**TODAY'S GAME:** Is Game 3 (1-1) of a 3-game series vs **Meshach Sullivan's Astros** and the third game (1-1) of a 7-day/6-game homestand that includes an off day tomorrow and a 3-game series vs the **Nationals** Tue through Thu.

- Following Thu's game vs **Wsh**, the Reds will resume their road schedule with a 6-game trip at **Cle** (5/15-5/17) and **Phi** (5/18-5/20).
- Cin is coming off a 0-7 road trip at **Pit** (0-3) and **Chc** (0-4).

**ELLYTRICITY:** Among all Major League shortstops this season, **Elly De La Cruz** ranks with the leaders in games (40, T1st), homers (10, T1st), runs (27, T1st), XBH (18, T1st), TB (82, T1st), RBI (29, 2nd), SLG (.516, 3rd), and OPS (.860, 3rd).

- Half of his 10 HR have come off left-handed pitching (47 PA)...hit 5 HR off lefties last year (210 PA)
- Is 3 stolen bases shy of 150 for his career...aiming to become the youngest Red (currently 24 years, 119 days old) since 1900 to reach the mark since 1900 (**Eric Davis**, 25 years, 82 days old).
- Is also 3 stolen bases shy of ranking among the fastest players since the live-ball era (since 1920) to reach 400 hits, 200 RBI, and 150 stolen bases for his career.
- Is on pace for 40 HR and 32 SB...would become the fourth Red in franchise history to join the "30-30 club"...(**Brandon Phillips** in 2007, **Barry Larkin** in 1996, **Eric Davis** in 1987).

**SAVE THE LAST DANCE FOR ME:** In last night's 3-1 vs **Hou**, **RHP Pierce Johnson** earned his first save as a member of the Reds - the 17th of his career.

- Johnson** became the sixth different pitcher this season to earn a save for the Redlegs (also: **Ashcraft**, **Burke**, **Pagán**, **Phillips**, **Santillan**).

**NO ROOM FOR THE BROOM:** The Reds have avoided being swept in **38 consecutive home series** (min. 1g), including this one vs **Hou**...it's the longest such streak since 9/19/11-9/25/13 when the Reds avoided being swept at **Great American Ball Park** in a franchise-record **52 consecutive home series**.

- The Reds avoided being swept in all 26 of their series last year at **GABP**...only the Cin teams of 1940, 1943, 1944, 1994, and 2012 ran the home schedule without being broomed.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** The Reds have grounded into just 18 double plays this season, the fewest in the majors.

**SERIES NOTES:** The Reds are meeting the **Astros** for the only time in 2026.

- Hou** took 2 of 3 vs Cin last year at **Daikin Park** (5/9-5/11).
- Cin has won 11 of the last 14 games vs **Hou**, 56 of the last 81 games, and 20 of the last 26 series.
- The Reds swept the **Astros** in 3 of their last 5 series, in 4 of their last 7 series, and in 5 of their last 10 series.
- In the 3-0 win on 5/9/25, the **Astros** snapped their 9-game losing streak vs Cin dating back to 6/17/19.
- The Reds' 9-game winning streak vs the **Astros** from 6/17/19-9/5/24 was their longest against **Hou** since winning 9 in-a-row 4/29-9/26, 2009...in 1995, Cin beat Hou in 11 straight games from 5/22-9/4.

**KEEPIN' IT CLEAN: 2b Matt McLain** has produced a career-high 74 consecutive errorless games at second base, beginning 8/11/25.

- McLain's** last error at the keystone came on 8/10/25 at **Pit** (throwing error in the 8th inning).

**MINIMIZING MISCUES:** The Reds rank fifth in the majors with a .990 fielding percentage (**Ath** .994, **SD** .993, **KC** .992, **LAD** .990)...Cin's 15 errors rank T5th...only the **A's** (8), **Padres** (10), **Royals** (11), and **Dodgers** (14) have fewer errors so far this season.

**3-4-5:** Reds' 3,4,5 batters lead the majors with 28 homers...the rest of the lineup has combined for 24.

**ROOKIE RECOGNITION: INF Sal Stewart** on Mon was named **National League Rookie of the Month** for March/April...became the ninth Red to ever earn the monthly honor, which was introduced in 2001 (last: **Spencer Steer**, May 2023).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor in the decision in the 3-2, 10-inning loss on Tue, 5/5 at Wrigley Field (5.2ip, 4h, 0r, 4bb, 4k, 98TP).

- Was his first scoreless outing of 5.2 innings or more since Opening Day vs Bos (6.0ip/0r).
- His 98 pitches and 4 walks were a season high.
- For the first time this season was the victim of a blown save.
- Allowed 8 of his 24 batters to reach.
- Pitched into the 6th inning; retired his first 2 batters before allowing a walk, single, walk...turned it over to Connor Phillips who set down Moisés Ballesteros to end the inning.

**APRIL 30 vs COL:** Earned his first win of the season on Thu, 4/30 in the 6-4 victory vs Col (6.0ip, 5h, 2r/2er, 2bb, 5k, 1hr, 86TP)...was his second quality start of the season, his first since Opening Day vs Bos (3/26).

- Averaged 14.3 pitches per inning, his lowest mark since 3/26...his previous 3 starts was averaging 22.3, 20.8, and 23.7 pitches per inning.
- Gave up just 1 extra-base hit, a 2-run homer to Tyler Freeman in the 1st inning...followed the 1st inning with 5.0 scoreless frames (4h, 4k, 1bb, 68 pitches).

**APRIL 24 vs DET:** In his first career appearance vs Det, did not factor in the decision in the 9-8 win on Fri, 4/24 at GABP (4.0ip, 6h, 5r/5er, 2bb, 4k, 2hr, 89TP)...opposed Framber Valdez.

- Was his third straight start in which he failed to reach 5.0 innings.
- His 1st-inning strikeout of Kevin McGonigle marked the 400th of his career...became the sixth-fastest Reds pitcher by appearances (81) to reach the 400K mark since 1893.
- Allowed a season-high 2 HR, 5 flyballs, 6 hard-hit balls, and a 92.6 mph average exit velocity.

**HE EARNED IT:** His 3.57 ERA through his first 83 career starts is the lowest by a Reds starting pitcher in that span since RHP Mario Soto (3.21, 1977-82).

**PERSONAL:** Graduated from Halifax County High School (South Boston, VA), the same school attended by All Elite Wrestling champion "Hangman" Adam Page and Major League pitcher Jeremy Jeffress...was named 2017 Gatorade Virginia Player of the Year...was a 4-year member of the Halifax swim team...at the University of Virginia became only the second pitcher in school history to record at least 300 strikeouts.

- Has appeared as a sub in 13 of his 31 games this season...his 13 games off the bench are tied for seventh-most among all National League position players.

- His 4 homers since 4/26 vs Det (date of Reds debut) are tied for third-most in the NL and for eighth-most in MLB...during that time, also ranks seventh among qualified National League leaders in slugging percentage (.600).
- Has produced 2 of the 3 hardest hits of his career through his first 12 games as a Red (112.6-mph solo HR, Mon at Chc; 112.0-mph single, 4/29 vs Col).
- Made his Reds debut on 4/26 vs Det after being recalled from AAA-Louisville on 4/25...in that game, hit his first HR with Cin and the 50th of his career...was the 10th Red since 2006 to homer in his first AB with the team (last: Kevin Newman, 2023).

## # 44 ELLY DE LA CRUZ • INF .277/.345/.516, 10 HR

- Has homered in each of the Reds' last 8 home series (since 9/18-9/21, 2025 vs Chc), tied for the second-longest streak in franchise history...Reds Hall of Famer Adam Dunn homered in 10 straight home sets during the 2005 season.
- Is the fourth Red since 1900 with at least 10 HR and 8 SB in the team's first 40 games of a season (also: Sal Stewart, 2026; Ron Gant, 1995; Eric Davis, 1987).
- His 5 home runs off left-handed pitching this season are tied for second-most in the majors, behind only Hou's Yordan Alvarez (6).
- Is 3 SB shy of 150 for his career...looking to surpass Eric Davis (25y, 82d) as the youngest Red (currently 24y, 119d old) since 1900 to reach 150 career steals.
- Is 5 extra-base hits shy of tying Bob Bescher (1908-13) for fourth-most by a switch hitter in Reds history.
- Finished April with 10 homers, tying Tony Perez (1970) for the most by any Red before May in club history...this season, ranks among NL leaders in total bases (82, T4th), homers (10, T5th), XBH (18, T7th), SB (8, T7th), and RBI (29, 8th).
- His 10 HR through April were also tied for the most by any Major League switch hitter before May since 1900, matching Sea's Cal Raleigh (2025), Nick Swisher (2006 w/Oak), and Lance Berkman (2002, '06 w/Hou).
- Posted his sixth career multi-homer game on 4/21 at TB, surpassing Pete Rose (1963-78, '84-86) for the most-such efforts by a switch hitter in Reds history

- Has produced 8 extra-base hits over his last 15 starts (since 4/19 at Min)...is 2 games shy of 500 for his Major League career.
- Has appeared at multiple defensive positions in the same game 18 times this season, second to Col's Willi Castro (19g) for the most-such instances in MLB.
- Hit his second homer of the 2026 season on 4/30 vs Col, a 2-run shot off Michael Lorenzen in the 5th inning...marked his 29th career home run out of the leadoff spot, tied with Gary Redus and Kal Daniels for fourth-most in Reds history.

## # 3 KE'BRYAN HAYES • INF .134/.192/.227, 2 HR

- His 6 homers since 4/24 are tied for most among all National League batters... during that time, also ranks among NL leaders in slugging percentage (.667, T2nd), extra-base hits (8, T4th), total bases (34, T4th), and OPS (1.006, 5th).
- Each of his six homers this season have come as a designated hitter, tied for fourth-most in MLB, fewer than only Phi's Kyle Schwarber (13), Hou's Yordan Alvarez (10), and LAA's Jorge Soler (7).
- Produced each of his first 4 homers as a Red in the 3-game series victory from 4/24 to 4/26 vs Det...became the first player in franchise history to produce each of his first 4 HR with the team in the same set.
- On 4/24 vs Det became the first Red and 11th player in MLB history to hit each of his first 2 home runs with a team in the same game, with one being a walkoff... this feat was last achieved by Adam Duvall on 4/1/23 for Bos vs Bal.

## # 9 MATT McLAIN • INF .207/.311/.314, 3 HR

- In Wed's 3rd inning at Chc snapped a season-long 0-for-19 hitless streak with a single off Colin Rea...also hit a solo homer in the 5th inning, his third HR of 2026.
- On 4/24 vs Det posted his first career multi-homer game and finished with a season-best 4 RBI, 1 shy of his career high (6/25/23 vs Atl).

## # 17 DANE MYERS • OF .235/.371/.294, 1 HR

- His .421 batting average against right-handed pitching this season ranks second among MLers with 15+ at-bats against RHP (Tor's Yohendrick Piñango, .429).
- Scored 9 runs over a span of 3 starts from 4/21-4/28, tied for third-most by a Red in any span of 3 starts since 1900, behind only Frank Robinson (10r, 7/8g1-7/12, 1962) and Curt Walker (10r, 7/15-7/17, 1930).
- Drew 7 walks and scored 9 runs over a 4-start span from 4/14-4/28...was the third Red since 1900 to post those stats over any span of 4 starts, joining Joe Morgan (6/27-6/30, 1977) and Bob Bescher (6/2-6/5, 1911).

- His 20.2% chase rate this season ranks fourth among NL batters with 90+ PA (Mil's Garrett Mitchell, 17.9%; Chc's Alex Bregman, 19.1%; Mil's Jake Bauers, 19.7%).

- Is 1 of 4 Major Leaguers this season to log 8+ SB attempts without being caught stealing (also: Pit's Konnor Griffin, Min's Luke Keaschall, Bos' Jarren Duran).
- In Thu's 6th inning at Chc hit his first home run since 4/25 vs Det, a solo shot off Shota Imanaga...marked his 15th career HR, tied for third-most by a Red through his first 58 career games since 1900 (Aristides Aquino, 19; Adam Dunn, 16).
- In Mon's 1st inning at Chc snapped a career-long 0-for-19 hitless streak (since 4/29 vs Col) with a single off Edward Cabrera.
- On Mon was named NL Rookie of the Month for March/April...is the ninth Red to ever earn the honor since its inception in 2001 (last: Spencer Steer, May '23).
- Finished April with 29 RBI, most by any Red before the month of May since the stat became official in 1920, surpassing Tony Perez (26, 1970).
