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THE TWINS: Have gone 1-3 through four games on their nine-game, 10-day roadtrip, losing a series 1-2 at Seattle over the weekend, followed by a loss in Kansas City last night...tonight, they will continue the trip with the second of three against the Royals at Kauffman Stadium through tomorrow night...after tomorrow night's game, they will travel to Milwaukee to play the Brewers at American Family Field over the weekend.

KANSAS CITY, MISERY: The Twins lost to the Royals last night by a score of 8-2, officially securing the season-series for the Royals...Joe Ryan (6-8) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing five runs (4 earned) on seven hits in 5.1 innings pitched, with two walks and three strikeouts...the offense recorded seven hits, four from Royce Lewis, one double and three singles...four hits for Royce tied his single-game career-high, done once before, on June 9, 2023 at Toronto...Josh Bell also added two hits, one being a home run, his 14th of the season.

WINNESOTA: Since May 9, the Twins have gone 40-35, for a .533 winning percentage, fifth-highest in the AL since that date:

ROYALTY CHECKS: The Twins and Royals are playing each other today for the 12th of 13 games in 2026...Twins have gone 4-7 vs. KC this season, 1-3 at Kauffman and 3-4 at Target Field. Tonight is the penultimate game of 2026 against the Royals...after tomorrow night's game, Kansas City will be the only team in the AL Central in which the Twins are done playing this season...these two will meet again to open the 2027 season at Kauffman on March 25.

Since the start of 2023, the Twins have gone 18-9 at home vs. the Royals, compared to 8-15 at Kauffman Stadium.

Twins have 197 wins all-time at Kauffman Stadium, their most in any opposing ballpark in their history (since 1961)...also the most for any opponent in this park (next: CWS - 189).

Josh Bell has eight hits against the Royals this season, four being home runs...Bell is hitting .306 (37-for-121) with seven doubles, nine home runs, 28 RBI and a .974 OPS in 34 career games vs. Kansas City...four of his 14 home runs this season have been against the Royals (April 1 off Falter, April 2 off Cruz, June 7 off Way and last night off Cruz)...he has seven home runs, 17 RBI and a 1.017 OPS in 18 career games at Kauffman.

In nine games against the Royals this season, Kody Clemens is hitting .353 (12-for-34) with three doubles, four home runs, seven RBI and a 1.183 OPS...he has 17 career hits against the Royals, eight of which are home runs.

FIRST IS THE WORST: Twins have allowed exactly two runs in the first inning in each of their last four games...Minnesota is 34-23 this season when scoring first, compared to 22-35 when the opponent does so...last time the Twins scored in the first inning was July 26 vs. the Athletics.

SERIES CONVERSATIONS: Twins need wins tonight and tomorrow to earn their 19th series victory of the season...they have gone 18-16-2 in series play, 11-5-1 at home and 7-11-1 on the road.

Twins began the season going 8-13-1 in their first 22 series through June 11, but have gone 10-3-1 their last 14 series overall, dating back to June 12-14 vs. St. Louis.

Twins have gone 4-2-1 in series play on the road over their last seven chances, but 0-2-1 in their last three...their last road series win was July 3-5 at Yankee Stadium.

Twins last series win at Kauffman Stadium was March 28-31, 2024, taking two of three...they have gone 0-4-0 in series play in this ballpark since.

KEEP THEIR HEADS RINGIN': Josh Bell is hitting .314 (16-for-51) with a .908 OPS in his last 12 road games...below are Bell's overall number comparisons from Opening Day through May 31 and since June 1:

He has 64 RBI on the season, tied for 12th-most in the AL.

He is on pace to record 90 RBI, which would be tied for second-most of his career (116 - 2019 & 90 in 2017).

ROYCE ROLLS: Royce Lewis has hit safely in nine-straight games, tying his career-high (previously September 14, 2023-June 5, 2024)...Lewis' streak ties Ryan Jeffers (July 21-August 2) for longest by a Twin this season...during the streak, Lewis is slashing .382/.400/.706. Additionally, has reached safely via hit or walk in a career-high 15-straight games.

MERITOCRACY: Low-A Fort Myers right-handed pitcher Merit Jones has been named Florida State League minor league Player of the Month for July...he went 3-0 with a 0.73 ERA in six appearances (3 starts) as he allowed two earned runs on 21 hits and eight walks while striking out 30 over 24.2 innings...he led the league in innings pitched (24.2), ERA (0.73) and wins (three) and was second in strikeouts (30) and strikeouts per nine innings (10.95)...Jones, 23, was selected by Minnesota in the 14th round of the 2025 MLB Draft out of the University of Utah.

GREAT DIVIDE: Tonight, Target Field is hosting Noah Kahan's "The Great Divide Tour"...two-time GRAMMY-nominated, multi-platinum Vermont singer-songwriter Noah Kahan has risen from his New England roots to become a globally resonant voice of his generation...across his career, Kahan has amassed nearly 15 billion global streams, sold nearly 12 million global albums, earned 22 Platinum and Gold certifications, and sold over 1.5 million tickets with headline shows in legendary venues around the world. This marks one of many concert events held at Target Field over the years, including Kenny Chesney, Foo Fighters, Pink, Eagles, Zac Brown Band, Billy Joel, Paul McCartney, and more.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2001, Kirby Puckett and Dave Winfield, along with Bill Mazeroski and Hilton Smith, were inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame...in 2023, the Twins inducted Joe Mauer into their Hall of Fame, making him the 38th member of the club...Mauer was inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame on July 21, 2024.
