THE TWINS: Completed their 10-game roadtrip with a record of 4-6, going 3-0 at Boston, 1-3 at Chicago-AL and 0-3 against the Pirates...tonight, Minnesota will begin a seven-game homestand with the first of three against the White Sox through Wednesday...after this series, Minnesota will host the Royals for four games, from Thursday-Sunday.
 ☞ Twins are looking to avoid losing their sixth-straight game today, which would be their longest since September 1-6, 2025.
 ☞ Twins have won three of their last four games at home...they have won two of their last three series* (May 12-14 vs. Miami and May 18-20 vs. Houston).
 ☞ Twins are on day 11 of a 17 games in 17 consecutive days...next day off is Monday, June 8.

TWINS SUFFER STEEL CITY SWEEP: The Twins lost to the Pirates on Sunday afternoon at PNC Park by a score of 9-3, suffering their third sweep of the season...Zebby Matthews (1-3) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing seven runs on six hits in 4.1 innings pitched, with two walks and seven strikeouts...Mike Paredes made his major league debut in relief, allowing two runs on two hits in 3.2 innings pitched, with three walks and three strikeouts...the offense recorded six hits, two from both Brooks Lee and Josh Bell...Lee homered twice, his second career multi-home game, accounting for all three runs on the day.

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and White Sox are playing the fifth of 13 games this season...these two last met for four games last week, from Monday-Thursday as the Twins won just once, taking game two by a score of 5-3 in 11 innings.

☞ Minnesota has gone 25-13 in its last 38 against the White Sox, dating back to May 4, 2023.
 ☞ Over his last 55 games against the Sox, Byron Buxton is hitting .320 (62-for-194) with 18 doubles, three triples, 17 home runs, 36 RBI, a .706 slugging percentage and a 1.097 OPS...Buck's 24 career home runs, 99 hits, 31 doubles and 57 RBI against the Sox are his most against any opponent.

☞ Buck has 24 career home runs against the White Sox, tied with Tony Oliva for fifth-most in club history (since 1961), trailing Harmon Killebrew (61), Bob Allison (34), Torii Hunter (25) and Justin Morneau (25).
 ☞ Luke Keaschall has hit safely in all 12 career games vs. the Sox, hitting .372 (16-for-43) with four doubles, seven walks, a .471 on-base percentage and a .936 OPS.

☞ Keaschall's 12-game hitting streak to begin his career against the White Sox is the longest in Twins history (since 1961) and tied for third-longest in Twins/Senators history (since 1901), behind Jimmy Ryan (17 G), Jackie Hayes (13 G), George Case (12 G) and Bill Coughlin (12 G).

☞ From April 11, 2023-April 23, 2025, the Twins won 14-straight home games vs. the Sox...since then, they have lost five-straight at Target Field to Chicago.

HE'S E-LUKE-TRIC: Luke Keaschall went 1-for-3 yesterday at Pittsburgh, extended his hitting streak to seven games...over that span, he is hitting .370 (10-for-27) with two doubles and an .837 OPS...seven games marks a season-high...his career-high is 11, from April 18-August 10, 2025 (IL for 3+ months in the middle).

FAM-LEE BUSINESS: Brooks Lee homered twice in yesterday's series finale against the Pirates, his second career multi-homer game (also 2 on 7/29/25 vs BOS)...also recorded multi-hit games in four of 10 games on the Twins' last roadtrip, hitting .286 (10-for-35) with three doubles, three home runs, 10 RBI, three walks, six runs scored and a .988 OPS during that span.

☞ Larry Lee, Brooks' dad and the head baseball coach for Cal Poly, led his team to their first Super Regional in school history yesterday, winning the Los Angeles Regional hosted by UCLA, who was the number one overall seed in the tournament...the Mustangs defeated Saint Mary's 5-2 in the clinching game, punching their ticket to the Supers next weekend for a chance to go to the College World Series.

KISS 'EM GOODBY-RON: Byron Buxton has hit 17 home runs in 36 games since April 13...since that date, he ranks second in baseball, trailing Kyle Schwarber (18) and ahead of Munetaka Murakami (16)...he is currently in a three-game homer drought, his last being a leadoff homer on Wednesday at Chicago-AL, off David Sandlin...since April 21, his longest homer drought is three games.
 ☞ Since 2020, nobody in baseball has homered more against the White Sox than Buxton (17).

FOR THE COMMUNITY: The Minnesota Twins and the club's six minor league affiliates this week are participating in the fifth annual Minnesota Twins Week of Service...during the Week of Service, coaches, clubhouse personnel and front office staff from the Twins and each of Minnesota's minor league affiliates will volunteer in their respective local communities with partners of their choosing...the Twins will also make a donation to a nonprofit of each affiliate's choice...it was believed to be MLB's first-ever coordinated effort of its kind across an entire organization when it debuted in 2022.
 ☞ Earlier today, "Play Day with the Minnesota Twins" at Whittier Elementary School, Pablo López, Toby Gardenhire, Anthony Banda, Josh Bell and LaRoy Hawkins joined students on the field adjacent to the school for fun, and engaged in playtime during recess...Twins personnel also packed backpack and mental health kits on the Main Concourse at Target Field.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1991, the Twins were in fifth place in the AL West (5.5 GB) and beat the Royals 8-4, their first win in what ended as a club record 15-game winning streak.

- Is scheduled to make his 13th start of 2026 and 127th start (128th game) of his career.
- Is 3-0 with a 3.21 ERA (42.0 IP, 15 ER), 10 walks, 47 strikeouts and a .204 (31-for-152) BAA in seven career starts against Chicago-AL.
- In his last start on May 26 vs. Chicago-AL, Ryan did not factor into the decision despite making a quality start, firing a season-high 7.2 innings of two-run, five-hit ball, with no walks and nine strikeouts in a 5-3, 11-inning Twins victory.

LAST TIME OUT: Ryan made his 12th start of the season on May 26 at Chicago-AL opposite right-hander Sean Burke...recorded his team-high seventh quality start of the season but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on five hits (1 HR) through 7.2 innings pitched, with no walks and matched a season-high nine strikeouts, set in his previous start on May 20 vs. Houston...threw 78.6% of his pitches for strikes, his best strike percentage since throwing 91/72 (79.1%) of his pitches for strikes on April 25, 2023 vs. New York-AL.

- The start matched the second longest outing of his career (also 7.2 IP on September 18, 2022 at Cleveland) and longest since recording his longest career outing – a complete-game shutout of the Boston Red Sox – on June 22, 2023 at Target Field.
- Marked his ninth career start with at least nine strikeouts and no walks, the second-most such games in Twins history (1961-), trailing only Johan Santana (13 G).
- Surrendered a game-tying, two-run blast to Munetaka Murakami in the eighth inning, snapping a stretch of five consecutive starts without allowing a homer dating back to April 28 vs. Seattle; the streak fell just one game shy of matching his career-long six-game homerless streak set from April 25-May 24, 2023.
- Did not surrender a hit until Colson Montgomery's two-out single in the fourth inning, snapping a streak of 25 batters without allowing a hit spanning back to Houston's Christian Vázquez, who notched an RBI-single in the second inning on May 20...the only batter to reach safely in that span was Sam Antonacci, who was plunked to leadoff the game.

TWO STARTS AGO: Ryan made his 11th start of the season on May 20 vs. Houston opposite right-hander Mike Burrows...recorded his sixth quality start of the season and earned the win, allowing just one run on four hits through 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and a season-high nine strikeouts.

- His only blemish in the game came on a second-inning, RBI single from former Twins teammate Christian Vázquez...following a three-hit, one-run second inning for the Astros, Ryan would go on to retire 13 consecutive batters from the second inning through the sixth inning.

OH, IT'S YOU AGAIN: This will mark Ryan's eighth career start against the White Sox and second consecutive, with his most recent start against our friends from the Southside coming just six days ago...he is 3-0 with a 3.21 ERA (42.0 IP, 15 ER), 10 walks, 47 strikeouts, a 0.98 WHIP and a .204 (31-for-152) BAA.

- He has gone 6.0-or-more innings in six consecutive outings against the White Sox dating back to May 2, 2023, with five of those being quality starts...the six-game streak is the longest by a Twins starter against the White Sox since José Berrios' six-gamer from September 28, 2018-September 16, 2019.
- Ryan has faced 13 hitters on the White Sox' active roster (including IL); those hitters have combined for a .292 (19-for-65) BAA with four doubles, four home runs, two walks and 12 strikeouts.

COMMANDING THE CENTRAL: Today marks Joe's 42nd career start (43rd game) against an opponent from the American League Central division...he is 19-9 with a 2.97 ERA (242.1 IP, 80 ER), 50 walks, 256 strikeouts, a 0.94 WHIP and a .200 (177-for-885) BAA.

- In four starts against division opponents this season, Ryan is 1-1 with a 3.97 ERA (22.2 IP, 10 ER), six walks, 24 strikeouts, a 1.10 WHIP and a .224 (19-for-85) BAA...the Twins' offense has provided Ryan with two-or-fewer runs of support in three of those four starts.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In 62 career road starts, Ryan is 21-20 with a 3.89 ERA (344.1 IP, 149 ER), 77 walks and 363 strikeouts, compared to 28-19 with a 3.54 ERA (361.1 IP, 142 ER), 85 walks and 426 strikeouts in 65 home appearances (64 starts).

- In six starts away at Target Field this season, Ryan is 2-2 with a 2.15 ERA (29.1 IP, 7 ER), six walks, 36 strikeouts, a 0.89 WHIP and a .187 (20-for-107) BAA.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: In 2026, lefties are slashing .203/.264/.346 (27-for-133) with seven doubles, four home runs, six walks and 35 strikeouts against Ryan, while righties are slashing .188/.243/.248 (19-for-101) with six doubles, eight walks and 35 strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .215/.275/.382 (280-for-1,304) with 89 walks and 328 strikeouts (3.69 K/BB), while right-handed hitters are slashing .224/.271/.409 (300-for-1,337) with 73 walks and 461 strikeouts (6.32 K/BB).

- Ryan's 6.32 K/BB against righties is the sixth highest among all pitchers in Major League Baseball since he made his debut on September 1, 2021 (min. 1,000 batters faced).

THE ARSENAL: Ryan relies on a six-pitch mix...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:

- Ryan ranks third among major league pitchers with a .079 (3-for-38) BAA on his curveball and is third with a 43.9 strikeout percentage (min. 40 plate appearances).
- Has a 27.3% whiff percentage on his four-seamer, which is the fifth highest among American League pitchers (min. 300 pitches).
- Joe has an overall pitching run value of 14, which falls within the league's 98th percentile, and is tied for the sixth highest in all of baseball.

MAY-KING HIS MARK: Joe finished May with a 1-0 record and a 1.73 ERA (26.0 IP, 5 ER) through five starts, lowering his career ERA in the month of May to 2.43 (140.2 IP, 38 ER)...it is the second consecutive season he has posted a sub-two ERA in May, after owning a 1.86 ERA (29.0 IP, 6 ER) in May of 2025.

- His career 2.43 ERA in the month of May is the best by a starting pitcher in Twins club history (1961-) and fifth since the franchise's inception in 1901 (min. 25 games).

CAREER NOTES

- In 2026, was invited to participate in the World Baseball Classic as a member of Team USA.
- In 2025, made first career MLB All-Star Game appearance, throwing a 10-pitch perfect fourth inning with two strikeouts (SD Manny Machado and CHC Kyle Tucker).
- 2025 marks his seventh professional season, including 2020, and his fourth consecutive year in the Twins' season-opening rotation.
- In 2024, set single-game career high in strikeouts (12) and recorded career strikeout no. 500.
- Made first career Postseason start in 2023 vs. Houston (ND, 2.0 IP, 2 H, 1R/ER, 1HR, 0 BB, 1 K).
- In 2023, set career highs in starts (29), innings pitched (161.2) and strikeouts (197).
- In 2022, his first full major league season, was Twins Opening Day starter and led both the club and all AL rookies in wins (13), innings pitched (147.0) and strikeouts (151).
