GUARD PLAY: The Twins are playing the Guardians today for the 11th and 12th times of 13 games in 2025...Twins have gone 3-7 this season, going 1-2 at Target Field and 2-5 at Progressive Field...these two will first meet in 2026 for three games at Progressive from May 8-10.
◆ Six of the 10 games this season between these two teams have been decided by one run... the Twins have gone 2-4 in those games.
◆ Since the start of 2024, 16 of the 23 games between these two have been decided by two runs-or-fewer (Twins 3-13 in those)...and 11 have been decided by one run (Twins 2-9).
◆ Austin Martin is hitting .368 (7-for-19) in eight career games against the Guardians.

THE LEFTORIUM: Twins are hitting .302 (71-for-235) with an .867 OPS over their last 21 games against left-handed pitching.

◆ Brooks Lee is hitting .301 (28-for-93) with an .830 OPS in his last 54 games vs. lefties.

◆ Byron Buxton is hitting .305 (29-for-95) with nine home runs, a .684 slugging percentage and a 1.055 OPS against left-handed pitching on the season — his highest OPS vs. lefties in his career...Buck's .684 slugging percentage ranks second-best in baseball this season, trailing Aaron Judge (.750).

◆ Austin Martin is hitting .361 (13-for-36) with a .967 OPS against lefties this season.

ALL ABOUT THAT BASE: The Twins have stolen a base in a season-high seven-straight games, their longest streak since swiping a bag in 10-straight games from July 19-28, 2004...they have 105 stolen bases on the season, their most under a Rocco Baldelli-led team and their most since stealing 135 in 2012...the club record (since 1961) is 151 in 1997.

AUSTIN POWER: Austin Martin went 1-for-4 last night, extending his career-high on-base streak to 15 games (previous was 8)...over his last 22 games, Martin is hitting .347 (25-for-72) with six doubles, four RBI, 14 runs scored, 14 walks, just 14 strikeouts, a .460 on-base percentage and an .890 OPS.

◆ Martin has posted a .420 on-base percentage in 17 games this month, fifth-best in the AL and 14th-best in baseball.
