TODAY'S STARTER: #73 - LHP SHANE DROHAN

LHP Shane Drohan, 27, was acquired from Boston with LHP Kyle Harrison and INF David Hamilton on February 9 in exchange for INF Caleb Durbin, INF Andruw Monasterio, INF/C Anthony Seigler and a 2026 Competitive Balance Round B selection....Drohan went 5-1 with a 2.27 ERA in 12 games (11 starts) at Triple-A Worcester last season, holding opponents to a .185 AVG with 67 strikeouts in 47.2 innings while posting a 1.01 WHIP....he missed time while on Worcester's injured list from 5/13-8/25 with left forearm inflammation....Drohan was selected by Boston in the fifth round of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of Florida State University.

ALSO SCHEDULED TO PITCH...

LHP DL Hall, 27, went 1-0 with a 3.49 ERA in 20 games (3 starts) with Milwaukee last season....he held opponents to a .174 AVG....Hall began last season on the 60-day injured list with a left lat strain and was reinstated on May 28.... he was on the 15-day injured list from 8/16-9/27 with a right oblique strain....Hall was acquired on 2/1/24 as part of the trade that sent RHP Corbin Burnes to the Orioles....the initials "DL" stand for Dayton Lane.

RHP Easton McGee, 28, spent most of last season at Triple-A Nashville and went 5-0 with a 3.59 ERA and 1 save in 32 games (1 start)....he held opponents to a .190 AVG with 53 strikeouts in 47.2 innings....McGee also had five stints with the Brewers last season, posting a 5.52 ERA in 9 relief appearances.

RHP Jacob Waguespack, 32, is a non-roster invitee....he went 2-0 with a 2.45 ERA in 25 relief appearances between Triple-A Durham (Rays) and Triple-A Lehigh Valley (Phillies) last season....he has pitched in the Major Leagues with Toronto (2019-20) and Tampa Bay (2024), going 5-5 with a 5.11 ERA in 31 games (14 starts).
