team lead 24) hit back-to-back homers in the sixth inning, the D-backs’ fourth occurrence this season, to push the lead to 9-1.
- **Kevin Ginkel** (W, 0.2 IP), **Taylor Clarke** (1.0) and **Dennis Santana** (2.0) combined for 3.2 scoreless frames with 3 hits, 1 walk and 2 strikeouts.

ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs selected INF/OF **Pavin Smith** from Triple-A Reno, optioned C **Adrian Del Castillo** to Reno following last night’s game and re- called INF **Tyler Locklear** to the roster and placed him on the 60-day Injured List (fractured right thumb).

CORBIN CONTINUES HISTORY: **Corbin Carroll** with his 20+ homers, 20+ stolen bases and 15+ triples, recorded the 10th such season in MLB history...Carroll is the first player with 2 such seasons (2025, 2026). [h/t: SlangsOnSports].

- On Friday, Carroll recorded his fourth straight sea- son with 20+ doubles, 10+ triples and 20+ homers (2023-26).
- His 4 straight such seasons is tied for the sec- ond-longest streak in baseball history [also: Johnny Callison/PHI 1962-65 and Dick Allen/PHI 1964-67)], behind Lou Gehrig/NYY (5 straight, 1927-31) [Elias Sports Bureau].

J-MAR’S IMMACULATE NIGHT: **Justin Martinez’s** immaculate inning featured 5 swings and misses, 1 called strike and 1 foul, with 4 straight whiffs to close out the inning.

- **Martinez** joins Randy Johnson (Aug. 12, 2001 @ Pirates), Byung- Hyun Kim (May 11, 2002 @ Phillies), Wade Miley (Oct. 1, 2012 vs. Rockies) and Michael Soroka (March 30, 2026 vs. Tigers) as the 5 D-backs to achieve the feat.
- The D-backs are the first team to record multiple such innings in a season since the Pirates in 2023 (Colin Holderman and Johan Oviedo).

RETURN WITH AUTHORITY: **Justin Martinez** has not al- lowed an earned run in 8 games (2 R-0 ER in 7.2 IP) since returning from the 60-day Injured List on Aug. 18...is 2-0 with an opponent .080 AVG (2-for-25)/.338 OPS with a 0.91 WHIP, 5 walks, 11 strikeouts and no extra-base hits.

WILD CARD RACE: The D-backs are in fourth place in the NL Wild Card race, a 0.5 game behind the Padres (Sea- son tied 5-5), 3.0 games behind the Cubs (T-WC1, trail 2-4) and the Phillies (T-WC1, tied 3-3).

OVER THE LONG HAUL: The D-backs are 12 games above .500 (34-22) since July 9...their 34 wins since then are tied for third most in the Majors (also: Braves, Brew- ers, Rays), behind the Red Sox (38) and Yankees (35).

HOME SWEET HOME: **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base safely in 35 of his last 38 home games, batting .305 (43-for-141)/.834 OPS with 11 doubles, 1 triple, 2 homers, 21 RBI and 21 walks.

- **Ketel Marte** has a 7-game home hitting streak, batting .423 (11-for-26)/1.285 OPS with 3 doubles, 2 homers, 8 RBI and 3 walks.

TRENDING BATS: **Nolan Arenado** has 3 homers in his last 5 games while hitting .412 (7-for-17)/1.545 OPS with 1 double, 5 RBI and 5 walks.

- **Gabriel Moreno** has hit safely in his last 5 starts at a .346 clip (9-for-26)/.952 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 ho- mer, 5 RBI and 3 walks.
- **Tim Tawa** has hit in his last 5 games (with PA) at a .389 clip (7-for-18)/.977 with 1 homer, 2 RBI and 1 walk.

VS. RANGERS: The D-backs have taken 4 of their last 5 home series...have won or tied 8 of their last 9 home series since 2013.

• The D-backs are 8-4 in their last 12 overall meetings.
