#### Record Pace

The Brewers are on pace for 98 wins, which would break the regular season franchise record of 96 accomplished in 2011 (96-66) and 2018 (96-67).

#### <u>Separation</u>

The Brewers currently lead the Reds by 11.0 games in the NL Central, which marks the largest divisional lead in franchise history.....the largest lead prior to this season was 10.5 games several times in 2011 (last: 9/5/11).

# Had My Phil

The Brewers are 0-5 against the Phillies this season and have been shut out in the last 2 games.....their 12-0 loss yesterday was the largest margin of defeat to the Phillies in franchise history.....the previous high was 10 runs twice, coming in 13-3 (8/21/02 in Milwaukee) and 10-0 (8/29/04 in Philadelphia) losses.

# You've Got Maile

Luke Maile yesterday made the third pitching appearance of his career as he threw the ninth inning of the 12-0 loss (1ip, 2h, 1r, 1er, 1hr).....his previous pitching appearances came with the Blue Jays on 5/5/19 at Texas (1ip, 1k) and 5/25/19 vs. San Diego (1ip, 1h, 2k, 1hbp)....Maile joined Daniel Robertson (4/23 vs. ChC) and Jace Peterson (8/14 at Pit-G1) as the only position players to pitch for the team in 2021.

Josh Hader is unscored upon in his last 11 outings (10.1ip, 4h, 3bb, 19k).

# Born Again Christian

In his last 25 games, **Christian Yelich** is batting .326 (30-for-92) with 2 HR and 12 RBI.....he has scored 15 runs during this stretch and has posted a .373 on-base percentage.

# Yes I Cain!

In his last 32 games, **Lorenzo Cain** is batting .295 (31-for-105) with 4 HR, 20 RBI and 19 runs.

AT HOME: The Brewers are 38-31 at home, going 11-9-2 in series play.....had seasonhigh 7-game home winning streaks from 6/3-6/13 and 6/25-7/8.....had a season-high 5-game home losing streak from 7/9-7/21.

<u>ON THE ROAD</u>: The Brewers are 46-24 on the road, going 17-4-1 in series play.....had a season-high 8-game road winning streak from 7/7-7/30.....had a season-high 5-game road losing streak from 5/3-5/7.....are 1 win away from tying the franchise record for wins on the road set by the 1982 team [47-33].

ALL-STARS: The Brewers were represented at the All-Star Game by Corbin Burnes, Josh Hader, Freddy Peralta, Brandon Woodruff and Omar Narváez.....the five players selected tied a franchise record, all consecutively (also 2018 and 2019)....it marked the first time in franchise history that the team had three or more pitchers selected.

MANAGER: Craig Counsell is in his seventh season as manager [518-467] and sixth full season.....he is second in franchise history in wins, trailing Phil Garner (563-617)..... under Counsell, the Brewers made the postseason in three consecutive years for the first time in franchise history (2018-20).....Counsell was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing Ron Roenicke.....he is signed through 2023.

COACHES: Assistant hitting coach Jacob Cruz (2nd season), hitting coach Andy Haines (3rd season), pitching coach Chris Hook (3rd season), bullpen coach Steve Karsay (3rd season), third base coach Jason Lane (6th season, 1st as 3B coach), associate pitching, catching and strategy coach Walker McKinven (2nd season) and bench coach Pat Murphy (6th season) all returned from the 2020 coaching staff.....new to the staff is first base coach Quintin Berry.

# TONIGHT'S STARTER: #52 - LHP ERIC LAUER (19g, 15gs, 4-5, 3.43)

LAUER AT A GLANCE: Eric Lauer, 26, will make his 20th appearance and 16th start of the season.....it will be his second appearance against the Phillies....Lauer last started last Thursday at San Francisco and had no decision in the Brewers' 5-1 loss (7ip, 3h, 1r, 1er, 1bb, 4k, 1hr, 1wp, 90 pitches).....he is 4-5 with a 3.26 ERA as a starter (77.1ip, 28er) and 0-0 with a 4.50 ERA in relief (12ip, 6er).....the team is 7-8 in his starts.....he has 6 quality starts.....opponents are batting .228 (77-for-338, 13hr).....he is in his third stint with the team in 2021 (4/29-5/14, 5/26-8/3 and 8/15-current).....was on the injured list (COVID-19) from 8/4-8/14....Lauer was acquired from San Diego with INF Luis Urías and a player to be named or cash in exchange for RHP Zach Davies and 0F Trent Grisham on 11/27/19 (trade completed on 5/27/20 - cash).

CAREER: Is 18-24 with a 4.43 ERA in 76 games / 69 starts (362ip, 178er).....is in his fourth Major League season with San Diego (2018-19) and Milwaukee (2020-21).....was the Padres' Opening Day starter in 2019.....Lauer was selected by San Diego in the first round (25th overall) of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Kent State University.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 3-5 with a 5.67 ERA in 12 games / 11 starts (54ip, 34er)....is 3-3 with a 3.99 ERA in 10 games / 9 starts this season (47.1ip, 21er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 8-11 with a 4.81 ERA in 37 games / 32 starts [170.1ip, 91er].....is 1-2 with a 2.79 ERA in 9 games / 6 starts this season [42ip, 13er].

CAREER vs. PHILLIES: Is 1-1 with a 2.25 ERA in 2 starts (12ip, 3er), including a 6-5 loss this season on 5/4 at Citizens Bank Park (6ip, 8h, 6r, 2er, 0bb, 7k, 3hr).....his other start vs. Philadelphia came in an 8-2 win for the Padres on 6/3/19 at Petco Park (6ip, 2h, 1r, 1er, 3bb, 3k, 1hbp).....both starts came against Aaron Nola.
