ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs made the following roster moves:

- Recalled C **Adrian Del Castillo** from Triple-A Reno
- Selected RHP **Trevor Richards** (No. 38) from Triple-A Reno
- Signed INF **Sergio Alcántara** (No. 3) as a Major League free agent
- Placed INF **Ketel Marte** on the Restricted List
- Optioned INF **Tristin English** to Triple-A Reno
- Optioned RHP **Juan Morillo** to Triple-A Reno (post-game Sunday)
- Transferred C **Gabriel Moreno** to 60-Day Injured List (right hand contusion)

ALL-STAR RECAP: **Ketel Marte** (starting 2B), **Corbin Carroll** (reserve OF) and **Eugenio Suárez** (reserve 3B) - were key contributors in a historic evening in Atlanta to help lead the National League to victory.

- Marte** (1-2, 2B, 2 RBI) became the first D-back with multiple RBI in an All-Star Game, as well as the first D-back with a RBI since Luis Gonzalez in 2005 @ Comerica Park (Detroit)...the now 3-time All-Star has hit safely in each of his All-Star appearances and is tied with Devon White (3) for second all-time in All-Star hits, trailing only Gonzalez (4).
- Carroll** (1-1, HR, RBI) is the first D-back to hit a home run in the All-Star Game, with a solo home run off Tigers' RHP Casey Mize to also mark his first career All-Star hit...entering the game, Arizona was the only team to never record a home run in an All-Star Game.
- Suárez** (0-1, HBP) entered the game at third base in the fifth inning and had a highlight-reel barehanded play for the first out of the ninth inning...he was hit by a pitch in his second plate appearance which removed him from consideration for the end-of-game Home Run Derby.

2025 DRAFT RECAP: The D-backs drafted 14 pitchers and 6 position players over the 2-day 2025 MLB draft, including:

- SS **Kayson Cunningham** (Age 19; Round 1; 18th overall) out of Lady Bird Johnson HS (San Antonio, Texas)...No. 14 overall draft prospect by MLB Pipeline and No. 1 draft prospect in state of Texas by MLB Pipeline and *Perfect Game*.
- RHP **Patrick Forbes** (Age 21; Compensation Pick; 29th overall) out of the University of Louisville...No. 31 overall draft prospect by MLB Pipeline and rated as No. 1 player in Kentucky by *Perfect Game*.
- RHP **Jack Martinez** (Age 22; Round 8; 243rd overall) out of Arizona State University.
- INF **Brady Counsell** (Age 22; Round 10; 303rd overall) out of the University of Kansas...son of Craig Counsell, D-backs 2001 NLCS MVP and current manager of the Chicago Cubs.
- RHP **Raul Garayzar** (Age 22; Round 18; 543rd overall) out of the University of Arizona.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 5-1 @ Angels on Sunday.

- The D-backs combined for a 4-run fourth inning that sent 8 batters to the plate.
- Geraldo Perdomo** was the first to reach in each scoring inning via a walk (leadoff in fourth; 1-out in fifth).
- Blaze Alexander** went 2-for-4 with 1 double and his first RBI.
- Merrill Kelly** earned his eighth win behind 5.0 innings of 1-hit, 1-run ball.
- Relievers **John Curtiss**, **Kevin Ginkel** and **Kendall Graveman** combined for 4.0 scoreless frames.

SNAKEBITES: D-backs' hitters vs. right-handed pitching have combined for an MLB-best .459 SLG [league AVG: .406], ahead of the Yankees (.454), Cubs (.451) and Dodgers (.444).

- Corbin Carroll**, when ahead in the count, has a MLB-best 1.950 OPS [league AVG: 1.107], ahead of James Wood/WSH (1.815), Aaron Judge/NYY (1.780), Cal Raleigh/SEA (1.776), Bryce Harper/PHI (1.690) and Shohei Ohtani/LAD (1.598).
- Eugenio Suarez**, when behind in the count (0-1, 0-2, 1-2, 2-2) has a NL-fourth-best .426 SLG [league AVG: .312], behind Kyle Tucker/CHC (.483), Pete Alonso/NYM (.470) and Michael Busch/CHC (.466).
- Geraldo Perdomo**, when behind in the count (0-1, 0-2, 1-2, 2-2) has reached 56 times [league AVG: 17.4], tied for third most in the Majors with Sal Frelick/MIL, behind Luis Arráez/SD (57) and Bobby Witt Jr/KC (57).

VS. CARDINALS: In their initial 3-game series on the road vs. Cardinals from May 23-25, the D-backs fell in 3 straight 1-run games, the first time ever doing so against St. Louis and first time in any 3-game series since Aug. 24-26, 2020 vs. Rockies.

- Randal Grichuk**, in his 3 games @ Cardinals this season, hit .500 (3-for-6)/1.167 SLG with 1 double, 1 homer, 2 RBI and 1 walk.
- Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** has hit safely in 3 straight games...in his last 8 games, has hit .343 (12-for-35)/.457 SLG with 1 double, 1 homer and 6 RBI.
- Jake McCarthy**, in his last 6 games, has hit .389 (7-for-18) with 1 double, 1 RBI and 2 walks.

CALL TO THE 'PEN: D-backs relievers, in their last 10 games since July 4, are fifth in the Majors with a 1.97 ERA (7 ER in 32.0 IP), and are scoreless in 7 of the 10 games.

- Among all bullpens since June 30 (14 G), the D-backs are the only staff to surrender only 1 homer.

- In his last 6 starts, since June 13, is 3-0 with a 2.43 ERA (9 ER in 33.1 IP), opponent .203 AVG, 1.02 WHIP, 10 walks and 27 strikeouts...the D-backs are 5-1 in those starts.
- Tossed a quality start in his last bid vs. Cardinals on April 13, 2024 (W; 1 ER in 6.0 IP)...D-backs won 4-2.

- The D-backs are 7-4 in the last 11 games he hits a home run.
- Hit his 30th home run on July 12 @ Angels to become the second D-back with 30+ home runs before the All-Star Break, joining Luis Gonzalez in 2001 (35 HR in 87 G)...he joins Luis Gonzalez (2001) as the only D-backs with 30+ home runs in the team’s first 96 games.
- Had his 20th career multi-homer game on July 12 @ Angels.
- Recorded his 900th career RBI on June 30 vs. Giants (on solo homer).
- Hit his 250th career double on June 28 vs. Marlins
- Named the NL Player of the Week on June 23, his third career honor (all this season, also: March 31 and April 28)...he is the first D-back to win 3+ honors in a single season and it is the first time Arizona has won 3+ awards since 2019.
