- Made four appearances for Seattle in 2019, posting a 14.73 ERA (6 ER/3.2 IP)

- Pitched for the Surprise Saguaros in the Arizona Fall League following the 2019 season; appeared in nine games, posting a 2.08 ERA (2 ER/8.2 IP) with 11 K

- Has appeared in back-to-back games for the O's; posted a 7.90 ERA (12 ER/13.2 IP) on 0 days rest in 2019
- Appeared on his fifth career Opening Day roster, and third-straight with Baltimore
- His 65 games were second-most on the O's during the 2019 season (Fry - 66)
- Had a 2.91 ERA (11 ER/34.0 IP) in 35 road games, as opposed to a 6.18 ERA (27 ER/39.1 IP) in 30 games at Oriole Park
- His 73.1 IP as a reliever last season ranked as the 10<sup>th</sup>-most in the AL
- Posted a 0.89 ERA (2 ER/20.1 IP) when pitching on 3+ days of rest in 2019
- Worked to a 3.72 ERA (12 ER/29.0 IP) with a .183 (19-for-104) opponents batting average in 29 appearances after the All-Star Break
- Had a season-long scoreless stretch of 9.2 IP (10 games) from 8/25-9/17

- Has a career 10.00 ERA (10 ER/9.0 IP) in 12 appearances against NYY
- Appeared on his second-straight Opening Day roster
- Led the O's with 66 appearances, tied for fifth-most among left-handed pitchers in the AL this season
- Posted a 3.95 ERA (12 ER/27.1 IP) in 31 home games, as opposed to a 6.60 ERA (22 ER/30.0 IP) in 35 road games; seven of his nine losses came on the road
- Allowed just 11 of 43 inherited runners to score during the 2019 season (25.6%), the 8<sup>th</sup>-lowest percentage in the AL

- Has recorded at least two strikeouts in 128 of his 285 career appearances
- Appeared on his fifth-straight Opening Day roster with the O's
- Was one of 11 players in the majors during 2019 to record at least 10 saves and at least seven holds
- Worked more than 1.0 inning in six of his 11 saves last season
- Retired 46 of the 58 first batters he faced during the 2019 season
- Allowed only two-of-21 (9.5%) inherited runners to score; tied for the third lowest percentage in the majors during 2019 among pitchers with at least 20 inherited runners

- Made nine relief appearances for the Orioles in 2019 and posted a 6.57 ERA (9 ER/12.1 IP) in these games
- Made five stints with the big league club (Opening Day Roster-6/17, 7/6-8, 7/13-14, 7/29-8/8, 9/3-end of season) during the 2019 season

- ⚾ Hit .390/.422/.627 (23-for-59) with nine extra-base hits, 12 runs, and nine RBI in 17 games against NYY last season, including hitting .424 (14-for-33) in 10 home games
- ⚾ Batting .404 (91-for-225) against left-handers since the start of the 2019 season; his 91 hits during this stretch leads the majors; next closest is Charlie Blackmon with 67 hits
- ⚾ Batting .360 (86-for-239) when leading off or hitting second in the lineup (since the start of 2019)
- ⚾ His .352 (94-for-267) batting average on the road, since the beginning of the 2019 season, leads the majors
- ⚾ Recorded the Orioles first hit of the 2020 season, a single in his first at-bat in the second inning
- ⚾ Appeared on this third career Opening Day roster (2016, 2019, 2020)
- ⚾ Finished the 2019 season ranked eighth in the AL and 16<sup>th</sup> in the majors in batting average
- ⚾ His 88 hits against lefties in 2019 were the most in a single-season in O's history
- ⚾ Was the 17<sup>th</sup> time in MLB history (14<sup>th</sup> different player) in which a player recorded at least 88 hits against left-handed pitching; the most in the majors since 1987 (Tony Gwynn - 90)
- ⚾ His 11.00 plate appearances/strikeout (550 PA/50 K) led the majors in 2019

Current streak: 1G (since 7/26; .200, 1-5, 2B, RBI) 2020 High: 1G (7/26-current; .200, 1-5, 2B, RBI)

- ⚾ Went 2-for-38 with one double in 13 games against NYY last season
- ⚾ Appeared on his ninth-straight Opening Day roster with the Orioles and the 11<sup>th</sup> of his career
- ⚾ Started the 2019 season 0-for-33 and was hitless in 54-straight at-bats and 62-straight plate appearances dating back to the 2018 season, setting the MLB record
- ⚾ Recorded his 10<sup>th</sup> home run of the season on 8/28/19 at WSH; his eighth-straight season with 10-or-more home runs

## 21 • AUSTIN HAYS • OF (R) .182/.286/.182 - 0 HR - 1 RBI

- ⚾ A career .302 (29-for-96) hitter against RHP, compared to a .163 (7-for-43) hitter against LHP
- ⚾ Of the 22 career games in which he has recorded a hit, 11 have been multi-hit games
- ⚾ Made his MLB debut on 9/7/17 vs. NYY; his first career HR came at NYY on 9/16/17
- ⚾ Appeared on his first career Opening Day roster this year
- ⚾ According to STATS LLC., Hays became the first MLB rookie to have 5+ RBI, a SB, and an outfield assist in the same game (9/23/19 at TOR) since RBI became an official stat in 1920
- ⚾ Recorded his first career two-home run game on 9/23/19 at TOR; also recorded a career-high 5 RBI, while also recording his first career stolen base
- ⚾ Batted .248 (87-for-351) with 17 HR across four different minor league levels last season

## 11 • JOSÉ IGLESIAS • INF (R) .538/.538/.769 - 0 HR - 2 RBI

- ⚾ Has hit in the three-hole in the lineup in each of the first three games; prior to this season, he had just one career start in the three-hole (5/29/19, while with CIN)
- ⚾ His .538 batting average ranks third in the majors and his seven hits rank tied for sixth
- ⚾ Matched his career high (fifth time) with four hits on 7/26 at BOS; also matched his single-game-high with two doubles (seventh time)
- ⚾ Appeared on his seventh career Opening Day roster; his first Opening Day roster came in 2013 as a member of the Red Sox when he was the Opening Day shortstop
- ⚾ Set career-highs in games played (146), hits (145), home runs (11), runs (62), and RBI (59) in 2019
- ⚾ Made a career-high 136 starts at shortstop last season; posted a .980 fielding percentage
- ⚾ Led the National League in first inning batting average (.433) during the 2019 season; ranked second in both on-base percentage (.452) and slugging percentage (.733)
- ⚾ Ranked fifth in the National League with a .322 (84-for-261) road batting average last season
- ⚾ Batted .571 (8-for-14) with two home runs and 21 RBI with the bases loaded in 2019

- ⚾ His 17 RBI were the most by an opponent against NYY last season and his six home runs were tied for the third-most against the Yankees
- ⚾ Appeared on his second career Opening Day roster (2019, 2020)
- ⚾ Was one of 20 players in the AL in 2019 with at least 30 home runs and at least 90 RBI
- ⚾ Last season he became the fifth player (eighth time) in Orioles history to hit at least 30 home runs in a season in which they were 25-or-younger (Machado 3x, Powell 2x, Schoop, and Murray)
- ⚾ Made 109 starts as the DH, 21 starts at first base, and eight starts at third base last season

- ⚾ Appeared on his second-straight Opening Day roster; started at 3B last season for the O's
- ⚾ Made 89 starts at third base and four starts at first base during the 2019 season
- ⚾ Hit .306 (22-for-72) with RISP and .366 (15-for-41) with RISP and two outs last season
- ⚾ Hit a walk-off, two-run homer on 8/11/19 vs. HOU for the Orioles first walk-off win of 2019 and his first career walk-off homer...Landed on Eutaw Street, his first career Eutaw Street home run and the second-ever walk-off to Eutaw Street in ballpark history (Luke Scott, 7/19/07 vs. DET)

- ⚾ Appeared on his second career Opening Day roster (2018, 2020)
- ⚾ Led the Orioles with five outfield assists during the 2019 season; made 37 starts in right field, 32 starts in left field, and 20 starts in center field
- ⚾ Made 20 starts in center field last season; entered the season with zero career games in CF in his professional career (minors or majors)
- ⚾ After being recalled from Triple-A on 6/7/19, he was second on the Orioles in doubles (20), home runs (19), and RBI (58), and fourth in hits (98) and runs scored (44)
- ⚾ Recorded his first career multi-home run game on 8/31 at KC; hit a home run from each side of the plate; seventh different Oriole (15<sup>th</sup> time) to hit a home run from both sides of the plate in the same game

- ⚾ Matched his career-high with four hits four different times during the 2019 season, all of which came on the road (8/30 at KC, 7/27 at LAA, 7/25 at LAA, and 5/25 at COL)

- ⚾ Drove in 16 runs in his first 16 games in 2019 with the O's; drove in four runs in his final 43 games
- ⚾ Hit his first career Eutaw Street home run on 6/28/19 vs. CLE off of RHP Mike Clevinger
- ⚾ Started the 2019 season with Triple-A Norfolk and was recalled on 6/3/19
