TODAY'S START—Joe Boyle will make his ninth start as a Ray and his 13th appearance of the campaign...marks the second time in his career he has faced the Blue Jays...is in his third stint with the Rays, joining April 13-14 and July 6–Aug. 22...acquired from the Athletics along with **INF Will Simpson, RHP Jacob Watters** and a Competitive Balance Round A selection for **LHP Jeffrey Springs** and **LHP Jacob Lopez**, Dec. 14, 2024.

LAST TIME OUT—Boyle went 4.1 innings on Sept. 21 vs. BOS in a no-decision in his final home start of the year...he allowed one run on four hits with a career-high nine strikeouts...tied a career-high seven strikeouts swinging (also: Aug. 24, 2024 vs. MIL)...he worked out of a bases loaded jam in the 1st inning before striking out his next four batters faced and five of his next six...allowed a walk-double-double sequence to begin the 4th inning that plated his lone run allowed.

- ✦ Has five strikeouts or more in each of his last three starts...marks his second streak of three such starts or more in his career (also: 3G, Aug. 13-24, 2024).

PARTY IN CANADA—Boyle is making his second career start opposite the Blue Jays tonight...his lone start prior came on Sept. 15 at Steinbrenner Field and he spun 6.0 scoreless frames with four hits allowed and five strikeouts...across five appearances (3GS) in 2025 against the AL East, he is 0-1 with a 3.20 ERA (19.2IP, 7ER) and a .208 (15-for-72) opp. average...he has allowed two runs or fewer in four of those five outings and has gone 4.0 innings or more in three of five.

BREAKING OUT THE PASSPORT—In five appearances (3GS) away from Steinbrenner Field this season, he is 0-2 with a 8.15 ERA (17.2IP, 16ER) and a .239 (17-for-71) opp. average...14 of his 16 earned runs allowed have come in his three starts, falling short of completing 4.0 innings in each...throughout his career, he is 2-4 with a 7.05 ERA (44.2IP, 35ER) and a .222 (37-for-167) opp. average...his last winning decision on the road came on April 7, 2024 at DET (w/ OAK).

- ✦ The right-hander has made eight career starts on the road...in his first two starts (Sept. 30, 2023 at LAA & April 7, 2024 at DET), he was 2-0 with a 2.25 ERA (12.0IP, 3ER) and limited opponents to 21B, 1 2B and 1 HR in those contests...since then, he is 0-4 with a 11.22 ERA (21.2IP, 27ER) and four runs or more allowed in five of six.

THE ARSENAL—In addition to limiting opponents to a .213 (16-for-75) clip on his fastball, opposing hitters are 22-for-102 (.216) in at-bats ending with Boyle's slider (18-for-71) and split-finger (4-for-31)...he has generated a combined 31.1 pct. whiff rate on his secondary offerings and recorded 40 of his 53 strikeouts on those pitches...107 of his 124 career strikeouts have come on his four-seamer or his slider, with the others coming on a splitter (11), sweeper (5) and a sinker (1).

- ✦ With two strikes, opponents are 5-for-47 (.106) with 29 SO and a 35.6 pct. whiff rate against his slider.

ALRIGHT, ALRIGHT, ALRIGHT—Boyle has held righties to a .191 batting average (38-for-199) in his career...he has allowed just 12 extra-base hits, walked 28 batters and struck out 64 right-handed batters...meanwhile, lefties have hit at a .237 clip (50-for-211) against him with 20 extra-base hits, 42 walks and 60 strikeouts.

MINOR MATTERS—In his 18 games (17GS) with Triple-A Durham this season, Boyle has gone 8-4 and pitched to a 1.88 ERA (86.0IP, 18ER), posted a 1.01 WHIP and limited opponents to a .154 (46-for-299) batting average...in his most recent stint with the Bulls, he went 2-0 with a 2.08 ERA (13.0IP, 3ER) and 18 SO across three starts.

- ✦ Min. 250 AB, his .154 opp. average is the lowest among Triple-A pitchers this season...min. 85.0 IP, his 1.88 ERA is second-lowest.
- ✦ He was named International League Pitcher of the Week three times and named IL Pitcher of the Month for June...he went 3-0 with a 1.80 ERA (30.0IP, 6ER), a 0.97 WHIP and a .167 (18-for-108) opp. average in six outings (5GS) during the month...was also named Rays Minor League Pitcher of the Month by the club's baseball operations department.

FIRST IMPRESSIONS—Boyle's first start for the Rays came in a spot start on April 13 vs. ATL...he earned his first and only win of 2025 after tossing 5.0 hitless innings (2R, OER) with 2 BB, 1 HBP and 7 SO...the right-hander retired 13 straight batters to open the game before allowing his first baserunner to reach via walk in the 5th inning...put out the next two batters before yielding a hit-by-pitch and a walk to end his outing.

- ✦ He became one of 22 players since 1901 to toss five hitless innings (or more) in his debut with a team and the second Ray to turn the trick (**Nathan Eovaldi** - 6.0IP on May 30, 2018 at OAK).

2024 RECAP—He went 3-6 with a 6.42 ERA (47.2IP, 34ER) and 56 SO across 13 appearances (10GS) with the Athletics...was on the 15-day IL (low back strain) from May 6–June 5...optioned to Triple-A Las Vegas following his reinstatement and recalled on Aug. 13...optioned back to Las Vegas on Sept. 4 and finished the season there.

- ✦ Limited opponents to a .164 (11-for-67) average with 26 SO against his slider compared to a .270 (27-for-100) clip with 25 SO against his fastball.
- ✦ Held opponents to a combined .200 (30-for-150) average the first and second times through the lineup compared to .414 (12-for-29) the third time through.
- ✦ On Aug. 19 vs. TB, turned in the longest scoreless outing of his career (6.0IP, 2H, OR, 3BB, 6SO) in the Rays final trip to Oakland Coliseum.

TOMORROW'S PROBABLE STARTER: LHP IAN SEYMOUR (4-2, 2.85)

LAST OUTING—Pitched on Sept. 23 at BAL in relief...he went 4.0 innings and allowed four hits, three runs, two walks, one home run and one hit batter with two strikeouts...threw 89 pitches, his fifth straight appearance with 80 or more pitches thrown.

vs. BLUE JAYS—Started on Sept. 17 at Steinbrenner Field against Toronto in his lone appearance against the club...he threw 7.0 innings with one run (OER) allowed on four hits and one walk with three strikeouts.

- Activated from the 10-day IL (fractured left wrist) yesterday after missing 49 games (Aug. 1–Sept. 25)...homered in his first AB off of the IL, his 13th of the year.
- Since June 1, he has hit safely in 37 of 51 contests and reached base in 45 games...over that span, he is 59-for-189 (.312) with 11 2B, 6 HR, 24 RBI, a .849 OPS and 17 multi-hit games.
- Among major league first basemen with at least 350 AB, he ranks first in average (.316/114-for-361)...he also ranks highly in OBP (1st, .395), OPS (2nd, .879), OPS+ (2nd, 144), SLG (6th, .485) and bWAR (8th, 3.2).
- With runners in scoring position, he is slashing .365/424/.541 (31-for-85) with 45 RBI...he is also batting .333 (12-for-36) with RISP and two outs.
- In 73 games against AL opponents this season, he is hitting .317 (83-for-262) with 17 2B, 11 HR and 42 RBI...he has recorded a hit in 28 of his last 34 starts (June 16–pres.) against the AL.

- Hit his 45th HR of the season last night at TOR...marks the second-most home runs by a major league player in an age-21-or-younger season (age as of June 30), behind only the Milwaukee Braves **Eddie Mathews** (47, 1953)...marks the second-most homers in a season in franchise history, one shy of **Carlos Peña's** 2007 season (46)...he has 110 RBI, the most by a Ray since **Evan Longoria** had 113 in 2009 and fourth most in a single season in club history...became the first player in franchise history to have six home runs or more in every month of a single season.
- Has reached base safely in 18 of his last 22 games, going 26-for-84 (.310) with 6 2B, 6 HR and 16 RBI.
- Has 90 RBI in his last 105 games since May 24, T2nd in the majors in that span...is also second in XBH (58) and T3rd in HR (37) in that span.
- The Rays are 60-40 when he records a hit and 12-40 when he goes hitless...in wins (72G) this season, he is hitting .328 (97-for-296) with 24 2B and 30 HR compared to .193 (59-for-299) with 4 2B and 15 HR in losses (80G).
- Was named the Don Zimmer Most Valuable Player for 2025 by the Tampa Bay chapter of the BBWAA.
- On Sept. 13 at CHC, he hit his 50th career home run, becoming the second-youngest Dominican-born player in major league history to reach 50 career home runs (22y, 70d) behind only **Juan Soto** (20y, 297d).
